

1. Learned counsel for the appellant present. Mr. Fazal Shah, Mohmand, Additional Advocate General alongwith Mr. Khalid Nawaz, Inspector for the official respondents and private respondent No.22 in person present.

2. Vide order dated 24.01.2023 the private respondents were directed to be summoned through TCS. The appellant had also deposited the expenses and the private respondents were summoned but a number of private respondents could not be served probably because of incorrect addresses. Similarly vide order dated 21.03.2023, the learned Member (Judicial) had directed that the private respondents, except private respondent No.22, be served through Inspector General of Police. Mr. Khalid Nawaz, Inspector is present and states that according to the information communicated to him, the private respondents have been served but there is no report in writing regarding that, therefore, oral statement cannot be considered as sufficient for further proceeding. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant has made two requests one for hearing of this appeal at the principal seat as a number of private respondents were posted in different stations of the province and secondly that he may be allowed to submitted correct addresses of all the respondents or to make an application for publication of notice in the newspaper. He further submitted that in case application is filed for publication of notice in the newspaper appropriate order regarding publication may also be passed. Thus in case an application for issuance of court notices against the private respondents, such notice be issued in the Urdu Daily Mashriq, Peshawar, the expenses of which be deposited alongwith the application. To come up on 20.07.2023 before the S.B at Peshawar. P.P given to the parties.
