SULTAN MAHHOOD KHATTAK, MEMBER. This appeal has been fined by Sher Ali Khan, the appollant under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwe Service Tribunal Act 1974, against the order dated 12.8.2010 whereby the appellant has been superceeded from promotion to List "i" due to indifferent record. If him been, prayed that on acceptance of the appeal, the impugned order may be set asi ie and the respondents may be directed to enlist his name in List "F" from the date when his juniors were enlisted in the said list.





- Brief facts of the case are that the appellant joined the Police Force in the year 1977 and promoted upto the rank of Sub Inspector. He has more than 33 years service at his credit without any adverse entry against him. Meeting of DPC for admission of Sub Inspectors of Sub Inspectors to List "F" was held on 19.7.2010 in which the appellant was superseded without mentioning any specific deficiency or adverse remarks. Other colleagues/batch-mate of the appellant were recommended for enlistment in list "F" while he has been superseded. The impugned notification dated 12.8.2010 received to the District Police Dir Lower on 13.8.2010. Feeling aggrieved, the appellant filed departmental appeal on 10.9.2010, which elicited no response within the statutory period of ninety cays, hence the present appeal.
- 3. The appeal was admitted to regular hearing on 24.3 2011 and notices have been issued to the respondents. The respondents have filed their joint written reply and contested the appeal. The appellant also filed rejoinder in adbuttall
- 4. Arguments heard and record perused.
- 5. The learned counsel for the appelant argued that the appellant was appointed in the year 1977 and promoted up to the rank of Sub Inspector the has received no adverse entry of any kind in his service as Sub Inspector but has been superseded while his other colleagues have been considered and their names have been included in List "F". He further argued that other colleagues of the appellant have been promoted while the appellant has been discriminated. The DPC acted in arbitrary manner as no specific deficiency or diverse remarks has been mentioned in its remarks. He requested that the appeal may be accepted as prayed for

The learned AAG argued that the appellant has not been discriminated. It is name alongwith other colleagues placed the tope. Other colleagues of the appellant have been enlisted in List "F" while the appellant has not been recommended due to "C" report received by the appellant in the year, 2009. He requested that the appeal may be accepted as prayed for.

7. The Tribunal observes that the appellant has been superseded from promotion list "F" on the basis of indifferent record of service but no adverse remarks communicated. In his letter dated 29.6.2010, the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Malakand Range stated that the adverse remarks from 14.1.2009 to 31.12.2009 may be conveyed to the appellant but was not conveyed to him till holding of the DPC meeting on 19.7.2010. Hence the appellant cannot be deprived

his legitimate right of promotion on the basis of uncommunicated adverse - marks.

Asif Saeed Khan Khosa, CJ.: In his capacity as a Station House Officer the respondent had not been considered for promotion whereafter the Service Tribunal had directed the appellants to include the respondent's name in the seniority list from the date his juniors were enlisted. The said order passed by the Service Tribunal was interfered with by this Court and the matter was remanded by this Court to the Departmental Authority to consider the respondent's case afresh. After that a Notification was issued on 11.04.2018 through which the respondent was promoted as Inspector with effect from 25.05.2015 but through a contempt petition the High Court had interfered with that

ATTESTED

Sonior Court Associate Supreme Court of Pakistan Islamabad Notification and had held that earlier on the respondent was denied promotion on the basis of an adverse entry in his P.E.R. but the said adverse entry was never communicated to the respondent and, thus, the same could not stand in the way of the respondent in the matter of his promotion treating him at par with those who had been promoted earlier and were junior to him. In that backdrop the High Court had directed that the respondent was to be promoted by the appellants with effect from 12.08.2010. In the above mentioned backdrop we have found the impugned judgment passed by the High Court to be just and fair and, thus, the same does not warrant any interference by this Court. This appeal is, therefore, dismissed.

Criminal Miscellaneous Application No. 67-P of 2018

2. As the main appeal has been dismissed by this Court, therefore, this miscellaneous application seeking interim relief has lost its relevance. Dismissed.

ANNEX: II

INSTRUCTIONS FOR GUIDANCE

While filling in the quantification Form and working out quantification marks the following factors may be kept in view to avoid in error:-

- (i) <u>DEDUCTION</u> is to be made as indicated below:-
 - (a) One mark for each adverse report;
 - (b) 3 marks for each minor penalty imposed on a civil servant in a disciplinary case under E&D Rules, 1973/Disciplinary Rules prevailing at the time;
 - (c) 5 marks for each major penalty imposed on a civil servant in a disciplinary case under E&D Rules, 1973/Disciplinary Rules prevailing at the time.
- (ii) Addition of 2 marks is to be made for service in a (specified training) institutions for a period of two years or more.
- (iii) If more than one PERs have been initiated on an officer during the calendar year, their average marks would be the marks for the whole calendar year.
- (iv) Writing of a PER covering part periods of two calendar years is not permissible.
- (v) If a period of report is less than 3 months, it shall be ignored for purposes of quantification.
- (vi) Quantification marks should be in round figure.
- (vii) If the overall grading in a PER is ambiguous e.g. placed between 'Good' and 'Average' the quantification will be based on the lower rating.
- (viii) Where Only two reports or less are available on an officer against posts in a particular basic pay scale, these PERs will be added to the PERs earned in the lower post for calculating the average marks.
- (ix) Where an officer appointed to a higher post on acting charge basis is considered for regular promotion that post, the PER earned during acting charge appointment will be added to PERs earned in the lower post for calculating average marks.

First Step

Arithmetic mean will be calculated for each calendar year containing 2 or more PERs to derive the PER score for that year as follow:

Third Step

Weightage for posts held at each level will be given as follows in computing the aggregate score against a uniform scale of 100 marks for promotion:

to post carrying basic pay scale 18 10xA (i)

to post carrying basic pay scale 19 (6xB)+(4xA)

(ii) (5xC)+(3xB)+(2xA)to post carrying basic pay scale 20 (iii)

(5xD)+(3xC)+(A+B)to post carrying basic pay scale 21 (iv)

Where

A = Average marks for reports in posts carrying basic pay scale 17

B = Average marks for reports in posts carrying basic pay scale 18

C = Average marks for reports in posts carrying basic pay scale 19

D = Average marks for reports in posts carrying basic pay scale 20

VI. Date of Promotion:

Promotion will always be notified with immediate effect.

VII. Notional Promotion:

In respect of civil servants who retire (or expire) after recommendation of their promotion by the PSB/DPC, but before its approval by the competent authority, their promotion shall be deemed to have taken effect from the date of recommendation of the PSB/DPC, as the case may be, and their pension shall be calculated as per pay which they would have received had they not retired/expired.

VIII. Promotion of Civil Servants who are awarded minor penalties.

- (a) The question of promotion to BS-18 and above in case of civil servants who have been awarded minor penalties has been settled by the adoption of quantification of PERs and CEI which allows consideration of such cases for promotion subject to deduction of 5 marks for each major penalty, 3 marks for each minor penalty and 1 mark for each adverse PER from the quantified score and recommendation for promotion on attaining the relevant qualifying threshold.
- (b) However, the CEI policy is not applicable to civil servants in BS-16 and below. In this case, the concerned assessing authorities will take into consideration the entire service record with weightage to be given for recent reports and any minor penalty will not be a bar to promotion of such a civil servant.

IX. Promotion in case of pending investigations by NAB:

If there are any NAB investigations being conducted against an officer, the fact of such investigations needs to be placed before the relevant promotion for which may take a considered decision on merits of the case.

 All the existing instructions on the subject shall stand superseded to the above extent, with immediate effect.

- b) The civil servants who are on deputation abroad or working with international agencies within Pakistan or abroad, will be asked to return before their cases come up for consideration. If they fail to return, they will not be considered for promotion. They will be considered for promotion after earning one calendar PER and their seniority shall remain intact.
- c) In case of projects partially or fully funded by the Federal or Provincial Government, where PERs are written by officers of Provincial Government, the condition of earning one calendar PER shall not be applicable to officer on deputation and the officer on return to his/her cadre shall be considered for promotion.
- d) The civil servants on deputation to Federal Government, Provincial Government, autonomous/semi-autonomous organization shall be considered for promotion and informed to actualize their promotion within their cadres. They shall have to stay and not be allowed to go back immediately after promotion. Such stay shall be not less than a minimum of two years. If he/she declines his/her actual promotion will take place only when he/she returns to his/her parent cadre. His/her seniority in the higher post shall, however, stand protected.
- e) The cases of promotion of civil servants who have not successfully completed the prescribed mandatory training (MCMC, SMC & NMC) or have not passed the departmental examination for reasons beyond control, shall be deferred.
- f) Promotion of officers still on probation after their promotion in their existing Basic Scales shall not be considered.
- g) A civil servant initially appointed to a post in a Government Department but retaining lien in a department shall not be considered for promotion in his parent department. However, in case he returns to parent department, he would be considered for promotion only after he earns PER for one calendar year.
- h) A civil servant who has resigned shall not be considered for promotion no matter the resignation has yet to be accepted.

V. Deferment of Promotion:

- (a) Promotion of a civil servant will be deferred, in addition to reasons given in para-IV, if
 - (i) His inter-se-seniority is disputed/sub-judice.

- (d) The officers who have been granted exemption from mandatory training having attained the age of 56 years or completed mandatory period of serving in a Training Institution upto 27-12-2005, may be awarded marks on notional basis for the training factor (for which he/she was exempted) in proportion to the marks obtained by them in the PERs.
- (e) Status quo shall be maintained in respect of officers of special cadres such as teachers, doctors, professors, research scholars and incumbents of technical posts for promotion within their own line of speciality. However, for calculation of their CEI, 70% marks shall be assigned to the quantified score of PER s and 30% marks shall be at the disposal of the PSB.

- (b) This condition will not be applicable to civil servants in specialized cadres such as Doctors, Teachers, Professors, Research Scientists and incumbents of purely technical posts for promotion within their own line of specialization as envisaged in the existing Promotion Policy.
- (c) The qualifying thresholds of quantification of PERs for nomination to these trainings are as under:



- (d) There will be no exemptions from mandatory trainings. An officer may, however, request for temporary exemption in a particular moment in time but grant of such exemption would be at the discretion of the competent authority. No such request with regard to an officer would be made by the Government Departments concerned.
- (e) Three officers shall be nominated for each slot of promotion on the basis of their seniority. Those unwilling to attend will be dropped at their own expense without prejudice to the rights of others and without thwarting or minimizing the chance of improving the quality of service.
- (f) Officers failing to undergo mandatory training in spite of two time nominations for a training shall stand superseded if such failure was not for the reasons beyond the control of the officers concerned.

III. Development of Comprehensive Efficiency Index (CEI) for promotion:

- (a) The Comprehensive Efficiency Index to be maintained for the purpose of promotion is clarified as under:
 - (i) The minimum of aggregate marks for promotion to various grades shall be as follows:

STANDING ORDER NO. 03-12016

Advance Course for Inspectors

This Standing Order is issued under Article 10(3) of Police Order 2002.

- 2. Aim: The standing order aims at regulating the promotion of Inspectors to the rank of Deputy Superintendents of Police (DSsP) through Advance Course which will equip Inspectors with requisite skills and knowledge to assume and discharge higher responsibilities in a professional manner.
- 3. Advance Course shall be mandatory for promotion from the rank of Inspector to the rank of DSP. No Inspector shall be promoted to the next rank unless he/she has successfully completed Advance Course in accordance with the standards and in the manner set forth to that count.
- 4. Duration and Schedule: Duration of the course will be 14 weeks divided into two terms. The 1st course will be started in mid March whereas the 2sd course will take start in mid July. It will be conducted twice a year.
- 5. Venue: The course will be conducted at Police Training School Swat. Some of the modules to be arranged at Specialized Schools in other Regions. The venue of the course has been shifted from PTC Hangu to PTS Swat due to difficulty in arranging competent visiting faculty over there. Swat bring divisional headquarters has High Court Bench, University of Swat and Saidu Sharif Medical College in its fold. Thus experienced and competent visiting faculty can easily be arranged to conduct modules in disciplines of criminal justice, medico legal and personality development etc.
- 6. Nomination: For each course maximum 25 participants will be nominated and nomination for Advance Course shall strictly be in accordance with order of seniority.
- 7. Exemption: There shall be no exemption from Advance Course on any ground whatsoever provided in case when an Inspector has attained the age of 58 years before the first day of a Advance Course for which such Inspector is otherwise due to be nominated on the basis of seniority. Such inspector, if otherwise eligible for promotion in accordance with rules, shall be promoted without qualifying Advance Course.
- 8. In case an Inspector fails to join Advance Course for which he/she is nominated in accordance with seniority, on any ground whatsoever, shall not be entitled for exemption on the grounds of reaching the age of 58 years subsequently. Such an Inspector shall be required to qualify Advance Course before promotion, even if he/she has attained the age of exemption, i.e. 58 years. Otherwise he/she shall not be promoted.
- 2. Exemption from the physical component of Advance Course for an Inspector shall be subject to the prior approval of the Inspector General of Police on the recommendation of committee headed by Addl: IG HQrs, DIG/Trg, AIG/Establishment and Medical Officer.
- 10. Advance Course Syllabus:-The Advance Course Syllabus shall include the following academic modules:
 - a) Police related subjects, including police administration, crime management, police operations, security, intelligence, IT in policing and modern policing concepts.
 - b) General subjects, including management, leadership, human resource management, financial management, public administration, IT, etc.
 - c) Any other subject approved by the Provincial Police Officer.

The Advance Course Syllabus is attached at Annexure-1.



11. Training Activities: Training will be module based followed by assessment after each module and written test at the end of term. Training activities include physical training, class room and extension lectures, study tours, syndicate discussions, class presentation, research papers, synopsis of the lecture delivered, conduct of Police Station inspection etc. Module will be as followed:-
