Learned counsel for the appellant present and argued that appellant was promoted to BPS-17 on 12.04.2019. Vide order dated 25.04.2019 lien in favour of appellant was issued which was further extended for one year vide order dated 26.05.2021. After completion of said period of retention of lien order was cancelled vide notification 28.02.2022. He further argued that when appellant was on lien his basic pay was Rs. 64870/- but when he again joined his parent department his basic pay was reduced to Rs. 58430/- and thus pay protection was not granted to the appellant which is against the rules. He contended that appellant filed departmental appeal on 06.07.2022 which was not responded, therefore, he filed instant appeal on 07.11.2022 under section-4 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974. Points raised during the course of arguments needs consideration. Therefore, appeal in hand is admitted for regular hearing subject to all legal objections. The appellant is directed to deposit security fee within 10 days. Thereafter, notices be issued to respondents for submission of written reply/comments. Respondents be summoned through TCS the expenses of which be deposited by the appellant. Adjourned. To come up for written reply/comments on 25.10.2023 before S.B at camp court, Abbottabad. P.P given to appellant.
