





It is argued that case of appellant for promotion to BS-17 was included in the Working Paper for Provincial Selection Board meeting to be held on 18.02.2020. For reasons not in the knowledge of appellant, the proposed meeting was delayed for about five months and in the meanwhile, recruitment in the respective quota of appointment in P.M.S BPS-17, were made. A notification dated 29.05.2020 was issued in that respect. It was also the argument of learned counsel that as the meeting of PSB scheduled on 18.02.2020 was delayed for no fault of the appellant, he was entitled to the seniority with effect from the said date. The departmental appeal was submitted by him on 30.07.2020 which was declined on 01.09.2020, hence the instant appeal. Learned counsel relied on Rule 17(b)(ii) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.

Prima-facie and in view of contents of order dated 01.09.2020 by the departmental appellate authority, the declining of respondents in granting relief to the appellant was based upon flimsy grounds. During the relevant period promotions to other posts were carried out on the recommendations of PSB, therefore, the excuse regarding non-constitution of the Board appears to hold no ground. The appeal in hand is, therefore, admitted to regular hearing subject to all just exceptions. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days. Thereafter, notices be issued to the respondents for submission of written reply/comments on 12.03.2021 before S.B.





SERVICE APPEAL UNDER SECTION-4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED NOTIFICATION DATED 02.07.2020 WHEREBY APPELLANT HAS BEEN PROMOTED TO THE POST OF PMS OFFICER (BPS-17) WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT INSTEAD OF w.e.f 20.02.2020 AND AGAINST THE APPELLATE ORDER DATED 01.09.2020 WHEREBY DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT HAS BEEN REJECTED ON NO GOOD GROUNDS.

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this appeal the impugned appellate order dated 01.09.2020 may very kindly be set aside and the original impugned Notification dated 02.07.2020 may kindly be modified/rectified to the extent of ante dating the promotion of the appellant as PMS Officer (BPS-17) w.e.f. 20.02.2020 with all back benefits including seniority. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

R/SHEWETH:

ON FACTS:

1. That appellant is the employee of respondent Department and is serving as Additional Assistant Commissioner (BPS-17) at Jamrud, District Khyber quite efficiently and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors.
2. That appellant while serving as Tehsildar (BPS-16) in the respondent Department a list regarding panel of Tehsildars for consideration to the next higher scale i.e. PMS (BPS-17) wherein name of the appellant appeared at serial No.45 of the list. Copy of the list is attached as annexure.....**A.**

3. That the names of eligible officers of the Revenue Department were processed wherein the name of the appellant appeared at serial No.45. That the meeting of the provincial Selection Board (PSB) was scheduled on 20/02/2020 but unfortunately on the same date the meeting was postponed due to decision delivered by the Peshawar High Court setting aside the Act, of Provincial Assembly enhancing the retirement to 63 years. Copies of the letter dated 18.02.2020, working paper and seniority list are attached as annexure.....**B, C & D.**

4. That since the appellant apprehended that nominees of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission in the meanwhile be appointed, therefore, requested was made by the appellant to before the secretary Establishment Department to re-scheduled the PSB as soon as possible but the same could not be held. Copy of the application is attached as annexure.....**E.**

5. That feeling aggrieved the appellant along with his colleagues knocked the door of Peshawar High Court in writ petition No.1861-P/2020. That during pendency of the mentioned writ petition the respondents recommended and appointed the private respondents as PMS Officers (BPS-17) vide Notification dated 29.05.2020. Copies of the memo of writ petition and Notification are attached as annexure.....**F & G.**

6. That appellant and his colleagues filed two Civil Miscellaneous in the ibid writ petition, one for suspension of operation of the Notification dated 29.05.2020 and the other one for impleadment. Copies of the CM's are attached as annexure.....**H.**

7. That during pendency of the said writ petition the respondents promoted the appellant and his colleagues to the post of PMS Officer (BPS-17) on regular basis vide impugned Notification dated 02.07.2020 but with immediate effect. Copy of the Notification is attached as annexure**I.**

8. That where after the appellant withdrawal the above mentioned writ petition with the permission to approach the proper forum vide order and judgment dated 28.07.2020. That where after the appellant filed Departmental appeal against the Notification dated 02.07.2020 but the same was regretted on 01.09.2020. Copies of the judgment, Departmental appeal, rejection and record are attached as annexure.....**J, K, L & M.**

9. That appellant feeling aggrieved and having no other remedy but to file the instant service appeal on the following grounds amongst the others.

GROUND:

A- That the impugned Notification dated 02.07.2020 whereby the appellant was prompted to the post of PMS Officer with immediate effect instead of w.e.f 20.02.2020 is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable and liable to be modified/rectified.

B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondents in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article-4 & 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.

C- That the impugned appellate order dated 01.09.2020 is against the law, facts and norms of natural justice, therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside.

D- That appellant has been discriminated by the respondents by not promoting him from the date when appellant promotion was due i.e. w.e.f 20.02.2020.

E- That the respondents acted in arbitrary and malafide manner while issuing the promotion order with immediate effect instead of w.e.f due date i.e. 20.02.2020.

F- That the respondents violated Section-9 of the Civil Servant Act, 1973 read rule-7 of the Appointment, Promotion & Transfer Rules, 1989 by issuing the promotion Notification with immediate effect instead of w.e.f. 20.02.2020.

G- That appellant is fully entitled for promotion from the date when the first PSB was scheduled i.e. 20.02.2020.

H- That the impugned Notification 07.02.2020 is violative of Article-38 (e) of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.

I- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

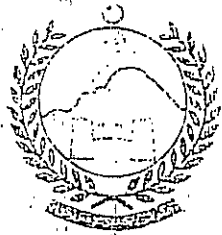





1. That petitioner's are performing their duties as Tehsildars B-16 District Khyber and Board of Revenue.
2. That petitioner's have 20% share in their cadre of Tehsildar for promotion to the post of Provincial Management Service (PMS B-17) and are eligible for promotion to the post of PMS B-17 with effect from 17-01-2020, but no process was initiated for the said purpose.

That almost all 23 posts of PMS B-17 in their share are lying vacant but due to the change scenario the matter could not be made finalized.

That in the scrutiny list of Board of Revenue, the names of petitioners were figured at S. No. 42 and 48 respectively being eligible and qualified for promotion to the post of PMS B-17. (Copy as annex "A")

That working paper for the said purpose were finalized by the department and Meeting of Provincial Selection Board (PSB) was scheduled for 20-02-2020, but the Meeting could not be held due to the fresh development, curtailing the age of superannuation of employees in the KP as 63 years from 60 years. (Copy as annex "B" & "C")

Hence this Writ petition, inter alia, on the following grounds:-

Grounds:

- a. That to fill up the posts of PMS B-17, petitioner's department has 20% quota in their share and the process of promotion reduces to be initiated & finalized.
- b. That for the said purpose, Meeting of PSB was scheduled for 20-02-2020 but the same was postponed due to the change scenario of 63 years age.
- c. That petitioner's has no concern with age of superannuation, 60 or 63 years, yet the matter was delayed by the PSB for no legal reason.
- d. That at present petitioner's etc have into their credit 20% quota in the cadre of PMS B-17 fixed for promotion of Tehsildars.
- e. That no reason for none finalizing of quota of promotion of Tehsildars B-16 was given and the one i.e. 60 or 63 years has no concern with the case of petitioner's.

- f. That at present the departments have 53 vacancies of the post of PMS B-17 which cannot be kept vacant for indefinite period.
- g. That by not holding Meeting of PSB fixed for 20-02-2020 is based on malafide.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the Writ Petition, in exercise of the extraordinary constitutional jurisdiction, this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:-



1. That the appellant has been promoted to the post of PMS (BPS-17) on regular basis at serial No. 14 vide impugned notification No. dated of Establishment Department Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar. (Copy of notification dated 02.07.2020 is attached as annexure A).
2. That the post of PMS (BPS-17) were lying vacant in the promotion quota for Tehsildars for which the name of the eligible officers were processed for promotion. The meeting of the Provincial Selection Board (PSB) was scheduled on 20.02.2020 but unfortunately on the same date the meeting was postponed. (Copy of working paper & minutes of meeting are attached as annexure B & C). Due to decision delivered by the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar setting aside the act of Provincial Assembly enhancing the age of retirement to 63 years. Since the appellant apprehended that the nominees of the

Public Service Commission Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar. In the meanwhile be appointed therefore request was made to Establishment Department to re-schedule the PSB as soon as possible but the same could not be held. Therefore a writ petition No. 1861-P/2020 was filed on dated 02.03.2020 before the Peshawar High Court Peshawar in case titled "Aftab Ahmad & others Vs Secretary to Govt & others" (Copy of writ petition is attached as annexure D).

3. That in the meanwhile the Establishment Department vide notification No. SO E II (ED) 3(81)2020 dated 29.05.2020, have appointed the candidates as officers of Provincial Management Service (BPS-17). Recommendees of the Public Service Commission Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar is attached as annexure -F.
4. That the said notification dated 29.05.2020 issued by the Establishment Department in which the seniority of the appellant has been badly affected.
5. That the Writ Petition No. 1861-P/2020 was decided / directed by the Honourable Chief Justice Peshawar High Court Peshawar vide its judgment dated 30.07.2020 to approach the proper forum. (Copy of judgment dated 30.07.2020 is attached as annexure G).
6. That the appellant was entitled for promotion on 20.02.2020. When the promotion was not affected due to the decision of the

High Court the settled law on the point is that the Civil Servant is entitled from the date of occurrence of vacancy and since the vacancies were available on the date of the previous PSB i.e. 20.02.2020, therefore the appellant is entitled for promotion w.e.f. 20.02.2020.

NO.SOE-II(ED)2(192)2020:- WHEREAS the applicants Mr. Aftab Ahmad, Mr. Zulfiqar, Mr. Hafiz Waqar, Syed Sultan Haider, Mr. Faqir Hussain and Mr. Dil Nawaz Khan (PMS officers) filed departmental appeals in compliance of the Judgement of Peshawar High Court Peshawar dated: 28.07.2020 in writ petition No: 1861-P/2020, C.M No.1009-P/2020 and Impleadment No.1010-P/2020, wherein the court passed the following order "*requested for withdrawal of the writ petition with the permission to approach the proper forum. Order accordingly*".

The applicants therefore via their departmental appeal raised the following objections;

- i. Establishment Department vide notification dated 02.07.2020 promoted the applicants on regular basis with immediate effect on the recommendation of Provincial Selection Board in its meeting held on 09.06.2020, while they were eligible for their promotion with effect from 20.02.2020 and asserted for all back benefits since then.
- ii. Despite the fact that they were eligible for promotion to the post of PMS BS-17 and vacancies were available in the share quota of Tehsildars when PSB was scheduled earlier on 20.02.2020 but was postponed due to the decision of Peshawar High Court Peshawar dated: 19.02.2020 in writ petition No.5673-P/2019 regarding setting aside the act of Provincial Assembly enhancing the age of retirement to 63 years, which badly affected their seniority.
- iii. Applicants further asserted that due to the postponement of PSB 123 nos. appointment of recommendees of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission was made against the initial quota and they were placed above in the seniority list.

AND WHEREAS the applicants cannot be promoted with retrospective effect on regular vacancy with effect from 20.02.2020. They were promoted within the parameters of schedule-I Rule-7 of PMS Rules 2007 on regular basis to the post of PMS BS-17 as per the recommendation of PSB meeting held on 09.06.2020.

AND WHEREAS PSB was scheduled on 20.02.2020 but was postponed due to the judgment passed by Peshawar High Court Peshawar dated: 19.02.2020 in writ petition No.5673-P/2019. Number of officers included in the panel of PSB got retired attaining the age of superannuation i.e. 60 years in the light of the said judgement and their names had to be excluded from the working papers. In light of the decision, the Provincial Government decided the retirement cases as per circular letter No: SO(Policy)E&AD/1-13/2019 dated: 16.03.2020. Resultantly, fresh working papers had to be prepared. Working out the new panels and the corresponding quotas of promotion due to retirements turned out to be a voluminous work. Furthermore, PSB was not scheduled again till 09.06.2020 as the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa declared emergency in the wake of the escalation in the transmission of

COVID-19 and closure of all the departments except a few essential ones. These departments, being closed could not prepare the working papers.

AND WHEREAS contrary to the claims of the applicants their case has no similarity to the appointment of the PMS officers under initial quota, as under Article-240(b) of Constitution of Pakistan the process of recruitment of PMS officers through Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission was initiated on 20.10.2017 with the placement of requisition to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission and after completion of the whole recruitment process, Establishment Department issued their appointment notification dated: 29.05.2020. Meanwhile, promotion process continued unabated and various PSB meetings were held on 08.11.2017, 28.12.2017, 03.05.2018, 17.09.2018, 26.12.2018, 19.04.2019, 23.09.2019 and 09.06.2020 which clearly indicates that no parallel can be drawn between initial recruitment and promotion of the applicants.



PARAWISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS NO. 1-3

Respectfully Sheweth: that the Respondents submit as under:-

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:

1. The Honourable Tribunal has got no jurisdiction to entertain the instant Appeal.
2. That the appellant has got no cause of action/locus standi to file the instant appeal against the respondents.
3. That the appeal is not maintainable.
4. That the appellant has presented the facts in manipulated form which disentitles him for any relief whatsoever.
5. That the instant appeal is hit by Section 4 (b) (i) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Services Tribunal Act, 1974.
6. That the appellant has not come to this Honourable Tribunal with clean hands.
7. That this Honourable Tribunal, lacks jurisdiction in the instant case.
8. That the appeal is badly time barred.

ON FACTS:

1. Pertains to record, hence no comments.
2. **Correct.** The appellant stood at Sr. No. 45 of the seniority list (of graduate Tehsildars BS-16) provided by Senior Members Board of Revenue for consideration of promotion to next higher scale i.e. PMS BS-17.
3. **Correct.** The appellant was at Sr. No. 45 of the seniority list. Moreover, as has been admitted by the appellant, that the PSB was scheduled on 20.02.2020 but was postponed due to judgment of Peshawar High Court Peshawar dated: 19.02.2020 in Writ Petition No. 5673-P/2019. Resultantly, a considerable number of officers included in the panel of PSB got retired as they attained the age of superannuation i.e. 60 years, in the wake of the said judgment. Accordingly, the Provincial Government decided the retirement cases as per circular letter No: SO(Policy)E&AD/1-13/2019 dated: 16.03.2020 and fresh working

papers had therefore, to be prepared. Working out the new panels and the corresponding quotas of promotion due to retirements turned out to be a voluminous task. PSB was not scheduled again till 09.06.2020 as the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa declared emergency in the wake of escalation in the transmission of COVID-19 and ordered closure of all departments except a few essential ones. These departments, being closed could not prepare the working papers. However, the process of recruitment of PMS Officer (BS-17) through Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission was initiated on 20.10.2017 with the placement of requisition to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission and after completion of the whole recruitment process, Establishment Department issued their appointment notification dated: 29.05.2020. Meanwhile, promotion process continued unabated and various PSB meetings were held on 08.11.2017, 28.12.2017, 03.05.2018, 17.09.2018, 26.12.2018, 19.04.2019, 23.09.2019 and 09.06.2020 which clearly indicate that no parallel can be drawn between initial recruitment and promotion of the applicants.

4. **Incorrect.** contrary to his claim, the case of the appellant has no similarity to that of PMS officers who are appointed under initial quota. The process of recruitment of PMS Officers through Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission initiated on 20.10.2017 with placement of requisition on the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission and after completion of the whole recruitment process, Establishment Department issued their appointment notification dated: 29.05.2020. Meanwhile, promotion process continued uninterrupted and various PSB meetings were held on 08.11.2017, 28.12.2017, 03.05.2018, 17.09.2018, 26.12.2018, 19.04.2019, 23.09.2019 and 09.06.2020 which clearly show that initial recruitment and promotion are two different phenomena.
5. **Correct** to the extent that the appellant alongwith others filed a writ petition No: 1861-P/2020, CM No.1009-P/2020 and Impleadment No:1010-P/2020 in Peshawar High Court, Peshawar whereby honourable High Court, Peshawar vide order sheet dated: 28.07.2020 in ibid writ petition disposed of the case with these remarks "*requested for withdrawal of the writ petition with the permission to approach the proper forum. Order accordingly*". Appointment of private respondents as PMS Officers on 29-05-2020 was altogether a different activity which remained under process since 2017.
6. Pertains to record hence, no comments.
7. **Incorrect.** The notification dated 02.07.2020 had been issued in pursuance of the recommendation of Provincial Selection Board (PSB) meeting held on 09.06.2020 whereby Tehsildars BS-16 were promoted as PMS-BS-17 in accordance with rules and

Promotion policy which states, *"This Policy will apply to promotions of all civil servants holding appointment on regular basis and will come into effect immediately"* (Annex-I).

8. **Correct** to the extent that in pursuance of High Court order dated: 28.07.2020, the appellant filed the departmental appeal addressed to the Chief Secretary, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa which was regretted through speaking order being devoid of merit (Annex-II). Moreover, detailed reply has been given in Para-3 above.
9. Needs no comment.

ON GROUNDS:


- A. **Incorrect.** The notification dated 02.07.2020 had been issued in pursuance of the recommendation of Provincial Selection Board (PSB) meeting held on 09.06.2020 wherein Tehsildars BS-16 were promoted as PMS-BS-17 in accordance with rules and Promotion policy specified for promotion to higher grade. However, claim of the appellant for ante-dated promotion w.e.f 21.02.2020 instead of 02.07.2020 is contrary to promotion policy which states *"this Policy will apply to promotions of all civil servants holding appointment on regular basis and will come into effect immediately"*.
- B. **Incorrect.** The appellant has been treated in accordance with law. Nothing in Article-04 & Article-25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, has been violated as Constitution ensures the implementation of rules in all aspects and in this connection, the whole process was conducted impartially.
- C. **Incorrect.** The speaking order dated 01-09-2020 was issued in accordance with law after due consideration of all the points voiced in the appeals and rules / policies in vogue, having found no reason to accede to the request.
- D. **Incorrect.** No discrimination was made by the respondents. However, request of the appellant for ante-dated promotion w.e.f 20.02.2020 instead of 02.07.2020 was not acceded to being contrary to promotion policy.
- E. **Incorrect.** The promotion order has been issued in accordance with law on the recommendations of the competent forum.
- F. As explained in para-A, above.
- G. **Incorrect.** The appellant is unreasonably claiming promotion w.e.f 20-02-2020 as Provincial Government has the authority to schedule the PSB meeting and recommend eligible officers for promotion under relevant rules / laws. In the


instant case, PSB scheduled on 20-02-2020 was postponed for inevitable reasons and was not re-scheduled till 09.06.2020 due to COVID-19.


- H. **Incorrect.** No article of the constitution has been violated. Relevant rules have been implemented in true letter and spirit.
- I. That the Respondents also seek permission to agitate further grounds at the time of Arguments.

PRAYER

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that the instant petition being devoid of merit may very graciously be turned down/ dismissed with costs.

Promotion Policy

In order to consolidate the existing Promotion Policy, which is embodied in several circular letters issued in piecemeal from time to time, and to facilitate the line departments at every level in prompt processing of promotion cases of Provincial civil servants, it has been decided to issue the "North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants Promotion Policy, 2009" duly approved by the competent authority, for information and compliance by all concerned. This Policy will apply to promotions of all civil servants holding appointment on regular basis and will come into effect immediately. The Policy consists of the provisions given hereunder:-

I. Length of service:

(a) Minimum length of service for promotion to posts in various basic scales will be as under:

Basic Scale 18:	5 years' service in BS-17.
Basic Scale 19:	12 years' service in BS-17 & above
Basic Scale 20:	17 years' service in BS-17 & above

No proposal for promotion shall be entertained unless the condition of the prescribed length of service is fulfilled.

(b) Service in the lower pay scales for promotion to BP-18 shall be counted as follows:

- (i) Half of the service in BS-16 and one fourth in Basic Scales lower than 16, if any, shall be counted as service in Basic Scale 17.
- (ii) Where initial recruitment takes place in Basic Scale 18 and 19, the length of service prescribed for promotion to higher Basic Scales shall be reduced as indicated below:

Basic Scale 19 : 7 years' service in BS-18

Basic Scale 20 : 10 years' service in BS-18 and above.

or 3 years' service in BS-19.

II. Linking of promotion with training:

(a) Successful completion of the following trainings is mandatory for promotions of officers of the Provincial Civil Service / Provincial Management Service to various Basic Scales:

- Mid-Career Management Course at National Institute of Management (NIM) for promotion to BS-19
- Senior Management Course at National Management College, Lahore for promotion to BS-20
- National Management Course at National Management College, Lahore for promotion to BS-21

(b) This condition will not be applicable to civil servants in specialized cadres such as Doctors, Teachers, Professors, Research Scientists and incumbents of purely

within a period of six months from such recommendations, they would lapse. The case of such civil servant would require placement before the PSB/DPC afresh.

VI. Date of Promotion:

Promotion will always be notified with immediate effect.

VII. Notional Promotion:

In respect of civil servants who retire (or expire) after recommendation of their promotion by the PSB/DPC, but before its approval by the competent authority, their promotion shall be deemed to have taken effect from the date of recommendation of the PSB/DPC, as the case may be, and their pension shall be calculated as per pay which they would have received had they not retired/expired.

VIII. Promotion of Civil Servants who are awarded minor penalties.

- (a) The question of promotion to BS-18 and above, in case of civil servants who have been awarded minor penalties has been settled by the adoption of quantification of PERs and CEI which allows consideration of such cases for promotion subject to deduction of 5 marks for each major penalty, 3 marks for each minor penalty and 1 mark for each adverse PER from the quantified score and recommendation for promotion on attaining the relevant qualifying threshold.
- (b) However, the CEI policy is not applicable to civil servants in BS-16 and below. In this case, the concerned assessing authorities will take into consideration the entire service record with weightage to be given for recent reports and any minor penalty will not be a bar to promotion of such a civil servant.

IX. Promotion in case of pending investigations by NAB:

If there are any NAB investigations being conducted against an officer, the fact of such investigations needs to be placed before the relevant promotion fora which may take a considered decision on merits of the case.

2. All the existing instructions on the subject shall stand superseded to the above extent, with immediate effect.

ORDER

NO.SOE-II(ED)2(192)2020:- WHEREAS the applicants Mr. Aftab Ahmad, Mr. Zulfiqar, Mr. Hafiz Waqar, Syed Sultan Haider, Mr. Faqir Hussain and Mr. Dil Nawaz Khan (PMS officers) filed departmental appeals in compliance of the Judgement of Peshawar High Court Peshawar dated: 28.07.2020 in writ petition No: 1861-P/2020, C.M No 1009-P/2020 and Impleadment No.1010-P/2020, wherein the court passed the following order "*requested for withdrawal of the writ petition with the permission to approach the proper forum. Order accordingly*". The applicants therefore via their departmental appeal raised the following objections:

- i. Establishment Department vide notification dated 02.07.2020 promoted the applicants on regular basis with immediate effect on the recommendation of Provincial Selection Board in its meeting held on 09.06.2020, while they were eligible for their promotion with effect from 20.02.2020 and asserted for all back benefits since then.
- ii. Despite the fact that they were eligible for promotion to the post of PMS BS-17 and vacancies were available in the share quota of Tehsildars when PSB was scheduled earlier on 20.02.2020 but was postponed due to the decision of Peshawar High Court Peshawar dated: 19.02.2020 in writ petition No.5673-P/2019 regarding setting aside the act of Provincial Assembly enhancing the age of retirement to 63 years, which badly affected their seniority.
- iii. Applicants further asserted that due to the postponement of PSB 123 nos. appointment of recommendees of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission was made against the initial quota and they were placed above in the seniority list.

AND WHEREAS the applicants cannot be promoted with retrospective effect on regular vacancy with effect from 20.02.2020. They were promoted within the parameters of schedule-I Rule-7 of PMS Rules 2007, on regular basis to the post of PMS BS-17 as per the recommendation of PSB meeting held on 09.06.2020.

AND WHEREAS PSB was scheduled on 20.02.2020 but was postponed due to the judgment passed by Peshawar High Court Peshawar dated: 19.02.2020 in writ petition No.5673-P/2019. Number of officers included in the panel of PSB got retired attaining the age of superannuation i.e. 60 years in the light of the said judgement and their names had to be excluded from the working papers. In light of the decision, the Provincial Government decided the retirement cases as per circular letter No SO(Policy)E&AD/1-13/2019 dated: 16.03.2020. Resultantly, fresh working papers had to be prepared. Working out the new panels and the corresponding quotas of promotion due to retirements turned out to be a voluminous work. Furthermore, PSB was not scheduled again till 09.06.2020 as the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa declared emergency in the wake of the escalation in the transmission of

COVID-19 and closure of all the departments except a few essential ones. These departments being closed could not prepare the working papers.

AND WHEREAS contrary to the claims of the applicants their case has no similarity to the appointment of the PMS officers under initial quota, as under Article-240(b) of Constitution of Pakistan the process of recruitment of PMS officers through Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission was initiated on 20.10.2017 with the placement of requisition to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission and after completion of the whole recruitment process, Establishment Department issued their appointment notification dated, 29.05.2020. Meanwhile, promotion process continued unabated and various PSB meetings were held on 08.11.2017, 28.12.2017, 03.05.2018, 17.09.2018, 26.12.2018, 19.04.2019, 23.09.2019 and 09.06.2020 which clearly indicates that no parallel can be drawn between initial recruitment and promotion of the applicants.

NOW THEREFORE, after due consideration of all the points voiced in the appeals and rules / policies in vogue, the competent authority having found no reason to accede to the request of the applicants; which are regretted being devoid of merit.
