



3. Today, during the pendency of a similar nature appeal No.16227/2020 titled "Engineer Arshad Ali & 56 others Vs. Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa" the respondents despite rejection of departmental appeal, had extended grant of Technical Allowance to the appellants of those appeals, but w.e.f 07.07.2021. Those matters were remitted to the department for consideration of their request to give effect to the Notification dated 07.07.2021 from 19.10.2018. As the same Technical Allowance has been sought in this appeal also, therefore, the learned counsel for the appellant says that the appellant would be satisfied if this matter was also sent to the Government for consideration of request of the appellant in line with the similarly placed people.

4. In view of the situation, this appeal is also remitted to the respondents to consider the request of the appellant for similar treatment with the similarly placed civil servants and pass an appropriate speaking order under the law. Disposed of. Consign.

Shaheen Iqbal Vs. Chief Secretary, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar & others.

ORDER

Kalim Arshad Khan, Chairman: Learned counsel for appellant present. Mr. Muhammad Jan, District Attorney for the respondents present.

2. Facts of the case are that appellant was serving as Water Management Officer in the Water Management Department. In the meanwhile, the Provincial Cabinet approved the grant of Technical Allowance to all the engineers serving the Provincial Government Departments w.e.f 01.07.2018. The appellant was under the expectancy that he would also get the same benefits, but to the utter surprise of the appellant, the said relief was granted only to the engineers serving in C&W, Irrigation, PHE and Local Government Department; that the same benefit was also extended to the colleagues of the appellant serving in the Mines & Minerals Department and respondent No.4 vide letter dated 16.07.2021, also requested respondent No.3 for grant of the said benefit to the appellant. The appellant filed departmental appeal to the respondents for redressal of the issue but in vain. Thereafter, he filed writ petition before the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, which was decided with direction to the respondents to decide the departmental appeal which was later on decided in the shape of rejection, hence, this appeal.


