APPEAL U/S 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SRVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE DECISION OF DEPARTMENTAL PROMOTION COMMITTEE/ RESPONDENTS DATED 21.05.2022 WHEREBY THE APPELLANT WAS DEFERRED FROM PROMOTION WITHOUT ANY REASON OR JUSTIFICATION.

#### Respectfully submitted;

1. That the petitioner being bonafide resident and fully qualified was duly appointed as Junior Clerk in BPS- 11 vide office order of respondent no. 1 dated 16.05.2019. (Copy of the appointment order is annexure A)

- 2. That petitioner thereafter fulfilled all the requisite formalities including medical/ character certification and surety bonds etc, assumed the charge and started performing his duties with utmost zeal and to the entire satisfaction of his superiors and public as well and was placed at serial no. 2 of the initial tentative seniority list issued by the office of respondent no. 1, which later was finalized in ditto. (Seniority List is annexure B)
- 3. That there were total 8 vacancies of senior clerk to be promoted from amongst the junior clerks, while the number of candidates were 9, to be promoted and the appellant is/was at S.No. 2 in the DPC Seniority list.
- 4. That when the DPC was being conducted on dated, 21/5/2022, the appellant was on Ex. Pakistan Leave. (Copy of the ex-Pakistan leave certificate, annexure C)
- 5. That however, when the department promotion committee's meeting was held on 21/5/2022, the DPC unanimously deferred the appellant for promotion, without disclosing any reason at all. (Copy of the impugned minutes of the DPC meeting and final list of promotees' are annexure D & E respectively)
- 6. That it came to the knowledge of appellant that he was deferred due to an alleged ACR pertaining to the year 2019, however the same was not available, and never communicated to appellant, as same was misplaced by the office of Superintendent District Courts Kurram as per enquiry conducted. (Copy of the enquiry a/w report is annexure F)
- 7. That it is pertinent to mention that the alleged adverse ACR of the year 2019 was re-written by respondent no. 2 after the misplacement of the original ACR of 2019, however as per information of the appellant his lost ACR was more than satisfactory based on entire satisfaction of the reporting officer who was kind enough to award an appreciation certificate owing to the most satisfactory performance of the appellant despite the floating fact that being amongst the first to face the merger of districts having no previous experience and skills in office management but yet gave his best to run the system smoothly. (Copies of commendation/ appreciation certificates are annexure G&H while copy of the impugned ACR for the year 2019 is I)
- 8. That while the DPC was being conducted, the appellant had two successive good ACRs for the years 2020/2021, which never came under any consideration before the committee.

- 9. That according to the tentative seniority list of DSJ establishment at S.No. 7 and in minutes of the meeting of DPC held on 21/5/2022, at S.No.8, namely, Gul Zaman S/o Abdul Mat Khan (Junior Clerk), whose last ACR of 2021 for consideration at the said meeting was adverse with remarks, "not fit for promotion", despite of which the said DPC promoted him from Junior Clerk to Senior Clerk.
- 10. That on 28.06.2022, the appellant made an appeal in the above context to respondent no. 1 for considering him for promotion being fit and qualified in all respects and setting aside the alleged adverse remarks entered in the ACR pertaining to the year 2019 which was ordered to be placed before the committee for consideration. (Copy of the departmental appeal and the order sheet are annexure J & K respectively)

Pertinent to mention here that the departmental appeal was preferred as soon as the appellant returned from ex-Pakistan leave and getting knowledge of the impugned DPC meeting and order for which purpose a separate application is accompanying this appeal for condonation of delay for consideration of this honourable tribunal.

- 11. That despite several requests for knowing the fate of his appeal which as per the order sheets is still pending before the concerned DPC, the appellant is constrained to approach this honourable tribunal.
- 12. Feeling aggrieved by the above, the appellant now approach this honourable court for setting aside the impugned actions and orders on the following inter alia grounds;

## GROUNDS

- a. Because the impugned original order of the DPC dated 21.05.2022, the impugned list of promotion vide office order no. 1993-96/DSJ/Kurram of even dated and the alleged ACR bearing no. 991/DSJ/Kurram dated 21.07.2020 are against the law, rules, equity and facts hence not tenable.
- b. Because the impugned orders are against the fundamental rights and service security guaranteed by the constitution.
- c. Because the impugned orders are arbitrary, whimsical, perverse and violative of the service laws and rules and principles of natural justice and have resulted in grave injustice to the appellant.
- d. Because the respondents have not adopted the procedure laid down for assessment of a candidate for promotions and have decided the

fate of the appellant purely on personal whims and conjectures without consulting the unblemished record of the appellant resulting into grave injustice and inequality with the appellant.

- e. Because consideration for promotion is a substantial right guaranteed to the appellant and denial of the same without any due cause or course of law is not sustainable in law.
- f. Because the impugned notification is not sustainable on the score alone that the same was not prepared after conducted thorough enquiry and preparation of working paper in accordance with law.
- g. Because the appellant was not treated in accordance with law and was rather discriminated and condemned unheard while not considering him for his due promotion.
- h. Because an application for condonation of delay is accompanying this appeal which may be considered for any delay in filing of this appeal and disposal of the same on merit alone.
- i. Appellant seeks permission to agitate further grounds at the bar.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal, the impugned original order of the DPC dated 21.05.2022, the impugned list of promotion vide office order no. 1993-96/DSJ/Kurram of even dated and the alleged ACR bearing no. 991/DSJ/Kurram dated 21.07.2020 may be set aside and the appellant may be promoted to Senior Clerk BPS-14 as per law with all back and future benefits, along with any other relief deemed appropriate please.







- 2. Their appointment to the service shall be subject to the following terms and conditions, besides the condition mentioned above: -
  - I. They will be governed by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989.
  - II. They will be allowed the minimum pay of respective basic pay scales plus other allowances as admissible under the rules. Those who are already in Government service and whose pay is more than the minimum of respective basic pay scales, will be allowed to draw pay which they were drawing before their appointment, subject to permission by the Competent Authority. Their pay shall be fixed at proper stage in respective basic pay scales.
  - III. They shall be governed by such rules and instructions relating to leave, T.A, and Medical Attendance as may be prescribed from time to time.
  - IV. They shall be on probation initially for a period of one year extendable upto two years.



- V. They will be eligible for continuance and eventual confirmation in the post on satisfactory completion of their probationary period, subject to availability of permanent posts and the completion of prescribed training, if any.
- VI. Their services shall be liable to be dispensed with at any time without notice and assigning any reason before the expiry of the period of their probation/extended period of probation, if, their work or conduct during this period is not found satisfactory. In the event of termination from service, fourteen days notice or in lieu thereof fourteen days pay will be paid by the Government. In case of resignation, they will give one month notice to the Competent Authority or in lieu thereof one month pay shall be forfeited to the Government. The resignation shall, however, be subject to the acceptance by the Competent Authority.
- VII. They will be governed by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants Conduct Rules, 1987 and any other instructions which may be issued by the Competent Authority from time to time.
- 3. If the above terms and conditions of appointment, also communicated vide separate letters, are acceptable to them, they should report for duty to the undersigned immediately. The offer of appointment shall be deemed to have

been cancelled, in respect of any of them who fails to report for duty to the undersigned within one month from the date of issue of this order.

4. They shall join duty at their own expenses.

As per dispatch diary No. 177 dated 16/03/2020 of the office of the learned AD&SJ-II, Kurram produced as Ex CW1/1, ACR Forms of the staff of the AD&SJ-II, Kurram were handed over to the Hon'ble DSJ, Kurram but in the last column of the dispatch diary, no signatures of the receiving official of the establishment of the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Kurram are found. According to detail report of Sayed Rooh Ullah Superintendent of the court of Sessions Ex PA, the ACR Form of Mr. Imtiaz Hussain was lying beneath the waste papers which were torn by the countersigning authority and its pieces were lost with waste being taken away by TMA and such evidence is not available on file.

O5. In the light of the evidence recorded and material available on file, there is still ambiguity to conclude that who has officially received the ACR Forms of the staff of the learned AD&SJ-II, Kurram in the office of the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Kurram. No doubt the superintendent of the establishment of the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Kurram is responsible for maintenance of the record of the ACR Forms. It is a newly merged district and all the staff including superintendent of the court of the Sessions are newly appointed and possibility of omission in maintenance of record is very much there but no mala fide on the part of any official is found as per available record. As a result, the undersigned has reached to the conclusion that omission in maintaining the record of the ACR Forms is done in the office of the superintendent of the court of Sessions; however, the staff is new and freshly appointed and no mala fide on their part is found.

A warning be issued to the superintendent of the court of Sessions with the direction to be careful in future while receiving and maintaining the confidential record of ACR/PER forms of the staff. All the staff members may also be directed to clearly mention the receiving person of the record with proper signatures as per last column of the dispatch diary so as to affix the responsibility on the official concerned who has received the record. This tracking system is missing in the dispatch diaries of the courts. Instructions in this regard will also be helpful in maintenance of the record in future.

06. With the above findings and recommendations, inquiry report is hereby submitted to the Hon ble District & Sessions Judge, Kurram for his kind consideration and further appropriate order please.
