**REJOINDER ON BEHALF OF APPELLANT IN RESPONSE TO THE REPLY  
SUBMITTED BY THE RESPONDENTS**

**R/SHEWETH:**

**PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:**

(1 to 7):

All the preliminary objections raised by the respondents are incorrect and baseless and not in accordance with law and rules, rather the respondents are estopped due to their own conduct to raise any objection at this stage of the appeal. Furthermore the respondents are taking different stance on the same issues hence they are stopped under the law to do so.

**ON FACTS:**

- 1- Incorrect and misleading. The respondents are misleading this Honorable Tribunal on the issue of House Hold and PBMC staff because the respondents in their replies in Appeal No. 3936/2020 titled "Arshad Khan VS Govt. of KP" and in comments submitted before the August Peshawar High Court in W.P No. 6271-P/2019 titled "Amin-ul Haq and others vs Govt. of KP" had categorically mentioned that the employees of House Hold staff cannot be reflected in the seniority list of regular employees borne on the strength of Administration department so how could the official respondents now adjusted the private respondents, some of them belongs to the PBMC staff and some of house hold, in the seniority of the secretariat staff. That similarly the rest of the private respondents mentioned at Para 1(iii) are junior to the appellant because they had passed their matriculation in the year 2018-2021 and as per the rules the matriculate Class-IV are required to be promoted to the post of Daftari from Naib Qasid and then after serving for at least two years as Daftari are to be promoted to the post of Junior clerk but the private respondents mentioned in Para 1(iii) are directly promoted to the post of Junior Clerk without promoting them to the post of Daftari. That it is pertinent to mention here that if any employee of House Hold or PBMC was required to be adjusted in the Secretariat then as per law and rules he was supposed to be adjusted at the bottom of the seniority list. Similarly in the case WP No.6732-P/2019 titled Yasir Zeb VS Government of KPK, the respondents have taken the plea against house hold staff. **Copies of the comments of the respondents and working papers for juniors promotion are attached as Annexure.....A&B.**
- 2- Incorrect and misleading. The respondents have repeatedly violated section 8 of the KP Civil Servant Act 1973 read with Rule 17 of the APT Rules 1989.
- 3- Incorrect and not replied accordingly. That detailed reply has been given in Para 1 of the rejoinder.
- 4- Incorrect and not replied accordingly.
- 5- Incorrect and not replied accordingly.

- 6- Incorrect and misleading. The seniority position of the appellant was repeatedly disturbed due to the unlawful and illegal adjustment of the private respondents on wrong position of the seniority.
- 7- Incorrect, para-7 of the appeal is correct.
- 8- Incorrect the objection of the appellant was not entertained irrespective of the fact that the appellant had highlighted all the illegality and irregularities.
- 9- Incorrect and misleading, the detail reply/answer to this Para has been given Para 1 above.
- 10- Incorrect the departmental appeal has not been decided within the statutory period of ninety days.
- 11- Incorrect the juniors and ineligible were promoted to the post of Junior Clerk.

**GROUND:**

**(A TO F):**

All the grounds of main appeal are correct and in accordance with law and prevailing rules and that of the respondent are incorrect and baseless hence denied. That the respondent Department has wrongly adjusted the private respondents in the seniority list of secretariat staff and illegally and unlawfully promoted the juniors to the appellant by violating Section 8 of the K.P Civil Servant Act read with Rule-17 of K.P APT rules 1989. Moreover, contrary to their reply to the instant appeal, the respondents have concluded an inter-se agreement with the private respondents tendering NOC to holding of DPC for promotion of house hold staff with the pledge to the effect that in future no outsider shall be entered in the seniority list of class-IV employees of civil secretariat. **Copy of agreement is attached as Annexure .....C.**

It is therefore most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this rejoinder the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

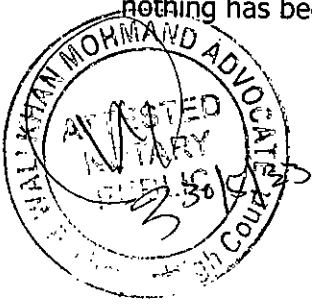

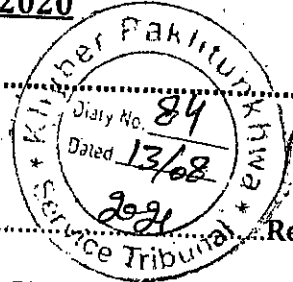

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS.

- i. That Appellant has got no cause of action and locus standi.
- ii. That Appeal is not maintainable in the present form.
- iii. That Appeal is not based on facts.
- iv. That Appellant has not come to this Tribunal with clean hands.
- v. That Appeal is bad for mis-joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.

RESPECTFULLY SUBMITTED:

1. Pertains to record of Governor's House, hence no comments.
2. No comments.
3. **Incorrect, hence denied.** It is submitted that the appointment of the appellant is not regulated under APT Rules, 1989 (**Annex-I**) as is also evident from the terms and conditions of the service of the appellant which is reflected in his appointment order (**Annex-II**). Since the appellant is the household employee of the Governor House, therefore, the name of the appellant cannot be reflected on the seniority list which is solely meant for regular employees borne on the cadre strength of the Administration Department.

It is further added that the House Hold Staff is recruited separately by three different entities or authorities i.e. **Administration Department, Governor's House and Chief Minister's House** for working in Rest Houses under their respective administrative control. Administration Department has framed and formally notified separate Service Rules for House Hold Employees working under their administrative control (**Annex-III**). Hence, it is also open for the other two entities viz, the Governor House and the Chief Minister's House to frame similar service structure for their respective employees.

4. Name of the appellant was rightly missing from the seniority list of Secretariat employees borne on cadre strength of Administration Department issued in 2015 as he was not appointed against the post borne on cadre strength of Administration Department, under the prevailing rules.
5. No comments.
6. Reply as per Para-4 above.

7. **Incorrect.** Departmental Appeal / representation of the appellant was duly processed and regretted by the Competent Authority (**Annex-IV**).
  8. **Incorrect, hence denied.** In fact, the appellant has tried to gain undue favour from this Hon'ble Tribunal and, therefore, has misled it by quoting the seniority of the employees he has nothing to do with. From appointment order of the appellant it is amply clear that he is an employee of the Governor's House, Peshawar and, moreover, not even a copy of the appointment order of the appellant was endorsed to the Administration Department/ Civil Secretariat by his appointing authority which clearly indicates that he is wholly solly the employee of the Governor's House and not of Administration Department. House Hold Employees of the Governor's House constitute separate cadre/ service borne purely on cadre strength of the said entity hence, legally he cannot share seniority with Civil Servants borne on the cadre strength of Administration Department.

**GROUND:**

- A. **Incorrect.** Appellant has been treated according to law. No right of appellant whatsoever, has therefore, been violated.
- B. Reply as per Para-3 of facts.
- C. **Incorrect.** Appellant has no legal right of promotion or seniority against an alien cadre or entity other than his own cadre or sanctioned strength on which he is borne i.e. Governor House.
- D. Subject to proof. No. fundamental right of appellant has been violated. As against this, it is the appellant who actually seeks to violate fundamental/ legal rights of countless employees borne on the cadre strength of Administration Department.

It is therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of these comments the instant Appeal being devoid of merit may graciously be turned down / dismissed with cost.

4. That in view of the Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, this Hon'ble Court has got no jurisdiction to entertain the instant Petition.

**ON FACTS:-**

1. Correct to the extent that the Petitioners are permanent Household Employees of Administration Department / Chief Minister's Secretariat.
2. As explained in Para-1, above.
3. Correct to the extent that the Petitioners were appointed as Bearers.
4. **Incorrect.** Promotion against the post of Junior Clerk (BS-11) is purely made in the light of specified Service Rules and Promotion Policy. The Petitioners are Household Employees, appointed by Secretary Administration under proviso of Rule 10(2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989 (**Annex-I**) and being non-secretariat staff, cannot be promoted against posts reserved for Secretariat employees.

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5. Incorrect as laid. SSC certification alone is not sufficient to enable the Petitioners to be promoted.
6. Incorrect. As explained in Para-4 above.
7. Correct to the extent that some Household *Malis* (BS-03) were promoted to the post of Daftari (BS-04) on the recommendations of Departmental

The Regulation Wing, Establishment Department has opined in the matter that Household Cadre is a "non-Secretariat Service"; and that such employees are not supposed to be considered for promotion to the posts of Secretariat Service. However, it has also been clarified that the Household Employees are required to be given chances /channels of promotion within their own cadre i.e. Household Cadre. Administration Department is keenly working on formulating a viable service structure for all Household Employees. In this regard, a Committee has recently constituted with the sole mandate to formulate a viable service structure for Household Employees of Civil Secretariat (Annex-II). Moreover, precedents of service structure of Household Employees of sister province have also been requested / sought (Annex-III).

- 8. Correct to the extent that the employees were promoted as Junior Clerk (BS-11) because as per Service Rules, Daftaris are eligible to be considered for promotion to Junior Clerk on seniority-cum-fitness basis.
- 9. Incorrect as laid. The applications submitted were duly processed and regretted being not covered under the Rules /Policy.
- 10. No comments.

**GROUNDS:**

A. **Incorrect as laid.** The petitioners are seeking quota for promotion in another cadre of Civil Secretariat, while their own cadre is in existence (Annex-IV). It is not binding on respondents to introduce any promotion quota / share for the petitioners to the post of Junior Clerk (BS-11). The Petitioners are Household Employees. They seeking a quota /share for promotion to the posts of Junior Clerk (BS-11) at the level of Civil Secretariat. As per advice of Regulation Wing, Establishment Department, Household Cadre is a "non-Secretariat Service"; and that such employees are not supposed to be considered for promotion to the posts of Secretariat Service. They have also added that Household Employees must be given chances /channels of promotion within their own cadre i.e. Household Cadre. In this connection, Administration Department is keenly working on formulating a viable service structure for all Household Employees. In this regard, a Committee has recently been constituted with the sole mandate to formulate a viable service structure for Household Employees of Civil Secretariat (Annex-II *ibid*). Moreover, precedents of household service structure have also been solicited from sister province (Annex-III *ibid*). Promotion against the post of Junior Clerk (BS-11) is purely made in the light of specified service rules and promotion policy. The Petitioners are Household Employees, appointed by Secretary Administration under proviso of Rule 10(2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989 (Annex-I *ibid*) and being

Household Employees of Civil Secretariat (Annex-II *ibid*). Moreover, precedents of Household service structure have also been solicited from sister province (Annex-III *ibid*). After formulation of service structure / channel, all the Household Employees will get ample opportunity for elevation to higher posts in their own cadre. It will take some time.

C. **Incorrect as laid.** The Petitioners can neither be placed in seniority nor can they be considered for promotion as Junior Clerk in Civil Secretariat as there is no provision for them in the existing service rules of that post. Moreover, as per advice of Regulation Wing, Establishment Department, Household Cadre is a "non-Secretariat Service"; and that employees belonging to such cadre are not supposed to be considered for promotion to the posts falling on the strength of Secretariat Service. On the other hand, Malis, Farash and Sweepers etc can not only be placed in seniority but also can be considered for promotion as Junior Clerk in Civil Secretariat as there is provision for them in existing service rules of that post. Establishment department has neither promoted any household employee as a Junior Clerk nor has violated any rule / article. Therefore, no discrimination exists on the part of Establishment Department.

D. **Incorrect as laid.** As in C above.

E. **Incorrect as laid.** The Petitioners can neither be placed in seniority nor can they be considered for promotion as Junior Clerk in Civil Secretariat as there is no provision for them in the existing service rules of that post. Moreover, as per general advice of Regulation Wing, Establishment Department, household cadre is a "non-Secretariat Service"; and that employees belonging to such cadre are not supposed to be considered for promotion to the posts falling on the strength of Secretariat Service. Administration Department is keenly working on formulating a viable service structure for all household employees. Household staff is recruited, transferred or promoted in the light of their own rules / policies having no relevancy with the Civil Secretariat staff as it has clearly been mentioned in the proviso under Rule 10(2) of (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989 that nothing in this sub-rule Rule 10(2) shall apply to the Household staff of Chief Minister House Peshawar, Frontier House (Now KP House) Islamabad, Frontier Rest House Bannu, Swat and Abbottabad, Frontier House Nathiagali and Shahi Mehman Khana, Peshawar and any other House to be established by the Government. Hence, no policy has been violated.

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

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**WORKING PAPER**

Subject:- **PROMOTION OF DAFTARIES / JUNIOR CLERK (A.C.B) ETC TO JUNIOR CLERKS (BS-11). IN THE CIVIL SECRETARIAT, KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA.**

According to column-5 of S.No. 4 of the appendix to the Establishment Department Notification No. SOE.IV(E&AD)/1-35/2014 dated 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2019 (Annex-I), the post of Junior Clerk (BS-11) is to be filled in by adopting the following method of recruitment:-

- (a) 60% by Initial recruitment.
- (b) 40% by promotion from amongst Daftaries, G.Operator, Qasids and Naib Qasids including other equivalent posts in the Secretariat with two years service as such, who have passed FA/FSc.Examination; and

*"Provided further that The condition of FA/F.Sc or its equivalent qualification from a recognized Board, as laid down at clause (a) shall not apply for a period of four years from the date of commencement of this Notification to the existing matriculate incumbents of the post of Daftaris, Gestetner Operators, Qasids and Naib Qasids including holders of other equivalent posts for promotion to the post of Junior Clerk (BS-11)".*

2. There are 437 sanctioned posts of Junior Clerks (BS-11) in the Civil Secretariat, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in the current financial year 2021-22 (Annex-II), out of these, 136 vacancies falling to the share of promotion are vacant as per following details:-

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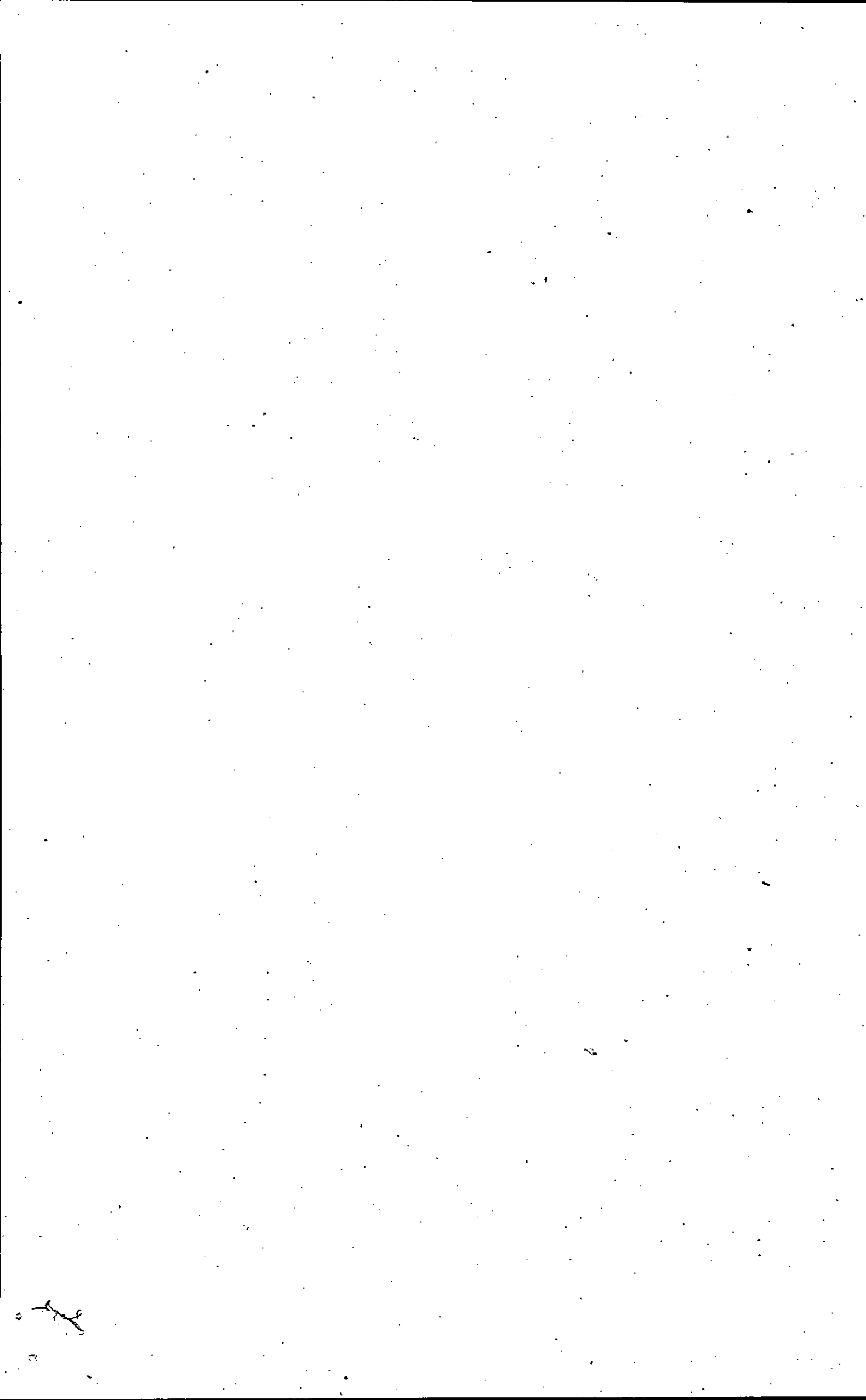



- ii. In case of arrival of recommendees against initial quota as and when desired by the competent authority their appointments shall be considered as cancelled.



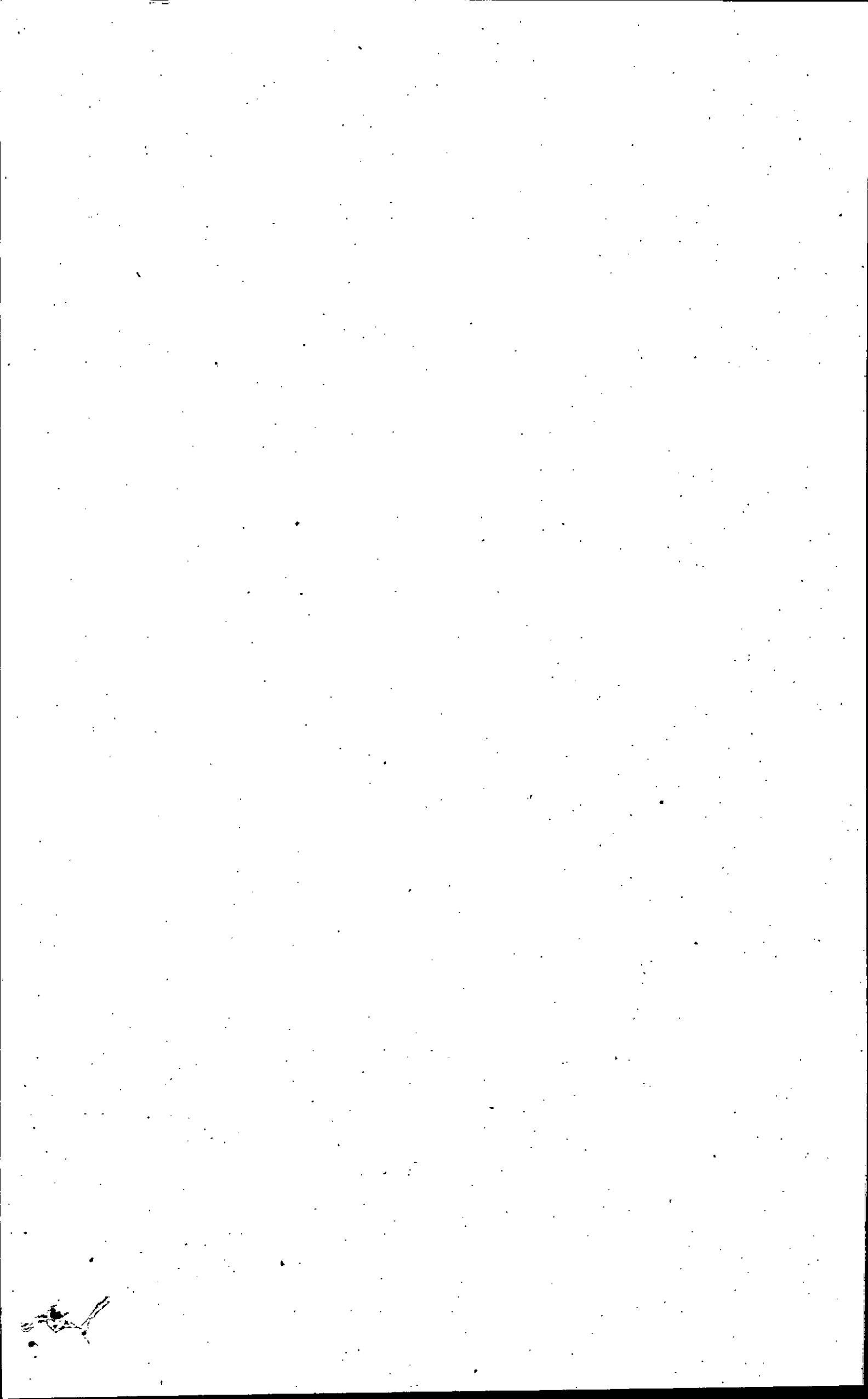

3- In future no outsider shall be entered in the seniority list of the class-IV employees of Civil Secretariat


