SERVICE APPEAL: Under section 4 of service tribunal Act, 1974, for declaration to effect that seniority list of SST updated on 31-12-2022 issued by Respondent No 2, whereby SST initially appointed on Adhoc basis in the year 2006, 2007, 2008 and were later regularized on ' 24-10-2009 (respondent No 4 to respondent No 626) under KPK (regularization of service) Act 2009 have been given seniority over the appellant who was appointed on recommendation of KPK Public Service Commission is against the law and fact, discriminatory, void ab-intio, arbitrary, malafide, illegal against section 4 of KPK (regularization of service) Act 2009 and against the Judgment of Supreme Court of Pakistan Dated 02-06- 2022, Hence in effective upon the rights of the appellant. That the first batch of the SST consisting of 10 candidates were recommended by the KPK (Public Service Commission) on 24-08-2009 (annexed as annexure "A") which is the commencement of **KPK** prior to 2009 (regularization of service) Act promulgated on 24-08-2009, Hence the appellant ranks senior in service over the employees initially appointed on Adhoc Basis & later on regularized in service (respondent No 4 to respondent No 626).

PRAYER: On acceptance of instant service appeal, the Honorable court may graciously be pleased to pass the order as under:

a. Declaration to the effect the impugned seniority list of SST updated with on 31-12-2022 issued by respondent No 2 whereby SST initially appointed on Adhoc basis in the year 2006, 2007, 2008 and were later on regularized on 24-10-2009 (respondent No 4 to respondent No 626) under KPK (regularization of service) Ac 2009 have been given seniority over the appellant who was appointed on the recommendation of KPK Public Service Commission is wrong, incorrect, against law and facts, discriminatory, void

ab-intio, misuse of authority, malafide, Illegal, against section 4 of KPK (Regularization of Service) Act 2009 and against the Judgment of Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan Dated 02-06-2022, hence in effective upon the rights of appellant. The promotion of SST (Secondary School teacher) made by respondent No 2 on the basis of impugned seniority list is also against the law and facts. The already promoted SST on basis of impugned seniority list should be considered and placed junior to appellant.

- b. That, the Appellant who is appointed on the basis of recommendation of the Khyber Pakhtunkhawa public service commission may graciously be declared senior over the SST who were initially appointed on Adhoc basis and were later on regularized on 24-10-2009 under KPK (regularization of service) Act 2009 (respondent No 4 to respondent No 626).
- c. Direction to the respondents to prepare afresh seniority list in accordance with section 4 of KPK (regularization of service) Act 2009 and Judgment dated 02-06-2022 issued by Honorable of Supreme Court of Pakistan.
- d. Direction to respondents to consider and place the appellant as senior to already promoted SST (initially appointed on adhoc basis) on the basis impugned seniority list (respondent No 4 to respondent No 626).
- e. Any other relief which Honorable court deem fit and proper may graciously be granted to the appellant in the highest interest of justice.

Respectfully Sheweth

1. That, the appellant had applied for the post of SST in

the light of advertisement No-01-2009. That the first batch of the SST was recommended by Khyber Pakhtunkhawa public service commission on 24-08-2009 before the commencement of KPK (Regularization of service) Act 2009 through proper recruitment process. (Copy of Advertisement of KPPSC & copy of recommendation of the commission dated 24-08-2009 are annexed as annexure "A & B")

- That, similarly SST (respondent No 4 to respondent No 626) were initially appointed on the Adhoc basis in the year 2006, 2007, 2008 and were later on regularized on 24-10-2009 under KPK (regularization of service) Act 2009. (copy of KPK (Regularization of service) Act 2009 is annexed as annexure "C")
- That respondent No 2 issued seniority list of SST updated on 31-12-2022, whereby respondent No 4 to respondent No 626 who are initially appointed on Adhoc basis in the year 2006, 2007, 2008 and were later on regularized on 24-10-2009 under KPK (regularization of service) Act 2009 were given seniority over the appellant (Copy of seniority list of SST as annexed is annexure "D").
- 4 That, above mentioned seniority list was issued by respondent No 2 is in violation of section 4 of the KPK (regularization of the service)Act 2009 and the Judgment of Supreme Court of Pakistan Dated 02-06-2022, Hence appellant filed departmental appeal before the respondent No 2 (copy of departmental

Appeal is annexed as annexure "E")

- 5 That, the respondent No 2 had not decided the departmental appeal filed by the appellant within the stipulated period of 90 days.
- 6 That feeling aggrieved from seniority list of SST issued by respondent No 2 and not deciding the departmental appeal within stipulated period of 90 days, the appellant files instant service appeal inter alia on amongst other grounds.

GROUNDS:

- A. That, the seniority list of SST updated on 31-12-2022 issued by respondent No 2, whereby SST initially appointed on adhoc basis in the 2006,2007,2008 and were later on 10-2009 regularized on KPK(regularization of service) Act (respondent No 4 to respondent No 626) have been given seniority over the appellant who was appointed on the recommendation of KPK Public Service Commission is against the law and fact, discriminatory, void ab-initio, arbitrary , malafide, illegal, against section 4 of the KPK (regularization of service) Act 2009 and against the Judgment of Supreme Court of Pakistan Dated 02-06-2022. (copy of judgment Dated 02-06-2022 is annexed as annexure "F")
- B. That the Act of the respondent No. 2 in not deciding the departmental appeal within statutory period of 90 days is also against law

and fact discriminatory, Arbitrary, malafide and misuse of authority.

- c. That according to section 4(1) of KPK (regularization of service) Act 2009 regarding determination of the seniority, it is laid down that "The employees whose services are regularized under this Act or in the process of attaining service at the commencement of this Act shall rank junior to all civil servants belonging to the same service or cadre, as the case may be, who are in service on regular basis on the commencement of this Act, and shall also rank junior to such other persons, if pursuance in who, the recommendation of the Commission made before the commencement of this Act, are to be appointed to the respective service or cadre, irrespective of their actual date of appointment".
- D. That the Act of respondents is in sheer violation of Judgment of Supreme Court of Pakistan dated 02-06-2022 already passed in the similar matter.
- E. That, the first batch of SST were recommended by KPK (Public Service Commission) on 24-08-2009 before the commencement of KPK (regularization of service) Act 2009 which was promulgated on 24-10-2009. The August Supreme Court of Pakistan in its judgment dated 02-06-2002 held that "Admittedly, the recommendation of the first batch amongst the appellants were made by the KPPSC to the competent authority on 15-09-2009,

whereas the Act was promulgated on 24-10-2009, therefore, the recommendations of all the appellants shall be deemed to have been made by the competent authority prior to the commencement of the Act, irrespective of the subsequent recommendations and dates of their appointments. Hence, the services of those employees, which were regularized pursuant to the Act, shall rank junior to those candidates, whose recommendations were KPPSC. the made bv prior commencement of the Act. The department while constructing the seniority list was right in placing the appellants senior to those who were regularized pursuant to the Act. The list has wrongly been reversed by the Tribunal, which amounts to misinterpretation of the relevant provisions of law, which is an illegality, on the basis whereof, the judgment impugned is not sustainable".

- F. That, Appellant who was appointed on the basis of recommendation of the KPK public service ranks senior in Service over the employees initially appointed on Adhoc basis and were later on regularized in service(respondent No 4 to respondent No 626).
- G. That, Act of respondents amounts to colorful exercise of power and misuse of authority which is not tenable in the eyes of law.
- H. That, respondents have committed discrimination with appellant, which is sheer violation of Article 4 and 25 of the constitution of the Islamic republic of Pakistan 1973.

- I. That, matter of appellant is concerning terms and conditions of service under Article 212 of constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973 hence, appellants have no other proper forum except this Honorable service Tribunal.
- J. That, instant appeal is well in time.
- κ. That, the other points shall be agitated at the time of argument with prior permission of the Honorable Tribunal.

It is therefore prayed that instant appeal may graciously be accepted as prayed for in the heading the instant appeal.

[First published after having received the assent of the Governor of the ³/Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] in the Gazette of [Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] (Extraordinary), dated the 24th October, 2009]

to provide for the regularization of the services of certain employees appointed on adhoc or contract basis.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the regularization of the services of certain employees appointed on adhoc or contract basis, in the public interest for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- Short title and commencement.--(1) This Act may be called the 5[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- <u>Definitions.</u>—(1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - (a) "Commission" means the [Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Public Service Commission:
 - "contract appointment" means appointment of a duly qualified (aa) person made otherwise than in accordance with the prescribed method of recruitment;
 - "employee" means an adhoc or a contract employee appointed (b) by Government on adhoc or contract basis or second shift/night shift but does not include the employees for project. post or appointed on work charge basis or who are paid out of contingencies;

- (c) "Government" means the Government of the ¹[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa];

- (e) "law or rule" means the law or rule for the time being in force governing the selection and appointment of civil servants; and

- Regularization of services of certain employees.—All employees including recommendees of the High Court appointed on contract or adhoc basis and holding that post on 31st December, 2008 or till the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to have been validly appointed on regular basis having the same qualification and experience for a regular post:

Provided that the service promotion quota of all service cadres shall not be affected.

- 4. Determination of seniority.——(1) The employees whose services are regularized under this Act or in the process of attaining service at the commencement of this Act shall rank junior to all civil servants belonging to the same service or cadre, as the case may be, who are in service on regular basis on the commencement of this Act, and shall also rank junior to such other persons, if any, who, in pursuance of the recommendation of the Commission made before the commencement of this Act, are to be appointed to the respective service or cadre, irrespective of their actual date of appointment.
- (2) The seniority interse of the employees, whose services are regularized under this Act within the same service or cadre, shall be determined on the basis of their continuous officiation in such service or cadre:

Provided that if the date of continuous officiation in the case of two or more employees is the same, the employee older in age shall rank senior to the younger one.

- 4A. Overriding effect.—Notwithstanding any thing to the contrary contained in any other law or rule for the time being in force, the provisions of this Act shall have an overriding effect and the provisions of any such law or rule to the extent of inconsistency to this Act shall cease to have effect.

That the Honorable Supreme court of Pakistan have passed the judgment in the light of entire scenario in CP NOs 290 to 297 Dated 22-06-2022, That the recommended SSs appellants will be senior to Adhoc to regularized SSs into seniority, then promotion will be accordingly. Copy of judgment of SC is annexed as annexure "B."

That the stance of recommended SS and Appellant SST are same. Department have not treated with Appellent equally same as recommended SSs Appointees. It is clear cut discrimination treated with SST Appellant, and it is violation of the said Act.



That the Adhoc to regularized SSTs (2009,2010), those who have promoted SSTs to SSs rather than recommended SSTs (2011, 2012) against the secton 4 of Assembly Act KPK (Regularization of service) Act 2009, they placed on senior to as next coming recommended SSTs to SSs as subject wise. **Copy of seniority list of Regularized promotes is annexed as annexed "C."**

The right of appellant is accrued, so being aggrieved, appellant has file Departmental appeal before the Appellent authority to resolve the matter accordingly.

It is therefore requested before the competent authority that our rights are accrue against the discrimination with SST (KPPSC) to be granted seniority like as SS (KPPSC) in the light of honorable Supreme court Dated 02-06-2022 in CPs No 290 to 297 regarding title Badshah Zamin and others VS Siraj khan and others. We hope that you will accept our appeal and remaintain the seniority promoted on SSs, place them on junior to next coming Recommended SSTs to SSs promotees.



James Khan Mandokhail, J. We intend to dispose of all these appeals through this judgment as the question of law in all the appeals is common and these are directed against a consolidated judgment dated 17.11.2020 passed by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar.

2. Facts in brief are that the respondent No.1 was appointed as Subject Specialist on contract basis in

It is important to mention here that before promulgation of the Act, the education department KP invited applications from suitable candidates for appointing them against different posts of Subject Specialist. The process was started by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission (the KPPSC). In view of the fact that the candidates were large in number, therefore, it could not be possible to recommend all the candidates at one go. Consequently, the KPPSC on 15th September 2009 recommended the first batch for their appointment. The process of recommendation was continued and ultimately it was completed when the last batch was recommended on 11th June 2010. The official respondents issued a seniority list, whereby the appellants were placed senior to the respondent No.1 and others, vide seniority list dated 13.12.2017. The respondent No.1 feeling aggrieved, filed a departmental appeal, which remained un-responded, us such, he approached the learned Peshawar High Court because of the fact that by that time, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal (the Tribunal) was not functioning. When the Tribunal started functioning, the learned High Court. referred the matter to it for adjudication and decision. The Tribunal asked the respondent No.1 to file proper memo of appeal, which he did and the appeal was registered

Sentor Court Ascrolate Supreme Court of Pakistan Islamabad accordingly. After hearing the parties, the Tribernal allowed the appeal of the respondent No. 1 in the following terms:

"10. In view of the situation, appeals are necepted, the impugaced Scalarity list dated 13.12.2017 stands set uside with directions to respondent department to correct/modify the impugaced scalarized vide notification dated 31.05.2010 w.e.f. 24.09.2009 under the Khyber Polchtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009 shall be placed senior to all those persons recommended by the Commission after the commencement of the Act ibid as per provisions contained in Section 4 of the Act ibid. No order as to costs. Filed be consigned to the record room."

The appellants filed civil petitions which were converted into appeals, by means of the order dated 10.03.2022, which is reproduced herein below:

"After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, and in the facts and circumstances of the case; we find it appropriate to grant leave to appeal in the instant petitions to examine the question as to what, in terms of section 4 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2003, and the other relevant law and regulation, would be the point of initiation of recommendations by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission ("KPPSC"), and as to when in fact such initiation commenced in respect of the petitioners.

2. At this point in time, Mr. Muhammad Shoaib Shaheen, the learned counsel for the petitioners requests to the Court to allow him to implead KPPSC in this case. The request is allowed. The amended memo of petition be accordingly filed within a week, so that notices be issued to KPPSC for a date after four weeks."

5. Heard the learned counsel for the parties and have perused the record. The controversy between the parties revolves around Sections 3 and 4 of the Act, which are reproduced herein below:

"3, <u>Regularization of services of certain employees.</u>—All employees including recommendees of the High Court appointed on contract or adhoc basis and holding that post on 31" December, 2008 or till the

commencement of this Act shall be deemed to have been validly appointed on regular basis having the same qualification and experience for a regular post:

Provided that the service promotion quota of all service cadres shall not be affected.

- 4. <u>Determination of sentority.</u>—(1) The employees whose services are regularized under this Act or in the process of attaining service at the commencement of this Act shall rank junior to all civil servants belonging to the same service or cadre, as the case may be, who are in service on regular basis on the commencement of this Act, and shall also rank junior to such other persons, if any, who, in pursuance of the recommendation of the Commission made before the commencement of this Act, are to be appointed to the respective service or cadre, irrespective of their actual date of appointment.
- (2) The seniority interse of the employees, whose services are regularized under this Act within the same service or cadre, shall be determined on the basis of their continuous officiation in such service or cadre:

Provided that if the date of continuous officiation in the case of two or more employees is the same, the employee older in age shall rank senior to the younger one."

(Emphasis supplied)

Perusal of the above provisions of the Act would reveal that the contract and adhoc employees, holding the post on 31st December 2008 till the commencement of the Act shall be deemed to have been appointed on regular basis w.e.f. 24th September 2009, i.e. the date of the promulgating of the Act. The issue between the private parties in the appeals is with regard to the determination of their seniority, According to: section 4 of the Act, the employees whose services are regularized pursuant to the Act, "shall also rank junior to such other persons, if any, who, in pursuance of the recommendation of the Commission made before the commencement of this Act, are to be appointed to the respective service or cadre, irrespective of their actual date of appointment." Through this section, the lawmakers have given preference to those employees, who

were recommended by the KPPSC for their appointment, before the promulgation of the act, irrespective of their actual date of appointment.

7. The first batch of the employees was recommended by the KPPSC on 15th September 2010, before the commencement of the Act, whereas, because of bulk of the candidates, the recommendations of rest of the candidates were made on different dates, after the commencement of the Act. The question before us is that rest of the candidates, who were recommended by the KPPSC for their appointments, after the commencement of the Act, would get the benefit of section 4 of the Act or otherwise? The relevant provisions of the Act are required to be read alongwith Section 35(3)(a) and (b) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission Regulations, 2003 (the Regulations), which are reproduced herein below:

"35. RECOMMENDATIONS.

- (1) ---
- (2) ---
- (3) (a) Where a large number of subjects/specialties are included in an advertisement, recommendations may not be pended till the finalization of the entire batch but instead zonal allocation be worked out subject-wise and recommendation conveyed to the Department without indicating to them the zonal allocation and the inter-se-seniority. recommendations to the Department it shall be made clear that the inter-se-seniority of the recommendee is linked with other subjects and the overall merit position and zonal adjustment will be intimated on the completion of interviews in all subjects.
 - (b) The combined merit list shall be against a particular advertisement where by the posts were advertised collectively but recommendations were staggered due to interview schedule or any other reason."
- 8. In clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 35 of the Regulations, it has been clarified that where a large

number of candidates apply for a large number of posts, the recommendations may not be pended till the of the entire batch. In case the finalization recommendation of any batch is made, in the first instance, following by recommending other batches of the candidates for their appointment, the inter se seniority shall be on the basis of their merits, determined by the KPPSC, without taking into account the dates of recommendations. The intention of the law-makers is very much clear that in case of more than one candidate, if the recommendation of the commission is withheld or delayed. in respect of one or more candidates, for want of completion of the process or for any other reason, beyond the control of the candidates, the recommendations of the commission made subsequently on different dates, are to be considered to have been made by the commission on the dates, when first recommendation was made. Under such circumstances, the date of the recommendations of the first batch, sent to the competent authority for the appointment shall be considered as the date of recommendation for all.

Admittedly, the recommendation of the first batch amongst the appellants were made by the KPPSC to the competent authority on 15.09.2009, whereas the Act was promulgated on 24.10.2009, therefore, the recommendations of all the appellants shall be deemed to have been made to the competent authority prior to the commencement of the Act, irrespective of the subsequent recommendations and dates of their appointments. Hence, the services of those employees, which were regularized pursuant to the Act, shall rank junior to those candidates, whose recommendations were made by the KPPSC, prior to the commencement of the Act. The department while constructing the seniority list was right

in placing the appellants senior to those who were regularized pursuant to the Act. The list has wrongly been reversed by the Tribunal, which amounts to misinterpretation of the relevant provisions of law, which is an illegality, on the basis whereof, the judgment impugned is not sustainable.

These are the reasons for our short order dated 02.06.2022, which is reproduced herein below:

"For the reasons to be recorded separately, all these appeals are allowed and the orders of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, Peshawar are set aside."
