

Contends that the appellant alongwith others was enlisted as Constable in District Police Lakki Marwat through order dated 30.12.2016. On 29.03.2017, the order of appointment in respect of the appellant and nine others was withdrawn. The appellant submitted Writ Petition No. 343-B/2017 before the Honourable Peshawar High Court Bannu Bench which was allowed on 28.03.2018. The Honourable Court was not only pleased to set aside the order dated 29.03.2017 but the petitioners were declared to be enlisted constables for District Lakki Marwat. Despite unconditional judgment, the respondents undertook denovo enquiry which was not called for. Resultant to denovo enquiry an order was passed on 14.06.2019, whereby, the appellant was imposed upon major penalty of removal from service w.e.f. 11.04.2019. The departmental appeal there-against also did not prevail and was rejected on 08.11.2019. It is also pressed into service by learned counsel that the impugned order dated 14.06.2019 was passed without associating the appellant in the departmental proceedings. Regular/proper enquiry was never held while the appellant was subjected to major penalty. Similarly, statement of allegations, charge sheet and show cause notice were also not given to the appellant. Learned counsel referred to the impugned order dated 14.04.2019 and stated that the order itself was invalid as the penalty against the appellant was given with retrospective effect.

In view of the arguments of learned counsel and the available record, instant appeal is admitted to regular hearing, subject to all just exceptions. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days. Thereafter, notices be issued to the respondents. To come up for written reply/comments on 07.12.2020 before S.B.


SECTION-4 OF THE UNDER APPEAL PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 14.06.2019 WHEREBY MAJOR PENALTY OF REMOVAL FROM SERVICE HAS BEEN IMPOSED ON THE APPELLANT AND AGAINST THE DATED 08.11.2019 ORDER IMPUGNED APPELLATE WHEREBY DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT HAS BEEN REJECTED ON NO GOOD GROUNDS

PRAYERS:

That on acceptance of this appeal the impugned orders dated 14.06.2019 and 08.11.2019 may very kindly be set aside and the appellant may be re-instated into service with all back benefits. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

R/SHEWETH: ON FACTS:

- 1-That after fulfilling all the codal formalities the appellant was appointed as constable vide order dated 30.12.2016 through Departmental Selection Committee after vacancies have been advertised in the leading news paper. That after appointment the appellant was sent for condensed recruitment course by the respondent No.3. Copy of the appointment order is attached as appearance. A.
- **2-** That after completion of the said course the appellant submitted his arrival and started performing his duty as constable at the concerned station quite efficiently and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors.



- **3-** That during service of the appellant an unknown complaint was received to the high ups regarding impersonation in the recruitment/appointment of the constable and on the aforementioned anonymous complaint the respondent No.3 requested for conducting a departmental inquiry vide letter dated 06.03.2017. Copy of the letter is attached as annexure
- 5- That feeling aggrieved the appellant along with his other colleagues filed writ petition No.343-B/2017 before the Peshawar High Court, Bannu Bench which was decided in favor of the appellant vide dated 28.03.2018 with the view that "For what has been discussed above, we admit and allow this petition and declare the impugned order, whereby the appointment order of petitioners was withdrawn is unlawfully, illegal, without lawful authority, discriminatory and against the natural justice. Therefore, the same order is set aside and petitioner shall be deemed to be enlisted constable for District Lakki Marwat". Copy of the Judgment is attached as annexure E.

8-That appellant feeling aggrieved and having no other remedy but to file the instant service appeal on the following grounds amongst the others.

GROUNDS:

- A-That the impugned orders dated 14.06.2019 and 08.11.2019 issued by the respondents are against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and material on the record hence not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- **B-**That appellant has not been treated by the respondent department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondent violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- **C-**That the respondents acted in arbitrary and mala fide manner while issuing the impugned orders dated 14.06.2019 and 08.11.2019.
- **D-**That the respondent Department removed the appellant from service in a hasty manner without waiting for the outcome of the CPLA which is pending before the Supreme Court of Pakistan.
- **E-** That the appellant has been proceeded under the wrong provision of law and as such the impugned orders dated 14.6.2019 and 8.11.2019 are void ab anitio in the eye of law.
- **F-** That no charge sheet and statement of allegation has been issued to the appellant before issuance of the impugned order dated 14.06.2019.
- **G-**That no show cause notice has been served on the appellant before issuing the impugned order dated 14.06.2019.
- **H-**That no chance of Personal Hearing / Defense been provided to the appellant before issuance of the impugned order dated 14.06.2019.
- I- That no regular inquiry has been conducted against the appellant which is as per Supreme Court judgments is necessary in punitive actions against the civil servant.
- **J-** That appellant has been discriminated on the subject noted above and as such the impugned order dated 14.06.2019 is not tenable in the eye of law.

- **K-**That the impugned order dated 14.06.2019 is the clear violation of the judgment 28.03.2018 passed by the Honorable Peshawar High Court, Bannu Bench no direction/instruction has been issued to the respondent Department for conducting Departmental inquiry.
- L- That the appellant has been proceeded under a wrong law by issuing the impugned order dated 14.06.2019, hence not tenable in the eye of law and liable be set aside.
- M- That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

Total 32 candidates were recruited in District Lakki Marwat in the existing vacancy of Constable vide this office OB No. 464 & 465 dated 30.12.2016. Due to the complaints of impersonation in unfair means in the said NTS examination, the Provincial Police Officer, KPK Peshawar was requested to kindly direct NTS agency to carryout necessary verification through available resources i.e their identification through NTS Video Cameras/ CCTV for their authentication vide this Office Memo: No. 145 dated 06.01.2017. The undersigned constituted a committee headed by DSP/ Hqr: Lakki for conducting thorough probe/ scrutiny into unfair means/ impersonation cases. The said committee after conducting thorough probe into the matter cleared 19 candidates and whereas the cases of following 10 candidates were found as suspicious as per the detail given below:

The facts relevant for the disposal of this. petition are that petitioners being residents of District Lakki Marwat and having requisite qualifications, applied for their appointments as constables against vacant posts lying in District Lakki Marwat. They after being qualified in physical and running tests were called for NTS test. In which they appeared and after passing the same along with others (total 32 cand dates) were enlisted as constables vide OB No.464 cated 30.12.2016. After their enlisting as constables a correst undence took place between respondents No:4 and 7. As a result of that correspondence vide office letter No.17 8 dated 06.3.2017, it was alleged that due to the complaints regarding NTS test, scrutiny/verification of the NTS test of suc a sful candidates was carried out. Since, it was said in the complaints that NTS result of successful candidates was strome of impersonation in the said test. The committee is verification/scrutiny of impersonation of

Resultantly, the appointment order of petitioners have been withdrawn vide impugned order No.145 dated 28.3.2017.

The respondents in response to the present writ petition, on the direction of this Court filed their para-wise comments, wherein they raised legal and factual objections, on the basis of which they sought dismissal of the petition in hand. They submitted their response in reply to the para-1 of the petition, which reads as:

"1) Incorrect. The candidates including the petitic iers submitted their applications for the appointment as constables on vacant posts in District Lakki Marwat submitted directly to the NTS authority. After conducting all tests (physical, running, written rovisional merit list was issued by the authority. The respondent

A committee was constituted to probe into the matter/scrutiny unfair means/impersonation. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners vehement, argued the impugned order No.145 dated 28.3.2017 is at d by respondent No.7, whereby the appointment orders of petitioners have been withdrawn as a result of being declared disqualified on account of alleged impersonation made by them to go through in NTS test is unlawful, illegal, based on surmises and conjecture, which order under no canon of justice can be held valid and just. He further contends: that it is a settled principle of law which has been laid flown by the superior Courts in various

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particularly without providing manner prejudicial opportunity of hearing to the person who would effect by such order, impugned Order OB No.464 speaks for itself that petitioners at no stage of the alleged scrutiny of impersonation have been provided an opportunity to defend them against the said allegations by issuing any show cause notice or charge sheet or conducted any full-dress enquiry/trial into the said allegations, thus, the same order on the principle of locus poenitentia is liable to be recalled and petitioners describe to be reinstated in their services. He further contended all others candidates whose video clips were not available have been recommended for training, thus petitioners have not been treated equally and met with sheer discrimination. He next contended that petitioners before the withdrawal of their appointment orders have not been issued any nonce or show cause, so as to defend theirselves against the allegation of impersonation, allegedly made for passing their NTS test. In this regard placed reliance on (PLD 2007 Peshawar 147). He next contended that the impugned order for the withdrawal of services of the

one should be condemned without being heard, the impugned order is self explanatory that no opportunity have been provided to the petitioners for defending themselves against the allegations on the basis of which their appointment orders have been withdrawn. He lastly prayed for recalling of impugned order being illegal, arbitrary and against the principle of natural justice.

5. On the other hand, learned AAG appearing on behalf of respondents strongly opposed the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioners in support of the petition in hand. He submitted that respondents after thorough scrutinizing the video clips, which were made available to them through CCTV, installed in Hall, where NTS test was carried out have come to conclusion of a personation on behalf of petitioners in their NTS test. The video of same clipping is available with the respondents in "ISB, which can be watched by this Court. He lastly prayed the instant petition having no merit is liable to be dismissed.

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6. We have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties and carefully gone through the record.

Perusal of the impugned order would show that respondents before withdrawing the appointment orders of petitioners have not resued any show cause notice or charge sheet to them, so as they defend their selves against the allegations of impersonation. Further perusal of the record would show the respondents did not bring on file show ; cause notice or charge sheet, which as per the principle of fair play and natural justice was required to be issued to the petitioners before passing the impugned withdrawal of their appointments. We have noticed that this Court vide its order dated 14.02.2018 specifically directed the respondents to place on file the record in support of their stance, which they took in their comments, but in spite of that direction they did not bring any record on the file of the case of instant petition in support of their contention, which they raised in their comments. The mere saying of learned AAG that video clips of the alleged impersonation of the

can be watched by this Court is not a substitute to counter the claim of petitioners that their appointments orders have been withdrawn without providing them an opportunity of hearing to dete il themselves. We have already hinted hereinabove, parationers' appointment orders have been withdrawn on the alleged allegations of impersonation without issuing them show cause notice or charge-sheet and conducting a far. fledge enquiry into the allegations leveled against them. It the facts and circumstances of the case, which have in discussed hereinabove, we have no hesitation to itself that petitioners were condemned without being heard before the withdrawal of their appointment orders. Which act of respondent is a sheer violation of principle of natural justice and cannot be sustained in the eye of law. We may point out here that nothing has been brought on the record to show that persons who allegedly impersonated the petitioners in their NTS test have been booked under FIR for the commission of such offence. Absence of sine, the mere saying of respondents that AT

petitioners have been impersonated in their NTS test is fallacies and is not acceptable by any prudent mind. It is well settled principle of law that the right accrued/vested in some person cannot be withdrawn unilaterally. Any such act will be hit by the principle of locus poenitentia and order so made will be having no value in the eye of law. Reliance can be placed on case titled "Asim Khan and others Vs Zahir Shah and others" (2007 SCMR 1451) and "Jawad Ali and others Vs. Superintendent Jail and others" (2017 PLIC I (C.S.)587).

8. For what has been discussed above, we admit and allow this petition and declare the impugned order, whereby the appointment order of petitioners was withdrawn is unlawful, illegal, without lawful authority, discriminatory and against he natural justice. Therefore, the same order is set aside and petitioner shall be deemed to be enlisted constables for District Lakki Marwat.

ORDER.

My this order will dispose off the departmental enquiry initiated against FC Hafiz ur Rehman No.71 while posted at Police Lines, Lakki Marwat was found to indulge in the following allegations:-

- 1. That he was recruited as Constable by NTS Authority alongwith 31 candidates against the existing vacancies of Constable vide this office OB No.464 & 465 dated 30.12.2016. Due to complaint of his involvement in impersonation and unfair means during the said NTS examination, the Provincial Police Officer, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Peshawar was requested to direct NTS agency to carry out necessary verification through available recourses i.e their identification through NTS video cameras/CCTV for their authentication vide this office memo: No.145 dated 06.02.2017. A committee headed by DSP/Hqrs: Lakki Marwat was constituted by then DPO Lakki Marwat to conduct thorough probe /scrutiny into unfair means /impersonation cases. The said Committee after conducted thorough probe into the matter, 19 candidates were cleared and the 10 candidates including he was found as suspicious/guilty.
- 2. That after complete proceedings necessary guidance was also sought from CPO Peshawar vide this office memo: No.1718 dated 06.03.2017. The necessary guidance from CPO Peshawar was received vide CPO Peshawar memo: No.3127/E-IV dated 10.03.2017, that "As approved by the competent, the suspicious candidates not found clear in the scrutiny process by your office shall be considered disqualified".
- 3. That this all speaks gross misconduct on his part and make him liable to be punished under Police Rules-1975.

Earlier, the applications/complaints of Fahad Naz Khan and Imran Ullah Khan who were received to this office from RPO Bannu office vide Endst: No.3037-38/EC dated 31.10.2016, that impersonation were made during the NTS Test by the candidates held in 2016. Due to the complaints of impersonation and unfair means in the said NTS Examination, CPO Peshawar was requested to direct NTS Agency for provision of Video/CCTV recording so that their identification through NTS Video/CCTV recording could be carried out vide this office Memo: No.145 dated 06.01.2017. In response, the NTS Agency intimated this office and provided video clips in CD that can be searched through Roll Nos. as requested for verification. The then District Police Officer, Lakki Marwat constituted a committee headed by the then DSP/Hqrs: Lakki Marwat for conducted thorough probe /scrutiny into unfair means/impersonation cases. The said committee after conducted through probe into the matter cleared 19 candidates whereas the cases of the 10 candidates including the delinquent official were found as suspicious.

In view of above, guidance was asked from CPO Peshawar vide this office Memo: No.1718 dated 06.03.2017. In response the guidance was received to this office vide CPO Peshawar Memo; No.3127 dated 10.03.2017 that "As approved by the competent authority the 10 candidates not found cleared in the scrutiny process by your office shall be considered disqualified". Upon the guidance of CPO Peshawar their appointment order was withdrawn vide this office OB No.145 dated 28.03.2017. The said official preferred an appeal in Peshawar High Court Bannu Bench Bannu for setting aside the order of this office OB No. quoted above. The Honorable Apex Court Bannu set aside the subject order and re-instated them into service vide Judgment dated 28.03.2018. In the compliance of order of Honorable Apex Court Bannu Para No.7 and AIG Legal CPO Peshawar vide letter No.1919/Legal dated 05.04.2019, he was re-instated alongwith 09 petitioners into service provisionally /conditionally vide this office OB No. 188 dated 11.04.2019.

He was proper charge sheeted on based upon summary of allegations and SP/Invst: Lakki Marwat was appointed as Enquiry Officer. The enquiry office after conducting proper departmental enquiry submitted finding report wherein the allegations leveled against him were proved without any doubt of shadow stated that from the CCTV video/picture it is depicted that the said delinquent official was not appeared/present in the NTS written Exam 2016.

"The undersigned also thoroughly checked the enquiry papers and CCTV video /picture that the delinquent official was not appeared /present in the said written exam and the impersonation case was also found proved/correct on his part". He was also served with final show cause notice to this effect. His reply to the final show cause notice was perused and was also found unsatisfactory. After completion of all codal formalities further guidance was also asked from Worthy RPO Bannu vide this office letter No.4220/EC dated 31.05.2019. In response the Worthy RPO Bannu conveyed the requisite remarks to this office that "proceed /forward as per law accordingly" vide his Endst: No.2179/EC dated 03.06.2019. He was also provided full opportunity for person hearing in orderly room on dated 12.06.2019, where he offered no cogent reasons to prove his innocence and badly failed to rebut the allegations leveled against him.



Therefore, I Abdul Hayee, District Police Officer, Lakki Marwat exercise of the power vested in me under Police Rules-1975, hereby impose upon him major punishment of Removal from service with effect from 11.04.2019.

After successful completion of the course/training I submitted my arrival and started performing duty as constable at the concerned station quite efficiently and up to the entire satisfaction of my superiors. It is worth mentioning here that during my service an unknown complaint was received to the high ups regarding impersonation in the recruitment/appointment of the constables and on the basis aforementioned anonymous complaint the District Police Officer, Lakki Marwat requested for conducting a departmental inquiry vide letter dated 06.03.2017 and on the letter the District Police Officer, Lakki Marwat constituted a committee and the committee declared 10 employees were declared suspicious and vide letter dated 10.03.2017 considered disqualified. Later on vide order dated 29.03.2017 my appointment order along with my other colleagues were withdrawn. Feeling aggrieved I was filed writ petition No.343-B/2017 before the Peshawar High Court, Bannu Bench which was allowed and the concerned authority was directed to re-instate the petitioners. The concerned authority re-instated me alongwith my other colleagues conditionally subject to the outcome of CPLA vide letter dated 05.04.2019 and 11.04.2019 but also conducted de-novo inquiry and after completion of the inquiry I was once again removed from service vide order dated 14.06.2019. Respected Sir, I am belonging to a poor family and have no any other source of income and the above mentioned illegalities has not been committed by me.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this Departmental appeal I may very kindly be re-instated into service with all back benefits.

Brief of the case is that due to complaint of their involvement in impersonation and unfair means during the NTS examination, held in the year 2016, the Provincial Police Officer, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa was requested by DPO Lakki Marwat to direct NTS agency to carryout necessary verification through available resources i.e their identification through NTS/video cameras/CCTV for their authentication. In response, the NTS agency provided video clips in CD to DPO Lakki Marwat. DPO Lakki Marwat, accordingly, constituted a committee headed by the then DSP HQr: Lakki Marwat to conduct thorough probe/scrutiny into the said unfair means/impersonation cases. The committee found them as suspicious/guilty. Subsequently, DPO Lakki Marwat, vide Memo: No.1718 dated 06.03.2017 solicited guidance of CPO Peshawar in this regard. The guidance of CPO Peshawar was received to DPO Lakki Marwat, vide CPO Peshawar letter No.3127/E-IV dated 10.03.2017, with the remarks "as approved by the competent authority, the suspicious candidates not found clear in the scrutiny process by your office shall be considered disqualified". As a result of which, their appointments orders were withdrawn, vide DPO Office Lakki Marwat OB No.145 dated 28.03.2017. Aggrieved from the order, they preferred appeals to the then RPO Bannu (appellate authority) which were turned down, vide this office order Endst: No:1829/EC dated 13.06.2017.

Subsequently, they filed writ petition No.343-B/2017 in Peshawar High Court, Bannu Bench which was accepted by declaring the impugned order, whereby the appointment order of petitioners was withdrawn, as unlawful, illegal, without lawful authority, discriminatory and against the natural justice, vide order dated 28.03.2018. In the light of the judgment of Peshawar High Court Bannu Bench as well as instructions received from CPO Peshawar, vide letter No.1919/Legal dated 05.04.2019, DPO Lakki Marwat reinstated them into service provisionally and conditionally subject to the outcome of CPLA with further direction to conduct a fresh/proper departmental inquiry, vide his office OB No.188 dated 11.04.2019.

Consequently, they were proceeded departmentally under Police Rules 1975 and the inquiry papers were entrusted to SP/Inv: Lakki Marwat. After conduct of inquiry, SP/Inv: Lakki Marwat submitted his findings, wherein, the allegations leveled against them were proved without any shadow of doubt, stated further that from the CCTV video/picture, it was depicted that they were not appeared/present in the NTS written examination, 2016. Resultantly, they were awarded major punishment of removal from service, vide DPO Office Lakki Marwat OB No.336 dated 13.06.2019. Aggrieved from the order, they again preferred appeals to then RPO Bannu (appellate authority). The appellate authority provided them opportunity of personal hearing in orderly room on 09.07.2019. During personal hearing, they contended that the pictures for comparison with NTS admit cards were uploaded from CD and resultantly it had caused issue of non comparison with the NTS admit cards, hence, DPO Lakki Marwat was directed, vide this office Memo: No.2637/EC dated 11.07.2019, to send the video/CD to FSL Lahore Punjab for:

- 1. Whether the pictures of the candidates in the CD are dislocated while comparing with NTS admit card.
- 2. Whether the CD are edited or otherwise.
- 3. Comparison of candidates' pictures with that of NTS admit cards in the CD be carried out so that to establish genuine identity of the candidates as per NTS admit cards and NTS record.

DPO Lakki Marwat accordingly addressed Director, FSL Lahore Punjab, vide his office letter No.5472/EC dated 17.07.2019. Now, the audio visual analysis report of FSII Lahore Punjab has been received, vide DPO Office Lakki Marwat letter No.7043/EC dated 11.09.2019 which transpires that "(1) no editing feature, in the visual contents of ten (10) video files contained in Item # 1 has been observed etc and (2) after forensic facial comparison of the persons seen in videos with the pictures of eight (08) persons (mentioned above) contained in Item#1, it was concluded that the facial features of the eight persons seen in pictures contained in Item # 1 I do not match with the persons seen in videos contained in Item # 1".

Therefore, I, Abdul Ghafoor Afridi, Regional Police Officer, Bannu Region Bannu, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Police Rules, 1975 (amended in 2014) hereby reject their appeals and endorse the punishment awarded to them by DPO Lakki Marwat.

A committee headed DSP/HQrs Lakki Marwat was constituted by then DPO Lakki Marwat to conduct thorough probe / security into unfair means / impersonation cases. The Committee after conducted thorough probe into the matter, 19 candidates were cleared and the 10 candidates including you were found as suspicious as suspicious / guilty.

That after complete proceedings necessary guidance was also sought from CPO Peshawar vide this office Memo No.1718 dated 06.03.2017. The necessary guidance from CPO Peshawar was

received vide CPO Peshawar Memo No. 3127/E-JV dated 10.03.2017, that 'as approved by the competent, the suspicious candidates not found clear in the security process by your office shall be considered disqualified".

That all speaks gross misconduct on your part and makes you liable to be punished under police Rules-1975.

ORDER SHEET. Order sheet maintained. STATEMENTs.

- 1. He replied to the charge sheet and stated that the allegations mentioned in the charge sheet are totally baseless regarding the impersonation and dismissal from the department. The Honourable court reinstated him without any enquiry while wrongly enquiry is initiated against him. In this regard his appearance is fixed for 24.04.2019 in the High Court Peshawar Bannu Bench, Bannu and detail reply will be produce after the order of the Court because his application is under trial in the court.
 - 2. Statements of the then Committee Members Asmat Ullah Computer Operator, IHC Hikmat Ullah Reader to DPO Lakki and Head Clerk Ibrahim-Shah. They supported their previous signatures and signed the committee report under the supervision of the then DSP/HQrs: Lakki Afsar Khan Khattack.

<u>PREVIOUS RECORD.</u>

a. Letter No. 145 dated 06.01.2017 addressed to W.PPO KPK Peshawar by the then DPO Lakki Marwat regarding the NTS qualified recruited candidates as constables in District Police Lakki Marwat after observing all codal formalities. Since the complaints of impersonation and unfair means have been received in the said NTS examination, therefore the verification is also

required to be carried out through NTS Agency on the score i.e their identification through NTS video Cameras/CCTV Cameras for authentication. The NTS Agency may kindly be approached to conduct their verification through their available resources and result, thereof may kindly be communicated to this office for further necessary action.

- b. After conducting Enquiry by the then DSP/HQrs: Lakki Marwat, 19 candidates were cleared and the 10 candidates were found as suspicious/guilty.
- c. After complete proceedings, necessary guidance was also sought from CPO
 Peshawar vide letter No. 1718 dated 06.03.2017, necessary guidance from
 CPO Peshawar was received vide CPO Peshawar memo No. 3127/E-IV dated
 10.03.2017, that

"As approved by the competent, the suspicious candidates not found clear in the security process by your office shall be considered disqualified". Letters are enclosed.

COURT DECISION.

Perusal of the impugned order would show that respondents before withdrawing the appointment orders of petitioners have not issue any show cause Para-7. notice or charge sheet to them, so as they defend their selves against the allegations of impersonation. Further perusal of the record would show the respondents did not bring on file show cause notice or charge sheet, which as per the principle of fair play and natural justice was required to be issued to the petitioners before passing the impugned order for withdrawal of their appointments. We have noticed that this court vide its order dated 14.02.2018 specially directed the respondents to place on file the record in support of their stance, which they took in their comments, but in spite of that directions they did not bring any record on the file of the case of instant petition in support of their contention, which they raised in their comments. The mere saying of learned AAG that video clips of the alleged impersonation of the petitioners are available with them in shape of USB, which can be watched by this court, is not a substitute to counter the claim of petitioners that their appointments orders have been withdrawn without providing them an opportunity of hearing to defend themselves. We have already hinted hereinabove, petitioners, appointment orders have been

withdrawn on the alleged allegations of impersonation without issuing them show cause notice or charge sheet and conducting a full-fledge enquiry into the allegations levelled against them. In the facts and circumstances of the case, which have been discussed hereinabove, we have no hesitation to hold that petitioners were condemned without being heard before the withdrawal of their appointment orders. Which act of respondent is a sheer violation of principle of natural justice and cannot be sustained in the eye of law. We may point out here that noting has been brought on the record to show that persons who allegedly impersonation the petitioners in their NTS test have been booked under FIR for the commission of such offence. Absence of same, the mere saying of respondents that petitioners have been impersonated in their NTS test is fallacies and is not acceptable by any prudent mind. It is well settled principle of law that the right accured/vested in some person cannot be withdrawn unilaterally. Any such act will be hit by the principle of locus poenitentia and order so made will be having no value in the eye of law. Reliance can be placed on case titled "Asim Khan and others Vs Zahir Shah and others" (2007 SCMR 1451) and Jawad Ali and others Vs. Superintendent Jail and others (2017 PL/C (C.S.) 587).

Para-8. For what has been discussed above, we admit and allow this...

Petition and declare the impugned order, whereby the appointment order of the petitioners was withdrawn is unlawful, illegal, without lawfulauthority, discriminatory and against the natural justice. Therefore, the same order is set aside and petitioner shall be deemed to be enlisted constables for District Lakki Marwat.

CONCLUSION :-

After conducting the enquiry and perusal the record, the undersigned reached to the conclusion that:-

All the Recruits including the said Mohammad Asif Nawaz-78 were summoned, recorded their statements and tally the video/pictures of examination centre with Recruits in the presence of the previous Committee Members Head Clerk Ibrahim Shah, IHC Asmat Ullah Computer Operator and IHC Hikmat Ullah Reader of DPO Office Lakki Marwat.

The said Mohammad Asif Nawaz-78 was not matched his video/picture of examination centre and the impersonation case was found correct.

Therefore, the allegations mentioned in the charge sheet are stand proved against Recruit Mohammad Asif Nawaz-78 please.

That all speaks gross misconduct on your part and makes you liable to be punished under Police Rules-1975.

- 4. By reason of the above, you appear to be guilty or misconduct under section 02 (iii) of the KPK Police Rules 1975 and has rendered yourself liable to all or any of the penalties as specified in section 04 (i) and & b of the said rules.

In this regard his appearance is fixed for 24.04.2019 in the High Court Peshawar Bannu Bench, Bannu and detail reply will be produce after the order of the Court because his application is under trial in the court.

PREVIOUS RECORD.

Letter No. 145 dated 06.01.2017 addressed to W.PPO KPK Peshawar by the then DPO Lakki Marwat regarding the NTS qualified recruited candidates as constables in District Police Lakki Marwat after observing all codal formalities. Since the complaints of impersonation and unfair means have been received in the said NTS examination, therefore the verification is also required to be carried out through NTS Agency on the score i.e their

COURT DECISION.

Perusal of the impugned order would show that respondents before Para-7. withdrawing the appointment orders of petitioners have not issue any show cause notice or charge sheet to them, so as they defend their selves against the allegations of impersonation. Further perusal of the record would show the respondents did not bring on file show cause notice or charge sheet, which as per the principle of fair play and natural justice was required to be issued to the petitioners before passing the impugned order for withdrawal of their appointments. We have noticed that this court vide its order dated 14.02.2018 specially directed the respondents to place on file the record in support of their stance, which they took in their comments, but in spite of that directions they did not bring any record on the file of the case of instant petition in support of their contention, which they raised in their comments. The mere saying of learned AAG that video clips of the alleged impersonation of the petitioners are available with them in shape of USB, which can be watched by this court, is not a substitute to counter the claim of petitioners that their appointments orders have been withdrawn without providing them an opportunity of hearing to defend themselves. We have already hinted hereinabove, petitioners, appointment orders have been withdrawn on the alleged allegations of impersonation without issuing them show

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cause notice or charge sheet and conducting a full-fledge enquiry into the allegations levelled against them. In the facts and circumstances of the case, which have been discussed hereinabove, we have no hesitation to hold that petitioners were condemned without being heard before the withdrawal of their appointment orders. Which act of respondent is a sheer violation of principle of natural justice and cannot be sustained in the eye of law. We may point out here that noting has been brought on the record to show that persons who allegedly impersonation the petitioners in their NTS test have been booked under FIR for the commission of such offence. Absence of same, the mere saying of respondents that petitioners have been impersonated in their NTS test is fallacies and is not acceptable by any prudent mind. It is well settled principle of law that the right accured/vested in some person cannot be withdrawn unilaterally. Any such act will be hit by the principle of locus poenitentia and order so made will be having no value in the eye of law. Reliance can be placed on case titled 'Asim Khan and others Vs Zahir Shah and others (2017 PL/C (C.S.) 587).

Para-8. For what has been discussed above, we admit and allow this

Petition and declare the impugned order, whereby the appointment order of the

petitioners was withdrawn is unlawful, illegal, without lawfulauthority, discriminatory

and against the natural justice. Therefore, the same order is set aside and petitioner

shall be deemed to be enlisted constables for District Lakki Marwat.

CONCLUSION :-

After conducting the enquiry and perusal the record, the undersigned reached to the conclusion that:-

All the Recruits including the said Recruit Constable Hafiz ur Rehman-71 were summoned, recorded their statements and tally the video/pictures of examination centre with Recruits in the presence of the previous Committee Members Head Clerk Ibrahim Shah, IHC Asmat Ullah Computer Operator and IHC Hikmat Ullah Reader of DPO Office Lakki Marwat.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER KPK POLICE RULES - 1975.

I. Abdul Hayee, District Police Officer. Lakki Maryat as competent authority, am of the opinion that FC Hafiz ar Rehman No.71 while posted of Police Lines Laking biarwat has rendered himself liable to be proceeded against as the committed the following acts/commission within the meaning of Section-02 (iii) of KPK Police Rules 1975.

STATEMENT OF ALLEGATIONS.

- 1. That he was recruited as Constable by NTS Authority alongwith 31 candidates against the existing vacancies of Constable vide this office OB No.464 & 465 dated 30.12,2016. Due to complaint of his involvement in impersonation and unfair means during the said NTS examination, the Provincial Police Officer, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar was requested to direct NTS agency to carry out necessary verification through available recourses i.e. their identification through NTS video cameras/CCTV for their authentication vide this office memo: No.145 dated 06.02.2017. A committee headed by DSP/Hqrs: Lakki Marwat was constituted by their DPO Lakki Marwat to conduct thorough probe /scrutiny into unfair means /impersonation cases. The said Committee after conducted thorough probe into the matter, 19 candidates were cleared and the 10 candidates including the said constable were found as suspicious/guilty.
- 2. That after complete proceedings necessary guidance was also sought from CPO Peshawar vide this office memo; No.1718 dated 06.03.2017. The necessary guidance from CPO Peshawar was received vide CPO Peshawar memo; No.3127/E-IV dated 10.03.2017, that "As approved by the competent, the suspicious candidnes not found clear in the scrutiny process by your office shall be considered disqualified".
- 3. That all speaks his gross misconduct on his part and makes him liable to be punished under Police Rules-1975

4. For the purpose of securitizing the conduct of the said official with reference to the above allegations SP/Invst: Lakki Marwat is appointed as Enquiry Officer.

The Enquiry Officer shall conduct proceedings in accordance with provision of Police Rules 1975 and shall provide reasonable opportunity of defense and hearing to the accused official, record its finding and make within twenty five (25) days of the receipt of this order, recommendation as to punishment or other appropriate action against the accused officer.

The accused officer shall join the proceedings on the date, time and place fixed by the Enquiry Officer.
