





Counsel for the appellant present. Preliminary arguments heard.

In term of normal procedure, the departmental appeal seems to be time-barred but in view of particular legal position to be discussed herein-after, the bar of limitation for the time-being is immaterial. In wake of COVID, 19, the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for the first time declared Public Health Emergency in March, 2020 for three months which was extended from time to time for further term and presently it has been extended by the Government vide Notification No. SOG/HD/1-102/Covid-19/2020/3062, dated 30.06.2021 for the period from 01.07.2021 to 30.09.2021. The case of the appellant falls within the period of emergency. In view of Section 30 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Epidemic Control and Emergency Relief Act, 2020, the limitation period provided under any law shall remain frozen. This appeal having been filed after promulgation of the said Act, is not affected by bar of limitation. Excluding the case of appellant from rigors of limitation, his appeal is fit for full hearing. Keeping the question of limitation relating to filing of appeal intact for determination during full hearing, this appeal, subject to all just and legal objections including objection of limitation is admitted for regular hearing. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days. Thereafter, notices be issued to the respondents for submission of written reply/comments in office within 10 days after receipt of notices, positively. If the written reply/comments are not submitted within the stipulated time, or extension of time is not sought through written application with sufficient cause, the office shall submit the file with a report of non-compliance. File to come up for arguments on 07.12.2021 before the D.B.





APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KP SERVICE TRIBUNALS ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE ORDER DATED 30.07.2020 WHEREBY JUNIORS TO THE APPELLANT UMAR ALI KHAN, SAJID ALI AND NAEEM KHOKHAR WERE PROMOTED TO THE POST OF JUNIOR CLERK AND AGAINST NOT TAKING ACTION ON THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN STATUTORY PERIOD OF 90-DAYS.

PRAYER:

THAT ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL, THE ORDER DATED 30.07.2020 MAY KINDLY BE SET ASIDE AND THE RESPONDENTS MAY BE DIRECTED TO CONSIDER THE APPELLANT FOR PROMOTION TO THE POST OF JUNIOR CLERK W.E.F 30.07.2020 WHEN HIS JUNIORS WERE PROMOTED. ANY OTHER REMEDY WHICH THIS AUGUST TRIBUNAL DEEMS FIT AND APPROPRIATE THAT MAY ALSO BE AWARDED IN FAVOUR OF THE APPELLANT.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

FACTS:

1. That the appellant was appointed as Sweeper in the ADP Scheme of the Department titled "Rehabilitation Center for Drug Addicts" under the Directorate of Social Welfare and Women Development Department, Peshawar on fixed pay basis. That the appellant has throughout good and clean service record.
2. That under the office order dated 08.06.2007 the service of the appellant along with other employees from the ADP Scheme were regularized with effect from 01.07.2007.
3. That the appellant was at Sr. No. 20, while the private respondent No. 6 at Sr. No. 30, Private respondent No. 7 at Sr. No. 38 and Private respondent No. 8 at Sr.No. 47 in the seniority list issued on 31.07.2017. **(Copy of Seniority List is attached as Annexure - "A").**
4. That the respondent Department issued notification/rules on 25.09.2019 wherein 30% quota by promotion on the basis of seniority cum-fitness from amongst Daftaris, Naib Qasids, Chowkidars, Sweepers, Malis, Security Guards, Cooks & Attendants with 02-years service as such who have passed F.A/F.Sc examination from recognized Board has been fixed for promotion to the post of Junior Clerk. **Copy of notification/rules is attached as Annexure-B.**
5. That on 20.07.2020 wherein willingness regarding promotion from the post of Class-IV to the post of Junior Clerk BPS-11 were submitted in

which the name of the appellant was also included and 25.07.2020 a letter was issued to all the District Officers Social Welfare of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for submission of ACRs of officials included in the panel of promotion against the post of Junior Clerk (BPS-11). **(Copies of letter dated 20.07.2020 & 25.07.2020 is attached as Annexure - "C & D")**.

6. That on 30.07.2020 a promotion order was issued in which the junior to the appellant namely: Umar Ali Khan, Sajid Ali and Naeem Khokhar were promoted as junior clerks BPS-11. **(Copy of Promotion Order dated 30.07.2020 is attached as Annexure - "E")**.
7. That the appellant feeling aggrieved from the order dated 30.07.2020 filed departmental appeal against the injustice against him. But no action has been taken on the departmental appeal of the appellant till date. **(Copy of Departmental Appeal dated 29.09.2020 is attached as Annexure - "F")**.
8. That now the appellant comes to this august tribunal for redressal of his grievances on the following grounds.

GROUND:

- A) That the impugned order dated 30.07.2020 and not deciding the departmental appeal of the appellant within 90 days are against the law, facts, norms of justice and material on record. Therefore, not tenable and the order dated 30.07.2020 is liable to be set-aside to the extent of private respondents.
- B) That the appellant was senior to the private respondent No. 7 to 9 and therefore it is his legal right to be promoted in the impugned order dated 30.07.2020.
- C) That the appellant has fulfilled the criteria for promotion to the post of junior clerk and has legitimate expectancy to be promoted to the post of Junior Clerk but the respondent department has promoted junior to the appellant in an arbitrary manner which is against the principle of legitimate expectancy and natural of justice.
- D) That by not promoting the appellant from the date when his junior were promoted will effect his future promotion which will caused irripable loss to the appellant in the shape of pension and other monitoring benefits.

- E) That the appellant has not been treated as per law and rules, and has been deprived from his due rights by exercising authority in a fanciful manner.
- F) That the appellant seeks permission to advance others grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

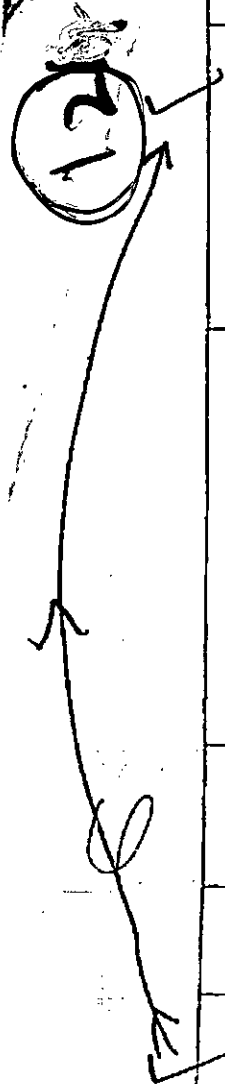

With due respect, it is stated that, the appellant was appointed as sweeper on 31-05-2-004, in ADP scheme "Rehabilitation Center for Drug Addicts, Peshawar", Social Welfare, Special Education and Women Empowerment Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. On 1st July 2007, the service of appellant, regularized. The appellant is graduate employee.

1. Your kind attention is invited to fact of matter, that, on 12-05-2015 a meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee was held, to promote Matriculate Class-iv to the post of Junior Clerk according to reserved quota of 33%. In continuation of Departmental Promotion Committee, two junior Class-IV to appellant were promoted to the post of Junior clerk, vide Notification No E-17/56/DSWVol-III/2175-84, dated Peshawar the 26-06-2015, the junior class-IV namely Mr. Zahid Khan and Mr. Fazle Qadar whom were promoted, although, the appellant highlighted his grievances before competent authority but no heed was paid, and the appellant was deprived discriminately without assign any reason. (Annexure A)

On dated, 20-07-2020, the administrative department circulated a letter vide NoE-17/64/DSW, to ask willingness from class-IV including appellant, whom were to be promoted to the post of junior clerk, where the appellant was at serial No-05 (Annexure B). The appellant submit his willingness for promotion to the post of Junior clerk, in this regard an-other letter was issued vide No DSW/Promotion/2020-21, dated 25-07-2020, to submit A.C.R's for promotion in this letter the appellant was also at serial No, 05. On 30-07-2020, administrative department issued promotion order vide No, E-17/56/Vol-III/DSW/862-73, in-pursuance of meeting of departmental. Promotion Committee was held on 30-07-2020 (Annexure C), But astonishingly, once again the appellant has been deprived from promotion and again the junior to appellant namely, Mr. Noor Khan at serial No-06, Mr. Umar Ali Khan at serial No-09, Mr Sajid Ali at serial No-12, and Mr. Naeem khokhar at serial No-13, were promoted to the post of junior clerk.


Attested

At the score of this discrimination, the appellant was retorted with the pretence that this promotions have been made by first acquiring F.A qualification when questioned this discrimination before the competent authority. It is brought in your kind notice that no any condition has been laid down in service rules as such (Annexure D) and it is also clarified in Esta-Code Khyber Pakhtunkhwa , in civil servant APT rules 1989, in chapter VI, Explanation-III/4, regarding seniority,

"The inter-se-seniority of civil servant in a certain cadre to which promotion is made from different lower post, carrying same pay scale shall be determined from the date of regular appointment /promotion of the civil servant in the lower post."


On dated, 04-08-2020, appellant submitted a written application for re-consideration of promotion but yet no response founded. (Annexure E)

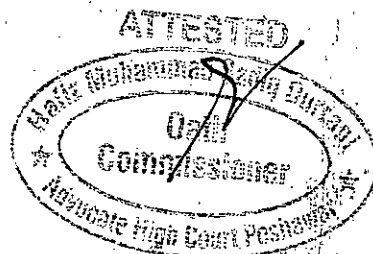

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:

1. The appellant has got no cause of action to file the present service appeal.
2. The appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
3. The appeal is based on malafide intentions.
4. The appellant has no locus standi.
5. The appeal in hand has badly time barred.
6. The appellant has not come to Honorable Tribunal with clean hands.
7. The appellant has concealed the material facts from this Honorable Tribunal, hence liable to be dismissed.
8. The appeal is liable to be dismissed for non joinder & misjoinder of necessary parties.
9. The appeal is against the prevailing laws & rules

FACTS

1. Correct with clarification that the appellant was initially appointed as Sweeper in ADP scheme of the Department titled 'Rehabilitation Center for Drug Addicts Peshawar' vide order No. E-17/65/DSW/8626-34 dated 25-05-2004 (Annex-I).


2. Correct with clarification that pursuant to the upgradation of Junior Clerk from BPS-07 to BPS-11, Service rules of the respondent department were revised and only those class-IV employees were declared fit for promotion to the post of Junior Clerk (BPS-11), who had availed a minimum of FA/F.SC Qualification. Revised Seniority Lists were prepared on the basis of date of acquisition of the prescribed qualification i.e FA/F.Sc. It is worth to narrate here that the Petitioner stood at S. No. 22 of the revised Seniority Lists prepared on the basis of revised Service Rules (**Annex-II**).
3. Correct with clarification that pursuant to the amendment in Service Rules vide Notification No. SO-II/SWD/II-12/Service Rules/2019 dated the 25th September 2019. Seniority Lists were amended on the basis of date of acquisition of the prescribed qualification i.e FA/F.Sc. The Petitioner stood at S. No. 22 of the revised Seniority Lists prepared on the basis of revised Service Rules (**Annex-II**).
4. As explained above.
5. Correct with clarification that there are certain standards which are required to be considered for promotion. Among them important are 1. Prescribed qualification 2. Prescribed length of service and 3. Seniority cum fitness for ascertaining fitness of a candidate for promotion, Annual Confidential Reports (ACRs) are important documents, as such, ACRs of prospective candidates for promotion to the position of Junior Clerk were solicited. Since the petitioner stood at S. No. 22 of the revised Seniority List, as such, he was not considered for promotion.
6. Incorrect, hence denied. As explained above, the petitioner was not promoted as he stood at S. No. 22 of the amended Seniority Lists prepared on the basis of amended Service Rules (**Annex-III**). Had the Seniority List been impugned in the eyes of the Petitioner, he should have challenged it at appropriate forum.
7. Incorrect, hence denied. As explained above
8. In light of the above facts the department requests to dismiss the appeal on the following grounds.

GROUND


- A) Incorrect, hence denied. The order dated 30-07-2020 has been issued in light of prevailing service rules.

Keeping in view the above facts and grounds, it is requested to dismiss the instant service appeal being meritless.




