**SERVICE APPEAL U/S 04 OF THE KHYBER
PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974
AGAINST THE ORDER NO: 4780-84, DATED: 11-04-
2023 PASSED BY THE RESPONDENT NO.3
WHEREBY THE APPELLANT'S TRANSFER ORDER
DATED 26.12.2022 HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN.**

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH,

1. That the appellant was appointed as PST (BPS-
12) vide order dated: 08.02.2019 and was posted
at Government Girls Primary School Faqir Abad,
Karak. (Copy of the appointment order is annexed
herewith as Annexure "A").
2. That while serving at the above-mentioned place
of posting, the appellant was then transferred to

Government Girls Primary School No.2 Teri on the basis of wedlock policy of the government vide order dated 26.12.2022. (Copy of the transfer order is annexed herewith as Annexure as "B").

- 3. That pursuant to the above-referred order, the appellant took over charge at GGPS No.2 Teri and started performing her duties over there.
- 4. That to the utter surprise of the appellant, the respondent No.3, vide order dated 11.04.2023, withdrew the appellant's above-mentioned transfer order against which appeals/representations were preferred to the respondents but to no avail. (Copies of the impugned order dated 11.04.2023 and of the appeals are annexed herewith as Annexure "C" & "D").
- 5. That being aggrieved of the impugned order and non-deciding the appellant's appeals, she is constrained to prefer this appeal before this Hon'ble Tribunal on the following grounds, inter alia:-

GROUND:-

- 1. That the impugned order is illegal, unwarranted and unjustified in the eyes of law, hence liable to be set aside.

2. That the impugned order dated 11.04.2023 of the respondent No.3 is also based on mala fide, hence untenable.
3. That the impugned order is passed in utter disregard to the wedlock policy of the government, therefore, same needs to be set aside.
4. That the impugned order is without lawful authority and of no legal effect, therefore, is liable to be struck down.
5. That while passing the impugned order, the appellant has been condemned unheard, therefore, on this score alone same is to be set aside.
6. That the order dated 26.12.2022 was quite in line with the relevant policy of the government and its withdrawal by the respondent No.3 cannot be countenanced.
7. That apart from the above mentioned submissions, counsel for the appellant may be allowed to raise additional grounds at the time of arguments.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this Appeal, the impugned Order dated 11.04.2023 of the respondent No.3 may kindly be set aside and by allowing this appeal

the appellant be re-transferred to GGPS No.2 Terri based on the wedlock policy.

Any other relief not specifically asked for may also graciously be extended in favor of the Appellant in the circumstances of the case.

Their Services shall be governed by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Act, 1973, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Appointment Deputation, Posting and transfer of Teachers, Lecturer, Instructor and Doctors) Regularity Act, 2011, and such rules and regulation as may be issued from time to time by the Government.
2. Their service will be considered regular and they will be eligible for pension/deduction of GP Fund in term of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant Act, 1973, as amended in 2013, however the teacher appointed on or after 7/6/2022 shall be dealt with Section (2) (2) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Amendment) Act, 2022.
3. Their Services are liable to termination on one month notice from either side. In case of resignation with out notice, their one month pay/ allowances shall be forfeited to the Government.
4. They shall possess the same qualifications and experience required for the subject post on regular basis as specified in Section (3) (a) of the Act.
5. Their regularization shall not effect the service promotion Quota of all service cadre as specified in Section (3) (c) of the Act.
6. They shall be entitled for seniority and pay from the date of initial Appointment on Adhoc/Contract basis as specified in section (3) (d) of the Act.
7. They shall performed duty for at least three years from the date of taking over charge where they were appointed/ posted initially.


