1. Learned counsel for the petitioner present. Mr. Fazal Shah Mohmand, Additional Advocate General for respondents present.

Learned counsel for the petitioner says that 9th November, 2022 was the date fixed in this matter, the said day was declared as public holiday on account of Allama Iqbal day and the case was listed for 10th November, 2022, which day too, was not notified and on 10th November, the Tribunal filed the application presuming that the petitioner was satisfied with the seniority list, produced on the last date. The petitioner was, however, left at liberty to file fresh application if he considered that the judgment of the Tribunal was not so implemented. The learned counsel submits that the petitioner could not make application within 30 days because of his unawareness about the date of passage of order. Besides, he being a Police Officer, was engaged in some emergency duties.. The reason being sufficient for acceptance of the petition. Therefore, the petition is restored also for the reason that the petitioner says that the implementation was not in accordance with judgment of the Tribunal, therefore, notice be issued to respondents for 04.07.2023 before S.B at Camp Court, Swat, for reply to the objection raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the judgment was not completely implemented.
