### ORDER

GULZAR AHMED, CJ:- This petition is barred by 14

days. An application for condonation of delay has been filed.

Learned Additional Advocate General, KP (the AAG) for the petitioners-Department contends, that delay has occurred because of the lengthy process for obtaining approval of the Constituted Law Committee for filing of the CPLA before this

he is unable to show that such submission is supported by any law. It is to be noted that this ground has not been accepted by this Court as a sufficient cause for condoning of delay and no reason has been assigned as to why such ground should be accepted now. No affidavit whatsoever has been filed by the officials of the petitioners to support the ground taken in the application and the application, apparently, has been made without applying mind to it and by omitting to give all relevant reasons with specific dates during which the delay has been caused. Even each day's delay has not been explained by the learned AAG for the petitioners, which is the requirement of law. The application, on the face of it, appears to be wholly not sustainable and meritless. The same is, therefore, dismissed. The petition is also dismissed as time barred.

2. The Chief Secretary, Government of KPK shall take notice of the fact that the cases of the Government of KPK are being filed before this Court with delay and the applications, which are filed for condonation of delay, do not even provide for any ground and the filing of the petition before this Court is treated as just a formality. Proper action shall be taken against those officials, who are responsible for filing of the delayed petitions before this Court and also the persons, who are responsible in making of application for condonation of delay,

ATTESTEMOT that, in routine stereo type applications are filed without at all applying mind to the facts and circumstances of the case, Surior Court Associate Supreme Court of Pakistan Supreme Court of Pakistan which are just meaningless and are not supported by any

material whatsoever. The Chief Secretary shall ensure that the

action is taken against the officials, because there seems to be a scam, where the government matters are deliberately delayed to favour the opposite party. A report shall be submitted by the Chief Secretary, Government of KP to this Court within a period of one month, showing compliance of the Courts' order.
