JOINT PARAWISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS No: 1-5.

Respectfully Sheweth:

The Respondents 1 to 5 submit as under:-

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS.

- 1 ***That*** the Appellant has got no cause of action/locus standi.
- 2 ***That*** the Appellant has not come to this Honorable Court with clean hands.
- 3 ***That*** the appeal in hand is based on mala fide intentions for illegal service benefits.
- 4 ***That*** the appellant has concealed material from the ambit of this Honorable Bench is the titled matter.
- 5 ***That*** the case is bad for mis-joinder and non-joinder of the nessacery parties to the appeals.
- 6 ***That*** the matter is barred by law.
- 7 ***That*** the appellant has been treated as per law rules of policy by the Department.
- 8 ***That*** this Honorable Bench has got no jurisdiction to entertain the tiled case in view of legal bar under the law.
- 9 ***That*** the service rule dated 24-7-2014 & 24-4-2018 are legally competent.
- 10 ***That*** the Appellant is not entitled for the relief he has sought from this Honorable Bench through the instant case.

ON FACTS.

- 1 Correct to the extent of the appointment of the appellant against the PST in BPS-12 on Union Council based policy vide Notification dated 2-6-2012 issued by the then EDO (E&SED) District Malakand which is attached as **Annexure-A** for ready reference.
- 2 Needs no comments as this para pertains to the academic qualification of BS in computer Science which is not a matter of dispute in the given circumstances of the case.
- 3 Correct to the extent of framing service structure/Rules for the grant of promotion to the different Teaching Cadre employees of the Department including the appellant against the SST (Sc/G) posts in the Department under the specified reserved Quota for promotion notified by the Respondent Department vide Notification dated 24-7-2014 attached as **Annexure-B** for ready reference Hence, the plea of the appellant is misleading and liable to be rejected..
- 4 Correct that vide Notification dated 24-4-2018 attached as **Annexure-C**, the Respondent Department has framed and notified service Rule/structure for different cadre of information Technology (IT) including the SST (IT) in BPS-16, wherein, the prescribed qualification for promotion has been maintained as under:-
 - a) *Fifty percent by promotion on the basis of Seniority cum fitness from amongst the CT, (IT) with five years' service as such and having the qualification prescribed for the post of SST (IT) in BPS-16.*
 - b) *Fifty percent by initial recruitment. Provided that if no suitable candidate is available for promotion then by initial recruitment.*
- 5 Correct that the appellant while aggrieved from the aforesaid service structure/Rules, has filed a WP No. 596-P/2019 in the Peshawar High Court Peshawar under Article 199 of the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973 which was dismissed vide judgment dated 03-9-2020 in favor of the Responded Department on merits of the case and a copy of the cited Judgment dated 03-9-2020 is attached as **Annexure-D** for ready reference.
- 6 Incorrect, hence, denied on the grounds that no Departmental appeal has been filed by the appellant against the afore mentioned service rule/structure dated 24-7-2014 & 24-4-2018, therefore, got finality under the relevant provision of law & limitation act 1908 against the appellant.
- 7 Incorrect, hence, denied, the stand of the appellant is illegal, therefore, the appeal in hand is liable to be rejected on the following grounds inter alia:-


ON GROUNDS.

- A. **Incorrect & not admitted.** The plea of the Appellant is without any cogent reason and legal justification as the service rules/structure dated 24-7-2014 & 24-4-2018 are mainly based on natural justice and equality, wherein, each & every teaching cadre has a prospect of promotion to the higher posts in the Department on the basis of seniority cum fitness basis. Therefore, the claim of the appellant is liable to be rejected.
- B. **Incorrect & not admitted.** The Appellant has been treated as per law, rules and service Rules & structure as mentioned above, therefore, the appellant seeks two separate channels for promotion against the SST (IT) post and SST (G) which is illegal and liable to be rejected.
- C. **Incorrect & not admitted.** The plea of the appellant is illegal and liable to be rejected in view of the above submission made in foregoing paras of the present reply on behalf of the Respondents.
- D. **Incorrect & not admitted.** The act of the Respondents with regard to the afore stated service Rules & structure dated 24-7-2014 & 24-4-2018 is within legal sphere & liable to be maintained.
- E. **Incorrect & not admitted.** The act of the Department is legal having no aspect of discrimination towards to the appellant in the aforementioned service Rules. Therefore, the stance of the appellant is liable to be rejected.
- F. **Incorrect & not admitted.** No constitutional violation has been made by the answering Respondents. They have always fulfilled their legal and constitutional obligations.
- G. **Incorrect & not admitted.** Hence, needs no further comments, however, the Respondents also seek leave of this Honorable Bench to submit additional record, grounds and case Law at the time of arguments of the case.

Therefore, it is most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may kindly be dismissed to in favor of the Respondents in the interest of justice.







TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Their services will be considered regular, but without pension and gratuity in terms of Section-19 of the Civil servants Act 1973 amended vide NWFP Civil servants (Amendment) Act 2005. They will however be entitled to contributory provident fund in such a manner and at such rates as prescribed by the government.
2. Their appointment is purely on temporary basis and is liable to termination at any time without notice. In case of resignation they shall be required to submit one month's prior notice OR deposit one month's pay into Government treasury in lieu thereof.
3. They will be governed by such rules and regulation as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time for the category of government servants to which they belong.
4. They should produce health and age certificate from the medical Superintendent District Head quarter Hospital Batkhela, Malakand Agency.
5. The appointment of the aforesaid selected candidates is subject to the condition that they are domiciled in Malakand.
6. No TA/DA is allowed in case of initial recruitment.
7. In case of fresh candidate they should not be handed over charge if their age exceed 38 years (for being related to backward areas of Tehsil Swat and Sama Ranizai) or below 18 years.
8. The drawing and disbursing officer concerned shall have to collect photo copies of their testimonials along with verification fees and submit the same to the office of the undersigned for further verification from the institution concerned.
9. Their salary should not be drawn unless and until a clearance certificate regarding verification of documents and release of pay is issued by this office.
10. In case of non availability of vacancy the last one of the relevant category according to their merit position will lose the job.
11. The fresh appointees shall be on probation for the period of two years which is extendable to one year more while in the case of promotion the probation will be one year and shall be extendable for the next one year.
12. The appointees should join their posts within 15 days of the issue of this order, failing which the order shall stand automatically cancelled.
13. Those fresh candidates except in-service candidates, who have been posted in the schools which are closed for summer vacation, will be entitled for their salaries from the date of reopening of the schools on the expiry of summer vacation.
14. The appointment of any candidate if challenged on any grounds in any court of law and the case if decided in favour of the challenger/ appellant/ plaintiff, the appointment of the concerned challenged appointee shall stand null and void.
15. Charge report should be submitted to all concerned.

2. The forum was informed that E&SE Department vide Notification No. SOG/E&SED/1-86/SS.IT/2016 of E&SE Department Peshawar dated 15.08.2016 has notified the nomenclature of Information Technology Teaching Cadre/Posts serving in the Government High & Higher Secondary Schools of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa of E&SE Department, as Subject Specialist-IT (SS-IT/Computer Science) BPS-17 (Annex-A). Further E&SE Department vide Notification No. SO (PE)4-5/SSRC/Meeting/ 2013/ Teaching Cadre: dated 24/07/2014 has approved promotion to SS posts (BPS-17) from SST (BPS-16). The SST regular having 50% quota of the total sanctioned SS posts allotted for promotion (Annex-B). 50% quota has already been allotted for SSTs (General/Science) in 12 different subjects for Subject Specialist Post. But unfortunately, SSTs (General/Science) who have M.Sc (Computer Science)/BS (CS)/MIT qualification and are eligible for promotion to the post of SS (IT) B-17 have no quota for promotion.

3. In light of the above facts, this Department, therefore, proposed that all those SSTs (General/Science) who have M.Sc. (Computer Science)/BS (Computer Science)/MIT may be given 50% quota for promotion to the post of SS (IT) B-17 like other SSTs, so as to bring uniformity in the teaching cadre.



Computer Science from promotion to the post of SST is illegal, unlawful, discriminatory and without lawful authority with the direction to consider and include the subject of Computer Science in the criteria for promotion to the post of SST.

Any other relief though not specifically asked for to which the petitioner is found entitled in the circumstances may also be granted.

2. Keeping in view the averments made in the instant petition, comments were called from the respondents who furnished the same accordingly, wherein, they opposed the issuance of desired writ, as prayed for.

3. Arguments heard and record perused.

4. Perusal of the record reveals that petitioners have called in question the recruitment rules notified vide Notification dated 24.07.2014, whereby, according to them, the incumbents, holding the posts of Primary School Teacher (BPS-12) with qualification of

Computer Science, are not included in the feed cadre for the post of Senior Science Teacher (BPS-16).

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners has laid much stress upon the discrimination so meted out to the petitioners and also about depriving them from future prospect of promotion, albeit, we are of the view that questioning the vires of rules purely relates to the terms and conditions of service, for which the proper forum is Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunals Act, 1974. Besides, the jurisdiction of this Court is barred under Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. In this regard, reference can be made to the cases of "I.A Sherwani and others (1991 SCMR 1041)"; "Ali Azhar Khan Baloch (2015 SCMR 456)" and "Mubeen-ul-Salam (2006 SCMR 100)".
