Learned Deputy District Attorney has, at the very outset, pointed out that similar appeals were adjourned sine die at the Principal Seat, because the matter in issue in this appeal was earlier taken to the Peshawar High Court and was decided. The decision of the Peshawar High Court was challenged before the Supreme Court of Pakistan. The Supreme Court set aside the decision of the Peshawar High Court, remitting the matter back to it for decision of the matters. The result of the appeals, earlier adjourned sine die by the Tribunal, was stated to be dependent upon the decision of the Peshawar High Court in the matters remitted to it. The appellant controverted that his appeal was on different footing. The appellant also wants to file rejoinder to the reply submitted by the respondent No.5. The matter is adjourned to 27.11.2023 before the D.B at Camp Court, Abbottabad. In the meanwhile, the appellant may file rejoinder and the learned Deputy District Attorney shall place on file copies of the appeal earlier adjourned sine die by the Tribunal.
