
01. Husband of the appellant present. Mr. Fazal Shah Mohmand, Additional Advocate for the respondents present.

02. Mst. Shahida Parveen, DEO (Female) D.I.Khan is present in person and, though, she has submitted a report, but that is not in line with the order sheet dated 21.03.20223 nor any record has been produced as directed in the said order sheet. The DEO present in the court contends that she was newly posted at the station and secondly that the record pertains to 2003, while bifurcation of office was made by the Government in the year 2013. That she had deputed two employees to dig out the entire record required by the Tribunal. But to trace the record, she sought 30 days time. Last chance is given to the respondents to produce the record on 21.06.2023. In case the record could not be found or is found to be damaged or lost or whatever, a detailed report in writing should be submitted but with reliable, cogent and concrete supporting material and not on the flimsy and whimsical grounds. The contention of the DEO that she was newly posted is not acceptable to the Tribunal. She could, at the most, make a request for some time, which she has made. The said time is granted to her on her own choice. Therefore, it is expected that the Tribunal be positively assisted by the DEO, who is head of the District and responsible officer.



03. Dr. Muhammad Imran, Sr. Subject Specialist says that at the time of bifurcation of the office in to two offices, i.e the District Education Officers (Male) and (Female), some of the record was not handed over to them, which might also be a reason for non-availability of record. It is in this regard, without making any comments, observed that this contention is also not acceptable. To come up for arguments on 21.06.2023 before the D.B at Camp Court, D.I.Khan. Parcha Peshi given to the parties.
