**PRAYER:-**

On acceptance of this appeal the impugned order vide letter/order dated 31-05-2018 may kindly be set aside and respondents may kindly be directed to grant the appellant travelling allowance and additional charge allowance of the post he held w.e.f. 24-11-2016 to 22-03-2018.

**Respectfully Submitted:-**

1. That the appellant was appointed as Instructor on 19-02-1995 and was promoted as Senior Instructor (BPS-17) 24-02-2014 and since then he performed his duties with honesty and full devotion.
2. That the appellant was transferred/posted as Senior Instructor to Govt. Skill Development Centre Balakot District Mansehra vide Office Order dated 16-04-2014 and was deputed/assigned additional charge as an Incharge Principal of Govt. Technical and Vocational Centre(boys) Umarzai District Charsadda vide Office Order dated 24-11-2016, and the appellant accordingly performed additional duties. **(Copies of Orders dated 16-04-2014 and 24-11-2016 are enclosed as Annexure A & B).**

3. That the appellant was holding the additional charge of the mentioned post and being Incharge of the Centre, had to travel there time and again to look after the affairs of the said post till 27-02-2018 when his deputing order was withdrawn vide Office Order dated 27-02-2018. The appellant relinquished charge of the said post on 22-03-2018. **(Copy of Office Order dated 27-02-2018 & Charge Relinquish Report are enclosed as Annexure C & D).**
4. That the appellant vide application dated 28-04-2018, 09-05-2018 and 10-05-2018 approached respondents for the grant of additional charge allowance and Travelling Allowance which was regretted vide letter dated 31-05-2018, Copy of which was communicated to the appellant on 18-06-2018. **(Copies of applications and letter dated 31-05-2018 are enclosed as Annexure E & F).**
5. That the impugned order/letter dated 31-05-2018 is against the law, facts and principles of justice on grounds inter alia as follows:-

#### GROUNDS:-

- A. That the impugned order communicated vide letter dated ~~31-05-2018~~ is illegal and void abinitio.
- B. That mandatory provisions of law and rules have badly been violated by the respondents and the appellant has not been treated according to law and rules.
- C. That the appellant was assigned dual charge by the respondents/competent authority and the appellant efficiently performed the duties of both the posts as assigned with no complaint of any sort and as such is entitled to the grant of additional charge allowance.
- D. That during his dual period, the appellant repeatedly travelled to Umarzai Centre to deal its affairs, as such he is entitled to the grant of Traveling Allowance which cannot be denied at the whims of some one.
- E. That the rules are very much clear on the grant of additional charge allowance as well as on the grant of Travelling Allowance but the respondents are not ready to treat the appellant according to the law and rules. **(Copies of Rules are enclosed as Annexure G).**
- F. That denying the appellant the benefits and allowances which he has earned, amounts to forced labour and exploitation which is prohibited by Islam as well as by the Constitution of the land.



G. That the appellant is denied his due rights without any omission or commission on his part and is not treated according to law thus his fundamental rights are violated guaranteed in the Constitution of the land.

H. That the appellant seeks the permission of this honorable tribunal for further/additional grounds at the time of arguments.


It is therefore prayed that appeal of the appellant may kindly be accepted as prayed for in the heading of the appeal.

## THE GOVERNMENT OF KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES RULES

Notified vide Government of The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Finance Department Notification No.FD.SO(SR-10/78 dated 15.7.1981 as amended from time to time.

### PART-I GENERAL

**Short title-** These rules may be called The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Traveling Allowance Rules, 1980. They shall come into effect on the fourteenth day of July, 1980.

**Extent of application-** These rules shall apply to:-

- i) All civil servants;
- ii) All officers belonging to All Pakistan Unified Grades in respect of whom the Governor of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province has been delegated the powers to frame the rules regulating their Traveling Allowances; and
- iii) Officers on deputation with the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province from the Federal Government or other Provincial Governments unless otherwise determined in any particular case.

**Definitions:** - "Chief Public Office" means at the Headquarters of a District the office of Deputy Commissioner, at an out-post or Tehsil, the Office of the Officer-in-Charge of post or Tehsil and at other places the Police Station or, if there be no Police Station the Post Office or, if there be no Post Office the point designated as such by a competent authority.

**Authorized Medical Attendant**" means a Medical Officer of Government required to attend on a civil servant or his family under the medical attendance rules.

**Civil Servant**" means the civil servants as defined in The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act 1973 (The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act XVIII of 1973) and for the purposes of these rules shall include the officers specified in clauses (ii) and (iii) of rule 1.4, unless otherwise determined in respect of any officer or class of officers.

**Competent Authority**" in relation to the exercise of any power means the Administrative Department concerned acting in consultation with the Finance Department, or any other authority to which such powers may have been delegated.

**Controlling Officer,**" means an officer declared as such for exercising supervision over Traveling Allowance claims of a civil servant or a class of civil servants.

**Day**" means a calendar day beginning and ending at midnight.

**Family**" means a civil servant's

- i) Wife or wives, or husband as the case may be if residing with or wholly dependent upon him;
- ii) Legitimate children and stepchildren less than 12 years of age;

and forward the bill payable by a local body to the local body concerned for necessary action under the rules of the Local Fund.

1.12 **Journeys for which traveling allowance may be drawn** - Traveling allowance may be drawn in respect of a journey performed for any of the following purposes: -

- a) for the purpose of tour;
- b) On transfer
- c) On joining a first appointment;
- d) On retirement; suspension, dismissal, death or termination of employment;
- e) To attend a course of training or to appear at an examination.
- f) To give evidence in a court or to attend an inquiry or conference;
- g) to obtain or furnish medical advice or treatment;
- h) to attend a Darbar or an official function; and
- i) any other purpose authorized by a competent authority.

1.13 **Journeys within sixteen kilometers** - The pay of a civil servant is supposed to include the cost of maintaining a conveyance proper to his status, and therefore, ordinarily he is not to be paid any traveling allowance for journeys within 16 kilometers of his Head Quarters, nor is he to be paid for journeys from his residence to his office. A competent authority may, however, sanction a monthly conveyance allowance to a civil servant under the following circumstances:-

- i) when he does intensive tour within sixteen kilometers of his headquarters;
- ii) when on account of shortage of residential accommodation in a particular locality, a civil servant has to reside at a considerable distance from his office.

1.14 **Conveyance Allowance** - Conveyance allowance is of two kinds:-

- i) that sanctioned on the condition that a particular type of conveyance will be maintained by the civil servant;
- ii) that sanctioned without any such condition being imposed.

1.15 **Conveyance allowance during leave or joining time** - (1) Conveyance allowance falling under rule 1.14(i) may be drawn only for the period the required conveyance is actually maintained on a certificate being furnished by the Officer concerned that this requirement has, in fact, been met.

Such a conveyance allowance may be drawn during leave or joining time at full rates, if the conveyance in question is an animal or an animal drawn vehicle and at half rates, in case of any other conveyance.

Provided that the post held by the civil servant immediately prior to the leave or joining time carried the allowance;

Provided further that the conveyance is actually maintained by the civil servant during the leave or as the case may be joining time.

2) Conveyance allowance falling under rule 1.14(ii) will be admissible only for the period during which the civil servant held the post to which the conveyance allowance is attached and will not be admissible during leave or joining time.

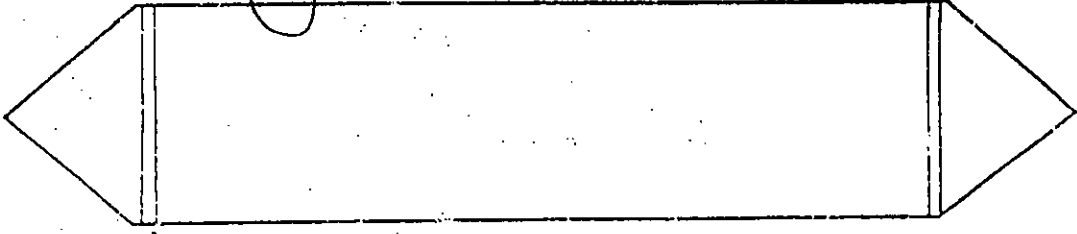

- A- That the appellant has no cause of action.
- B- That the appellant has got no locus standi.
- C- That the appeal is incompetent in its present forum.
- D- The appellant has not come to the court with clean hands.
- E- That the present appeal is bad in its present forum for non-joinder and mis-joinder of the necessary parties.
- F- That the certain material facts have been concealed from the honorable tribunal.

**Respectfully Sheweth,**

- 1) It pertains to record.
- 2) Para 2 of appeal is correct with further clarification that the appellant has concealed certain material facts from the honorable tribunal. The period during which the appellant is claiming travelling allowances / additional charge allowances, the Govt: Skill Development Centre Balakot was closed and it was not functioning at that time. As the appellant was not performing his duty at the said centre, therefore, he was assigned the duty as Incharge of GTVC, Umerzai, Charsadda as he was the resident of Swabi. He continued to draw his salary and allowances against his regular posting.
- 3) It is incorrect. The centre was closed and non functional. He was not performing his duty there except as DDO only for the purpose of drawing salaries of class-iv employees in Balakot.
- 4) The departmental appeal of the appellant for the grant of additional charge allowances and traveling allowances was regretted under the law and the findings of the PROVINCIAL OMBUDSMEN KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA. The due claim as per TA/DA rules were approved while unjustifiable were not honored. The detail of the case at **Annexure-A.**
- 5) It is incorrect. The impugned order / letter dated 31.5.2018 is not against the law, facts and principles. It is based on the decision / finding of PROVINCIAL OMBUDSMEN KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA.

## **G R O U N D S**

- A) Incorrect. The order is accordingly to law
- B) It is also incorrect. No rule has been violated.
- C) Incorrect, the appellant is not entitled to the additional charge allowances. As SDC, Balakot was closed and non functional.
- D) It is Incorrect SDC, Balakot was not functioning / closed. The appellant performed his duty at GTVC, Charsadda for which he drew his salaries and allowances against his regular posting.
- E) It is incorrect. The matter was thoroughly probed into by the Department and PROVINCIAL OMBUDSMEN KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA Secretariat. It was finally probed that the appellant is not entitled to be granted any TA/DA allowance.
- F) It is incorrect. No exploitation has been made to the Appellant. The appellant is claiming the allowance /charges of the work which he did not performed due to the closure of the said centre.
- G) It is not correct. As replied above.
- H) The respondents also seek the permission of this honorable tribunal for further / additional ground at the time of arguments.

In view of the above, it is requested that the instant appeal may be dismissed with cost.

The Agency further informed that the complainant is drawing his salary against regular post and not as temporary and is not allowed any transfer grant or daily allowance.

It is proved that Technical School GDC at Balakot was closed because there was no work and the complainant was transferred to GSDC Charsadda in order to save him from adverse effect. Therefore is not entitled to TA/DA allowance for performing duty of Drawing & Disbursing Officer only for the purpose of drawing salaries of Class-IV employees in Balakot. No maladministration has been proved against the Agency. Investigation is closed in terms of regulation 17(b) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Provincial Ombudsman Office (Registration, Investigation and Disposal of Complaints) Regulations, 2011.

JUDGMENT

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MUSARR AT HILALI:- This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 199 of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 praying that the respondents be directed to regularize the services of petitioners from the date of their appointment with all service benefits with further direction to the respondents to release monthly salaries of petitioners.

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2. Brief facts, as per averments of the writ petition are that under the International Labor Organization Program, "Community Based Livelihood Recovery Program, Mansehra" was launched under the control of Industries, Commerce, Mineral Development, Labour & Technical Education Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and for its smooth running, numerous posts were advertised by the department. The petitioners applied for appointment on the said posts whose interview was conducted on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2008 and ultimately they were appointed vide letters dated 24.11.2008, 26.1.2009, 24.2.2009, 7.7.2009, 26.1.2009 and 7.2.2009. That the petitioner No.1 was promoted to the post of Senior Instructor w.e.r 1.6.2009 vide order dated 3.6.2009 and on 29.11.2010 was directed to take over the charge of the post of Principal, Skill Development Center, Balakot. That on 19.9.2010, the department issued order wherein the posts of petitioners were created on regular side and the Finance Department sanctioned budget for them. It has further been averred that on 11.2.2011, salaries by name for the year

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2011-12 and 2012-13 have been handed over to the department of petitioners but the department is not paying the same to the petitioners and have been held since 01.1.2011. In the year 2012, the manager of the project wrote letter to respondent No.1 that the employees of the Centre are serving the department for the last 4 years but their services position is not clear which require regularization, therefore, the respondent No.1 should expedite process of recruitment/regularization of technical staff in Skill Development Center, Balakot but till date, despite the fact that the petitioners are serving the Center and the Finance Department release their salaries every year, the department is not paying them monthly salaries. Hence this petition.

Arguments of learned counsel for the parties heard and record perused.

3. Record reveals that in the year 2008-2009 the petitioners were appointed on different posts in the Skill Development Center, Balakot on fix pay/temporary basis for the project period, as per the terms and conditions of their

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appointment orders. The grievance of the petitioners is that they have been serving the respondent department for the last four years but neither they have been paid their monthly salaries nor have been regularized as per the North-West Frontier Province Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009 (NWFP ACT No. XVI of 2009).

4. It was during the service of the petitioners when, on 24.10.2009 the North-West Frontier Province Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009 (NWFP ACT No. XVI of 2009) was promulgated section 3 whereof

is reproduced below:

"3. Regularization of Services of certain employees. All employees including recommenders of the High Court appointed on contract or adhoc basis and holding that post on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2008 or till the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to have been validly appointed on regular basis having the same qualification and experience."

2. In view of the aforementioned section of law, the petitioners being in service of the respondent department;

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on 31.12.2008 were entitled to have been regularized. So far as the stance taken by the respondents in their comments is concerned that the appointment orders of the petitioners were issued by the project authorities and that the petitioners are not regular employees of the Directorate of Technical Education & Manpower Training, it is held that vide Notification No. SO (B&A) IND/6-53/2006 dated 14.9.2010 of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Industries, Commerce, Mineral Development Labour & Technical Education Department, the government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa accorded sanction to creation of the posts on which the petitioners were working as project employee. Similar controversies have been dealt with by this court in Writ Petition 1289 of 2010 decided on 08.3.2012 and subsequently in writ petition No. 382-A/2014 decided on 6.9.2016 wherein the petitioners who were appointed as project employees were regularized. Therefore, following the above judgements and in view of section 3 of Act XVI of 2009, the petitioners being similarly placed are entitled to be treated alike/regularized.

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6. In view of the above, this writ petition is allowed. The respondents are directed to regularize the services of petitioners forthwith against their working positions with their salaries from the date of their appointment or from the date when their salaries have not been paid, whichever the case may be.
