PARAWISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENT NO.2

Preliminary Objections:

1. That the instant appeal is not maintainable in the present form.
2. That the Appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the present appeal.
3. That the Appellant has not come to this court with clean hands.
4. That the Appellant has got no cause of action to file the present appeal against the respondents.
5. That the instant appeal is badly barred by time and law.

Respectfully Sheweth:

1. Pertains to record, hence needs no comments.
2. Incorrect. The appellant cannot claim benefits of Finance Department' letter dated 11-08-1991 (**Annex-I**) at this belated stage. The policy of advance increment on the basis of higher qualification under ibid letter was already discontinued vide Pay Revision-2001 (**Annex-II**). Even after its discontinuation in 2001, Finance Department through a circular letter dated 25-06-2010 (**Annex-III**) clarified to all Departments that those Government employees who had acquired higher qualification prior to 01-12-2001, but their cases have not yet been decided are eligible for advance increment, in light of the policy prevailing prior to 01-12-2001 and in the said letter gross period was also given but the appellants did not get benefit at that time.

Moreover, after promulgation of an Act, 2012 all kind of advance increments on the basis of higher educational qualification have been ceased as is evident from (**Annex-IV**).

3. Incorrect. As explained in preceding para the appellant is not legally entitled to the benefits of advance increment after the cutoff date.
4. Incorrect. The judgment referred by the appellant is judgment in personum and its benefit cannot be extended to him. Moreover, in a similar case, Peshawar High Court vide its judgment dated 14-06-2023 held that those employees who have not agitated their claim at the relevant time cannot claim benefits of advance increment (**Annex-V**).
5. Incorrect. No violation of law has been made as explained above.
6. No comments.

- D. Incorrect. As explained in para-04 of the facts, the appellant cannot claim benefits under Peshawar High Court Judgment dated 08-06-2017 as he had not submitted his claim prior to the promulgation of Cessation of Advance Increment on the basis of Higher Qualification Act, 2012.

Moreover, as replied in detail in preceding paras, this Provincial Government extended so many opportunities to all such employees as explained I paras above, to get the benefits of advance increment, in spite of its discontinuation in 2001 but the appellant failed to avail the opportunity at that time.

- E. Incorrect. No violation of law has been made as explained above.
- F. Incorrect. No violation of rights has been made.

In view of the above explanation, it is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of these para-wise comments, this honorable Service Tribunal may very graciously be pleased to dismiss the present appeal with cost.

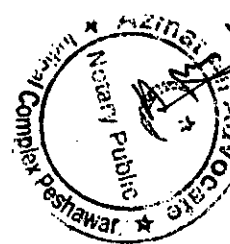

REVISION OF BASIC PAY SCALES AND FRINGE BENEFITS
OF CIVIL EMPLOYEES (BPS-1 - 15) OF THE PROVINCIAL
GOVERNMENT (1991).

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to say that the Governor, N.W.F.P., has been pleased to sanction Revision of the Basic Pay Scales for the Provincial Civil Servants (BPS-1 - 15) as detailed in the following paragraphs :-

2. BASIC PAY SCALES :-

The existing, modified and revised pay scales are detailed in the annexure to this letter. The revised pay scales

INITIAL FIXATION OF PAY

- (i) The initial pay of the existing employees who have been in Government Service since before the 1st June, 1991, shall first be fixed in the modified scale at the stage having the same pay or if there is no such stage at the next higher stage. Thereafter the pay shall be fixed in the Revised Pay Scale "on point to point basis" i.e. at the stage in the relevant revised basic pay scale which is as many stages above the stage occupied by him above the minimum of the modified basic scale.
- (ii) In the case of those employees whose pay is fixed in the revised scale at a stage which gives less than Rs.100/- increase in pay of May, 1991 a minimum increase of Rs.100/- in pay over May, 1991 level, would be allowed and thereafter pay fixed at the corresponding stage equal to this pay or if there is no such stage, at the next higher stage. The pay fixation formula has been illustrated through examples I, II & III in Appendix.
- (iii) The annual increment shall continue to be admissible subject to the existing conditions on the 1st of December each year.
- (iv) The increases allowed since 1-7-1988, as detailed below shall cease to be admissible from 1-6-1991:-
- Indexed pay sanctioned vide Finance Department circular No.FD(PRC)1-3/85, dated 4-8-1988.
 - Ad-hoc increase of 5% of pay sanctioned vide circular No.FD(PRC)1-3/85, dated 13-1-1990.
 - Ad-hoc increase of 10% sanctioned vide Finance Department circular No.FD(PRC)1-3/89 dated 21-7-1990.
 - Dearness Allowance of Rs.200/- p.m. sanctioned vide Finance Department circular No.FD(PRC)1-3/88 dated 16-1-1991.

FIXATION OF PAY ON PROMOTION

- In cases of promotion from a lower to higher post/scale before the introduction of these scales, the pay of the employee concerned in the revised scale may be fixed and so enhanced that it would not be less than the pay that would have been admissible to him if his promotion to the higher post/scale had taken place after the introduction of these scales.
- Government employees who are allowed selection grade shall be granted one premature increment from 1-6-1991 as is allowed in the case of promotion.

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GRANT OF ADVANCE INCREMENTS TO OFFICIALS FOR POSSESSING/
ATTAINING HIGHER EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION.

- 1) From 1-6-1991 onwards advance increments shall be allowed without the condition of the second Division to the officials in SPS 1-15 for possessing or acquiring higher educational qualifications over and above prescribed qualifications in the relevant Recruitment Rules to the extent given below :-

The advance increment already allowed in terms of para-6(a) of Finance Department's letter No.FD(PRC)1-1/87-Vol-VIII, dated 22-7-1987 would be doubled from 1.6.1991.

- ii) The advance increments shall be allowed at the time of recruitment or acquisition of higher qualification whichever is later. In cases where the employee is already at the maximum of the scale, he may be allowed the number of advance increments beyond the maximum of the scale as personal pay to be absorbed at the time of his move-over/promotion. Those employees who had acquired higher qualification in 3rd Division prior to 1-6-1991 and were not granted advance increments earlier would henceforth be allowed advance increments with effect from 1-6-1991.

6. MOVE-OVER

The concession of Move-over shall be available from 1-6-1991 onwards to those who are enjoying selection grade.

REVISION OF BASIC PAY SCALES AND FRINGE BENEFITS OF CIVIL EMPLOYEES (BPS 1 - 22) OF THE N.W.F.P. GOVERNMENT (2001).

Sir,

I am directed to state that the Governor of the NWFP has been pleased to sanction, with effect from December 1, 2001, a scheme of the Basic Pay Scales, Allowances and Pensions, 2001 for the Civil employees of the Government of NWFP in BPS 1 to BPS 22 as detailed below:

PART I - BASIC PAY SCALES AND ALLIED MATTERS.

2. BASIC PAY SCALES :- The existing Basic Pay Scales and the revised Basic Pay Scales are shown in Annexure-I to this letter. The revised basic pay scales shall

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replace the existing Basic Pay Scales 1994, and shall be effective from 1st Dec 2001.

DISCONTINUATION OF ALLOWANCES :- The following allowances shall cease to be payable on introduction of the revised pay scales with effect from 01-12-2001:-

- i. Cost of Living Allowance to BPS-1 to BPS 22 @ 7% of basic pay.
- ii. Adhoc relief of Rs. 300/-p.m. and Rs. 100/- p.m. to BPS 1 to BPS 16 (inclusive of BPS-17 by virtue of Move Over).
- iii. Secretariat Allowance/Personal Allowance if any/Adhoc Relief as recompense for Secretariat/Personal Allowance.

4. SPECIAL ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE :- Special Additional Allowance sanctioned vide Finance Department's letter No. FD(PRC)1-1/99 dated 26-7-1999 be frozen at the level drawn as on date of issue of this letter.

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5. INITIAL FIXATION OF PAY :- Pay of the employees in Government service on 30-11-2001 shall be fixed at the stage in the revised pay scales which is as many stages above the minimum as the stage occupied by him above the minimum of the 1994 Basic Pay Scale.

6. PAY FIXATION ON PROMOTION :- The existing provisions regulating the fixation of pay in case of promotion from lower to a higher post shall continue to apply.

7. SELECTION GRADE AND MOVE OVER :- selection Grade in the scheme of Basic Pay Scales and Move Over scheme shall stand discontinued w.e.f the date of issue of this letter.

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8. PAY FIXATION OF EMPLOYEES IN SELECTION GRADE AND THOSE WHO HAVE MOVED OVER TO HIGHER SCALE.

Pay of an existing employee drawing pay by move over shall be fixed with reference to the pay scale of the post for the time being held by him. In case the employee was drawing pay in Selection Grade, his pay will be fixed in the Selection Grade pay scale. The stage of fixation will be arrived at after allowing increments on notional basis in the original scale of the post or the Selection Grade, in 1994 Basic Pay Scales, upto the point of existing pay. Pay of the employees will then be fixed at the relevant stage in the revised pay scales 2001.

EXAMPLE I

Assistant, BPS-11 Selection Grade, BPS 15, Move over BPS 16 and in receipt of Pay of Rs. 5490/- Pay will be fixed in BPS-15 i.e Selection Grade pay scale at Rs. 8320/- as under :-

Pay fixation of an employee in BPS-11 who has moved over to BPS-14 and is in receipt of basic pay of Rs. 4480/- will be fixed after allowing notional increments in BPS-11 of 1994 Basic Pay Scales upto the stage of basic pay drawn. Pay in revised BPS-11 will be fixed at the corresponding stage of Rs. 6790/- as under:-

Pay Fixation of an employee in BPS-5 who has moved over to BPS-11 and is in receipt of basic pay of Rs. 3465/- will be fixed after allowing notional increments in BPS-5 of 1994 BPS upto the stage of basic pay drawn. Since basic pay of Rs. 3465/- is beyond the 30 stages in notional BPS-5, (1994 BPS), and resultantly more than the 30 stages of BPS-2001, therefore, his pay will be fixed at the notional 32nd stage i.e. at Rs.5300/-. The difference of Rs. 200/- (Rs.5300 - 5100) will be personal to him under:-

In such cases future increments upto a maximum of 3 years will also be allowed as personal to such employees.

9. **DATE OF INCREMENT:-** Annual increment shall continue to be admissible subject to the existing conditions, on the 1st December each year.

10. **SPECIAL PAYS/ALLOWANCES FOR OFFICES :-** The Special Pays/ Allowances sanctioned to offices as percentage of pay shall be discontinued on the introduction of revised pay scales w.e.f 1-12-2001 and adjusted in future increments.

11. **ADVANCE INCREMENTS :-** The existing scheme of advance increments is discontinued w.e.f. 1-12-2001. A fresh scheme, if any, will be introduced in due course.

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PART – III PENSION AND COMMUTATION

18. PENSION :- The Government has made the following reforms in pension/commutation scheme w.e.f. 1-12-2001 in respect of civil pensioners of Provincial Government :-

- Commutation Table shall be replaced by the new commutation Table at Annexure-II to this letter.
- Commutation upto 40% of gross pension shall be admissible at the option of the pensioner.

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The additional benefit of 2% - 10% for extra years of service after completion of 30 years of qualifying service in respect of civil pensioners shall be discontinued.

- d) The increase in pension @ 20% - 25% to Civil Pensioners allowed vide this Department's letter No. SOSR.III(F&TD)4-111/81 dated 27-7-1999 shall be discontinued.
- e) The benefit of restoration of surrendered portion of pension in lieu of commutation/gratuity shall be withdrawn.
- f) In future, the increase in pension to the pensioners shall be allowed on net pension instead of gross pension.
- g) All the pensioners shall be allowed an increase in net pension (inclusive of dearness increases allowed in the past) as follows:-

19. OPTION :- (a) All the existing civil employees (BPS 1 to 22) of the Provincial Government shall within 30 days from the date of issue of this letter, exercise an option in writing, addressed to the Audit office concerned in the case of employees in BPS 15 and above and to the DDO concerned in the case of employees in BPS 15 and below, either to draw pay in the existing Basic Pay Scales of 1994 or in the Revised Basic Pay Scales and Pension/commutation scheme 2001 as specified in this letter. Option once exercised shall be final.

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(b) An existing employee as aforesaid, who does not exercise an option to communicate such an option within the prescribed time limit, shall be deemed to have opted to be governed by the Revised Basic Pay Scales, Pension and Commutation Scheme 2001.

20. The government servant who retire w.e.f. 1-7-2001 shall be given the benefit of revised pay scales on presumptive basis discounted by 5% increase in Pension available, subject to the condition that all those who may like to avail this benefit should opt for the entire package i.e. revised scheme of Basic Pay Scales as contained in Part-II and revised package of pension as contained in Part-III of this letter.

21. The Autonomous/Semi Autonomous Bodies will have the option to adopt this pay package provided they have adopted in totality the Basic Pay Scale Scheme/Pension scheme and if their resources so permit as no additional grant will be provided by the Provincial Government. It will not be applicable to those employees of Bank of Khyber and Public Sectors Corporations and those employees who are governed by the Industrial Relations Ordinance 1969 and/or whose financial terms of service are settled through Collective Bargaining Agents. In case of Autonomous/Semi autonomous Bodies where employees are allowed different pay scales/allowances, the revision of their existing pay scales of their employees shall not be made without consultation of the Finance Department.

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22. All existing rules/orders on the subject shall be deemed to have been modified to the extent indicated above. All existing rules/orders not so modified shall continue in force under this scheme.



THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA CESSATION OF PAYMENT OF ARREARS ON ADVANCE INCREMENTS ON HIGHER EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION ORDINANCE, 2012.

(KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA ORDINANCE NO. I OF 2012)

AN ORDINANCE

*to cease the payment of arrears accrued on account of advance
increments on higher educational qualification.*

WHEREAS advance increments have been granted to certain Provincial Government employees on the basis of acquiring or possessing higher educational qualification over and above the prescribe educational qualification from time to time;

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Government vide Notification No. (PRC)1-1/2001, dated 27.10.2001, had already discontinued the scheme of advance increments on higher educational qualification;

AND WHEREAS due to financial constraints, it is not possible for Provincial Government to pay the claimed and unclaimed arrears accrued from the said increments;

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-


1. **Short title, application and commencement.**— (1) This Ordinance may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Cessation of Payment of Arrears on Advance Increments on Higher Educational Qualification Ordinance, 2012.

(2) It shall apply to all the employees of the Provincial Government, who were entitled to received advance increments on higher educational qualification.

(3) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from 1st day of December, 2001.

2. **Cessation of payment of arrears on advance increments on higher educational qualification.** — (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any decision, judgment and order of any Tribunal or Court including High Court or Supreme Court of Pakistan; for the purpose of any claim for payment of arrears on account of advance increments on higher educational qualification sanctioned in pursuance of any order, letter, office memoranda, notification, instructions and other instruments issued before 1.12.2001, such orders, letters, office memoranda, notifications, instructions and other instruments shall be deemed to be non-existent, ceased or revoked and no further claim whatsoever on the basis of these instruments shall be entertained and all cases in respect of such claims pending in any Court or Tribunal including High Court and Supreme Court of Pakistan shall stand abated.

(2) Any order made, instruction issued, decision, judgment or order of any Court or Tribunal including a High Court or the Supreme Court, implemented immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance, shall

be deemed to have been validly made, issued and implemented by the date of commencement of this Ordinance, and any amount already paid there-under on account of advance increments or arrears thereof shall be deemed to have been validly paid and shall not be recoverable from the recipient Government employees.


3. Removal of difficulties.—If any difficulty arises, in giving effect to the provisions of this Ordinance, the Provincial Government may make such orders as it may deem just and equitable.

IJAZ ANWAR, J. Through this single judgment, we intend to decide the instant writ petition and Writ Petitions, listed below, since in all these cases, similar questions of law and facts are involved. The connected writ petitions are:-

2. In the instant writ petition, the petitioners have prayed for the following relief:-

“It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of this writ petition, this Hon’ble Court may be pleased to declare the act as against the basic norms of law & rules repugnant to constitution, law and practice/policy as such no legal effect liable to be set-aside”.

3. In all these petitions, the petitioners have mainly questioned the vires of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Cessation of Payment of Arrears on Advance Increments on Higher Educational Qualification Act, 2012 (hereinafter to be referred as “the Act”).

4. Comments were called from the respondents who furnished the same, wherein, they opposed the issuance of desired writ asked for by the petitioners.

5. Arguments heard and record perused.

6. Perusal of the record transpires that the petitioners have questioned the vires of “the Act” on the ground that promulgation of “the Act” had defeated the judgments of the superior Courts. He further contended that vested rights of the petitioners have accrued in the matter and placed reliance on the judgments reported as **“FECTO Belarus**

7. On the other hand, the learned Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has referred to a recent judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan passed in the case titled "The Divisional Superintendent, Pakistan Railways, Rawalpindi and others Vs. Syed Irshad Ali Abid (2021 PLC (C.S.) 277)" and contended that the grant of increments on higher educational qualification has since been discontinued through Notification dated 13.09.2001, as such, it is a past and closed transaction and that necessary time was granted to the employees who have any claim, albeit, when they failed to claim the same for long ten years, as such, "the Act" in question was promulgated. He has also produced a letter dated 29.04.2010 issued by the Additional Secretary (Regulation), Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Department (Regulation Wing), whereby, clarification was given about the advance increments on higher educational qualification and according to which, a period of sixty days was provided for the remaining claims and argued that even then, petitioners have failed to claim the advance increments at the relevant time.

8. During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced letters/applications which were duly placed on file and contended that the rights of the petitioners to the grant of advance increments were secured

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and guaranteed by a Government's circular letter dated 11.08.1991 and that the case of the petitioners was matured at the relevant time before the cut-of-date i.e. 13.09.2001 when the grant of such increments was discontinued. He also referred to a judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan passed in "CPLAs No.525 and 526/2007 decided on 19.07.2007".

9. At this stage, the learned Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, representing the respondents, contended that the civil servants, who were holding higher educational qualification prior to discontinuation of advance increments in the year, 2001, are entitled for the benefit flowing from circular letter dated 11.08.1991, however, those who have improved their qualification after the notification dated 13.09.2001, under no circumstances, can claim the same benefit and that the bar created through "the Act" would be equally applicable.

10. In view of the above, we, without commenting upon the vires of "the Act" and in view of the statement of the learned Advocate General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, dispose of this and the connected writ petitions and direct the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners in the light of circular letter dated 11.08.1991 and in case, they fulfill the condition mentioned therein for the grant of advance increments prior to the cut-of-date, they be allowed such benefit. It is, however, clarified that only the case of the present petitioners shall be
