- Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that the claim of 2. the appellant was though clear to the extent of seeking ante-dation of promotion but he also sought such ante-dation of promotion with all consequential benefits including seniority. He says that such claim of the seniority was hidden in the relief of all back benefits, therefore, it is necessary that the officers who are presently senior to the appellant should be arrayed as party and when a respondent is added the appeal requires amendment accordingly. We allow the request of the appellant and directed him to file amended memo and grounds of appeal arraying all those officers as respondents from whom the appellant claims seniority.
