PRAYER

That on acceptance of this service appeal the impugned appellate order dated 14.06.2023 may very kindly be set aside and directed the respondents not to transfer the appellant from the post of Patwari Halqa Shabqadar till completion of his normal tenure. Any other relief which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favor of appellant.

R/SHEWETH:

ON FACTS:

The brief facts of the present appeal are as under:-

1. That the appellant is the employee of the respondent department and is serving as Patwari Halqa Shabqadar quite efficiently and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors.
2. That the appellant while performing his duty as Patwari Halqa Kharakai, District Charsadda was transferred and posted at Patwar Halqa Shabqadar vide Office order dated 29.03.2023. That in compliance of the order dated 29.03.2023 the appellant took over the charge and started performing his duty efficiently, wholeheartedly and upto the entire

satisfaction of his high ups. Copies of the order dated 29.03.2023 and charge report are attached as annexure..... A & B.

3. That the private respondent No.4 preferred departmental appeal against the order dated 29.03.2023 before the Commissioner, Peshawar Division, Peshawar (Respondent No.2) which was accepted vide impugned appellate order dated 14.06.2023 and he is allowed to assume charge against the post already held by the appellant. Copy of the appellate order dated 14.06.2023 is attached as annexure.....C.
4. That it is pertinent to mention here that the appellant recently transferred as Patwari Halqa Shabqadar i.e. vide order dated 29.03.2023 and the appellant has only two and half months tenure at the station mentioned above.
5. That the appellant feeling aggrieved and having no other remedy but to file the instant service appeal before this august Tribunal on the following grounds amongst the others:

GROUND:

- A- That the impugned appellate order dated 14.06.2023 is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- B- That the appellant has not been treated by the respondent Department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article-4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- C- That the respondents acted in arbitrary and malafide manner while issuing the impugned appellate order dated 14.06.2023 by transferring the appellant from the post of Patwari Halqa Shabqadar pre-maturely and in violation of law and rules.
- D- That the respondent Department violated Clause-I and IV of the transfer/Posting Policy of the Provincial Government by issuing the impugned appellate order dated 14.06.2023. Copy of the transfer/posting policy is attached as annexure.....D.
- E- That the impugned appellate order dated 14.06.2023 is violative of the principle of natural justice, hence the same is not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- F- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of appellant may kindly be accepted as prayed for.





- B That, the appellant is serving as Patwari in Revenue Department, initially the appellant was transferred to Mozah Shabqadar on dated 28/11/2022.

- C That, on 27/3/2023 the appellant submitted an application to Deputy Commissioner Charsadda for grant of 23 days Ex Pakistan leaves to travel abroad to perform umrah.
Copy of the application is attached as Annexure B.
- D That, the said application was accepted by the Deputy Commissioner Charsadda vide order dated 27/3/2023 with direction that the appellant is likely to return on the same post and grade after expiry of his Ex Pakistan leave.
Copy of the order dated 27/3/2023 is attached as Annexure C.
- E That, during his leave while performing umrah the Deputy Commissioner Charsadda issued an order herein Impugned where the appellant was transferred to Kharkhai from Shabqadar.



1. That, the impugned order is against the law having malafidely and illegally been passed in contravention of basic law and policy declared by the Government. The appellant was on leave and the impugned order has been passed in his absence.
Copies of unrah documents is attached as Annexure E.
2. That, the appellant was transferred to Shabqadar on dated 20/11/2022 and he was premature transferred from the said Mozah, which is in clear contravention of basic law and policy declared by the Government.
3. That, the impugned order is also against the settled policy of the Government, the Government of Kpk Revenue Department has recently issued a notification where all such type of transfer and posting was made subject to approval of the competent authority.
Copy of the said Notification attached as Annexure F.
4. That, the impugned order of the Deputy Commissioner Charsadda is also against the Election Act, 2017 and other election and enabling laws.
5. That, the Sartaj Alam Patwari is transferred on the seat of the appellant which against the law, unwarranted, un-constitutional, against the norms of natural justice.
6. That, any other ground not specifically taken will be argued with the permission at the time of arguments.
7. It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal the impugned order dated 29/3/2023 may kindly be set aside and further be declared illegal unlawful, void and ineffective being against the principle of natural justice.

INTERIM RELIEF

By way of interim relief the impugned order may kindly be suspended till the final disposal of the instant case.

ORDER

This order will dispose of the departmental appeal filed by the above named appellant against the order of the Deputy Commissioner dated 29.03.2023 whereby the appellant was transferred from Patwar halqa Shabqadar to Patwar halqa Kharakai during ex-Pakistan leave.

Aggrieved of the same, the appellant filed the appeal in hand terming the same in violation of law, rules/policy and prayed for setting aside the impugned order.

Brief facts of the case are that the appellant applied for 23 days ex-Pakistan leave on 27.03.2023 before the competent authority to proceed for Umra to Saudi Arabia. The AAC concerned recommended his application to the Deputy Commissioner on the same day. The competent authority approved the application and 23 days ex-Pakistan leave w.e.f 29.03.2023 to 20.04.2023 was sanctioned with the NOC to travel abroad. It is clearly mentioned in the office order dated 27.03.2023 that the official is likely return to the same post and grade after expiry of his ex-Pakistan leave. The appellant was transferred vide order dated 29.03.2023 during his ex-Pakistan leave, hence the instant appeal was filed by the appellant.

Para-wise comments sought from the Deputy Commissioner Charsadda received and perused, As per plea of the Respondent (Deputy Commissioner Charsadda), that since Rabi Girdawari was in progress and the appellant proceeded for Umra, therefore, it was inevitable to post another Patwari in his place to conduct Girdawari/crops inspection.

Appellant present and heard. Case record also perused. From perusal of record and Rules it is transpired that the appellant was granted ex-Pakistan leave on 27.03.2023 for performance of Umra with NOC to travel abroad and it was clearly mentioned that on the expiry of his ex-Pakistan leave the appellant is likely to return to his post and grade. The appellant was however, transferred to another halqa vide order dated 29.03.2023 instead of handing over charge of the post of the appellant in addition to another adjacent halqa Patwari. As per section-28 of the Revised Leave Rules -1981 (Assumption of charge on return from leave etc), "a civil servant, on return from leave, shall report for duty to the authority that sanctioned his leave and assume charge of the post of which he is directed by that authority unless such direction has been given to him in advance" the subject transfer of the appellant was made in violation of the ibid Rules. The plea of the Respondent in Para-wise comments is not convincing.

Keeping the above in view, the appeal in hand is accepted. The impugned order bearing DC(CHD)Estt:7 (25) Posting Transfer Revenue/ 2775-82 dated 29.03.2023 is set aside to the extent of the appellant falling at S.No. 04 of the office order. The appellant is allowed to assume charge of the post of Patwari halqa Shabqadar with immediate effect. File be consigned to GRR after necessary compilation.

POSTING / TRANSFER POLICY OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT

- i) All the posting/transfers shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused/misused to victimize the Government servants
- ii) All Government servants are prohibited to exert political, Administrative or any other pressures upon the posting/transfer authorities for seeking posting/transfers of their choice and against the public interest.
- iii) All contract Government employees appointed against specific posts, can not be posted against any other post.
- iv) The normal tenure of posting shall be three years subject to the condition that for the officers/officials posted in unattractive areas the tenure shall be two years and for the hard areas the tenure shall be one year. The unattractive and hard areas will be notified by the Government.
- v) {
- vi) While making postings/transfer from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa, specific approval of Governor, NWFP needs to be obtained

While making postings/transfers of officers/officials up to BS-17, from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa approval of the Chief Secretary NWFP needs to be obtained. Whereas, in case of posting/transfer of officers in BS-18 and above, from settled areas to FATA and vice versa, specific approval of the Governor NWFP shall be obtained.
- vi (a) All Officers/officials selected against Zone-I/FATA quota in the Provincial Services should compulsorily serve in FATA for atleast eighteen months in each grade. This should start from senior most scales/grades downwards in each scale/grade of each cadre.
- vii) Officers may be posted on executive/administrative posts in the Districts of their domicile except District Coordination Officers (D.C.Os) and DPOs/Superintendent of Police (SP). Similarly Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) shall not be posted at a place where the Police Station (Thaana) of his area/residence is situated.

Para-1(v) regarding months of March and July for posting/transfer and authorities for relaxation of ban deleted vide letter No: SOR-VI (E&AD) 1-4/2008/Vol-VI, dated 3-6-2008. Consequently authorities competent under the NWFP Government Rules of Business, 1955, District Government Rules of Business 2001, Posting/Transfer Policy and other rules for the time being in force, allowed to make posting/transfer subject to observance of the policy and rules. Added vide Urdu circular letter No. SOR-VI(E&AD)1-4/2003, dated 21-09-2004

- viii) No posting/transfers of the officer's/officials on detailment basis shall be made.
- ix) Regarding the posting of husband/wife, both in Provincial services, efforts where possible would be made to post such persons at one station subject to the public interest.
- x) All the posting/transferring authorities may facilitate the posting/transfer of the unmarried female government Servants at the station of the residence of their parents.
- (xi) Officers/officials except DCOs and DPOs/SPs who are due to retire within one year may be posted on their option on posts in the Districts of their domicile and be allowed to serve there till the retirement.
 DCOs and DPOs who are due to retire in the near future may also be posted in the District of their domicile subject to the condition that such posting would be against non-administrative posts of equivalent scales;
- xii) In terms of Rule-17(1) and (2) read with Schedule-III of the NWFP Government Rules of Business 1985, transfer of officers shown in column 1 of the following table shall be made by the authorities shown against each officer in column 2 thereof:

Outside the Secretariat		
1.	Officers of the all Pakistan Unified Group i.e. DMG, PSP including Provincial Police Officers in BPS-18 and above.	Chief Secretary in consultation with Establishment Department and Department concerned with the approval of the Chief Minister.
2.	Other officers in BPS-17 and above to be posted against scheduled posts, or posts normally held by the APUG, PCS(EG) and PCS(SG).	-do-
3.	Heads of Attached Departments and other Officers in B-19 & above in all the Departments.	-do-

1.	Secretaries	Chief Secretary with the approval of the Chief Minister.

xiii). While considering posting/transfer proposals all the concerned authorities shall keep in mind the following:

- a) To ensure the posting of proper persons on proper posts, the Performance Evaluation Report/annual confidential reports, past and present record of service, performance on post held presently and in the past and general reputation with focus on the integrity of the concerned officers/officials be considered.
- b) Tenure on present post shall also be taken into consideration and the posting/transfers shall be in the best public interest.

xiv) Government servants including District Govt. employees feeling aggrieved due to the orders of posting/transfer authorities may seek remedy from the next higher authority / the appointing authority as the case may be through an appeal to be submitted within seven days of the receipt of such orders. Such appeal shall be disposed of within fifteen days. The option of appeal against posting/ transfer orders could be exercised only in the following cases.

- i) Pre-mature posing/transfer or posting transfer in violation of the provisions of this policy.
- ii) Serious and grave personal (humanitarian) grounds.

2. To streamline the postings/transfers in the District Government and to remove any irritant/confusions in this regard the provision of Rule 25 of the North West Frontier Province District Government Rules of Business 2001 read with schedule - IV thereof is referred. As per schedule-IV the posting/transferring authorities for the officers/officials shown against each are as under:-

1.	Posting of District Coordination Officer and Executive District Officer in a District.	Provincial Government.
