2. When confronted with the situation that the appellant had completed more than the normal tenure at the place from where she was transferred, learned counsel for the appellant was very fair and frank not to controvert rendering this appeal fruitless to this extent. As to the claim of the appellant that the salaries of the appellant had illegally been deducted by the respondents in the months of May and October 2019 as there is no representation made in this respect to the competent Authority, the learned counsel for the appellant submitted that he would advise the appellant to make an application to the competent Authority for the desired relief to that extent. However, he requests that a direction may be given to the competent Authority to decide such application in accordance with law within 30 days. Order accordingly. Consign.
