APPEAL U/S 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT 1974 FOR THE MODIFICATION OF NOTIFICATION DATED 08-12-2022 TO THE EXTENT OF CONFIRMATION OF THE APPELLANT AS SUB INSPECTOR W.E.F 22-09-2002 WITH HIS COLLEAGUES AND FOR WHICH DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT HAS NOT BEEN RESPONDED DESPITE THE LAPSE OF STATUTORY PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS.

PRAYER:-

On acceptance of this appeal, the impugned Notification dated 08-12-2022 to the extent of the appellant may kindly be modified thereby confirming the appellant as Sub Inspector W.E.F. 22-09-2002 i,e from the date when his other colleagues/juniors were confirmed with due place in **Promotion/Application** Lists from due date in all the Seniority Lists thereby placing the name of the appellant above the name of Nisar Ahmad No 27/P, with all back benefits.

Respectfully Submitted:

1. That the appellant along with others was appointed through Khyber Rakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission as Probationer ASI including his juniors namely Nisar Ahmad Khan No 27/P, Tariq than No 31/P and Tariq Habib No 32/P on 21-12-1994. The appellant qualified Lower School Course on 20-09-1995 underwent Inter School Course on 20-03-1996 from Police Training College Hangu. The appellant was confirmed as ASI from the date of his initial appointment along with his stated colleagues vide Notification dated 05-01-1998. (Copy of Order

dated 21-12-1994, Lower School Course Certificate, Inter School Course Certificate & Notification dated 05-01-1998 are enclosed as Annexure A, B & C).

- 2. That the appellant underwent Upper College Course on 10-10-1998 and was brought on Promotion List "E" and was also promoted as ASI Selection Grade vide Notification dated 14-12-1998 and was promoted as Officiating Sub Inspector w.e.f. 22-09-2000 vide Notification dated 27-09-2000. (Copy of Upper College Course Certificate, Notification dated 14-12-1998 & Notification dated 27-09-2000 are enclosed as Annexure D, E & F).
- **3.** That the stated colleagues/juniors of the appellant were confirmed as Sub Inspectors w.e.f. 19-11-2003 vide Order dated 07-03-2005, while the appellant was deferred and not recommended due to incomplete SHO period besides non availability of his ACR,s. (Copy of Order dated 07-03-2005 is enclosed as Annexure G).
- 4. That the appellant was awarded the penalty of Stoppage of two years annual increment vide Order dated 24-09-2007 which increments were restored on appeal vide Order dated 13-11-2007. The appellant was also awarded the penalty of reduction as ASI which on appeal was converted into stoppage of two increments vide Order dated 19-09-2007. (Copies of Orders dated 24-09-2007, Order dated 13-11-2007 & Order dated 19-09-2007 is enclosed as Annexure H).
- 5. That the appellant was not confirmed as Sub Inspector due to incomplete mandatory period till 2022 as evident from the Notification dated 26-05-2021 & Notification dated 22-07-2022. (Copies of Notifications dated 26-05-2021 & Notification dated 22-07-2022 is enclosed as Annexure I).
- 6. That the appellant was transferred to Frontier Reserve Police for one year mandatory period on 27-08-2021 and was finally confirmed as Sub Inspector along with others vide Notification dated 08-12-2022. (Copy of Notification dated 08-12-2022 is enclosed as Appendix 1):
- 7. That the appellant preferred departmental appeal which was duly forwarded however the same has not been responded so far, despite the lapse of more than the statutory period of ninety days. (Copy of departmental appeal is enclosed as Annexure K)
- 8. That the impugned Notification dated 08-12-2022 to the extent of not confirming the appellant as Sub Inspector w.e.f 22-09-

2002 i,e from the date when his other colleagues were confirmed is liable to be modified/varied with due place in promotion lists from due date in all the Seniority Lists, placing the name of the appellant above the name of Nisar Ahmad No 27/P and the refusal of respondents accordingly, is against the law, facts and principles of justice on grounds inter-alia as follows:-

GROUNDS:

- A. That the impugned Notification dated 08-12-2022 to the extent of not confirming the appellant as Sub Inspector from the date his colleagues were confirmed and not promoting him is illegal, unlawful and void ab-initio.
- B. That mandatory provisions of law and rules have badly been violated by the respondents and the appellant has not been treated according to law and rules being his fundamental right as per Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution and law of the land.
- c. That the appellant and his stated colleagues namely Nisar Ahmad No 27/P, Tariq Iqbal No 31/P and Tariq Habib No 32/P. were appointed vide the same order as P ASI,s, and were also confirmed as Assistant Sub Inspectors vide the same order dated 05-01-1998, were brought on promotion List "E" and were also allowed ASI Selection Grade (BPS-11) vide the same order dated 14-12-1998. The appellant was promoted as Officiating Sub Inspector vide Order dated 22-09-2000 while the mentioned Nisar Ahmad, was promoted as Officiating Sub Inspector vide Order 19-11-2001 w.e.f 13-10-2001 while the mentioned Tariq Habib and Tariq Iqbal were promoted as Officiating Sub Inspectors vide Order dated 19-11-2001. The appellant as such was required to have been confirmed as Sub Inspector with effect from 22-09-2002 as per Police Rules 13-18: (Copies of Orders dated 22-09-2000 & Order dated 19-11-2001 is enclosed as Annexure L).
- D. That strangely the stated junior colleagues of the appellant were confirmed as Sub Inspectors w.e.f 19-11-2003 vide order dated 07-03-2005, were brought on Promotion List "F" and were promoted as Officiating Inspectors vide Notification dated 16-12-2005 and were confirmed as Inspectors vide Notification dated 21-05-2008. The mentioned colleagues of the appellant were promoted as DSP,s vide Notification dated 31-03-2012 and were promoted as Superintendents of Police (BPS-18) vide Notification dated 05-09-2022. (Copies of Notifications passed 16-12-2005, Notification dated 21-05-2008, Notification

dated 31-03-2012 & Notification dated 05-09-2022 is enclosed as Annexure M).

- E. That Police Rules 13-18 are very much clear on the point which also provide for confirmation after two years' probation in rank, while the appellant is not confirmed according to the said rules for reasons other than legal and fair. (Copy of Police Rules 13-18 is enclosed as Annexure N).
- **F.** That there is no omission or commission on part of the appellant as he performed his duties whenever and wherever he was posted and also did the courses whenever he was selected and given such opportunity, thus has been deprived of his due legal rights for no fault.
- **G**. That even the appellant has completed the mandatory Period but even then not confirmed as Sub Inspector, Inspector, as DSP and as SP with his colleagues for reasons best known to the respondents.
- H. That ante-dated confirmation as Sub Inspector has been allowed by this honorable Tribunal in numerous Service Appeals including Service Appeals No 1021/2015 titled as Fazal Dad VS PPO & others, Service Appeal No 1227/2013 titled as Waqar Ahmad VS PPO & others decided on 02-08-2018, (who is junior to the appellant), Service Appeals No 1458/2018 titled as Amjid Ali VS PPO (who is also junior to the appellant) ,besides others, hence the appellant too is entitled to be treated alike and should not be discriminated. (Copies of Judgments are enclosed as Annexure O).
- I. That the appellant has about twenty nine years of service with his best honest efforts.

It is therefore prayed that appeal of the appellant may kindly be accepted as prayed for, in the heading of the appeal.

Any other relief deemed appropriate and not specifically asked for, may also be granted in favor of the appellant.







Subsequently civil servant was promoted as Inspector, and was confirmed on said post after two years of his promotion and lastly he was promoted as: Deputy Superintendent of Police, and was confirmed long after sag promotion. Civil servant had claimed that due to his case of gallantry and excellent performance. his confirmation, right from A.S.-I. was required to be revised under 8.13.18 of Punjab Police Rules , 1934 and he was entitled to be confirmed at all stages from date of promotion or from date of an of gallantry whichever would be earlier. Representations of civil servant having been rejected to Authorities, civil servant had filed appeal before Service Tribunal. Performance of civil servant throughout had been commendable and he was holder of highest award namely 'Quaid-e-Azam Police Medal". Civil servant, many a time was recommended for out of turn promotion which was permissible under S.8-A of Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 on basis of his outstanding service record. Civil servant was not asking for out of turn promotion on account of his acts of gallanty or outstanding performance, but he was asking for his confirmation from date of his appointment/promotion as A.S.-I., SubInspector and Inspector with consequential service benefits including promotion as Deputy Superintendent of Police and so on. Two prerequisite conditions to successfully press into service 8.13.18 of Police Rules , 1934 which were, existence of vacancy and satisfactory service record, having fully been fulfilled by civil servant, he was entitled to relief

- Mr. Fazal Dad hereinafter referred to as the appellant has preferred the instant service appeal under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 against final order dated 10.08.2015 vide which his departmental appeal for ante-date confirmation as Sub Inspector w.e.f. 30.07.2010 was regretted and honce the instant service appeal on 28.08.2015.
- Brief facts of the case of the appellant are that the appellant was initially appointed as Constable in the year 1986 and then promoted as Head Constable in the year, 1996 and as ASI in the year 2005 and then as S.I in the year 2008 and there-

promoted as Offig. Sub inspector vide notification dated 21.04.2008 however he was confirmed as S.I on 13.09.2012 while his colleagues including junior to him were confirmed on 30.07.2010 and were assigned seniority in the List "f" accordingly. That the appellant was not confirmed as Sub inspector as he has not served as SIIO. That the appellant submitted written application/departmental appeal but in vain and hence the instant service appeal.

4. Learned counsel for the appellant has argued that the appellant was not assigned the duty to serve as incharge of Police Station. That the said omission is not attributable to the appellant as he was not afforded opportunity to serve as SHO by the high ups. In support of his claim reliance was placed on judgment of this Tribunal passed in service appeal No.

Officer, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar and others" wherein it was observed that it is the authority to give assignment of SEO to the appellant and when the authority fails to give such an apportunity then the rule of serving as independent SHO for one year would hold no ground. Similar view taken by this Erib mal in service appeal No. 1264/2012 | decided on 31.01.2013 as well as appeal No. 37/2011 decided on 03.4.2013.

was not maintainable as the same was not within time, In support of his arguments he has placed reliance on judgment of august Supreme Court of Pakistan passed in Civil Petition No. 566/2012 titled 'Tariq Habib Khan and others versus the Provincial Police Officer, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar and others'

- We have heard arguments of learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
- 7. The impugated final order was passed on 10.08.2015 while the appeal in hand was preferred on 28.08.2015 as such we hold that the appeal is within time. So far as the issue relating to confirmation of the appellant as Sub Inspector w.e.f. 30.07.2010 is concerned the same hold ground as it was not within the authority of the appellant to post himself as SHO of an independent Police Station. Had the relevant authority posted the appellant as SHO and had the appellant failed to perform as SHO despite such posting then the appellant would have not been found entitled to the relief claimed. Since the omission is on the part of the respondents as such the appellant cannot be deprived of his right to ante-date confirmation as Sub Inspector w.e.f. 30.07.2010 i.e. the date on which his colleagues were confirmed.
- 8. For the above mentioned reasons, we are constrained to accept the present appeal and set uside the impugned order



for the appellant while relying upon the judgment of this Tribunal passed in service appeal No. 736/2016 titled Amjad Ali Versus Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa through Secretary Home & Tribal Affairs Department Peshawar and others, argued that this Tribunal in a number of judgments held that confirmation of officiating police officials shall take place from the date of officiating promotion. Learned counsel for the appellant stressed that the appellant is also entitled to the same relief extended to Amjad Ali in Service Appeal No.736/2016.

- 4. As against that learned Deputy District Attorney resisted the present appeal and defended the impugned order dated 04.12.2008.
 - 5. Arguments heard. File perused.
- number of cases that the confirmation of officiating police officials shall be from the date of officiating promotion and that Service Appeal No.736/2016 filed by Mr. Amjad Ali was also accepted on the same analogy, with the direction to the respondent department to take into consideration the cases of all those similarly placed persons who have not been confirmed from the date of their officiating promotion in the light of judgments reported as 1996-SCMR-1 and 1996-SCMR-1185.
- 7. In view of above the present service appeal is accepted in terms of judgment passed in service appeal No.736/2016 as mentioned above. The inter se seniority of the colleagues/badge mates of the



REHIMANE WAY R MEMBER (E):- Brief facts of the case are as promoted as officiating Sub Inspector(SI) on 01-01-2010 but man as Strafter satisfactory service for two years, whereas his other and a sure confirmed in the rank of SI vide order dated inspector vide order dated dita inmediate effect, against which the appellant filed which was not responded to, hence the instant service appeal the appellant may be confirmed as sub inspector w.e.f.

10-09-2012, the date when his other colleagues/juniors were confirmed with due seniority in list F with all back benefits.

- 02. Written reply/comments were submitted by respondents.
- Arguments heard and record perused.
- 04. Learned counsel for the appellant has contended that the appellant was not confirmed as SI along with his colleagues due to the reason that during the tenure as officiating sub inspector, he did not serve in independent charge of a police station, a hotified police post or as in-charge investigation of a police station or in counter terrorism department. Learned counsel for the appellant further contended that such postings were beyond cortrol of the appellant; that according to Police Rules 13:18, it was the legal right of the appellant to be confirmed as SI after lapse of two years, but in case of appellant, the said rules have not been observed; That finally the appellant was confirmed vide order dated 13-07-2015 but with immediate effect instead of 10-09-2012 and was included to list F, whereas his other colleagues and juniors were confirmed on 10-09-2012 and were accorded seniority accordingly, the appellant too, as such is entitled to ante-dated confirmation as ST w.e.f 10-09-2012, but he was not treated accordingly. Learned courisel for the appellant further contended that similar nature cases have already been accepted by this Tribunal and the appellant is also entitled to same relief under the principles of equity and consistency. Reliance was placed on CP No. 538-P of 2003, Service Appeal No. 1502/2010, Service Appeal No. 1450/2013, Service Appeal No. 1227/2013, Service Appeal No. 1021/201; and Service Appeal No. 271/2018. Learned counsel for the appellant added that the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law and rule and was deprived of his legal rights in arbitrary and illegal manner. On the question of limitation, learned counsel for the appellant added that in matter of promotion, seniority, pay and other emoluments, limitation

would not foreclose his right accrued to him. Reliance was placed on 2002 PLC (CS) 1388, 2009 PLG (CS) 178 and 1999 SCMR 880. Learned counsel for the appellant prayed that on acceptance of this appeal, the appellant may be confirmed as SI w.e.f 10-09-2012, the date when his colleague/juniors were confirmed with due seniority in list F and with all back benefits.

- OS. Learned Deputy District Attorney appeared on behalf of official respondents have contended that confirmation in the rank of SI is subject to fulfillment of rule 13:10(2) and standing order ssued by the provincial police officer from time to time; that the appellant was required to qualify the requisite criteria for confirmation in the rank of SI. Learned Deputy District Attorney further contended that the appellant was confirmed as SI, when he fulfilled the mandatory requirements and orders are issued with immediate effect and not with retrospective effect as per law and fulfer Learned Deputy District Attorney added that other colleagues/ juniors of the appellant were promoted after fulfilling the requisite criteria. Learned Deputy District Attorney further added that posting/transfer on independent position are made after examining professional skills and ability of suitable officers; that the appellant was treated in accordance with law and his appeal being devoid of merit may be dismissed.
- O6. We have heard learned counsel for the parties and have perused the record. Record reveals that the only reason for non-confirmation of the appellant as SI was that the appellant had not fulfilled the criteria envisaged in 13:10(2) of Police Rules, 1934, which is reproduced as uncer:

"No Sub-Inspector shall be confirmed in substantial vacancy unless he has been tested for a year of an officiating Sub-Inspector in independent charge of a Police Station, a notified police post, or as in the grant annestigation of a police station of in counter terrorism department."

To this effect the worthy Apex Court as well as this Tribunal, in numerous dements have held that condition of postings as envisaged in the rule ibid, as

pediment in the way of confirmation as SI was not attributable to the appellant because postings were beyond control of the appellant, which powers rests with the competent authority and subordinate officials cannot be punished for such administrative lapses on part of the relevant authority, hence depriving him from being confirmed in the rank of SI along with his batch-mates would tantamount to his deprivation from further progression, which was not justified. It was also noted that respondents totally ignore Rule-13:18 of Police Rules, 1934, wherein it is laid down that all police officers promoted in rank shall be on probation for two years, provided that the appointing authority may, by a special order in each case, permit periods of officiating service to count towards a period of probation. On the conclusion of probation period a report shall be rendered to the authority empowered to confirm the promotion who shall either confirm the officer or revert him.

O7. In view of the foregoing discussion, we are of the considered opinion that case of the appellant is similar in nature with the cases already decided by this Tribunal as well as by the apex court, as referred to by counsel of the appellant. For the reasons, we are inclined to accept the present appeal with directions to the respondents to confirm the appellant as SI from the date when his other colleagues were confirmed, as well as place him in due place in the seniority list. The appellant is also held entitled to all consequential benefits, if any. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to record room.
