JUDGMENT

IJAZ ANWAR, J. Through this single judgment, we intend to decide this and the connected Writ Petition bearing No.2195-P/2020 titled "Muhammad Ajmal and others Vs. Directorate General Health Services, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar through its Director General and others", since, in both these cases, similar questions of law and facts are involved.

2. Petitioners have prayed for the following relief:-

"It is humbly prayed that on acceptance of this writ petition, this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:-

Declare:

- (i) *That the petitioners being qualified and having Bachelor degree in different branches of Pathology are qualified with the relevant requisite qualifications required in the field of Pathology.*
- (ii) *That the acts and actions of the respondents and their refusal to consider the petitioners eligible for the posts of Clinical Technologists (BS-17) by not including them in Cadre of Clinical Technicians due to their degrees in the field of Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/Cytology in line with other persons having Bachelor Degree in Medical Technology is without lawful authority, and of no legal effect and hence ineffective upon the rights of the petitioners.*

Set aside:

the recommendations of the 2nd Committee and the tentative seniority list based on those recommendations as on 21/05/2019 may please be rescinded.

Direct:

The respondents to act in the matter in accordance with law and to consider the petitioners being eligible alongwith other persons working on the same posts and similarly placed employees for the post of Clinical Technologists (BS-17) and restore the seniority list as prepared on 17.01.2019.

Grant:


Any other relief as deemed appropriate in the circumstances of the case not specifically prayed for may also be granted to the petitioners".

3. In essence, petitioners, being employees of MTI/Hospitals/Departments and having Bachelor Degrees in different branches of Pathology, are aggrieved of the decision/recommendations of the respondents/second Committee, whereby, their names were excluded from the Cadre of Clinical Technicians (BPS-17) on the ground that their degrees in the field of Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/Cytology are not relevant to the Pathology Technology. As such, the same is liable to be rescinded and the recommendations of the first Committee, whereby, these Pathology disciplines were considered relevant subjects to the Pathology Technology, may be treated as final for the purpose of promotion.

4. In view of the averments made in the instant petition, comments were called from respondents No.2 and 3, who furnished the same, wherein, they opposed the issuance of desired writ asked for by the petitioners.

5. Arguments heard and record perused.

6. Perusal of the record reveals that petitioners are mainly aggrieved of the decision of the Committee, whereby, the following recommendations were made:-

- 
- i. *To include the names of degree holders of Biochemistry, Microbiology, Hematology and Histopathology in the seniority list of qualified Paramedics of Pathology Cadre being relevant Technology.*
 - ii. *Subsequently to reform a separate Cadre for the degree holders of Biochemistry, Microbiology, Hematology and*

Histopathology later as and when the Govt. grants permission.

7. The Committee, infact, was constituted for the inclusion of the names of the Paramedics degree holders of Biochemistry, Microbiology, Hematology and Histopathology in the seniority list of qualified B.Sc Paramedics of Pathology Cadre. Similarly, they are further aggrieved of the provisional seniority list duly circulated, whereby, their names were excluded from the provisional seniority list of qualified degree holders of Pathology Technicians/Senior Technicians (Pathology)/Chief Technicians (Pathology). We, after having examined the case and considered the grievances of the petitioners, called upon learned counsel for the petitioners firstly to justify filing of constitutional petition before this Court and also to address the maintainability of writ petition in view of the bar contained Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. In response to this query, learned counsel argued that it was only recommendations of the Committee and thus without framing any separate Service Rules or amending the law, the names of the petitioners cannot be excluded from the seniority list besides there is no final order in their case.

8. Admittedly, petitioners have submitted their representation/ appeal before the Appellate Authority and in the comments, respondents have rejected their claim. We

are, thus, of the view that the claim/representation of the petitioners having been rejected; as such, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal is the only forum where such questions can be raised, taken and decided. Seniority being one of the foremost term and condition of service; as such, in view of the constitutional provisions, the jurisdiction of this Court is barred; besides, petitioners are also having alternate remedy available under the law.

9. In view of the above, since the matter in hand is ripe; as such, we, instead of dismissing this and the connected petition for want of jurisdiction, would send it to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal for its decision on merit and in accordance with law. Office is directed to send this and the connected writ petition alongwith its annexures in original to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal while its copies be retained for the purpose of record.

Respectfully Sheweth:-

1. That the paramedical cadre was comprised of 57 specialties before re-structuring in the year 2006. The paramedical cadre consists of:-

- Laboratory Technicians
- Blood Bank Technicians and
- Microscopists

(Copy of the list of sub-specialties of Paramedical Cadre is annexed as Annexure "A")

2. That the Government of N.W.F-P (Now Khyber Pakhtunkhwa) vide its notification No: SOH.III/8-60/05 (Paramedics) dated 10th May, 2006 further restructured it and restricted the paramedical cadre to 14 technologies. Through the Notification dated: 10.05.2019, the above specialties were merged together and restructured into different cadres and re-nomenclates as "Pathology Technologies" on basis of similarity in their job descriptions and having same basic qualification.

(Copy of the Notification dated: 10.05.2006 is annexed as Annexure "B")

3. That the basic qualification for all the technicians working as Pathology Technicians is "Diploma in Medical Technology" commonly known as "DMLT". The paramedics working in hospitals and Primary Health Care shall mentioned with the categories of posts meant for paramedics with the specific specialty (e,g Junior Clinical Technician (Pathology) or Junior Clinical Technician (Radiology) etc. The details of these 14 specialties/Technologies is attached as Annexure-C.

4. That the Government/Respondent amended the old Service Rules of 1999 were amended and B.Sc Medical Technology, or M.SC in Bio-Chemistry, or Microbiology from a recognized University is added as basic qualification for appointment for Technologist. Copy of the amended Notification is attached as Annexure-D.

5. That the recruitment rules were also reframed primarily in May, 10, 2006 (Annex-D/1) and later on 10th May 2016 (Annex-D/2), wherein the method of recruitment and qualification for all the 14 Technologies were as specified in the said rules.

6. That it was prescribed that the posts of Technologist (B-17) in all the technologies shall be filled in:

(3)

i). 40% by promotion from amongst the chief Technologist (B-16) with 5 years' service as such.

ii). 20% by promotion on the basis of seniority- cum- fitness from amongst the chief technicians, senior technicians and technicians having qualification prescribed for initial recruitment with three years' service as such in the relevant technology (a joint seniority list) with reference to the acquiring higher qualification will be caused for promotion against this quota.

iii). 40% by initial recruitment.

7. That the purpose of causing a joint seniority list, a committee was constituted in the year 2017 to ascertain the higher qualification (Graduation or Post graduation) and the relevancy of that qualification to the Pathology Technology. The Committee on 11.10.2017 recommended that:-

i. *To include the names of the degree holders of Biochemistry, Microbiology, Hematology and Histopathology in the seniority list of qualified Paramedics of Pathology Cadre being relevant Technology.*

ii. *Subsequently to reform a separate cadre for the degree holders of biochemistry, Microbiology, Hematology and Histopathology later as and when the Govt grants permission.*

(Copy of the recommendations is attached as Annexure "E").

8. That based on the report of the committee (Annex-E), wherein it was recommended that the paramedic's Bachelor/BS/B.Sc degree holders in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/Cytology having relevant subjects to the pathology technology be included in the joint seniority list for the purpose of promotion to the post of Technologist (B-17). It may be mentioned here that in the old Service Rules of 1999 (Annex-III/A), the M.Sc

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in Microbiology and Biochemistry were tagged with B.Sc Medical Technology and 50% promotion quota was prescribed for them. (4)

9. That a joint seniority list was accordingly prepared (Annex-F/1), wherein the B.Sc (Medical Technologists) and the aforesaid postgraduate degree holders in Microbiology, Bio-chemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/Cytology were also included.
10. That however on the move of Medical Technologists, another committee was constituted which declared that these postgraduate degrees (Microbiology, Bio-chemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/Cytology) are not relevant to the pathology technology (Annex-G) and another joint seniority list is being prepared (Annex-H) where from the undersigned degree holders in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/Cytology are being excluded.

(Copy of the Minutes of the committee dt: 02.04.2019 is Annex-"G" and Seniority list dt: 21.05.2019 is "H")

11. That it may be pointed out that the degree holders in the aforesaid four disciplines (Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/Cytology) being stake-holders were not participated or even called for to participate in the proceedings of the committee to defend their position as the said committee erred to declare that these subjects are not relevant to the concerned technology. It may be mentioned here that the paramedical cadre is comprised of 14 technologies, from amongst which pathology (Mentioned as technology No IV against no 4 in the relevant rules) is one technology. The various specialties of Microbiology, Hematology, Bio-chemistry and Histopathology/Cytology are sub branches of the said Pathology technology, because all these sub-specialties/specialties are functioning under a single umbrella of pathology department. The all degree-holders have the same basic qualification of DMLT and improved their educational qualification in these sub-specialties. These clinical technologists performed their jobs randomly in all sections of Pathology department of hospitals. All the main tests were performed by the Clinical Technologists in Pathology departments having qualification in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/

Cytology. List of the tests performed by the petitioners/technologists is attached as annexure "I".

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12. That even in the basic courses of Medical Faculty imparted to the paramedics, rudimentary knowledge of aforesaid main specialties are included and the B.Sc Medical Technology course is nothing but an aggregates text of all these main specialties subjects. Technologist(B-17) remains paramedics under the overall supervisory control of the consultant, who have this very qualifications, which the petitioners paramedics have acquired and claiming promotion on the basis thereof. The paramedics with the said higher qualification become more capable technologists for the pathology which is relevant technology for all these subjects. There is no irrelevancy of these M.Sc subjects with B.Sc Medical technology and concluding to the pathology technology.
13. That if M.Sc/BS(Hons) in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology, Histopathology/Cytology are not relevant to the pathology then in which other technology these specialty are relevant, whereas the pathology department is everywhere supervised by consultants recruited on the basis of these additional qualifications (Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/Cytology). The Consultants, who were members of the Second Committee for determination the faith of the degree-holders in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/Cytology are also degree-holders of these subjects and appointed consultants/head of the Pathology Departments in their respective hospitals.
14. That all the Consultants working/appointed in various domains of pathology on the basis of their degrees, in their respective domains, are the part of pathology and relevant in the field. Whereas, in the case of Paramedics, the BS/B.Sc/M.Sc/MS/MPhil degrees in the above mentioned domains declared to be irrelevant through the impugned decision of the departmental committee. Although, these qualified Paramedics have basic diploma of Pathology along with undergraduate and post-graduate degrees in different domains of Pathology.

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6

15. That according to 1999 Service Rules M.Sc Microbiology/Biochemistry are tagged with 50% quota for Technologists (BS-17), and now on basis of recommendations dated: 02.04.2019, these degrees becomes irrelevant? However, Microbiology and Biochemistry are still the main core domains of Pathology.
16. That in view the above, the conclusion drawn by the second committee on the move of the Medical technologist excluding the petitioners is unfounded and based on wrong assumptions / assessment. All these subjects are solely pertains to the pathology in the health delivery system and any Medical lab (Pathology Department) cannot be run without the personnel's equipped with these qualifications. It is there ridiculous that the paramedical staff with the said postgraduate qualifications is excluded from the pathology cadre, because Pathology is a medical specialty that is concerned with the diagnosis of disease based on the laboratory analysis of bodily fluids such as blood and urine, and tissues using the tools of Biochemistry, microbiology, hematology and molecular pathology. Pathologists work in close collaboration with medical technologists to ensure the accuracy and optimal utilization of laboratory testing.
17. That the petitioners filed an representation against the impugned recommendations of the Second Committee, and requested that the said recommendations of the second committee may please be rescinded, wherein these pathology disciplines have been excluded and the seniority list of graduate and postgraduate paramedics prepared on the basis of recommendations of the first committee as on 17/01/2017 may be treated as final for the purpose of promotion to the posts of Technologist (BPS-17) against 20% quota prescribed in the relevant rules. But the respondents had continue the process of promotion without implementing the recommendations of committee and acted against the interest of petitioners to favor a specific group of clinical Technologists violating their fundamental rights, which compel them to knock the doors of this Hon'ble Court on the following grounds amongst others:-

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GROUNDS

7

- a. That the qualification of MSc Microbiology, M.Sc Biochemistry were previously tagged with BSc Medical Technologist against the 50% promotion quota to posts in B-17 as notified in 1999 rules, (Annex-III A) which is an ample proof of the fact that MSc Microbiology and Biochemistry were the same relevant qualification for pathology technology MSc Histopathology/ cytology and MSc Hematology are also most relevant to the department of pathology in the health delivery system.
- b. That the Respondents have not treated petitioners in accordance with law, rules and policy on subject and acted in violation of Article 4 of the Constitution, and unlawfully refused to include the petitioners having degrees in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/ Cytology by not considering them Technologist having the requisite relevant qualifications in the different categories/cadres of Pathology in line with other employees working as Technologists in Health Department, which act of the respondents is unjust, unfair and hence not sustainable in the eyes of law.
- c. That even basic course of medical faculty imparted to the paramedics, rudimentary knowledge of aforesaid main specialties are included and the B.Sc Medical Technology course is nothing but an aggregates text of all these main specialties. The petitioners are randomly working/performing all relevant jobs, tests and task assigned to them as other Clinical Technologists, who were considered relevant in the Pathology Cadre having the same basic qualification of DMLT with additional qualification of B.Sc/BS in Pathology. The recommendations made by the Committee in this respect is against the definition and bifurcation of different branches of Pathology.
- d. That the case of petitioners and that of other Technologists similarly placed and serving in identical circumstances in different cadres/sections of Pathology department of the respondents, provincial Health Department are the same in as much as they are discharging the same duties and

responsibilities. Since all the units are operating under the same umbrella of the same constitution, therefore, petitioners cannot be treated with a different yardstick and are thus also entitled to be considered as part & parcel of the Paramedics working in the field of Pathology as clinical Technologists.

e. That Article 25 of the Constitution dictates that all are equal before law and entitled to equal protection of law and all persons similarly placed in similar circumstances must be treated alike and when certain rights were declared to be available to one or more persons similarly placed, then all those persons similarly placed with them would stand declared entitled to such rights. Thus in this backdrop of the matter, petitioners has been highly discriminated in as much as the classification is not based upon reasonable differentia and therefore, the acts and actions of the respondents militate against the concept of equality and equality in service as enshrined in Articles 25 & 27 of the Constitution.

f. That the Technologist (B-17) remains paramedics under the overall supervisory control of the consultants, who have this very qualification which the petitioners paramedics have acquired and claiming promotion on the basis thereof. The paramedics with the said higher qualification become more capable technologists for the pathology which is relevant technology for all these subjects. There is no irrelevancy of these M.Sc subjects with B.Sc Medical technology and concluding to the pathology technology. The acts of the respondents is discriminatory and against the fundamental rights of the petitioner because the respondents had appointed different persons having the bachelor degrees of Microbiology as Clinical Technologists in BS-17 in Khalifa Gul Nawaz Teaching Hospital Bannu and JCT (BS-09) in District Health Officer, Karak.

g. That if M.Sc/BS(Hons) in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology, Histopathology/Cytology are not relevant to the pathology then in which other technology these technologists are considered to be relevant, whereas the pathology

department is everywhere supervised by consultants recruited on the basis of these very qualifications. (9)

- h. That in the same sequence, the principles of policy incorporated in Chapter-2 of the Constitution which have also been made the responsibility of each organ and authority of the State to act upon it in so far as the same relate to the functions of the organ or authority, directs for the discouragement inter-alia of the departmental prejudices amongst the citizens; the promotion with special care of the educational and economic interest of the different classes; for promotion of social justice and for the eradication of social evils; the promotion of social and economic well-being of the people including equality in earnings of individuals in various classes of the service of Pakistan.
- i. That the conclusion drawn by the second committee on the move of the Medical technologist excluding the petitioners is unfounded and based on wrong assumptions / assessment. All these subjects are solely pertain to the pathology in the health delivery system and any Medical lab (Pathology Department) cannot be run without the personnel's equipped with these qualifications. The Committee members It is there ridiculous that the paramedical staff with the said postgraduate qualifications is excluded from the pathology cadre.
- j. That the petitioners in light of Articles 4 and 25 of the Constitution had the inalienable right to be treated in accordance with law, as in law there should be no discrimination, as all citizens were equal before the law and were entitled to equal protection of law, thus act of the respondents to deprive the petitioners from their rights, is an act beyond their authority.
- k. That the petitioners may be allowed to rely on any additional grounds (if any) during the proceeding of the case).

In view of the aforesaid submissions, it is humbly prayed that on acceptance of this writ petition, this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:-

DECLARE:

(i) That the petitioners being having qualified and having Bachelor degree in different branches of Pathology are qualified with the relevant requisite qualifications required in the field of Pathology.

(ii) That the acts and actions of the Respondents and their refusal to consider the petitioners eligible for the posts of Clinical Technologists (BS-17) by not including them in Cadre of Clinical Technicians due to their degrees in the field of Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Histopathology/ Cytology in line with other persons having Bachelor Degree in Medical Technology is without lawful authority, and of no legal effect and hence ineffective upon the rights of the petitioners.

SET ASIDE: That the recommendations of the 2nd committee and the tentative seniority list based on those recommendations as on 21/5/2019 may please be rescinded.

DIRECT:

// The respondents to act in the matter in accordance with law and to consider the petitioners being eligible along with other persons working on the same posts and similarly placed employees for the post of Clinical Technologists (BS-17), **AND** Restore the seniority list as prepared on 17.01.2019.

GRANT:

Any other relief as deemed appropriate in the circumstances of the case not specifically prayed for may also be granted to petitioners.

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INTERIM RELIEF

The respondents may kindly be restrained to act upon recommendations dated: 02.04.2019 and seniority list dated: 21.05.2019 for initiating and completing the process of departmental promotion of the paramedics working in Health Departments, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as Clinical Technicians to Clinical Technologists in Pathology till the final decision of the main writ petition.



In pursuance of the decision taken by the provincial cabinet in its meeting held on 27th December 2005, the Competent Authority is pleased to approve eight stage paramedics services structure of NWFP with effect from 27-12-2005. The salient features whereof shall be as under:-

1. The existing 57 different categories of paramedics as mentioned in annexure A to this notification are restructured into 14 cadres as per annexure B.
2. In all the aforesaid cadres/specialties, the posts in various pay scales shall be integrated/categorized and re-nomenclatured as under:-

The words "clinical" shall be mentioned with the categories of posts meant for paramedics working in the hospitals and "Primary Health Care" with the paramedics working in the field along with mention of specific specialty (e.g. Junior Clinical Technician (Radiology) and Junior Primary Health Care Technician (Multi purpose)).

3. The number of Posts in BPS-20, BPS-19, BPS-18, BPS-17, BPS-16, BPS,14, BPS-12 and BPS-9 shall be according to the proportionate ratio based on the total 8965 posts as mentioned in the provincial budget book for financial year 2005-2006. The proportionate ratio of 8 stage formula shall be as under:-

However additional posts shall be created for any of the left over personals of paramedics cadre (if any). Moreover, subsequent creation of posts in any of the 14 paramedics cadres in any scale shall also be included in the aforesaid proportionate ratio of posts in the 8 tiers formula. The proportionate ratios of posts in BPS-12 and above shall be modified accordingly as and when new creation of posts are made in BPS-9 in each of the 14 cadres subsequently.

4. Seniority of the incumbents of the posts in the 14 cadres so merged shall be caused on the basis of scale wise seniority as well as date of regular appointment in the pay scale. (e.g. in joint seniority list of BPS-12, the official already in BPS-12 will be placed on the top of the list and the officials in the lower pay scale shall be accordingly placed step by step in the list; invariably keeping intact the inter-Se-seniority of the incumbents in the same pay scales).
5. In the first instance, the higher posts in the re-structured 14 paramedics cadres as per annexure "C" shall be filled in by way of promotion, as one time exercise, where-after the service rules duly prescribed as at annexure D shall be followed in subsequent promotion/initial recruitments.
6. Promotions in the post in BPS-18, 19 and BPS-20 shall be made on the basis of joint seniority list. The Joint seniority list of all the 14 cadres shall be caused at BPS-17 level, keeping in view the principles laid down in section 8 of the NWFP civil servants (ACT), 1973 read with Rule-17 of the NWFP civil servants (appointment, promotion and transfer) rules, 1989.
7. The afore-said paramedics service structure into 14 cadres shall also be applicable mutatis-mutandis to the paramedics working in FATA and employees working in Districts, all autonomous, semi autonomous and corporate bodies.
8. There shall be a council of paramedics to be notified separately.
9. The approved implementation committee and anomaly committee shall also be notified separately.
10. This eight stage paramedics service structure will replace all existing categories, cadres, structures and nomenclatures and will cancel all such cadres /categories rules and regulations etc which are in contravention to the approved paramedics service structure. New posts in all type of Health Delivery System will be created in

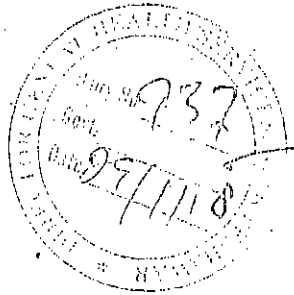

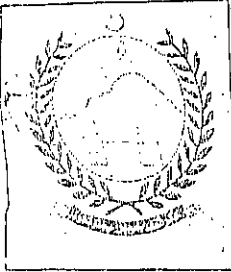

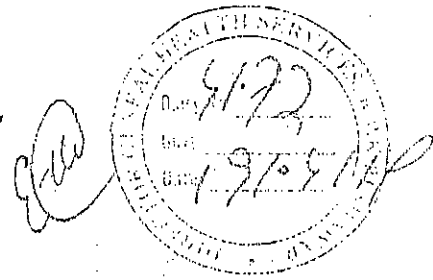

The meeting started with recitation from the Holy Quran and the chair welcomed the participants,

Deputy Director (Paramedics) has explained the background of the case stating that twenty percent (20) quota has been reserved for promotion of degree holders having degree in the relevant technology which is reproduced as under:-

"Twenty percent by promotion, on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness, from amongst the Chief Technicians, Senior Technicians and Technicians having qualification prescribed for initial recruitment with three years service as such in the relevant technology"

Moreover, the forum was apprised that in a meeting held on dated: 28-02-2017 under the chairmanship of Director (Admn) at Directorate it was recommended that conditionally the names of degree holders i.e Microbiology/Biochemistry/Biotechnology and Histopathology may be included in the seniority list of qualified Paramedics of Pathology cadre till a separate cadre of the said categories is framed.

It was pointed out that the aforesaid recommendations led to myriad of departmental appeals by the Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) degree holders of Pathology cadre. Recently, MLT degree holders submitted an appeal to Chief Minister, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on dated: 16-02-2019 stating that their seniority have been affected due to inclusion of Microbiology/Biochemistry/Biotechnology and Histopathology despite being irrelevant degree in the seniority list of Pathology cadre.

In pursuance of the remarks of the Chief Minister of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa a committee under the chairmanship of Deputy Secretary (Admn) Health Department was constituted vide Health Department Notification No. SOH-III/8-60/2019, dated: 14-03-2019 with following TORs:-

The committee shall check the relevant record/testimonials of Paramedics (Pathology) holding degrees of Microbiology/Bio-technology/Biochemistry etc in order to determine the relevancy of the degrees with Pathology and submit its recommendations within fifteen (15) days positively.

Tasked with the said TORs, the committee thoroughly looked into the matter and after threadbare discussion, Prof. Dr. Shahtaj Khan, Pathologist, MTI, HMC, Peshawar, Prof. Ahmad Rafiq, Pathologist, MTI, KMC/KTH, Peshawar & Asstt. Prof. Hamidullah Shah, Pathologist, MTI, LRH, Peshawar opined that Masters in Microbiology, Biotechnology and Biochemistry are not relevant for Clinical Technologist in Pathology (MLT). The joint expert opinion of the said Professors under their signatures (Flag-A) is reproduced verbatim as under:-

"Masters in Microbiology and Biotechnology are appointed as Microbiologist and Biochemist respectively and these degrees are not relevant for Clinical Technologist in Pathology (MLT), therefore their names should not be included in the list of Pathology (MLT). Separate posts should be created for the post of Technologist in the field of Microbiology, Hematology, Cytology, Biochemistry and Biotechnology under separate cadre in BS-17."

Decision:-

In view of the expert opinion of the above named Professors, the committee unanimously agreed that Masters in Microbiology, Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Hematology and Cytology should NOT be included in the seniority list of Pathology (MLT) being irrelevant degree and seniority list of qualified Technicians i.e. Pathology degree holders be prepared based on Pathology (MLT) degree only.

SUBJECT: PROMOTION OF PARA MEDICAL STAFF OF PATHOLOGY DEPARTMENT TO HIGHER POSTS OF TECHNOLOGIST IN B-17 ON THE BASIS OF POST GRADUATE DEGREE IN THE RELEVANT TECHNOLOGY.

Respected Sir,

With due reference and humble submission, it is stated that:

1. The paramedical cadre was previously comprised of 57 specialties (Annex-I).
2. The Govt. of KPK vide its notification No: SOH.III/8-60/05 (Paramedics) dated 10th may, 2006 restructured it and restricted the paramedical cadre to 14 technologies (Annex-II).
3. The recruitment rules were also reframed primarily in 2006 (Annex-III/B) and later on 10th may 2016 (Annex-IV), wherein the method of recruitment and qualification for all the 14 Technologies were as specified in the said rules.
4. It was prescribed that the posts of Technologist (B-17) in all the technologies shall be filled in:
 - i). 40% by promotion from amongst the chief Technologist (B-16) with 5 years' service as such.
 - ii). 20% by promotion on the basis of seniority- cum- fitness from amongst the chief technicians, senior technicians and technicians having qualification prescribed for initial recruitment with three years' service as such in the relevant technology (a joint seniority list) with reference to the acquiring higher qualification will be caused for promotion against this quota.
 - iii). 40% by initial recruitment.
5. For the purpose of causing a joint seniority list, a committee was constituted to ascertain the higher qualification (Graduation or Post graduation) and the relevancy of that qualification to the pathology technology.
6. Based on the report of the committee (Annex-V), wherein it was recommended that the degree holder paramedics in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Haematology and

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Histopathology / Cytology having relevant subjects to the pathology technology be included in the joint seniority list for the purpose of promotion to the post of Technologist (B-17). It may be mentioned that in the old service rules of 1999 (Annex-III/A), the M.Sc Microbiology and Biochemistry were tagged with B.Sc Medical technology and 50% promotion quota was prescribed for them. How these specialties of Microbiology and Biochemistry etc are irrelevant now?


7. A joint seniority list was accordingly drafted (Annex-VI), where in the B.Sc Medical technologists and the aforesaid postgraduate degree holders in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Haematology and Histopathology/Cytology were included.
8. However on the move of Medical technologists, another committee was constituted which declared that these postgraduate degrees are not relevant to the pathology technology (Annex-VII) and another joint seniority list is being prepared (Annex-VIII) where from the undersigned degree holders in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Haematology, and Histopathology/Cytology are being excluded.
9. It may be pointed out that the undersigned degree holders in the aforesaid four disciplines were not participated or called for in the proceedings of the committee to defend their position as the said committee erred to declare that these subjects are not relevant to the concerned technology. It may be mentioned that the paramedical cadre is comprised of 14 technologies, from amongst which pathology (Mentioned as technology No IV against no 4 in the relevant rules) is one technology. The various specialties of Microbiology, Haematology, Biochemistry and Histopathology / Cytology are sub branches of the said Pathology technology. As such all these sub specialties / specialties are functioning under a single umbrella of pathology department.
10. Even in the basic course of medical faculty imparted to the paramedics, rudimentary knowledge of aforesaid main specialties are included and the B.Sc Medical technology course is nothing but an aggregates text of all these main specialties. Technologist (B-17) remains paramedics under the overall supervisory control of the consultant, who have this very qualification which the applicants paramedics have acquired and claiming promotion on the basis thereof. The paramedics with the said higher qualification become more capable technologists for the pathology which is relevant technology for all these subjects. There is no irrelevancy of these M.Sc subjects with B.Sc Medical technology and concludingly to the pathology technology.
11. If M.Sc / BS (Hons) in Microbiology, Biochemistry, Haematology, Histopathology / Cytology are not relevant to the pathology then in which other technology these are relevant, whereas the pathology department is everywhere supervised by consultants recruited on the basis of these qualifications.
12. In view the above, the conclusion drawn by the second committee on the move of the Medical technologist excluding the applicants is unfounded and based on wrong assumptions / assessment. All these subjects are solely pertain to the pathology in the


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
health delivery system and any Medical lab (Pathology Department) cannot be run without the personnel's equipped with these qualifications. It is there ridiculous that the paramedical staff with the said postgraduate qualifications is excluded from the pathology cadre.


It therefore requested that the said recommendations of the second committee may please be receded wherein in these pathology disciplines have been excluded and the seniority list of graduate and postgraduate paramedics prepared on the basis of recommendation of the first committee as on 17/01/2017 may be treated as final for the purpose of promotion to the posts of Technologist (BPS-17) against 20% quota prescribed in the relevant rules.
