MR. KALIM ARSHAD KHAN, CHAIRMAN: Appellant alongwith his counsel present. Mr. Fazal Shah Mohmand. Additional Advocate General alongwith Miss. Parkha Aziz, Legal Advisor for the respondents present.

- 2. At the very outset, the learned counsel for the appellant referred to the impugned order wherein the major punishment awarded to the appellant was converted by the Departmental Appellate Authority into stoppage of one annual increment for a period of two years. The said period of two years has already elapsed. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that although the punishment for the specified period had come to an end after expiry of two years yet that may be a stigma for the appellant on his service record. He says that the appellant would be satisfied if it is found that this will not be used as hurdle in grant of other service benefits for which the appellant becomes otherwise entitled from time to time. Disposed of accordingly. Consign.
