JUDGMENT .

AHMAD HASSAN, MEMBER.- Arguments of the learned counsel for the parties heard and record perused.

FACTS

2. The appellant has impugned order dated 29.06.2016, whereby was dismissed from service. Feeling aggrieved, he filed departmental appeal which was rejected vide order dated 20.10.2016, hence, the instant service appeal.

ARGUMENTS

3. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that on the allegations of submitting fake/bogus matric certificate at the time of appointment disciplinary proceedings



were initiated against him and major penalty of dismissal from service was imposed on him. His matric certificate was deliberately removed by the respondents from his personal file. He appeared in 1st year examination as a regular student of GHSS Umerzai, Charsadda and got DMC which was placed on file. Absence from duty on the part of the appellant was not intentional/deliberate, rather illness of his mother forced him to stay away from duty. He was condemned unheard.

- 4. On the other hand learned Additional Advocate General argued that as per record the appellant appeared in SSC Annual Examination 1996 under roll no. 33517 and failed in Urdu by securing 32 marks. As per result sheet, he was directed to reappear in the said paper. Thereafter, he produced a fake DMC and certificate and got appointment in the Police Department. Upon investigation it was found correct. The assertion of the respondents was also supported by the report given by Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education Peshawar. The charge of production of fake bogus DMC was proved against the appellant.
- 5. Learned counsel for respondent no.4 concurred with the arguments advanced by learned Additional Advocate General.

CONCLUSION

6. In the instant appeal the appellant got appointment as Constable in the Police Department on the basis of a fake/bogus metric DMC/Certificate. He appeared in SSC Annual Examination 1996 and failed in Urdu by getting 32 marks. It was established that he had not passed SSC Examination. The photocopy of DMC annexed by the appellant with the memo of present appeal was fake. In the original result he got 32 marks in Urdu, while 70 have been shown in the fake DMC. The respondents referred the matter for verification to the BISE Peshawar in which it





was confirmed that he produced fake/bogus DMC. During the course of arguments learned counsel for the appellant was directed to provide copy of SSC of the appellant but he was unable to provide the same. Rather, it proved the charge of submission of/documents.

7. As a sequel to above, the appeal is dismissed. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

ON ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL THE IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 20-10-2016 OF THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPELLANT MAY GRACIOUSLY BE SET ASIDE AND THE APPELLANT MAY KINDLY BE RE-INSTATED IN SERVICE WITH ALL THE BACK BENEFITS.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

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- 1. That the appellant was enlisted in the Police Department as constable on 23-07-1998 who after undergoing the requisite training had joined regular service.
- 2. That the appellant was charge sheeted for using fake metric certificate, for taking disciplinary action and was issued final show cause notice which was replied by the appellant but was hot heard personally. (Copy of charge Sheet, disciplinary Action and final Show Cause notice are annexure A, B,C and D)
- 3. That appellant served the police department for a lengthy period of 18/19 years with a clear and unqualified service record and now after 18/19 years of service the appellant on the basis of fake and anonymous SMS complaint has been suddenly

removed / dismissed from service vide order dated 29-06-2016.(Copy of the dismissal order dated 29-06-2016 is annexure – E)

- 4. That the allegations against the appellants are that he has got the job on the basis of a fake metric certificate and remaining absent from service for about 18 days.
- 5. That feeling aggrieved from the impugned order dated 29-06-2016 the appellant preferred *appeal* against the same which was also decided vide order dated 20-10-2016 against the appellant and the same was communicated to the appellant on 25-10-2016. (copy of the appeal and order dated 20-10-2016 is annexure F and G)
- 6. That feeling dissatisfied from the orders dated 29-06-2016 and 20-10-2016 the appellant approaches this August tribunal for the redressal of his grievances inter alia on the following grounds:-

GROUNDS:-

- i. That the impugned orders of the respondents are illegal, incorrect, perverse, cursory, malafide, slipshod, without due inquiry and without looking into the record of the appellant hence are not tenable in the eyes of law.
- ii. That no opportunity of being heard has been given by the inquiry officer nor by the respondent # 3 while conducting inquiry and passing the impugned order dated 29-06-2016.
- iii. That the process leading to dismissal of appellant was initiated on the basis of an anonymous SMS whereafter the record of appellants file was checked and the original metric DMC was reported to be found missing from the file which clearly shows the grudge and mala fide of hidden hands against the appellant.
- iv. That the appellant duly provided original metric DMC along with all other documents to the department at the time of his appointment / enlistment which was duly verified at that time but lateron the same was shown to be missing.
- v. That as far as the Board record is concerned, the appellant applied for rechecking of his Urdu paper which was rendered as passed after re-checking and a passed metric DMC was issued to appellant which the appellant provided to the department at the time of his induction. But the same has been shown missing from the Amal Nama / file of the appellant available with the department while the provisional passed metric certificate issued by the concerned school in the same year is available. (copy of the Provisional Certificate is annexure H)
- vi. That appellant passed his metric as he was also granted admission by the same Board in the inter class and the same record is also available with the Board. The appellant appeared in his 1st year F.A. Examination as regular student of Govt. Higher Secondary School Umarzai, Charsadda, who was also issued failed DMC of 1st year F.A. (copy of F.A. DMC of 1st year is annexure I)
- vii. That being regular student of F.A. PART 1, the appellant attended all his classes and during this period the appellant was appointed in the police department.

- viii. That the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education Peshawar has also not maintained and scrutinized the academic record of the appellant and has given the verification reply to the department in a cursory and slipshod manner.
- ix. That absence of appellant was also not intentional but to the serious illness of his mother who has died recently.
- x. That appellant has never done anything wrong throughout his service career which could bring bad name to the department rather appellant has served the department with his heart and soul and with full zeal and fervour.
- xi. That as far as the fake Metric DMC is concerned the matter to this effect has not been thoroughly investigated and inquired into and a wrong conclusion has been drawn on the basis of incorrect and deficient information by the Board Authorities while for absence the appellant shall remain careful in future who shall respect obey his superiors.
- xii. That there is nothing on record against the appellant of his being involved in any corrupt practices or misconduct nor negligence, hence the appellant deserves re—instatement with all back benefits.
- xiii. That entire service record had remained unblemished and no adverse remarks has ever been earned by the appellant in the entire service record.
- xiv. That any other grounds which has not been specifically taken may be argued at the time of hearing.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal the punishment of dismissal may graciously be set aside and the appellant may be re-instated in the service with all back benefits.

This office order relates to the disposal of formal departmental enquiry against <u>Constable Sajid Iqbal No.3930</u> of Capital City Police Peshawar on the allegations that he was recruited in Police Department on take metric certificate.

Im this regard, he was issued charge sheet and summary of allegations. ASP Faqirabad was appointed as Enquiry Officer. He conducted the enquiry and submitted his report that defaulter official did not attend the enquiry proceedings. The E.O further recommended major punishment of dismissal from service for the defaulter official vide Enquiry Report No.26/ST dated 31.05.2016.

Upon the finding of Enquiry Officer, he was issued final show cause notice to which he received & replied but his explanation found un-satisfactory. He was called for O.R. but he failed to appear before this office & not reported arrival at PS AMUS & remained absent from 11.06.2016 till date.

Upon which DSP Legal opinion was sougth. He opined that "the accused official was repeatedly sommoned by the E.O but he deliberately failed to appear and defend himself. As such the E.O recommended him for award of major punishment of dismissal from service. Besides finding of E.O has also proved/established deceitfunctions. Act of the accused cosntable, due to which he was recruited as constable on fake certificate. Besides legal as well as departmental action has already been approved by worthy CCPO on 13.04.2016 which needs to be complied with without further loss of time."

In the light of recommendations of E.O. DSP Legal opinion & other material available on record, the undersigned came to conclusion that the alleged official found guilty of the charges of deceitful. Therefore, he is hereby dismissed from service under Police & Disciplinary Rules—1975 with immediate effect. Hence, the period he remained absent from 11.06.2016 till date is treated without pay.

- 2. That feeling aggrived from the impugned order of dismissal the appellant has got no other adequate and speedy remedy except to file the instant departmental appeal before this Honourable forum hence this appeal on the following grounds amongst others:-
- A) That the matric certificate of the appellant was fit and at the time of insistment the D.M.C and other relevant documents were correctly been filed before the concerned quarter and on the basis of those sertificates the appellant was appointed against the post of constable and issued proper appointment order.
 - B) That the appellant also passed the first year examination and its d.M.C and other documents are also attached.

- That the allegations fromed against the appellant are false, frivolous, and fictitious and the establishment were duty bound to scrutinised the documents and record of a person, and lateron after proper vertification and investigation to issue approper order of inlistment, in the instant no verification or any other investigation was made and after 17 years services the appellant has been dismissed.

 ATTESTED
- That the action taken against the appellant is baseless and concocted, as well as premature and in this stage a socalled forged and frivolous proceedings have been initiate which are not entertainable in the eye of law and natural justice.
- That totally baseless proceedings have been initiated agains the appellant and his 18 years services have been spoiled and he has been deprive of his lawful services, as wll as a limitation of service period have also been passed as at this stage no one is willing to provide services to the appellant.
- F) That the Police establishment remained sleeped for a long time of 18 years, and after a long time they remember the proceedings against the appellant.
- G) That the action taken against the appellant is baseless and concocted and the appellant under the law is entitled for re-instatement in service with all service benefits.

It is, therefore, humbly prahed that on acceptance of this departmental appeal the imougned order dated 29.6.2016 may very graciously be set aside and the appellant be re-instated in service with all service benefits salaries and wages.

ORDER

This order will dispose off departmental appeal preferred by ex-constable **Sajid Iqbal No. 3920** who was awarded the major punishment of **Dismissal** from service under PR-1975 vide OB No. 2305 dated 29.6.2016 by SP-HQrs: Peshawar.

- Short facts leading to the instant appeal are that the appellant was proceeded departmentally on the charge of SMS complaint received against him from the office of Inspector General of Police, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar vide No.159/PAS dt: 12.1.2016, that he was recruited in police department on fake matric certificate. He also absented himself from lawful-duty w.e.f 11.6.2016 to 29.6.2016 (18-days).
- against and 3-. . Proper departmental proceedings were initiated him Mr. Waseem Riaz Khan, ASP-F/Abad, was appointed as the E.O. The Enquiry Officer in his findings mentioned that as per letter No.6278 dt: 25.3.2016 of Peshawar Board Sajid Iqbal is failed in Urdu subject in the SSC Annual 1996. He found him guilty for recruitment as constable in police department on fake matric certificate. On receipt of the findings of the enquiry officer, the SP-HQrs: Peshawar issued him FSCN to which he submitted his written reply. The same was found unsatisfactory. He failed to appear before SP-HQrs: for personal hearing, therefore, awarded him the above major punishment.
- The appellant was called in O.R and heard him in person on 19.10.2016. The enquiry papers were perused. He was provided full opportunity to defend himself but he miserably failed to produce any cogent reason in his favour. He has rightly been connected with the charge framed against him. The punishment award to him commensurate with the gravity of offence. There is no justification to interfere in the order passed by SP-HQrs: Peshawar. His appeal for reinstatement in service is rejected/filed.

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS.

- 1. That the appeal is badly time barred.
- 2. That the appeal is bad for mis-joinder of unnecessary and non-joinder of necessary parties.
- 3. That the appellant has not come to this Hon'able Tribunal with clean hands.
- 4. That the appellant has no cause of action and locus standi.
- 5. That the appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant appeal.
- 6. That the appellant has concealed the material facts from Honorable Tribunal.
- 7. That this Hon'able Tribunal has no jurisdiction to entertain the appeal.

FACTS:-

- (1) Para No.1 pertains to record, hence needs no comments.
- (2) Para No.2 is correct to the extent that the appellant was proceeded departmentally on the allegations that he was recruited in police department on fake metric Certificate. He was issued proper charge sheet along with summary of allegations. He was summoned time and again but he did not attend the enquiry proceedings. Hence after fulfilling all codal formalities, the enquiry officer recommended him for major punishment. He was also called to OR for personal hearing and was heard in person in OR on 19.10.2016 but he failed to defend himself.
- (3) Para No.3 is incorrect. In fact as per letter No.6278 dated 25.03.2016 of Peshawar Board, Sajid Iqbal was found failed in Urdu subject in the SSC annual examination 1996. As the charges of fake metric Certificate were proved against him, hence he was awarded major punishment of dismissal from service.
- (4) Para No.4 is already explained above in detail.
- (5) Para No.5 is correct to the extent that the appellant preferred a departmental appeal but after due consideration was filed/ rejected because the charges leveled against him stood proved.

(6) That appeal of appellant being devoid of merits may kindly be dismissed with cost.

Grounds:-

- i. Incorrect. The punishment orders are legal, per the law/rules.
- ii. Incorrect. All codal formalities were fulfilled.
- iii. Incorrect. The charges leveled against him were proved.
- iv. Incorrect. The documents of appellant were proved fake after due verification from Peshawar Board.
- v. Incorrect. Para already explained in para No.3.
- vi. Incorrect. In fact the metric certificate was found fake vide letter No.6278 dated 25.03.2016 of Peshawar Board.
- vii. Incorrect. As above.
- viii. Incorrect. The charges leveled against him stood proved.
- ix. Incorrect. The appellant wilfully absented without taking permission/leave.
- x. Incorrect. The appellant was found guilty of misconduct.
- xi. Incorrect. Para already explained above in detail.
- xii. Incorrect. The appellant was found guilty of misconduct.
- xiii. Incorrect. The appellant was recruited on fake certificate.
- xiv. That the respondents also seek permission of this Honorable Service Tribunal to raise additional grounds at the time of arguments.

PRAYER.

It is therefore most humbly prayed that in light of above facts and submissions, the appeal of the appellant being devoid of merits and legal footing, may kindly be dismissed.



Respectfully sheweth:

Written Statement on behalf of Respondent No. 4 is as under;

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS.

- A) The Appellant has got no cause of action or locus standi against the replying Respondent.
- B) The Appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant Appeal.
- C) The Appellant has not come to the court with clean hands.
- D) The Appeal in hand is based on malafide and is intended to get unwarranted relief.
- E) That for adjudication of the instant Appeal extensive trespass into the domain of factual controversy required, which cannot be gone into, in this appeal, therefore, the appeal in hand being misconceived is liable to be dismissed on this ground alone.
- F) With utmost respect this Honorable Court has no Jurisdiction.
- G) That the present appeal is not maintainable and entertain able in its present form.

ON FACTS.

1) Not related to replying Respondent, hence, no reply.

- 2) In reply to this Para it is submitted that according to record of replying Respondent i.e result sheet etc the appellant was appeared in the SSC Annual Examination 1996 under Roll No. 33517 and failed in the subject of Urdu by securing 32 marks, therefore, was declared to reappear in Urdu but he failed to reappear. As the appellant is not matriculate and he submitted a fake DMC, therefore, the Departmental Authorities have rightly dismissed the appellant from his service.
- 3) As the appellant at the time of his appointment was not matriculate and he submitted a fake DMC, therefore, he was rightly removed/dismissed from service.
- 4) In reply to this Para it is submitted that according to record of replying Respondent the appellant was failed in Urdu paper and he has not reappeared in Urdu paper, hence, he had failed to pass his matric examination. He was rightly removed/dismissed from service on this ground. So far the ground of absence from service is concerned; the replying Respondent has no concern with this allegation.
- 5) Needs no reply.

0

6) Totally illegal and incorrect. The appellant has not come to this Hon'able Court with clean hands and was not entitled to implead the reply Respondent in the instant appeal, hence, the appeal in hand is liable to be dismissed on this ground alone. The detailed reply of grounds raised in appeal is as under;

GROUNDS

- i) In reply to this ground it is submitted that as the appellant was not matriculate and he had provide a fake DMC, therefore, he was rightly dismissed from service.
- ii) Illegal and incorrect.
- iii) Not related to replying Respondent, hence, no reply.

- iv) In reply to this ground it is submitted that according to record of replying Respondent the appellant has not passed his matric examination, therefore, it is totally incorrect that any document was verified from the replying Respondent.
- V) In reply to this ground it is submitted that according to record of replying Respondent the appellant was initially placed in UFM but later on the jury committee let off him and his actual result was declared as Re-Urdu due to obtaining 32 marks. It is totally incorrect that the appellant had applied for re-checking and after re-checking appellant was rendered as passed and a passed DMC was issued to the appellant. The photo copy of DMC of SSC annexed with the Memo of appeal is fake and factitious because the appellant has obtained 32 marks in Urdu and 66 marks was obtained in Pashto while in the DMC annexed with the appeal 75 marks has been shown in Urdu and 70 marks has been shown in Pashto which are incorrect according to the record of reply Respondent. (Copies of Gazette and extract of result sheet are Annex: "A" and "B" respectively.)
- vi) In reply to this Para it is submitted that according to board procedure prevailing at the time of appearance of the Petitioner in part-I exame, the documents provided with examination forms and result Gazette etc were used to scrutinize at the time of declaration of result of Part-II. As the Petitioner has not appeared in Part-II due to the reason that he was failed in Part-I, therefore, his documents at the time of Part-I exam remained unscrutinzed. On the basis of appearance in Part-I exame and DMC of Part-I, the Petitioner is not entitled to claim that he has passed his matric examination.
- vii) Not related to replying Respondent.

- viii) Totally illegal and incorrect. The replying Respondent after verifying all the record has given the verification reply to the Police Department. It is totally incorrect that the replying Respondent has not maintained or scrutinized the academic record of appellant before verification reply.
- ix) Not related to replying Respondent, hence, no reply.
- x) Not related to replying Respondent.
- xi) Totally illegal and incorrect. Detailed reply has already given in above paras.
- xii) Totally illegal and incorrect. As the appellant has prepared fake and factitious DMC and has obtained the service on the basis of such like document, therefore, is not entitled for any benefit or relief from this Hon'ble Court/Tribunal on the basis of such like document.
- xiii) Not related to replying Respondent.
- xiv) Totally illegal and incorrect.

It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the instant Appeal may kindly be dismissed with cost.
