It is the contention of the petitioner that although in the order of reinstating the petitioner, back benefits were shown to have been granted, but actually those were not granted, this fact has been admitted by the ADEO present in the court today, but he has tried to explain that in case they submit the case of the petitioner to the Account Office

some objections may be raised by them. It is in this regard, directed that it is the job of the DEO, how to resolve the issue with the Accounts Office etc. however, when the learned AAG made the ADEO understand the situation, he sought some time to implement the judgment in letter and spirit as well as in real sense, failing which the Tribunal may resort to coercive steps.
