**REPLY PARAWISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENT NO. 1 & 3**

Respectfully Sheweth,

**PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:**

1. The case has already been adjudicated vide Execution Petition No. 183/2017 in Service Appeal No. 342/2016 dated 20.06.2022, therefore, the instant case is hit by the principle of Res-judicata.
2. That the appellant has filed this appeal to waste the precious time of this Hon'ble Tribunal, therefore, he is not entitled for any relief claimed whatsoever.
3. This Honourable Tribunal has no jurisdiction to entertain the instant Service Appeal under section 4(b)(i) of the Service Tribunal Act, 1974 because the matter relates to the promotion of the appellant.
4. That the appellant has got no cause of action/locus standi to file the instant Appeal against the respondents.
5. That the appellant has presented the facts in manipulated form which disentitles him for any relief whatsoever.
6. That the appellant has not come to this Hon'ble Tribunal with clean hands.

**ON FACTS:**

1. Correct
2. Incorrect. It is submitted that a meeting of PSB was held on 30.11.2015, wherein a combined working paper for promotion of PCS EG BS-17 to BS-18 and PMS BS-17 to BS-18 was placed before the PSB. In this working paper, names of 1-PCS EG BS-17 and 23-PMS BS-17 (Total 24-officers) were placed before the PSB. The name of appellant was not included in this working paper as at that time his name was placed at Sr. No. 26 of the PMS BS-17 Seniority List.  
**10-posts** were available and the PSB considered the working paper and recommended 10-officers for promotion to BS-18 and deferred the case of 14-officers **(minutes of meeting are placed at Annex-I)**
3. Incorrect. It is submitted that a combined working paper for promotion of PCS EG BS-17 to BS-18 and PMS BS-17 to BS-18 was prepared in the first week of January 2016 and Secretary Establishment Department signed the same on 20.1.2016 i.e. after the retirement of appellant. At that time 6-posts were available for promotion of PCS EG/PMS BS-17 officers. The Working Paper contained panel of the following BS-17 officers, whereas the name of appellant was at Sr. No. 16 instead of 15 **(Annex-II)**.

On 18.2.2016, a meeting of the PSB was convened but due to paucity of time the working paper regarding promotion of PCS EG/PMS from BS-17 to BS-18 was not considered.

**The plea of the appellant is wrong that the officer mentioned at Sr. No. 1 to 11 and 13 & 14 were ineligible as petitioner has no authority to decide eligibility of any officer.**

*Since the appellant was at Sr. No. 16 and there were 6-clear vacancies in the share of promotion for BS-18. In case, the working paper would have been considered by PSB, even then, there was no chance of promotion of the appellant as his name was at Sr. No. 16.*

4. It is submitted that in pursuance of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Judgment dated 24.04.2017, Establishment Department placed the case regarding proforma promotion of Mr. Mumtaz Ahmad (appellant) before the Provincial Selection Board in its meeting held on 25.09.2017 and PSB thoroughly considered his case but observed that there was no vacancy entitling the appellant for promotion to BS-18 and even if he had not been retired from service on 09.01.2016, he could not have been promoted in the subsequent PSB meeting held on 18.02.2016 as total vacancies till that time were limited to 08 Nos, while the appellant's name was appearing at Sr. No. **16** of the Seniority List. After detailed deliberation, PSB could not find him eligible for Proforma promotion to BS-18 (**Annex-II**).

In this context, an implementation report was also submitted before the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal in Execution Petition No. 183/2017 in Service Appeal No. 342/2016 and the Honorable tribunal considered the same and passed the following judgment on 20.06.2022:-

*“the case of appellant was considered by PSB in its meeting dated 25.09.2017, but, he was not found eligible for promotion to the post of BS-18, therefore, there remains nothing to be done/determined in this petition. It is thus filed. The petitioner may avail the remedy from the decision of PSB which may have given him fresh cause of action”.*

5. As explained vide Para. 4 of the facts.
6. Correct to the extent of non-availability of clear vacancy.
7. No doubt, a vacancy had fallen vacant due to the retirement of Mr. Muhammad Iqbal in January, 2016. Establishment Department processed a working paper in the first week of January, 2016 for consideration of promotion of PCS EG/PMS BS-17 officers to BS-18 **against the available 6-vacancies, whereas the name of appellant was at Sr. No. 16 of the panel.**

On 18.2.2016, a meeting of the PSB was held but due to paucity of time the working paper regarding promotion of PCS EG/PMS from BS-17 to BS-18 was not considered.

*If, working paper would have been considered by PSB, even then, there was no chance of promotion of the appellant as his name was at Sr. No. 16.*

8. Correct to the extent of departmental appeal, which was considered, but, was not acceded to.

9. Needs no comments.

**GROUND:**

- A. Incorrect, hence denied. The case regarding proforma promotion of Mr. Mumtaz Ahmad (appellant) was thoroughly examined/considered in the Provincial Selection Board meeting dated 25.09.2017 and PSB could not find him eligible for Proforma promotion to BS-18 even if the appellant had not been retired from service on 09.01.2016, he could not have been promoted in the subsequent PSB meeting held on 18.02.2016 as total vacancies till that point of time were limited to 08 Nos, while the appellant's name was at Sr. No. 16 of the respective Seniority List.
- B. Incorrect. The appellant was treated within the prevailing law/rules like other officers. However, he was not found eligible for promotion to BS-18.
- C. Incorrect as explained in Para. 2 & 3 of facts.
- D. As per reply in Para-3 of on facts supra.
- E. Incorrect. The appellant was not eligible, therefore, he was not promoted to BS-18 and for the reasons, the Honorable Tribunal turned down his Execution Petition No. 183/2017 in Service Appeal No. 342/2016 vide its judgment dated 20.06.2022
- F. As explained in Para-E of the Grounds.
- G. Incorrect.

- I. Needs no comments.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that the instant petition, being devoid of merit, and legal consideration may very graciously be dismissed with costs.

PCS EG BS-17 The officer mentioned at No. 1 included in the panel possesses the requisite length of service for regular promotion to BS-18. On 5.9.2012 AND 7.1.2014 PSB superseded him with the direction that factual position regarding depositing the amount in govt. treasury be ascertained and did not recommend him for promotion on 4.10.2012.

On 7.1.2014 and 13.2.2014 board deferred his promotion. In the case regarding embezzlement/ misappropriation of funds allocated for Bomb Blast Victims at DIK, the officer was awarded a penalty of stoppage of three increments along with recovery of Rs. 11.1 million (jointly) from five accused. It has now confirmed by NAB Peshawar that out of five accused, four including the officer have returned their share of recoverable amount (Rs.15,75,000/-) in the aforementioned case availing the facility of "Voluntarily Return" which has been accepted by NAB.
