Learned counsel for the appellant produced copy of pay slip of the appellant for the month of May, 2023, to which the learned counsel and the appellant were confronted to show as to what recovery was being made from the appellant to which both of them were unanimous and said that till date no recovery of any sort was made but the appellant apprehends that the same might be done at a later point of time in view of the entries made in the service book of the appellant. Not only the entries made in the service book of the appellant are illegible but also the fact that nothing was being recovered from the appellant till date, rendering the appeal premature. Disposed of accordingly. However, the appellant is at liberty to set the law in motion as and when any coercive measures or any steps are taken against the terms and condition of his service. Consign.
