APPEAL UNDER SECTION-4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED SENIORITY LIST DATED 02-11-2017 WHEREBY JUNIORS/ PRIVATE RESPONDENTS NO.4 TO NO.17 HAVE BEEN PLACED SENIOR TO THE APPELLANT AND AGAINST NOT TAKING ACTION ON THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEALS OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN THE STIPULATED PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS.

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this service appeal the impugned seniority list dated 02-11-2017 may kindly be rectified/ modified and the appellant be placed at right place according to his seniority with

all back benefits. Any other remedy which this August Tribunal deems fit that may also be granted in favor of the appellant.

R/SHEWETH:
ON FACTS:

- 1- That the appellant was appointed as Anesthesia Assistant (BPS-6) in respondents department vide order dated 04-05-1993 and at present serving as Chief Clinical Technicians (Anesthesia) BS-16. Copy of the *Service Book* is attached as annexure**A.**
- 2- That the appellant is a highly qualified in his respective filed of Health and had obtained a professional degree in the B. Sc (Anesthesia Technology) in the year 2007 from a recognized institute under the N.W.F.P Medical & Dental Degree Ordinance, 1982 and also has got the BS (Honours) Paramedical Science from a recognized university. Copies of the Ordinance, 1982, and degrees are attached as annexure. **B & C.**
- 3- That it is important to mention here that vide letter dated 1-12-2004 the notification issued prior to the ordinance ibid were also made operative as the same were not inconsistent with the ordinance ibid. Copy of the letter dated 1-12-2004 is attached as annexure**D.**
- 4- That it is important to mention here that vie notification dated 10-05-2006 eight stage paramedics services structure was approved and the post of Technologist was re-designated in BPS-17. That vide notification dated 07-01-2008 the respondents issued the method of appointments and promotion of different paramedics staff, wherein vide serial No. 4 the post of Technologist was placed and method of recruitment for this post was 50 % by promotion and 50 % by initial recruitment having Bachelor Degree from a recognized university or recognized institution in the relevant field. Copies of the notification dated 10-05-2006 and dated 01-07-2008 are attached as annexure**E & F.**
- 5- That the respondents vide dated 02-11-2017 issued impugned final seniority list of the Degree Holder Clinical Technicians and astonishingly the appellant was placed at serial No. 15 irrespective of the fact that the appellant had obtained the degree in the relevant filed/ technology in the year 2007 and the private respondents No. 4 to No. 17 has obtained the same in the year 2011 and onwards, but the private respondent No. 4 to No. 17 have been placed at serial No. 1 to No. 14 and the appellant at serial No. 15. Copy of the impugned final seniority list is attached as annexure**G.**

- 6- That in light of that erroneous seniority list the private respondent No. 4 was promoted to the post of Technologist (BPS-17) vide order dated 01-02-2018. Copy of the order dated 01-02-2018 is attached as annexure **H.**
- 7- That the appellant feeling aggrieved from the erroneous/ impugned seniority list dated 02-11-2017 has preferred departmental appeal before the appellate authority but no response has been given within the stipulated period. Copy of the departmental appeal is attached as annexure **I.**
- 8- That by not deciding the departmental appeal within the statutory period, the appellant filed Writ Petition No-406-B/2018 before the Peshawar High Court, Bannu Bench but the same was consider as departmental appeal against the impugned order and the respondents were directed to decide it in accordance with law and rules within the period of one month from the date of receipt of this file vide order dated 24-11-2020. That the appellant was directed to approach proper forum if still aggrieved. Copies of the memo of writ petition and the order dated 24-11-2020 are attached as annexure **J & K.**
- 9- That the respondents have not decided the matter on several request of the appellant till date.
- 10- That feeling aggrieved from the inaction of the respondents and having no other remedy the appellant preferred the instant appeal on following grounds inter alia.

GROUND:

- A- That the impugned seniority list dated 02-11-2017 whereby junior to the appellant i.e. private respondents No.4 to No. 17 have been placed senior to the appellant is against law, facts, norms of natural justice and material on record hence liable to be set aside.
- B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondent department in accordance with law and rules on the subjected noted above and as such respondents violated the Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
- C- That the appellant has been discriminated by the respondents while issuing the impugned seniority list dated 02-11-2017.
- D- That by issuing the impugned seniority list dated 02-11-2017 the respondents have violated section-8 of the Khyber Pakhtunhwa Civil Servant Act, 1973 and Rule-17 of the Khyber Pakhtunhwa (APT) Rules, 1989.

E- That the respondents acted in arbitrary and mala fide manner while issuing the impugned seniority list dated 02-11-2017.

F- That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

THE MEDICAL AND DENTAL DEGREES ORDINANCE, 1982
(XXVI of 1982)

[31st October, 1982]

An
Ordinance

to repeal and with certain modifications re-enact the Medical Degree Act 1916.

Preamble.— Whereas it is expedient to repeal and with certain modifications, re-enact the Medical Degrees Act, 1916 (VII of 1916);

And whereas the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to Make and promulgate the following Ordinance:

1. **Short title, extent and commencement.—** (1) This Ordinance may be called the Medical and Dental Degrees Ordinance, 1982
(2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.
(3) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Definitions.—** In this Ordinance, "Scientific Medical and Dental System" means the scientific methods of Allopathic Medicine, Obstetrics, Surgery and Dentistry, but does not include the Homoeopathic, Ayurvedic or Unani system of Medicine.
3. **Right to Confer Degrees, etc.—** The right of conferring, granting or issuing in Pakistan degrees, diplomas, licences, certificates, or other documents stating or implying that the holder, grantee or recipient thereof is qualified to practise scientific Medical and Dental System shall be exercisable only by the authorities specified in the Schedule and by such other authority as the Federal Government or a Provincial Government may, by notifications in the official Gazette, and subject to such conditions as it thinks fit to impose, authorise in this behalf.
4. **Prohibition of unauthorised conferment of degrees, etc.—** Save as provided by Section 3, no person in Pakistan shall confer, grant or issue any degree, diploma, licence, certificate or other document stating or implying that the holder, grantee or recipient is qualified to practise scientific Medical and Dental System.
5. **Contravention of Section 4.—** Whoever contravenes the provisions of Section 4 shall be punishable with rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year or more than five years and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to fifty thousand rupees; and, if the person so contravening is an association, every member of such association who knowingly and willfully authorises or permits the contravention shall be punishable with rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year or more than five

years and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to twenty-five thousand rupees.

6. **Penalty for falsely assuming or using Medical and Dental titles.**— Whoever voluntarily and falsely assume or uses any title or description or any addition to his name implying that he holds a degree, diploma licence or certificate conferred, granted or issued by any authority referred to in Section 3 or recognised by the Medical and Dental Council of Pakistan or uses any words to give a false impression that he was qualified to practise scientific Medical and Dental System shall be punishable with rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year or more than five years and shall be liable to fine which may extend to fifty thousand rupees:

Provided that nothing in the section shall apply to the use by any person of any title, description or addition which he uses by virtue of any degree, diploma, licence or certificate conferred upon him or granted or issued to him in any subject other than medicine.

7. **Cognizance offences.**— No Court shall take cognizance of an offence punishable under this Ordinance except upon a complaint made by the Secretary of Medical and Dental Council or person authorised by the Secretary and notified in the official Gazette.

8. **Jurisdiction of Magistrate.**— No Court inferior to that of Magistrate of the first class shall try an offence punishable under this Ordinance.

9. **Offences to be bailable.**— Notwithstanding anything contained in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (Act V of 1898), all offences punishable under this Ordinance shall be bailable.

10. **Repeal.**— The Medical Degrees Act, 1916 (VII of 1916), is hereby repealed.

Peshawar Sept: 1977.

No.S.O.III(T)4-16/77. In exercise of the Powers conferred by section 3 of the Medical Degree Act 1916 (VII of 1916) and in supersession of the Government of West Pakistan, Health Department Notification No.ME.II/2-86, dated the 17th April, 1957 the Government of North West Frontier Province is pleased to constitute a Medical Faculty known as "NORTH WEST FRONTIER PROVINCE MEDICAL FACULTY" and to authorize it to exercise powers and perform functions subject to the general control of the Government in the manner to the extent hereinafter appearing.

1. In this notification, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - (a) "Faculty" means the North West Frontier Province Medical Faculty; and
 - (b) "Government" means the Government of the North West Frontier Province.

2. The faculty shall perform functions through a Governing Body which shall consist of eleven members including One member from the Finance Department, to be appointed either by virtue of office or by name by Government.

3. Provided that the Secretary to the Government of North West Frontier Province, Health Department shall be One of its member, who shall also be its president.

- (1) The Governing Body shall elect from among its members vice President.
- (2) The Vice President shall, subject to his continuing as member of the Governing Body, hold office for a term of two years.

4. A member of the Governing Body, other than a member appointed by virtue of office, shall hold office for a term not exceeding three years unless sooner removed by Government, and may be reappointed for another term of three years.

5. No person shall be or shall continue to be member of the Governing Body - who

- (a) is or at any time has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude.

- (b) is or at any time has been adjudicated insolvent; or
- (c) is found lunatic or becomes of unsound mind; or
- (d) is or at any time has been disqualified for employment; or dismissed from, the service of Pakistan; or
- (e) is under twenty one years of age; or
- (f) is not a citizen of Pakistan.

6. Government may, by order in writing and after affording an opportunity of being heard, remove any member of the Governing Body, if he:-

- (a) refuses or fails to discharge or becomes, in the opinion of Government, incapable of discharging his responsibilities under this Notification; or
- (b) has, in the opinion of Government, abused his position as such member; or
- (c) has absented himself from two consecutive meetings of the Governing Body without sufficient cause.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Notification, Government may remove any member of the Governing Body at any time without assigning any reasons, and any member may at any time before the expiry of his term resign his office and on the acceptance of such resignation by Government he shall cease to be a member.

8. Government may fill in the vacancy in the Governing Body caused by the resignation, death or removal of any member and the person so appointed shall be a member for the unexpired term of the member who resigned, died or was removed, as the case may be.

9. (1) The Headquarters of the Faculty, shall be at Peshawar, and Governing Body shall ordinarily hold its meetings at the Headquarters; provided that Government may direct the Governing Body to hold its meeting elsewhere.

(2) The Governing Body shall regulate its own procedure for convening meetings, circulations and service of notices of meetings, and keeping records of such meetings:

Provided that it shall hold at least two meetings in a year, one in the month of April and other in October.

1. The decision in the meeting of the Governing Body shall be taken by majority of the members present and voting and in case of equality of votes, the president or the Vice President as the case may be, presiding over the meeting, shall have the casting vote.
2. Six members shall constitute quorum for a meeting of the Governing Body.
3. The meetings of the Governing Body shall be presided over by the President and in his absence the Vice President shall preside over the meetings.
4. The minutes of the meeting shall be recorded and circulated by the Secretary; provided that in the absence of Secretary, the President or as the case may be, the Vice President, presiding over the meeting, may authorize any member to record and circulate the minutes of the meeting.

11. There shall be a whole time Secretary of the Governing Body, who shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Faculty.

12.

(1) The faculty shall have the right to confer grant or issue degrees, Diplomas, Licences, Certificates or other documents stating or implying that the holder, grantee or recipient is qualified to practice Western Medical Science, or to perform duties of the respective category.

(2) for the ultimate purposes of conferring, granting or issuing of Licences and certificates on or to certain persons so as to enable them to perform duty as Medical Technicians, Health Assistants, Sanitary Inspectors, Medical and Health Auxiliaries, Dispensers, Dressers, Para Medical Workers in leprosy, Radiographers or Laboratory-Assistants or any other category that may be approved by Government, the faculty shall perform all or any of the following functions:-

- (i) to prescribe courses of study and curriculum;
- (ii) to recognize medical institutions for imparting instruction and providing training;
- (iii) to prescribe standards, qualifications, eligibility and procedure for admission of persons in such institutions;
- (iv) to prescribe standards, eligibility and procedure for holding examinations;
- (v) to provide for conducting and making arrangements of examinations and for preparation, results of such examinations.

- (vi) to receive grants gifts and donations and other contributions whether generally or for specific purpose;
- (vii) to fix, demand and receive fee and other charges from the students and candidates;
- (viii) to institute awards, scholarships and prizes;
- (xi) to hold, control and administer the property and funds of the faculty.
- (x) to prepare, process and pass the annual budget;
- (xi) to make provision for buildings, premises, furniture, apparatus, books and other means required to carry out the purposes of the faculty;
- (xii) to sanction such expenditure as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of the Faculty;
- (Xiii) to confer grant or issue, licences, diplomas, and certificates on or to the persons who are qualified in the prescribed courses and examinations so as to enable them to perform duties and functions as Medical technicians, health assistants, sanitary inspectors, dispensers, Medical and Health auxiliaries, Dressers, Para Medical Workers, in leprosy, Radiographers, Laboratory Assistants, or any other category of persons who may be approved by Government and to prescribe forms of licences and certificates to be issued or granted to such persons;
- (Xiv) to appoint sub-committee from amongst its members for any specific purposes; and
- (xv) to do all other acts necessary for carrying out the purposes of the Faculty.

13. The Faculty shall be competent to acquire, hold and dispose off property, both movable and immovable.

14. The Faculty shall have a fund to which shall be credited its income from fees, donations, trusts, bequests, endowments, contributions, grants and other sources. The fund shall be maintained in accordance with the orders passed by the Government from time to time.

- 15. (1) The Faculty shall maintain proper accounts and other relevant records and prepare annual statement of accounts, in accordance with such directions as may be issued by Government, and Auditor-General of Pakistan.
- (2) The annual statement of accounts of the Faculty shall be submitted to Government within six months of closing of the Financial year.



(3) The accounts of the Faculty shall be audited by the Auditor General of Pakistan.

46. (4) The Faculty may, subject to such general or special orders as Government may, from time to time, give, appoint such officers and servants as it considers necessary for the efficient performance of its functions on such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by bye-laws.

(2) The Faculty shall employ such officers and other persons as may be transferred to it by Government, on such terms and conditions as may be determined by Government.

17. The Governing Body may, by General or special order in writing, direct that such of its powers, duties or functions shall, in such circumstances and under such conditions, if any, as may be specified in order, be exercisable also by the President or sub officer as may be specified therein.

18. The Governing Body may with the previous approval of Government, make bye-laws not inconsistent with this notification to provide for all matters for which provision is necessary or expedient for the purposes of giving effect to the provisions of this notification.

In pursuance of the decision taken by the provincial cabinet in its meeting held on 27th December 2005, the Competent Authority is pleased to approve eight stage paramedics services structure of NWFP with effect from 27-12-2005. The salient features whereof shall be as under:-

1. The existing 57 different categories of paramedics as mentioned in annexure A to this notification are restructured into 14 cadres as per annexure B.
2. In all the aforesaid cadres/specialties, the posts in various pay scales shall be integrated/categorized and re-nomenclatured as under:-

The words "clinical" shall be mentioned with the categories of posts meant for paramedics working in the hospitals and "Primary Health Care" with the paramedics working in the field-alongwith mention of specific specialty (e.g. Junior Clinical Technician (Radiology) and Junior Primary Health Care Technician (Multi purpose).

3. The number of Posts in BPS-20, BPS-19, BPS-18, BPS-17, BPS-16, BPS-14, BPS-12 and BPS-9 shall be according to the proportionate ratio based on the total 8965 posts as mentioned in the provincial budget book for financial year 2005-2006. The proportionate ratio of 8 stage formula shall be as under:-

- However additional posts shall be created for any of the left over personals of paramedics cadre (if any). Moreover, subsequent creation of posts in any of the 14 paramedics cadres in any scale shall also be included in the aforesaid proportionate ratio of posts in the 8 tiers formula. The proportionate ratios of posts in BPS-12 and above shall be modified accordingly as and when new creation of posts are made in BPS-9 in each of the 14 cadres subsequently.
4. Seniority of the incumbents of the posts in the 14 cadres so merged shall be caused on the basis of scale wise seniority as well as date of regular appointment in the pay scale. (e.g. in joint seniority list of BPS-12, the official already in BPS-12 will be placed on the top of the list and the officials in the lower pay scale shall be accordingly placed step by step in the list, invariably keeping intact the inter-Sc-seniority of the incumbents in the same pay scales).
 5. In the first instance, the higher posts in the re-structured 14 paramedics cadres as per annexure "C" shall be filled in by way of promotion, as one time exercise, where-after the service rules duly prescribed as at annexure D shall be followed in subsequent promotion/initial recruitment.
 6. Promotions in the post in BPS-18, 19 and BPS 20 shall be made on the basis of joint seniority list. The Joint seniority list of all the 14 cadres shall be caused at BPS-17 level keeping in view the principles laid down in section 8 of the NWFP civil servants (ACT), 1973 read with Rule-17 of the NWFP civil servants (appointment, promotion and transfer) rules, 1989.
 7. The afore-said paramedics service structure into 14 cadres shall also be applicable mutatis-mutandis to the paramedics working in FATA and employees working in Districts, all autonomous, semi autonomous and corporate bodies.
 8. There shall be a council of paramedics to be notified separately.
 9. The approved implementation committee and anomaly committee shall also be notified separately.
 10. This eight stage paramedics service structure will replace all existing categories, cadres, structures and nomenclatures and will cancel all such cadres /categories rules and regulations etc which are in contravention to the approved paramedics service structure. New posts in all type of Health Delivery System will be created in

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future in accordance with the frame work of this service structure. Any new specialties will be added in the frame work of approved paramedics service structure.

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




My name appear at S.No. 25 of the Provisional Seniority List of Clinical Technicians (Anesthesia) issued by the Office of the DGHS(Govt of KPK) vide letter No. 19252-331/AE-VII dated 07-12-2017, copy whereof is submitted as **Annex "A"**.
2. It is further submitted that I was admitted as a regular departmental student to the 02 years' degree course of B.Sc. (Anesthesia Technology) held at Post Graduate Paramedical Institute, Lady Reading Hospital, Peshawar and have passed the prescribed examination held in December 2006 by the NWFP (Now KPK) Medical Faculty Peshawar under Roll No. 248-2nd Batch and have been admitted by the ibid faculty to the Degree of B.Sc. 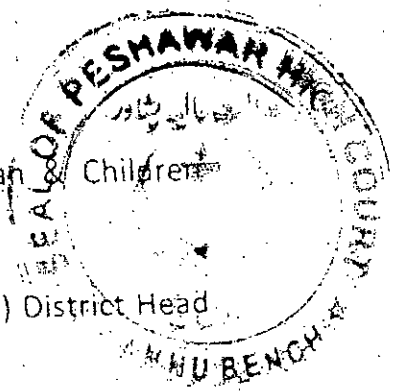




