2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the appellant produced copy of Notification dated 07.07.2021, which has already been annexed with the reply of the respondents and made a request that although the respondents had admitted the right of the appellant for his entitlement to grant of Technical Allowance vide the above notification, yet the notification was passed with immediate effect and was not passed with w.e.f 09.10.2018, i.e. the date of issuance of notification of other similarly placed engineers. Learned counsel says that the appellant would be satisfied if the matter is remitted to the department/departmental authorities to consider the request of the appellant for extending his entitlement of granting Technical Allowance w.e.f 19.10.2018. The matter is accordingly remitted to the respondents to consider the request of the appellant and pass an appropriate speaking order under the law. Disposed of. Consign.
