# PARAWISE COMMENTS ON BAHALF OF RESPONDENTS No. 01 to 03

# RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:-

- I. That the Appellant has got no cause of action/locus standi to file the instant Appeal.
- II. That Appellant has not come to this Hon'ble Tribunal with clean hands.
- III. That this Honorable Tribunal has got no jurisdiction to adjudicate upon the matter.
- IV. That the Appellant has deliberately concealed material facts from this Honorable Tribunal.
- V. That the instant Appeal is barred by law and time.
- VI. That the instant Appeal is bad in its present form hence not maintainable and liable to be dismissed with special cost throughout.

#### FACTS: -

1) Para # 1 pertains to record.

- 2) Para # 2 pertains to record.
- 3) Para # 3 is incorrect. Initiation of three disciplinary proceedings in inquiry # 167/VI (Annexure "B"), 168/VI (Annexure "C") & 169/VI (Annexure "D") and issuance of final show-cause notices # 1563-2/52, 1564-2/52 & 1565-2/52 dated 23/06/2022 (Aneexure "E", "F" & "G"), would bear ample testimony to her conduct and indifferent attitude towards performance of her official duties.
- 4) Para # 4 relates to personal life of the Appellant.
- 5) Para # 5 also relates to the personal life of the appellant. Nevertheless, she neither conveyed nor applied for leave on account of being indisposed.
- 7) Incorrect against facts and law, hence, denied Posting and transfer is part and parcel and integral part of the service. Her two postings from two different courts would reflect that she was unable to perform her work, to the satisfaction of the presiding officers. Ultimately, she was transferred to the scanning branch through an order dated 02/06/2022 which she did not comply, which is unbecoming of a civil servant.
- 8) Incorrect against facts and law, hence, denied. Since, there was sufficient material to proceed against the appellant, therefore, she was issued final show-cause notice by dispensing the inquiry within the meaning of rule 5(1)(a) of the KPK Govt Servant Efficiency & Discipline Rules 2011. This show-cause notice was served upon the appellant by the Superintendent Session Court in presence of the presiding officer of the court where she was posted.

- 9) The appellant has been dismissed from service vide impugned dismissal order dated 01/07/2022 (Annexure "I") by observing all the codal formalities, well within the remits and adhering to the rules governing the subject.
- 10) Para 10 is a matter of record.

#### **GROUNDS:**

· · ·

a- The impugned dismissal order is neither malafide & discriminatory nor against the law and rules.

- b. The appellant had been issued three show-cause notices bearing # 1563-2/52, 1564-2/52 & 1565-2/52 dated 23/06/2022 containing the statements of allegations. She did not file any reply and the competent authority after considering contents of the complaints and related facts of the case and reasons /grounds thereof, dispensed with the formal inquiries as permissible under E & D Rules 2011.
- c. The appellant through final show-cause notice # 1565-2/52, dated 23/06/2022
   was called upon to convey in writing, if she would like to be heard in person
   but she neither submitted any reply within the prescribed time nor intimated to opt for personal hearing, which speaks volume about her stubborn attitude.
- d. The impugned dismissal order dated 01/07/2022 was not ex-parte as the appellant herself intentionally did not opt to join the disciplinary proceedings.
- e. The undersigned as competent authority had adhered to the procedure provided under the rules governing the subject.
- f. The appellant's mother did not apply for medical leave rather the facts had been marshaled to give twist and cover to the conduct and indifferent attitude she has imply demonstrated during her service. Her assertion is belied by the office record.
- g. Since, the appellant did not apply for the medical leave, therefore, this para needs no comments.

The Appellant neither joined the fact findings inquiries nor bothered to submit reply to the final show-cause notice or to be heard in person in pursuance thereto, which, amply speaks of least respect to service discipline and good order. She was issued explanation bearing # 1444/-2/52, dated 13/06/2022,

which she had refused to receive as per report of the superintendent even dated. Her appeal is meritless and liable to be dismissed.

The Answering Respondents will also raise more grounds at the time of arguments with the permission of this Hon'ble Tribunal.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that the Appeal filed by the Appellant being incorrect, time barred, baseless, frivolous, illegal, without any substance and against the record, may graciously be dismissed with heavy cost.

Any other remedy which this Hon'ble court deem proper in the circumstances may also graciously be awarded in favour of the Answering Respondents.





It is reported against you that you have committed the below mentioned serious acts/omissions in contravention of the conduct rules while being working as Computer Operator in the court of Civil Judge-XI/JFC-IV:

(1) You had misbehaved with the then presiding officer Miss. Faiza Malik, thus, demonstrated a conduct prejudicial to good order and service discipline, which amounts to misconduct.

(2) You had, shown unprofessionalism and failed to comply with and obey lawful and reasonable orders given to you by your presiding officer, as you refused to switch on computer and to transmit the PQS data, thus failed to perform functions assigned to you in the discharge of your duty, rendering yourself inefficient.



(3) You had failed to maintain good conduct and discipline, thus, demonstrated a conduct unbecoming of Government servant and gentle woman, rendering yourself to misconduct.

Whereas, during the facts-finding inquiry, conducted by Senior Civil Judge (Admn), you opted not to defend yourself and was found guilty of misconduct.

Whereas, after conducting the facts-finding inquiry, there is sufficient evidence against you, therefore, the undersigned is satisfied that there is no need to hold any formal inquiry, hence dispensed with the formal inquiry, within the meanings of 3<sup>rd</sup> proviso to Rule 5 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 2011.

Whereas by reason of above, you, Miss Ayesha Zeb, Computer Operator, have been found guilty of inefficiency and misconduct, within the meanings of Rule 2 (1) (i) & 1 (i) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 2011, which, may lead to imposition of one or more of the penalties including major penalty of dismissal from service as prescribed in Rule 4 (1) (b) (iv) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 2011

Now, I, Mr. Ikhtiar Khan, District & Sessions Judge, being competent authority, call upon you, Miss Ayesha Zeb, Computer Operator, to show cause within 07 days of receipt of this notice, as to why one or more penalties including the major penalty of dismissal from service may not be imposed upon you under Rule 4 (1) (b) (iv) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 2011.

Your written reply to the show cause notice should reach the undersigned within seven days, failing which ex-parte decision shall be taken against you.

You are also called upon to convey, in writing, if you would like to be heard in person.
