

APPEAL UNDER SECTION-4 OF THE KHYBER
PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974
AGAINST THE INACTION OF THE RESPONDENTS BY
NOT PROMOTING THE APPELLANT TO THE POST OF
ADMIN OFFICER (BPS-17) LAYING VACANT SINCE
02.09.2023 AND AGAINST THE INACTION OF THE
RESPONDENT BY NOT DECIDING THE DEPARTMENTAL
APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN THE STATUTORY
PERIOD OF THE NINETY DAYS.

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this appeal the respondent may kindly
be directed to consider the appellant for promotion to the post of
Admin Officer (BPS-17) with all back benefits.

Any other remedy which is deems fit by this Hon'able Tribunal
may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

R/SHEWETH:

ON FACTS:

- 1- That appellant was appointed on 18.07.1993 as a Junior Clerk (BPS-05) in the respondent department and since then appellant is performing his duty with great zeal and zest, and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors. (Copy of the Appointment order is attached as annexure.....A).
- 2- That the appellant was promoted to the post of Senior Clerk (BPS-07) from the post of Junior Clerk (BPS-05) on 22.01.2004 and after lapse of time the appellant was promoted accordingly on dated 20.01.2014 to the post of Assistant (BPS-14) from the post of Senior Clerk. (Copy of Promotion, Notification are attached as Annexure-B&C).
- 3- That the appellant was promoted to the post of Programme Officer (BPS-16) from the post of Assistant (BPS-16), on 06.02.2019. (Copy of the Notification of Promotion is attached as annexureD).
- 4- That on 19.12.2022, the respondents department issued a Notification wherein Mr. Riaz Ahmad promoted from the post of Admin Officer (BPS-17) to the post of Deputy Director (BS-18). (Copy of the Notification dated 19.12.2022 is attached as annexureE).
- 5- That it is pertinent to mention here that the appellant is eligible and entitled to promoted to the post of Admin Officer as per rules on vogue.
- 6- That appellant feeling aggrieved the inaction of the respondents by

Officer preferred Departmental appeal on 14.04.2023 before the appellant authority but no reply has been received so far. (Copy of the Departmental appeal is attached as annexure..... F).

7- That the appellant feeling aggrieved and having no other remedy but to file the instant service appeal on the following grounds amongst the others.

GROUND:

A- That the inactions of the respondents by not promoting the appellant from the post of Programme Officer (BPS-16) to the post of Administrative Officer (BPS-17) are against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable in the eyes of law, and therefore the appellant is liable to be Promoted.

B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondent Department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article-4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan-1973.

C- That the respondents acted in arbitrary and malafide manner while not promoting the appellant on the vacant post (Admin Officer BPS-17).

D- That it is pertinent to mention here that as per the Rules, 2009 of the respondent department, the appellant is entitled for promotion to the said post (Admin Officer BPS-17), therefore, the inactions of the respondents by not promoting the appellant on the said post (Admin Officer BPS-17) is against the vested rights and norms of natural justice. (Copy of rules are attached as Annexure-G).

E- That the appellant has served the Department for a long period with unblemished service record and having seniority cum fitness, therefore, the appellant has the due right to be promoted to (BS-17).

F- That the appellant was not promoted to the post of (Admin Officer BPS-17) is violated of the Section 9 of the Civil Servant Act, 1973 read with Rule 7 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Civil Servant Appointment, Promotion & Transfer Rules, 1989.

G- That according to Article 38(e) of the Constitution state is bound to reduced disparity in the income and earning of individual including persons in the civil service of the Federation.

H- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.


It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

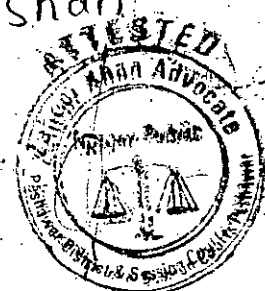



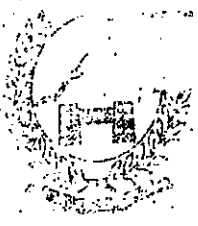

Reference to the Culture, Tourism, Archaeology & Museums Department letter No.SO(Cul)1-9/2018/1787-90 dated 26th April 2023 on the subject noted above and to state that the post of Administrative Officer is to be occupied by promotion on seniority cum-fitness from amongst the holders of the post of Programme officers, Account Officers and Senior Scale Stenographers (Annex-I).

As per the already framed service rules no joint seniority list of the Programme officer, Accounts Officer & Senior Scale stenographer has been issued for the year 2021, 2022 & 2023 because the post of Accounts Officer was upgraded from BPS-16 to BPS-17 on 19-01-2021 vide Notification No. SO(Cul)1-1/2019 dated 19-01-2021 (Annex-II) and the remaining posts of Programme Officer and Senior Scale Stenographer remained in BPS-16. Due to the difference in Basic Pay scales, issuance of joint seniority list is not possible.

Further to state that Director Culture being the head of attached formation is authorized to issue the seniority list upto the extent of BPS-16 but not BPS-17. To resolve the issue this office requested the administrative department thrice vide letters bearing of even No. Dir (C)1-2/2015/Service rules dated 10-02-2021, 16-09-2021 & 03-03-2022 for amendment in service rules to split the seniority of the post of Accounts Officer from the posts of Program Officer & Senior Scale Stenographer in light of the advice made by Finance Department vide letter No.SO(FR)FD/7-34/2020 dated 19-01-2021 (Annex-III). Working Paper for the proposed service rules amendment has been submitted to the administrative department accordingly.

It is hereby requested that the proposed amendment in service rules to the extent of Accounts Officer (BPS-17) may be placed before the SSRC enabling this office to issue the seniority lists for the aforementioned officers and to process the case of appointment on acting charge basis to the post of Administrative Officer (BPS-17). 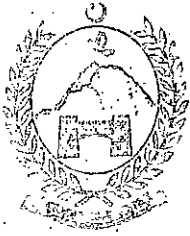
