**SERVICE APPEAL UNDER SECTION-4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED INACTION OF THE RESPONDENTS BY NOT IMPLEMENTING THE ORDER DATED 18-10-2017 WHEREBY THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL/REVISION PETITION OF THE APPELLANT HAS BEEN ACCEPTED AND THE RESPONDENTS HAVE BEEN DIRECTED TO REINSTATE THE APPELLANT INTO SERVICE WITH ALL BACK BENEFITS AND AGAINST THE INACTION OF THE RESPONDENTS BY NOT DECIDING THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL WITHIN THE STATUTORY PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS.**

**PRAYER:**

That on acceptance of this appeal the respondents may kindly be directed to implement the order dated 18-10-2017 and reinstate the appellant into service with all back benefits. Any other remedy which this August Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favour of the appellant.

**R. SHEWETH:**

**ON FACTS:**

- 1- That the appellant was an employee of respondent department and was performing his duty as sepoy No.4939 quite efficiently and to the entire satisfaction of the superiors.
- 2- That while performing his duties at the concerned station astonishingly the respondents vide order dated 08-06-2015 terminated the appellant from service. Copy of the impugned order dated 08-06-2015 is attached as Annexure.....**A.**
- 3- That the appellant feeling aggrieved from the aforesaid impugned order filed departmental appeal but the same has been

rejected through appellate order with no good grounds. Copy of appellate order are enclosed as Annexure.....**B.**

- 4- That the appellant after being highly aggrieved from the impugned order dated 08-06-2015 and appellate order of the respondents filed writ petition No.514-M/2015 in the Hon'able High Court Peshawar which was disposed of by the apex court in the terms as under:-

*"It was at best thought for that as Section 11 provides that whenever an appeal is dismissed, the revision petition may be filed to the higher authority which has not been done so. Let with consent of the parties, this writ petition be termed as revision petition to be placed before the next higher authority within the legal framework, who shall be all means decide the wheel of fortune of the petitioner within two months on receiving this order." Copy of the judgment dated 26-04-2017 is attached as Annexure.....**C.***

- 6. That following the judgment of the apex court the appellant has presented a departmental appeal/revision petition before the SAFRON. Copy of the departmental appeal/revision petition is attached as Annexure.....**D**

- 7. That the Secretary SAFRON while deciding the revision petition/departmental appeal of the appellant directed the competent authority to reinstate the appellant into service through order dated 18-10-2017. Copy of the order dated 18-10-2017 is attached as Annexure.....**E.**

- 8. That after the issuance of the reinstatement order by the Secretary SAFRON the appellant was quite hopeful for his reinstatement but the competent/appointing authority of the appellant was reluctant to reinstate the appellant into service without any plausible reason. Where after the appellant presented various applications for the implementation of the order dated 18-10-2017 but in vain and lastly the appellant submitted an application before the respondent No.2 vide dated 03-03-2023. Copies of the applications are attached as Annexure.....**F**

- 9. That feeling aggrieved from the impugned inaction of the respondents the appellant preferred the instant appeal on the following grounds.

**GROUND:**

- A- That the impugned inaction of the respondents by not implementing the order dated 18-10-2017 for the reinstatement of the appellant is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable; and liable to be set aside.
- B- That the appellant has not been treated by the concerned authority in accordance with law and rules and as such the

authority violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.






- C- That the impugned inaction of the respondents by not implementing the order dated 18-10-2017 for the reinstatement of the appellant is illegal and unlawful and the same is not sustainable in the eye of law.
- D- That impugned inaction of the respondents by not implementing the order dated 18-10-2017 for the reinstatement of the appellant is arbitrary, mala fide; and against the norms of natural justice.
- E- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may kindly be accepted as prayed for.

OFFICE ORDER

As reported by Subedar Major Malakand Levies that No.4947 Sepoy Ghafoor Khan was absent from his duty without any prior permission of the competent authority. He was time and again informed to attend his duty but he remained absent and report for departmental action against the official concerned vide Subedar Major endorsement No.284 dated: 05/05/2015.

Keeping in view of above, a show-cause notice issued to the official concerned vide this office No.2911/LC dated: 11/05/2015 through Post Commander Koper. The Post Commander Koper has reported that the official concerned is not present at his home and disappeared since some days. To this effect statement of his brother namely Saif-ur-Rehman also obtained on the overleaf of the show-cause notice.

Later on, a charge sheet was issued to the official concerned vide this office No.3321/LC dated: 26/05/2015 through Post Commander Koper. The Post Commander Koper has reported that the official concerned is not available/present in his home and gone to some unknown place His where about is not known. To this effect statements of elders of the locality namely Itbar Khar s/o Wali Muhammad r/o Miangan, Badraga and Saif ur Rehman s/o Pora Khan r/o Digan, Badraga, was recorded on the overleaf of charge sheet.

As Malakand Levies is a discipline force, the official concerned is found guilty/misconduct under Levy Rules 2013, Schedule-II (see rules-10) clauses B,D&O, and therefore, I Muhammad Ali Abbas, DC/Commandant Malakand Levies as competent authority hereby terminated the official concerned from service with immediate effect.

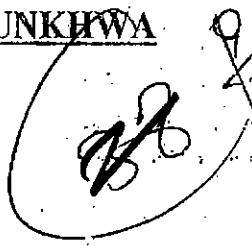

2. Background of the case is that the appellant was terminated on account of absence from duty. The DC / Commandant Levies stated in his comments that several summon were issued but the appellant remained absent and it was reported that the appellant is not at home and gone to some unknown place. Hence show-cause and thereafter charge sheet served upon the applicant but remained absent hence terminated from service on 08.06.2015.

3. The appellant was granted opportunity of personal hearing stating that he had a money dispute with someone and that is why he remained absent from duty. Moreover, he said that he was ill and could not attend duties. He could not give any plausible reason as to why he did not inform the authorities about the reasons for absence from duty, nor did he mention the money dispute in his written statement. Since he has not been able to submit any thing substantial during personal hearing, the appeal is rejected and the appellant may be informed accordingly.

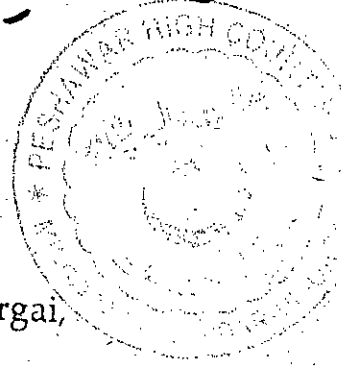

MOHAMMAD IBRAHIM KHAN, J.- Imploring the constitutional jurisdiction of this Court, Ghafoor Khan the Petitioner herein, by filing this writ petition has come up with the perspective prayer:-

*" In the light of above and so many other grounds, it is therefore, prayed that by acceptance of the instant writ petition the impugned order of termination of the Petitioner may be set aside.*

*" Any other remedy coupled with cost, which efficacious and appropriate, in peculiar circumstances of the case, may please be graciously granted, though not specifically prayed for."*

2. The grievance of the Petitioner is that he was appointed in Malakand Levies Force in the year 2006. He performed his duties with utmost zeal, zest and devotion to the entire satisfaction of his mental and physical capabilities whatsoever being entrusted to him. He was discriminated and terminated unlawfully and prematurely which is against the fundamental rights and Article 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.

3. He has set as many as grounds from (A) to (G) and has therefore prayed in accordance with the set prayer in the writ petition.

4. Learned DAG and learned A.A.G appearing on behalf of the Official Respondents in view of the comments furnished by DC/Commandant Malakand Levies, Respondent No. 4 and Secretary, Home & Tribal Affairs Department, Govt: of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar, Respondent No. 2 that

the appeal preferred before the Worthy Secretary Home Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Appellate Authority) after hearing was dismissed vide the order dated 16.01.2013. According to the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Gazette Extraordinary, 20th September, 2012 an appeal under section 11 if the competent authority dismisses such an appeal, the Force Personnel may file a revision petition to the next higher authority within thirty days of the receipt of decision of appeal or sixty days of the preference of appeal, whichever is earlier.

5. The next higher authority has been pointed-out is to be the SAFRON, but the Petitioner when his appeal has been dismissed has never preferred any revision to the said higher authority within the ambit of its limitation.

6. It was at best thought for that as Section 11 provides that whenever an appeal is dismissed, the revision petition may be filed to

the higher authority which has not been done so.

Let with consent of the parties, this writ petition

be termed as revision petition to be placed

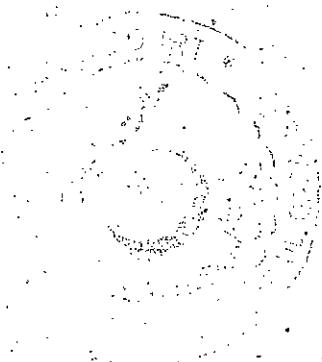
