1. Learned counsel for the appellant present. Mr. Asad Ali Khan, Asst: AG for official respondents No. 1 to 3, learned counsel for private respondent No.5 and an applicant named Abdul Muqtadir S/o Mumraiz Khan, a private person and not a civil servant, for his impleadment as respondent in the instant appeal.

2. As to the application for impleadment filed by Mr. Abdul Muqtadir, it is found that the applicant is neither a government servant nor the appeal in hand would have bearing on any of his rights, therefore, he is neither necessary nor proper party and thus his application is turned down.

3. During the course of arguments, learned counsel for private respondent No.5 produced copy of judgment dated 09.03.2023 passed by Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Bannu Bench in writ petition No. 1129-B/2020 which would show that the said writ petition was disposed of with the directions to the respondents to conclude the inquiry within shortest possible time, but not later than three (03) months. In this scenario, learned Asst: AG was asked to apprise the Tribunal regarding the said aspect, however he requested that some time may be granted to him for the said purpose. Adjourned. To come up for arguments on 30.05.2023 before D.B with the direction that learned Asst:AG shall apprise the Tribunal about the status of the enquiry, if any conducted against the appellant. P.P given to the parties.
