# PARAWISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENT NO.1, 2, 3 & 4.

#### **PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:**

- 1. The application is not maintainable in the present form.
- 2. The applicant has no locus standi to bring the present application.
- 3. The applicant is legally stopped by his own conduct to bring the present application.
- 4. The application is time barred.
- 5. That the applicant has no cause of action.

#### **Respectfully Sheweth:**

1. Correct to the extent that the applicant had filed service appeal No. 351/2014 against the rejection of his appeal by respondent No. 2, which was properly replied by the respondent department with the remarks that on 18/12/2009 the applicant alongwith others were appointed as Deputy Ranger on acting charge basis on the integrated seniority list of Foresters of Abbottabad Circle vide CF Abbottabad office order No. 91, dated 18/12/2009 as per Notification bearing No.SO(FT-II)/AD/1-584/70/5921-6000, dated 29/8/1990 under which Abbottabad Circle, Kaghan Intensive Management Project, Watershed Management Project and Mansehra Intensive Management Project were considered for promotion of Forester to the post of Deputy Ranger as one unit (Annex-I). Later on, vide the Administrative Deptt: vide notification No.SO(Estt)/Envt/1-4/2K11/1629-50, dated






5/10/2012, the Upper Hazara, Lower Hazara & Watershed Management Circles were declared as independent unit for promotion of Forester to the post of Deputy Ranger (Annex-II), as such the applicant being appointee of Watershed Circle was not promoted on regular basis to the post of Deputy Ranger having limited post i.e 3 Nos. of Deputy Ranger, while his other colleagues being Junior to him were considered for promotion to the post of Deputy Ranger having sufficient Nos. of posts i.e 10 Nos. in Lower Hazara Forest Circle and 4 Nos. in Upper Hazara Forest Circle.

- 2. Correct to the extent that the Chief Conservator of Forests Central Southern Forest Region-I Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar has constituted an Inquiry Committee vide his o/o No. 93, dated 05/05/2017 for restoration of his seniority (Annex-III). the committee after thrash out the record submitted his report which was subsequently submitted to Chief Conservator of Forests and finally the competent authority has restored his seniority w.e.f 08/10/2013 vide o/o No. 06, dated 05/07/2017 (Annex-IV) with the condition that the Deputy Ranger shall withdraw his service appeal from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal and produce withdrawal letter to CF concerned as well as to his office for record. After restoration of his seniority, the applicant was promoted to the post of Forest Ranger (BPS-16) vide o/o No. 85, dated 12/01/2018 (Annex-V) with the remarks that instead of withdrawal his appeal from the court of law, the applicant pursued his appeal till final decision dated 22/07/2022 although the applicant has since been retired on the age of superannuation w.e.f 07/04/2018.
- 3. No comments, however explanation available in Para-2 above.
- 4. As per explanation available in Para-2 above, the applicant when he was Deputy Ranger in (BPS-12) was promoted to the post of Forest Ranger (BPS-16) after restoration of his seniority on the recommendation of inquiry committee dated 20/03/2017 w.e.f 12/01/2018 and his retirement on the age of superannuation was matured on 07/04/2018. So far, giving him the promotion to next scale like his other colleagues is concerned, it is not possible on the analogy that he was no more in service after 7/4/2018 and his other colleagues were thus promoted only they are still in service like Zareen Gul already promoted to the post of SDFO and will be retired on the age of superannuation w.e.f 31/03/2024.
- 5. As per explanation available in Para-2 & 4 above.
- 6. The appeal already submitted to competent authority i.e Chief Conservator of Forests Central Southern Forest Region-I Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar by the applicant after announcement of the decision of KP Service Tribunal on 22/07/2022 has since been rejected vide letter No. 998/E, dated 23/08/2022 & No.2997/E, dated 18/11/2022 (Annex-VI & VII), furthermore, after announcement the decision of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, the case was sent to Law Deptt: for seeking advice regarding filing of CPLA in the Apex Court, which was discussed during the Scrutiny Committee meeting in Law Deptt: on 14/09/2022 and the committee also agreed that the desired relief in shape of restoration of seniority as well as promotion to the post of Forest Ranger (BPS-16) was granted to the applicant during January, 2018 with the condition that the applicant withdraw the appeal from Tribunal and retired from service w.e.f 7/4/2018 and having disposing of the appeal by the Service Tribunal (Annex-VIII).





Since the appellant is no more civil servant, therefore it is prayed that the present implementation petition having no legal footings/justification may kindly be dismissed with cost <u>as the appellant has already attained the age of superannuation on 07/04/2018.</u>





Enclosed please find herewith photocopy of appeal preferred by Mr. Sultan Mehmood the then Forest Ranger, which is self-explanatory for further necessary action in your office.

Brief history of the case is that the appellant was inducted on the strength of Watershed Circle and promoted to the post of Deputy Ranger on 18/07/2014, so far his other colleague namely Zareen Gul, who was also a Forester of Watershed Circle was earlier promoted to the post of Deputy Ranger in merit quota on 08/10/2013. During the year 2017, Chief Conservator of Forests Central Southern Forest Region-I Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar had constituted a committee on the appeal of Mr. Sultan Mehmood the then Deputy Ranger for submission of report in the subject appeal vide O/O No.93, dated 05/05/2017. After submission of report by the committee, seniority was restored w.e.f 08/10/2013 vide O/O No.6, dated 05/07/2017 with the condition that the Deputy Ranger shall withdraw his service appeal from the Court of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal and accordingly his promotion to the post of Forest Ranger on regular basis was discussed during the DPC meeting held on 28/11/2017. After issuance of his promotion order to the post of Forest Ranger on 12/01/2018, he was retired on the age of superannuation w.e.f 07/04/2018.

After lapse of about four and a half year, the Forest Ranger has provided order sheet dated 22/07/2022 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, which was also simply disposed off and no such direction is available in the subject case for further course of action, however it seems that instead of clear cut condition regarding withdrawal of his case from the Court available in his restoration of seniority order already issued vide o/o No.6, dated 05/07/2017, the Forest Ranger was busy in pursuing his case in the Court of law.

Furthermore, it has also been noticed that after retirement from Govt. Service w.e.f 07/04/2018, his pension case has not been processed till to date, therefore being such the position, you are requested to furnish your comments/report in the subject case so that the same could be decided please.



# MINUTES OF THE SCRUTINY COMMITTEE MEETING.

(AGENDA ITEM NO. 02)

SUBJECT:

SERVICE APPEAL NO. 351/2014 SULTAN MEHMOOD VERSUS GOVERNMENT OF KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA THROUGH SECRETARY FORESTRY, ENVIRONMENT AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT AND OTHERS.

A meeting of the Scrutiny Committee was held on 14-09-2022 at 11:00 A.M. in the Conference room of Law, Parliamentay Affairs & Human Rights Department under the Chairmanship of Secretary Law to determine the fitness of he subject case for filing of Appeal/CPLA before the Supreme Court of Pakistan. Advocate-on-Record (Mr. Mian Saad Ullah Khan Jandoli) and Assistant Advocate General (Mr. Bashar Naveed) represented the Advicate General office, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

The representatives of Environment Department Muhammad Amjad DFO alongwith Hafiz Abdul Jalii SO (Lit), apprised the Committee about the background of the case and stated that the Appellant Sultan Mehmood, filed the subject appeal before the Khyber Pakhanakhwa Service Tribunal against the order dated 30.01.2014 whereby his Departmental appeal for confirmation as Deputy Ranger had been rejected by Chief Conservator of Forest, Central Southern, Forest Region, being appellate authority of the appellant. The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal vide order/judgment dated 22.07.2022 disposed of the subject appeal on the request of the counsel of the Appellant, wherein the counsel requested to withdraw the appeal as conditional order was passed in appellants favour and the subject appeal was hurdle to give effect to the appellant right. The Scrutiny Committee decided that the subject case was not a fit case on the following grounds:

## GROUNDS/DISCUSSIOIS:

- Ì. that the Appellant alongwith others were promoted as Deputy Rangur (BPS-09) on cting charge basis on 18.09.2009. In view of notification dated 05.10.2012, Deputy langers working on acting charge basis were recommended for promotion on regular basis. Meeting of Departmental Selection Committee held on 30.09.2013 under the Chairmanship of Chief Conservator of Forest Central Southern Forest Region 1 recommended promotion of foresters including Mr. Zareen Gul, on regular basis on 08.10.2013 and promotion order was issued whereas the name of the Appellant was omitted from the processings of Departmental Selection Committee. Feeling aggrieved the Appellant filed his Departmental appeal for confirmation/regularization against the post of Deputy Ranger dated 28.10.2013 but the same was rejected by respondent No. 2. Thus the Appellant filed the instant appeal.
- ii. That during the pendency the instant appeal, meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee was held on 10.06.2014 recommended promotion of the Appellant as Deputy Ranger on regular basis and issued his promotion order on 18.07.2014 instead of 08.10.2015 thus the grievance of the Appellant to the extent of regularization of service as Deputy Ranger was redressed, however the Appellant was kept idegally deprived from his promotion as Deputy Ranger since 68.10.2013 which further effected the promotion of the Appellant from Deputy Ranger (BPS-12) to the post of Forest Ranger (BPS-16) on regular basis. On the Departmental appeal of the Appellant the Chief Conservator of forest Central Southern Ferest Region 1 Peshawar constituted an Inquiry Committee. The Inquiry Committee submitted his report and recommended restoration of the seniority in the cadre of Deputy Ranger from the date of Fromotion i.e 08.10.2013 with consideration of the case for further promotion as Forest Ranger (BPS-16) subject to the condition that the Appellant shall withdraw his appeal from Court.
  - The Scrutiny Committee held that the desired relief was granted to the Appellant with the iii. condition that the Appellant withdraw the appeal from Triounal. The representative of the Administrative Department informed the Scrutiny Committee that the Appellant that already been promoted to the post of Forest Ranger (BPS 16) in January, 2018 and has already been retired. The Bribunal disposed of the subject appeal on the plea of counsel for Appellant. Therefore agitating the matter in the upper Judicial forum would be futile exercise.

ADVICE:

Hence in view of above, it was decided with consensus by the Scrutiny Continued in the subject case for filing of Appeal/CPLA in the Supreme Court of Pakistan. case was not a fit case for filing of Appeal/CPLA in the Supreme Court of Pakistan.
