SERVICE APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE OFFICE ORDER NO.32 DATED 19.11.2021 PASSED BY RESPONDNET NO.1, WHEREBY THE MAJOR PENLATY OF "REDUCTIO OF PRESENT PAY BY 03(THREE) STAGES IN

THE TIME SCALES HAS BEEN IMPOSED UPON THE

APPELLANT.

CONSOLIDATED JUDGMENT

KALIM ARSHAD KHAN CHAIRMAN: Through this single judgment this appeal and the connected Service Appeal No. 454/2022 titled "Kashif Awais-

vs- Divisional Forest Officer, Forest Division, Haripur and other", are decided as both are against the same allegations.

- 2. According to the facts gathered from the record, the appellants were serving as Forest Guard in Haripur Forest Division, Haripur; that the appellants had issued a show cause notice on the allegations of misconduct, in-efficiency and corruption; that the appellants submitted a reply to the show cause notice; that respondent No.1 after submission of written reply to the show cause notice by the appellants summoned them for personal hearing and proceedings of such hearing were recorded in shape of written questions and answers; that respondent No.1 had imposed major penalty of "reduction of present pay by three stages in the time scales" upon the appellants; that the appellants being aggrieved of the said order preferred departmental appeal which was not responded within the statutory period of ninety days, hence, these appeals.
- 3. On receipt of the appeals and admission to full hearing, the respondents were summoned, who, on putting appearance, contested the appeals by filing written reply raising therein numerous legal and factual objections. The defence setup was a total denial of the claim of the appellants.
- 4. We have heard learned counsel for the appellants and learned Deputy District Attorney for the respondents.
- 5. The learned counsel for the appellants reiterated the facts and grounds detailed in the memo and grounds of the appeals while the learned Deputy District Attorney controverted the same by supporting the impugned order.

6. Through impugned order dated 19.11.2021, the appellants were awarded major penalty of "Reduction of his present pay by the three stages in the time scale". Admittedly no enquiry was conducted before imposition of major penalty upon the appellants, whereas the circumstances show that inquiry was necessary to be conducted so as to fix the responsibility as well as quantum of punishment if at all the appellants are found guilty during enquiry proceedings, therefore, we deem it appropriate to remit the matter back to the competent authority for conducting of enquiry into the matter strictly in accordance with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011. The enquiry proceedings shall be conducted within sixty days from the date of receipt of this order. Date of receipt of this order shall be communicated by the respondents to the Registrar of this Tribunal. Costs shall follow the event. Consign.
