ORDER

Syed Mansoor Ali Shah, J.- The departmental appeal, as well as, service appeal before the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal ("**Tribunal**") was barred by time and no plausible ground for condonation of the same has been shown to us. Even otherwise we have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner at some length and find that neither any substantial question of law of public importance has been specified in this petition nor any has been raised before us. It is also clarified that the Service Tribunal is the highest forum for the purpose of determination of facts and only a substantial question of law of public importance arising out of the case can be taken up by this Court. See *Secretary Revenue Division v. Iftikhar Ahmed Tabbasum* (PLD 2019 SC 563). No such question is involved in the instant petition, which is accordingly dismissed and leave refused.
