



OFFICE MEMORANDUM.

Subject: REVISION OF BASIC PAY SCALES, ALLOWANCES AND "ENSION OF CIVIL SERVANTS OF THE FEDERAL COVERNMENT.

The President has been pleased to sanction the revision of Basic Pay Scales, Allowances and Pension with effect from 1st July, 2011 for the Civil Servants of the Federal Government, paid out of Civil Estimates and out of Defence Estimates as defailed in the succeeding paragraphs:-

PART-I (PAY)

Revision of Basic Pay Scales:

The Basic Pay Scales-2011 shall replace the Basic Pay Scales-2008 with

effect from 01.07.2011 as contained in the Annexure to this Office Memorandum.

Fixation of Pay of the Existing Employees (w. c. f. 01.07.2011):

- The basic pay of an employee who was in service on 30.06.2011 shall be fixed in the Basic Pay Scale-2011 on point to point basis i.e. at the stage corresponding to that occupied by him/her above the minimum of Basic Pay Scales-2008.
- ii. In case of Personal Pay being drawn by an employee as part of his/her basic pay beyond the maximum of his/her pay scale on 30.06.2011, he/she shall continue to draw such pay in the Basic Pay Scales-2011 at the revised rates.

Annual Increment:

Annual increment shall continue to be admissible, subject to the existing conditions, on 1st of December each year.

PART-II (ALLOWANCES)

5.

Ad hoe Relief Allowances granted upto 01.07.2009;

The following Ad hoc Relief Allowances granted upto 01.07.2009 shall stand discontinued with effect from 01.07.2011 having been merged in the Basic Pay Scales-2008 so as to introduce Basic Pay Scales-2011:-

 - The Ad hoe Relief Allowance will be subject to Income Tax.
- iv. The Ad hoe Relief Allowance will be admissible during leave and emire period of LPR.
- The Ad has Refiel Allowance will not be treated as part of emblaments for the purpose of calculation of Pension/Gratifity and recovery of House Rent.
- The Ad hoc Relief Allowance will not be admissible to the employees during the tenure of their posting/deputation abroad.
- vii. The Ad hoc Relief Allowance will be admissible to the employees on their reputriation from posting/deputation abroad at the rate and amount which would have been admissible to them had they not been posted abroad.
- vin. The Ad hoe kehet Allowande will be admissible during the period of suspension.
- ix. The term "Basic Pay" will also include the amount of Personal Pay granted on account of annual increment(s) beyond the maximum of the existing pay scales.

Medical Allowance:

- i. Medical Allowance admissible to Civil Servants in BPS-16 .o BPS-22 @ 15% of the existing basic pay in Basic Pay Scales-2008 shall continue to be admissible at the frozen level of its admissibility as on 30.06.2011.
- ii. All the new entrants in BPS-16 to BPS-22 shall be allowed Medical Allowance @ 15% of the minimum of relevant Basic Pay Scales-2008 on: notional basis with effect from 01.07.2011, till further orders, and shall stand frozen at the same level.

All the Special Pays, Special Allowances or the Allowances admissible as percentage of pay (excluding those which are capped by fixing maximum limit) including House Rent Allowance and the Allowance/Special Allowance equal to one month Basic Pay granted to any Federal Government/FBR/Police employees irrespective of his/her posting in Ministry/Division/Department/FBR including eivil employees in BPS 1-22 of Judiciary shall stand frozen at the level of its admissibility as on 30.06.2011.

All the existing Civil Pensioners of the Federal Government including Civilians paid out of Defence Estimates have been allowed an increase in their pension at the following rates with effect from 1st July, 2011, until further orders:-N

i. Pensioners who retired on or after 01.07.2002 @ 15% of the ret pension.

ii. Pensioners who retired on or before 30.06.2002 @ 20% of not pension.

13. On introduction of the Basic Pay Scales-2011, the increases in pension allowed vide para-3 of the Finance Division Office Memorandum No. F.4 (1) Reg-6/ 2010/ 721 dated 05.07.2010 shall be discontinued to the new pensioners who would retire on or after 01.07.2011 who opts to draw pension under the Scheme of Dasie Pay Scales-2011.

14. However, 15% increases in pension allowed vide para-2 of the Finance Division. Office Memorandum No.F.4 (1) Reg-6/ 2010/721 dated 05.07.2010 shall continue to be admissible to the new pensioners who would retire on or after 01.07.2011 who opts to draw pension under the Scheme of Basic Pay Scales-2011.

15. The 15% increase in pension as mentioned at Paras-12 (i) above shall also be admissible to the pensioners who would retire on or after 01.07.2011.

16. For the purpose of admissibility of increase in pension for the Civil Pensioners sanctioned in this Office Memorandum the term "Net Pension" means "Pension being drawn" minus "Medical Allowance", which shall be continued to be admissible at the level of its admissibility as on 30.06.2011.

17. The increase shall also be admissible on family pension granted under the Pension-cum-Gratuity Scheme, 1954, Liberalized Pension Rules, 1977, on pension sanctioned under the Central Civil Services (Extra Ordinary Pension) Rules as well as on the Compassionate Allowance under CSR-353.

18. If the gross pension sanctioned by the Federal Government is shared with any Government in accordance with the rules laid down in part-IV of Appendix III to the Accounts Code, Volume-I, the amount of the increase in pension shall be apportioned between the Federal Government and the other Government concerned on proportionate basis.

19. The increase in pension sanctioned in this Office Memorandum shall not be admissible on Special Additional Pension allowed in lieu of pre-retirement Orderly Allowance.

20. The increase in pension shall not be admissible during the period of their reemployment, but the same shall be allowed after the termination of the re-employment contract. However, the increase in pension admissible to the pensioners of the Federal Government before their re-employment on contract basis shall continue to be admissible to them provided that they are not in receipt of any increases allowed as allowances with their pay in lieu of increases in pension,

21. The benefit of increase in pension sanctioned in this Office Memorandum shall also be admissible to those Civil Pensioners of the Federal Government who are reaiding abroad (other than those residing in India and Bangladesh) who retired on or after 15.08.1947 and are not entitled to, or are not in receipt of pension increase under the British Government's Pension (increase) Acts. The payment shall be made at the applicable rate of exchange.

Medical Allowance for the Pensioners:

- i. Medical Allowance admissible to the existing retired Civil Servants in BPS-1 to BPS-15 and in BPS-16 to BPS-22 @ 25% and @20% of the net pension respectively shall continue to be admissible at the frozen level of its admissibility as on 30.06.2011 and till further orders.
- ii. All the Civil Servants in BPS-1 to BPS-15 and in BPS-16 to BPS-22, who shall retire on or after 01.07.2011 onwards, shall be allowed Medical Allowance @ 25% and @20% of the net pension respectively and shall stand frozen at the same level.

Option:

The Ministry/Division/Department/Office to which an employee belongs and/or on whose pay roll he/she is borne shall obtain an option in writing from such employees within <u>60 days</u> commencing from the date of issue of this Office Memorandum and communicate it to the concerned Accounts Office/DDO, as the case may be, either to continue to draw salary in the Scheme of Basic Pay Scales-2008 or in the Scheme of Basic Pay Scales-2011 as specified in this Office Memorandum. Option once exercised shall be considered final.

 An existing employee, as aforesaid, who does not exercise and communicate his/her option within the specified time limit, shall be deemed to have opted for the Scheme of Basic Pay Scales-2011. 24. All the existing rules/orders on the subject shall be considered to have been modified to the extent indicated above. All the existing rules/orders not so modified shall continue to be in force under this scheme.

25. <u>Anomalies:</u>

An Anomaly Committee shall be set up in the Finance Divisior (Regulations Wing) to resolve the anomalies, if any, arising in the implementation of the Basic Pay Scales-2011 and Pension.

- 6. Incorrect. The appellant was retired on 14.05.2010 and was allowed pension with all benefits admissible to him under the rules in vogue.

In the light of the Notification dated: 14.07.2011 the appellant and that nothing has been left.

- The Appellant has got all benefits as admissible to him under the rules in vogue.
- 7. Incorrect. The Appellant has not pointed out any rules under which he was entitled for the benefit which has not been extended to him.

GROUND

A. The Appellant was retired on 14.05.2010. Therefore he was entitled for the increase in pension allowed in light of Notification dated: 04.07.2015, which has been granted to appellant accordingly.

- E. No appeal has been received in this regard to Respondent No.03

Subject:- <u>GRANT OF INCREASE IN PENSION TO CIVIL PENSIONERS OF THE FEDERAL</u> GOVERNMENT AS WELL AS RETIRED ARMED FORCES PERSONNEL.

The President has been pleased to sanction an increase in pension with effect from 1st July, 2010 until further order to all civil pensioners of the Federal Government including civilians paid from Defence Estimates as well as retired Armed Forces Personnel at the following rate:-

(1) These penaloners who retried before 01.12.2001 2070	(i)	Those pensioners who retired before 01.12.2001	20%
---	-----	--	-----

(ii) Those pensioners who retired on or after 01.12.2001 15%

2. The 15% increase in pension as mentioned at para 1 (ii) above will also be admissible to the pensioners who would retire on or after 01.07.2010.

3. The Government servants who would retire on or after 01.07.2010 will also be entitled for increase in pension @ 10%, 15% and 15% which have been allowed vide Finance Division's O.Ms No. 1(1)-imp/2005 dated 01.07.2005, 4(3)-Reg.6/2006 dated 30.06.2006 and 4(1)-R.6/2009 dated 13.07.2009.

4. For the purpose of admissibility of increase in pension sanctioned in this O.M. the term "Net Pension" means "Pension being drawn".

5. The increase will also be admissible on family pension granted under the Pension-cum-Gratuity Scheme, 1954, Liberalized Pension Rules, 1977, on pension sanctioned under the Central Civil Services (Extra Ordinary Pension) Rules as well as on the Compassionate Allowance under CSR-353.

6. If the gross pension sanctioned by the Federal Government is shared with any Government in accordance with the rules laid down in part-IV of Appendix III to the Accounts Code, Volume-I, the amount of the increase in pension will be apportioned between the Federal Government and the other Government concerned on proportionate basis.

7. The increase in pension sanctioned in this O.M. will not be admissible on Special Additional Pension allowed in lieu of pre-retirement orderly allowance.

8. The increase in pension allowed by the Government during their re-employment shall not be admissible during the period of their re-employment, but the same will be allowed after the termination of the re-employment contract. However, the increases in pension admissible to the pensioners of the Federal Government before their re-employment on contract basis will continue to be admissible to them provided that they are not in receipt of any increases allowed as Allowances with their pay in lieu of increases in pension.

9. The benefit of increase in pension sanctioned in this O.M. will also be admissible to those Civil Pensioners of the Federal Government who are residing abroad (other than those residing in India and Bangladesh) who retired on or after 15.08.1947 and are not entitled to, or are not in receipt of pension increase under the British Government's Pension (increase) Acts. The payment will be made at the applicable rate of exchange.

In case of Personal Pay being drawn by an employee as part of his / her basic pay beyond the maximum of his / her pay scale as on 30-06-2011, he / she shall continue to draw such pay in the Basic Pay Scales – 2011 at revised rates.

Annual Increment

Annual increment will continue to be admissible, subject to the existing conditions, on 1st of December each year.

15. For the purpose of admissibility: of increase in pension, as aforesaid, the term "Net Pension" means "Pension being drawn" *minus* "*Medical*, *Allowance*", as admissible.

14. Increases in pension allowed vide Para-3 of Finance Department letter No.FD(SOSR-II)4-111/2010 dated 15/7/2010 will not be allowed to civil servants who retired on, or would retire after, 01/7/2011, and who opt to draw pension under the Scheme of Basic Pay Scales-2011.

15. However, 15[%] increases in pension allowed vide Para-2 of Finance. Department letter No.FD(SQSR-II)4-111/2010 dated 13/7/2010 will continue to be admissible to those civil servants who retired on, or would retire after, 01/7/2011, and who opt to draw pension under the Scheme of Basic Pay Scales-2011.

16 15% increase in pension, as mentioned at Para-12/S.No:(i) above, will also be admissible to civil servants who retired on, or would retire after, 01/7/2011.

17 Increase in pension, as mentioned in Para-12 above, will also be admissible on *family pension* granted under the Pension-cum-Gratuity Scheme 1954, Liberalized Pension Rules, 1977, on pension sanctioned under the Provincial Civil Servante Pension Rules (Extra Ordinary Pension) as well as on Compassionate Allowance allowed under CSR-353.

18. If the gross pension sanctioned by the Provincial Government is shared with any Government in accordance with the rules laid down in part-IV of Appendix III to the Accounts Code, Volume-I, the amount of increase in pension shall be apportioned between this Provincial Government- and the other Government concerned on proportionate basis.

19 Increase in pension, mentioned in Para-12 above, will not be admissible on Special Additional Pension allowed in fleu of pre-retirement Orderly Allowance.

20. Increase in pension, mentioned in Para-12 above, will not be a admissible during the period of re-employment of a pensioner, but the increase will be allowed after the termination of the re-employment contract. However, the increase in pension admissible to the pensioners of the Provincial Government before their re-employment on contract basis will continue to be admissible to them, provided that they are not in receipt of any increases allowed as allowances with their pay in lieu of increases in pension?

21. The benefit of increase in pension sanctioned through this letter will also be admissible to those Civil Pensioners of the Provincial Government who are residing abroad (other than those residing in India and Bangladesh) who retired on or after 15/8/1947, and are not entitled to; or are not in receipt of pension increase under the British Government's Pension (increase) Acts The payment shall be made at the applicable rate of exchange.

22. Medical Allowance for the Pensioners.

- (i) Medical Allowance admissible to the existing retired Civil Servants in BPS-1 to BPS-15 and in BPS-16 to BPS-22. @ 25% and @ 20% of their net pension respectively, will continue to be admissible, but the amount will remain frozen at the level of its admissibility as or 30/6/2011, and until further orders.
- (ii) All Civil Servants in BPS-1 to BPS-15 and in BPS-16 to BPS-22, who retired on, or will retire after, 01/7/2011, will be allowed Medical Allowance @ 25% and @ 20% of their net pension respectively, which amount will remain frozen at the same level, until further orders.

23. Option.

(i)

The Department/Office to which an employee belongs, and/or on whose pay roll he/she is borne, shall obtain an option in writing from such employee, within 60 days commencing from the date of issue of this letter, either to continue to draw salary either in the Scheme of Basic Pay Scales-2008 or in the Scheme of Basic Pay Scale-2011 as specified in this letter. Option once exercised shall be considered final, which will then be communicated to the concerned Accounts Office or DDO, as the case may be.

(ii) An existing employee, who does not exercise and communicate his/her option within the specified time limit, shall be deemed to have opted for the Scheme of Basic Pay Scales-2011

All the existing rules/orders on the subject shall be considered to have been modified to the extent indicated above. All the existing rules/orders not so modified shall continue to remain in force as such.

25. <u>Anomalies</u>:

An Anomalies Committee will be constituted in the Provincial Finance Department to resolve anomalies, if any, arising out of implementation of the scheme of Basic Pay Scales – 2011 or out of other changes notified through this letter.
