**APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF KP SERVICE TRIBUNAL  
ACT 1974 AGAINST ILLEGAL AND MALAFIDE  
SENIORITY LIST 31-12-2022 OF HVC/REVENUE  
INSPECTOR OF IRRIGATION DEPARTMENT.**

**Respectfully Sheweth;**

The facts leading rise to present writ petition in brief are: -

1. That the appellant was appointed as Patwarl and after legal promotion, now working as Head Vermicular Clerk (BPS-10). Copy of order is annexure A.
2. That the department issued tentative seniority dated 31-12-2022 in which Revenue Inspectors are placed at initial position and Head vernacular clerk were placed thereafter.  
The copy of Seniority list is Annexure B,

3. That the next promotion of Head Vernacular Clerk is Zilladar (BPS-14) on basis of seniority cum fitness. For the recovery of Abiana the post of Revenue Inspector (BPS-10) was specifically created. The qualification for appointment of Revenue Inspector is Intermediate or equivalent from recognize boards. To adjust the Revenue Inspector in the service structure for promotion, the rules were amended vide notification dated: 07.02.2011 whereby Revenue Inspector and Head Revenue Clerk were placed at same status for the promotion of Zilladar (BPS-14) which is totally against the service rules and nature of work of two different cadres. Copy of rules is annexure D.
4. That on attaining knowledge of seniority list on 16-03-2023 and feeling aggrieved from the rules and seniority list dated 31-12-2023, appellant filed departmental appeal on 16-03-2023 which was not decided by the respondents till now. The copy of departmental appeal and letter is Annexure E.
5. That feeling aggrieved by the act of respondents, the appellant has left with no other option but to invoke the constitutional Jurisdiction of this Honorable court, inter alia, on the following grounds.

**GROUND:**

1. That the seniority list issued dated 31-12-2023 is totally against the seniority, service rules and nature of work of two different cadres.
2. That the joint seniority list, issued by the department of Head Vernacular clerk and Revenue Inspector is totally against the law and rules.
3. That the purpose and principal duties of Zilladar has to perform checking of initial record of Irrigation, entries in record of Final measurement (Khasra Girdawri), checking of demand slips, checking of demand statements (Khatuniayat) and also inspect the Patwari and

their record as per Para 1.30 of Revenue Manual. These powers of Zilladar clearly transpire that he shall be well-conversant with the Revenue Manual and Irrigation system to supervise the revenue establishment upon which the main system of Irrigation devolves. He has to supervise and check the work of sub-ordinate staff of Patwaris. On the other hand, the post of Revenue Inspector was created just to collect the Abiana from the farmers and he has no skill of any revenue system, so the nature of job is totally different. Copy of Revenue Manual is annexure E.

4. That the method for the recruitment for the post of Zilladar is clearly mentioned in West Pakistan Irrigation Department Zilladar Service Rules 1963 in which also the method of seniority is mentioned and in the presence of these rules, the seniority of employees for the promotion of Zilladar vide notification dated: 07.02.2011 is clearly against the law.
5. That the post of Revenue Inspector was created in 2010 for the collection of Abiana from the farmers while this duty was previously performed by the revenue staff of Board of Revenue. It is also evident from letters dated: 16.03.2020, the duty of collection of Abiana is once again shifted to the Board of Revenue Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and in this respect, Revenue Inspectors shall be attached with board of Revenue for collection of Abiana. Copy of letter is annexure F.
6. That it is also strange fact that while preparing the seniority list the Revenue Inspector was placed prior to the Head Vermicular Clerk in the seniority list issued by the department which is also a discriminatory fact amongst the servants of a department.

In wake of above submission, it is respectfully prayed that on

acceptance of this writ, may kindly accepted the appeal and may kindly set aside the seniority list dated: 31-12-2029 regarding the HVC/Revenue Inspector and may kindly declared the Revenue Inspectors are treated at par with Head Vermicular Clerk is totally against the law, rules and are illegal, ultra vires, without lawful authority. It is further prayed that any other relief which this hon'ble court deem fit may kindly be granted in circumstances and in best interest of justice.

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





The Zildadar should inspect the books of each Patwaris section each month and sign them in token of his inspection.

The Patwaris will be supplied with separate books for the two crops. As soon as one crop is over, the books for that crop should be submitted to the Divisional Office through the Zildadar. The Assessment Clerk will then check the counterfoils and note thereon the number and date of the final orders passed by the Divisional Officer in each case. Should be counterfoils show any cases not finally disposed of the Assessment Clerk will prepare a statement by Patwaris and Zildadar sections of such cases, and submit the same to the Divisional Officer through the Deputy Collector. The Divisional Officer will then forward these lists to the Sub-Divisional Officer to clear all pending cases and till this is done, these lists should not be filed.

After action as above, the book will be returned to the Patwaris for further use in the following Khari or Rabi, as the case may be.

The Notice No. 1 shall not be issued under the authority of any officer below the rank of Sub-Divisional Officer and no form shall be cancelled except under the authority of the Divisional Canal Officer.

## Chapter 2

### THE ZILDADAR

**Zildadar:** Zildadar is the junior member of the Superior Revenue Establishment and upon him mainly devolves the supervision and the checking of the work of subordinate Staff of Patwaris. His charge varies but usually consists of the work from 10 to 14 Patwaris. He is governed by the West Pakistan Irrigation Department Zildadar Service Rules, 1963 as adopted by the Government of Punjab.

He is a canal officer under Section 73 read with Rule 72 of the Canal Act.

**Check measurement (چیکر)** of Shudkar: The Khan Parai is considered to be more important than the Patta Parai. A higher limit has therefore been fixed for the former than the latter. And since the Zildadar is the immediate supervisory revenue staff, he must tour rapidly and systematically over his charge and must devote at least 3 days a week to the work during the earlier stage of the crop (initial recording). On each occasion, the Zildadar checks shudkar, of a Patwaris halqa, he will draw up a report of the result of the check in Vernacular Revenue Form No. 21-B which is more or less a check on the field work of the Patwaris rendering the latter fit for reward (bonus) or entailing him in disciplinary action leading ultimately to his dismissal as of the end resort.

**Duties and Powers of Zildadar:** His principal duties consists of:

- (i) Checking the initial record of measurements of irrigation (چیکر) to see that the areas irrigated in the Zildadar section are not left unbooked.
- (ii) Checking the final measurements (کلیاتی چیکر).
- (iii) Checking the demand slips (کلیاتی نامہ) and arranging distribution thereof among the irrigators (کلیاتی).
- (iv) Checking the demand statements (کلیاتی نامہ) and seeing that the entries in the Field Measurement Books are not left untransferred.
- (v) Watching the State of demand of water and indenting supplies in the interest of irrigation.
- (vi) Inspecting tanazas (تقاضی), viz. claims of remission of occupier's Rates (کلیاتی).
- (vii) Seeing that the Lal Khats of Patwaris are kept up-to-date as required under Para. 1.30 of Revenue Manual.

- (vii) Enquiring into all cases of unauthorized irrigation, waste of water and doubtful irrigation (آبیائی ناجائز و بیشبہ آبیائی).
- (ix) Investigating and reporting to the Divisional Canal Officer upon all cases of objections to the assessments.
- (x) Making preliminary enquiry, preparing Warabandi and implementing the same at site.
- (xi) Safeguarding and preventing accidents to all Canal and Drainage works within the meaning of Section 73 of the Canal & Drainage Act, VIII of 1873.

In addition to the duties assigned to the Zilladar (Canal Act), the Zilladar can initiate action in the following cases:—

- (i) can enquire into all cases of unauthorized irrigation, waste of water, doubtful irrigation;
- (ii) can investigate cases of objections on demand slips (*Fanaza-jaar*);
- (iii) can report cases of cuts and breaches in the canal system;
- (iv) can (duty bound) check at least one village of each Patwaris' circle (*halqa*) in respect of check and comparison of *khatauni* (Demand Statement) with the entries in *khatauni* (*shudkar*) of arithmetical accuracy area, kind of crop, schedule of rate and class of crop. In case the Patwaris *halqa* comprises of more than one village, he should check at least one-sixth (1/6) of *khatauni* work of the *halqa*, plus abstract of each *khatauni* checked by the Patwari;
- (v) can enter all charges for waste of water (آب ضائع) unauthorized irrigation (ناجائز آبیائی) and alterations due to additions and remissions of revenue (ایزادی و معافی);
- (vi) can report direct to the Sub-Divisional Canal Officer in regard to the demand of water supply and advise the latter how the available supply can be distributed most usefully in the section;
- (vii) can enter in the cash book all sums recovered in cash and issue a receipt in token thereof to the payee keeping in mind that he deposits the recoveries so made with the Sub-Divisional Canal Officer or in the nearest treasury or sub-treasury in the credit of the D.C.O. concerned;
- (viii) can receive a verbal or written complaint against his subordinates, enquire and report with the result to the D.C.O. concerned through his Deputy Collector for necessary disciplinary action which may include reduction or cancellation of bonus;
- (ix) can sanction casual leave to his subordinates;
- (x) can record and maintain a daily diary showing the acreage (*kham and phukta*) checked each day, the demand and supply of water and the conditions of crop in his section.

2.1. Purpose for which entertained, and principal duties: The Zilladar is the junior member of the Superior Revenue Establishment and upon him mainly devolves the supervision and the checking of the work of the subordinate staff of Patwaris. The extent of a Zilladar's charge varies, but usually consists of the work of from 10 to 14 Patwaris. The most important duties that he has to perform may be stated briefly as follows:

- (i) Checking the initial record of irrigation in the *shudkar* to see that the areas irrigated are recorded at the time;
- (ii) Checking on the ground the entries recorded in the final measurement book (*khatauni*);
- (iii) Checking the demand slips (*parchas*), and seeing that they are made over by the Canal Patwari to the Lambardar as soon as the final measurements of the village or *parhi* are completed and are distributed by the Lambardar to the cultivators, within 4 days of the receipt thereof by him as laid down in paragraph 1.21;
- (iv) Checking the demand statements (*khataunis*) and seeing that all entries in the Field Measurement Book (*khatauni*) are correctly charged for;
- (v) Watching the state of demand for water and indenting for supplies required for channels in his charge;
- (vi) Inspecting the *tanazas* (claims for remission of occupiers' rates);
- (vii) Seeing that Canal Patwaris keep their copies of the field books correct in accordance with the authenticated lists prepared by them with the help of the Revenue Patwaris in January each year and to sign the mutual report made by both the Patwaris, vide paragraph 1.25.

In addition to the above, it is the duty of the Zilladar to receive and to enquire into all cases of unauthorized irrigation, waste of water and doubtful irrigation. He will investigate and report to the Divisional Officer upon all cases of objections to the assessments (*tanazas*) sent to him for the purpose. When required to do so, he will collect items of miscellaneous revenue and amounts due on account of "Deposit Works" as laid down in paragraph 2.25.

It shall also be a part of the duties of Zilladar, as far as possible, to safeguard and prevent accidents to all canal and drainage works situated within his section and for this purpose he will be considered to be in charge of or employed upon

- To Ratify Whatever Advocates may do the Proceedings.
- Not to Hold the Advantages Responsibilities if the said case be proceed Ex-parte OR Dismissed in Default in Consequence of their Absence from the Court when it is called for Hearing.
- That the Advocates shall be entitled to withdraw from the Prosecution of the said case if the Whole or any part of the Agreed Fee Remain Un-Paid.
- That Advocates may be Permitted to argue any other point at the time of Arguments.
