#### **IOINT PARAWISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS 01 TO 03**

#### **RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:-**

Comments on behalf of respondents are submitted as under:-

## **Preliminary Objections:-**

- 1. That the appellant has no cause of action to file the instant service appeal.
- 2. That the instant appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
- 3. That the appellant has no locus standi to file instant appeal.
- 4. That on 26-02-2013 appellant was promoted from PET (BPS-15) to SPET (BPS-16) vide promotion Endst; No. 1422-29 dated 26-02-2013 on the same seniority list and he did not raise any objections upon the said seniority list as well as he did not challenge the promotion order dated 26-02-2013 hence, the principle of **Estoppel** is applicable in the instant case as appellant cannot agitate it at belated stage.
- 5. That as per reported judgment 1982 PLC (CS) 784 untrained period cannot be counted in seniority. Hence, in view of the judgment of Apex court instant service appeal is liable to be dismissed on this score alone.
- 6. That the instant service appeal is hopelessly <u>time barred</u> as appellant cannot challenge the seniority list at this belated stage.
  - 7. That the appellant has filed the present appeal just to pressurize the respondents.

- 8. That the instant service appeal is not maintainable in its present form as there is no final order.
- 9. That the appellant has not come to this Honorable Tribunal with clean hands. Hence, not entitled for any relief.
- 10. That the appellant was appointed as Physical Education Teacher (Untrained) vide appointment order Endst; No. 4187-95 dated 15-02-1995 whereas he acquired mandatory professional training of Physical Education Teacher on 11-05-1999. As per APT Rules 1989 Seniority shall be reckoned from the date of regular appointment i.e 11-05-1999.
- 11. That the appellant is estopped to sue due to his own conduct.
- 12. That the instant appeal is not maintainable due to non-joinder and misjoinder of necessary parties.
- 13. That the instant appeal is against the Rules and Policy of the Government.
- 14. That the appellant has suppressed the material facts from this Honorable Tribunal, hence, not entitled for any relief and appeal is liable to be dismissed without any further proceeding.

# Factual objections:-

- 1. That the Para No. 1 of the instant service appeal as composed is incorrect hence denied. Appellant was appointed as PET (untrained) vide Endst No. 4187-95 dated 15-02-1995.
- 2. That the Para No. 2 of the instant service appeal is correct.
- 3. That the Para No. 3 of the instant service appeal is correct.
- 4. That the Para No. 04 of the instant service appeal as composed is incorrect hence, denied and not admitted. Appellant was appointed as PET (untrained) on 15-02-1995 and final seniority list of PET was

prepared in the year 2012 and appellant was promoted from PET to SPET on 26-02-2013 on said final seniority as appellant passed mandatory PET training course on 11-05-1999 but appellant badly failed to challenge the final seniority list prepared in the year 2012 as well as promotion order dated 26-02-2013 hence, the principle of **Estoppel** is applicable in the instant case as appellant cannot agitate it at belated stage. (Copy of Final Seniority list of PET & Detail Marks Certificate of appellant is annexed herewith as **Annexure "A" & "B"** respectively)

5. That the Para No. 5 of the instant service appeal as composed is incorrect hence, denied. Departmental appeal as well as service appeal is hopelessly time barred as final seniority list was prepared in the year 2012 and appellant was promoted from PET to SPET (BPS-16) on 26-02-2013 on the same seniority list. Hence, instant appeal is liable to be dismissed on this score alone.

### **Grounds:-**

- a. That the ground a, as composed is incorrect hence, denied and not admitted. Seniority list was prepared in accordance with law rules and policy. Furthermore, as per judgment of this Honorable Tribunal the identical Service Appeal No. 1253/2016 dated 14-09-2022 has already been dismissed. Hence, instant Service Appeal is liable to be dismissed on the principle of consistency. (Copy of Judgment in Service Appeal No. 1253/2016 dated 14-09-2022 is annexed herewith as Annexure "C")
- b. That the ground b, as composed is incorrect hence, denied and not admitted.
  - c. That the ground c, as composed is incorrect hence, denied and not admitted. Furthermore, as per reported judgment 1982 PLC (CS) 784 untrained period cannot be counted in seniority. Hence, in view of the judgment of Apex court instant service appeal is liable to be dismissed on this score alone.

d. That the ground d, as composed is incorrect hence, denied and not admitted. Comprehensive reply has already been given in preceding Paras.

e. That the ground e, as composed is incorrect hence, denied and not admitted. Furthermore, as per 1993 SCMR 1119 seniority in a particular grade is reckoned from date of regular appointment i.e from the date of passing of professional examination (JDP).

f. That the ground e, as composed is incorrect hence, denied and not admitted.

g. That answering respondents seek leave of this Honorable Tribunal toraise additional grounds/ points during the course of arguments.

Under the circumstances it is humbly requested that in the light of above referred facts Service Appeal in hand may please be dismissed with cost.

#### JUDGEMENT.

MIAN MUHAMMAD, MEMBER(E):- The appellant has involved jurisdiction of the Service Tribunal under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 with the prayer that "on acceptance of the instant appeal the respondents may kindly be directed to give due seniority to the appellant since the date of appointment in service i.e. 16.01.1990 instead of 07.09.1993 alongwith all consequential benefits".




Proof to its as per memorandum of appeal, are that the appeals to be any noted as Princip Select Teacher Contrained) in the rest relief dep turent on the tel. 1989 on temporary basis. Services of the appealant were subsequently regularized on 16.01.1090. During his service, the appealant acquired professional educational qualification for 14%. M.S. appealant acquired professional educational qualification deposition of the test of M.S. appealant acquired professional educational qualification deposition. M.S. appeals and PTC. The respondent department directlated tentative revised seniority list of PS1s (2016) wherein the appealant's seniority was recknowled from the date of acquiring PTC i.e. at the Co3 though also allegedly given graded pay from the date of appearament, but he was not given seniority from the date of his appearament. He therefore, preferred departmental appeal on 18.08.20.16 which was not responded within the stipulated period of 9.1 days, whereafter he filed the instant service appeal in the service Tribunal on 16.12.2016.

On admission of the service appeal in preliminary hearing on 23.62 2017, the respondents were put on notice to submit written defense through reply para-wise comments. Reply/Purawise comments were submitted on 26.64.2017. We have heard learned counsel for the appeals of as well as fearned District Attorney for the respondents in Divisional Bench and gone through the record thoroughly with their valuable assistance today.

I corned counsel for the appellant argued that the respondent department has wrongly considered the seniority of appellant from the cute of his acquiring professional qualification i.e. PTC w.c.f. 97 66,1993 and not from the date of regularization of his service w.c.f. 15 64 (199). The appellant was granted graded pay from the date of hys





appointment, therefore, his sentority is also required to be reckoned from the date of his appointment. He argued that inaction on part of the respondent department to give sentority to the appellant from the date of his appointment i.e. 16.01.1900; is against the provision of Article 4 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan. He further argued that he may be granted sentority from the date of his appointment in service i.e. 16.01.1990 instead of acquiring profession qualification w.e.f. 07.09.1993 with all consequential back benefits, while concluding his arguments.

Learned District Attorney on the other hand, contended that 05. due to lack of prescribed professional qualification for the post of PTC, the first appointment of appellant as untrained PTC was purely temporary and upon acquiring the prescribed qualification on 07,09,1993 he became eligible for the post of PTC. His seniority was therefore, correctly reckoned from the date of 07.09,1993. He further argued that the appellant has not arrayed any private person as respondent who now stands senior to the appellant in the impugned seniorax list. He contended that regular appointment means an appointment of a duly qualified person in the prescribed manner in accordance with law and rules; the standard which is lacking in the case of appellant. Moreover, after passing the PTC course i.e. 07.09.1993 the appellant was accordingly regularized in service and he was given his due position in seniority list after his regular appointment. He relied on Service Tribunal judgement of 13.06.2016 delivered in service appeal No. 11/2015 of Sanaullah Jan SPST (BS-14) versus Secretary Elementary & Secondary Education and others.

The service appeal in hand being devoid of any merit may be dismissed, he concluded.




the appellant was initially appointed as PTC (untrained) (now PST) on temporary/adhoc basis on fixed pay on 09.01.1989 and his services were later on, regularized on 16.01.1990. It was during service that the appellant acquired the required qualification for the post of PST on 07.09.1993 and as such his seniority was shown in column 16 (Date of taken over charge) against PST post from the date of passing PTC examination, in the tentative revised seniority list of PSTs (2016). The Service Tribunal in its judgement dated 13.06.2016 delivered in service appeal No. 11/2015 titled Sanaullah Jan SPST (BS-14) Versus Secretary Elementary & Secondary Education Khyber Pakhtunkhwa laid down the following principle:-

No.

"Ordinarily on a post for which a certain special training/ examination is must so such appointment without such course/examination cannot be treated as a regular examination. The admitted position in this case is that the appellant was initially appointed as untrained teacher. He was appointed against a fixed pay. There is no legislation or notification from the respondents side specifying in particular that appointment of the PTC Teacher tappellant) will be regular appointment from the date of their first appointment. The Tribunal is afraid to subscribe the view of the learned counsel for the appellant that in the light of the referred notifications the appellant became regular servant from the date of their first appointment. A regular appointment means an appointment of a duly qualified person in the prescribed manner in accordance with the law and rules which standard is evidently lacking

in case of the appellant. After passing the PTC Course on 14.12.1993 it seems that the appellant was accordingly regularized in service, therefore, he was given his due position in the seniority list after his regular appointment which step is in accordance with the law and rules on the subject."



Similarly, Section 8 (4) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil-Servants Act, 1973 is relevant to be quoted here which lays down the principle for determining seniority of a civil servant in the following:

"Seniority in a post, service or cadre to which a Civil-Servant is promoted shall take effect from the date of regular appointment to that post."

In view of the foregoing discussion, It can be concluded that as the appellant was appointed as regular PST with effect from the date of passing the basic required qualification for the post of PTC on 07.09.1993 he has therefore rightly been placed in the tentative revised seniority list (2016) from such date. We, therefore, find that the appellant has been treated in accordance with law and relevant rules. The service appeal being devoid of merit, is dismissed. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to record room.
