That vide notification dated 07-01-2008 the respondents issued the method of appointments and promotion of different paramedics staff, wherein vide serial No. 4 the post of Technologist was placed and method of recruitment for this post was 50 % by promotion and 50 % by initial recruitment having Bachelor Degree from a recognized university or recognized institution in the relevant field. - - 7- That the appellant feeling aggrieved from the erroneous/ impugned seniority list dated 02-11-2017 has preferred departmental appeal before the appellate authority but no response has been given within the stipulated period. Copy of the departmental appeal is attached as appearing.



THE MEDICAL AND DENTAL DEGREES ORDINANCE, 1982 (XXVI of 1982)

[31st October, 1982]

An Ordinance

to repeal and with certain modifications re-enact the Medical Degree Act 1916.

Preamble.— Whereas it is expedient to repeal and with certain modifications, re-enact the Medical Degrees Act, 1916 (VII of 1916);

And whereas the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to Make and promulgate the following Ordinance:

- 1. Short title, extent and commencement.— (1) This Ordinance may be called the Medical and Dental Degrees Ordinance, 1982
 - (2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions.— In this Ordinance, "Scientific Medical and Dental System" means the scientific methods of Allopathic Medicine, Obstetrics, Surgery and Dentistry, but does not include the Homoeopathic, Ayurvedic or Unani system of Medicine.
- 3. Right to Confer Degrees, etc.— The right of conferring, granting or issuing in Pakistan degrees, diplomas, licences, certificates, or other documents stating or implying that the holder, grantee or recipient thereof is qualified to practise scientific Medical and Dental System shall be exercisable only by the authorities specified in the Schedule and by such other authority as the Federal Government or a Provincial Government may, by notifications in the official Gazette, and subject to such conditions as it thinks fit to impose, authorise in this behalf.
- 4. Prohibition of unauthorised conferment of degrees, etc.— Save as provided by Section 3, no person in Pakistan shall confer, grant or issue any degree, diploma, licence, certificate or other document stating or implying that the holder, grantee or recipient is qualified to practise scientific Medical and Dental System.
- 5. Contravention of Section 4.— Whoever contravenes the provisions of Section 4 shall be punishable with rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year or more than five years and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to fifty thousand rupees; and, if the person so contravening is an association, every member of such association who knowingly and willfully authorises or permits the contravention shall be punishable with rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year or more than five





ears and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to twenty-five thousand rupees.

6. Penalty for falsely assuming or using Medical and Dental titles.— Whoever voluntarily and falsely assume or uses any title or description or any addition to his name implying that he holds a degree, diploma licence or certificate conferred, granted or issued by any authority referred to in Section 3 or recognised by the Medical and Dental Council of Pakistan or uses any words to give a false impression that he was qualified to practise scientific Medical and Dental System shall be punishable with rigorous imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year or more than five years and shall be liable to fine which may extend to fifty thousand rupees:

Provided that nothing in the section shall apply to the use by any person of any title, description or addition which he uses by virtue of any degree, diploma, licence or certificate conferred upon him or granted or issued to him in any subject other than medicine.

- 7. Cognizance offences.— No Court shall take cognizance of an offence punishable under this Ordinance except upon a complaint made by the Secretary of Medical and Dental Council or person authorised by the Secretary and notified in the official Gazette.
- 8. Jurisdiction of Magistrate.— No Court inferior to that of Magistrate of the first class shall try an offence punishable under this Ordinance.
- 9. Offences to be bailable.— Newithstanding anything contained in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (Act V of 1898), all offences punishable under this Ordinance shall be bailable.
- 10. Repeal.— The Medical Degrees Act, 1916 (VII of 1916), is hereby repealed.





No.S.O.III(T)4-16/77. In exercise of the Powers conferred by section 3 of the Medical degree Act 1916 (VII of 1916) and in supersessions the Covernment of West Pakistan, Health Department Notification No.ME.II/2-36, dated the 17th April, 1957 the Government of North West Frontier Province is pleased to constitute a Medical Faculty known as "NORTH WEST FRONTIER PROVINCE MEDICAL FACULTY" and to authorize it to exercise powers ad perform functions subject to the general control of the Government in the manner to the extent hereinafter appearing.

- In this motification, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - (a) "Faculty" means the North West Frontier Province Medical Faculty; and
 - (b) "Government" means the Government of the North West Frontier Province.
- 2. The faculty shall perform functions throught a Governing Body which shall consist of eleven meders including One member from the Finance Department, to be appointed either by virtue of office or by name by Government.
 - 3. Provided that the Secretary to the Government of North West Frontier Province, Health Department shall be One of its member, who shall also be its president.
 - (1) The Governing Body shall elect from among its members vice President.
 - (2) The Vice President shall, subject to his continuing as member of the Governing Body, hold office fora term of two years.
 - A member of the Governing Body, other than a member appointed by virtue of office, shall hold office for a term not exceeding three years unless sooner removed by Government, and may be greappointed for another term of three years.
 - 5. No person shall be or shall continue to be makes of the Coverning Mady who
 - (a) is or at any time has been convisted of an offence involving matel (no)[[a]]

(b) is or at any time has been adjudicated in solvent; or



- (c) is found lunatic or becomes of unsound mind; or
- (d) is or at any time has been disqualified for employmen in; or dismissed from, the service of Pakistan; or
- (e) is under twenty one years of age; or
- (f) is not a citizon of Pakistan.
- 6. Government may, by order in writing and after afforting an approtunity of being heard, remove any member of the Governing Body, if he;-
 - (a) refuses or fails to discharge or becomes, in the mopinion of Government, in capable of discharging his responsibilities under this Matification; or
 - (b) has, in the opinion of Government, abused his position as such member; or
 - (c) has absented himself from two consecutive meetings of the Governing Body without sufficient cause.
- 7. Not withstanding anything contained in this Notification, Government may remove any member of the Governing Body at any time without assigning any reasons, and any member may at any time before the expiry of his term resign his office and on the acceptance of such resignation by Government he shall cease to be a member.
- 8. Government may fill in the vacancy in the Government Body caused by the resignation, death or removal of any member and the person so appointed shall be a member for the unexpired term of the member who resigned, died or was removed, as the case may be.
- 9. (1) The Haddquarters of the Faculty, shall be at Poshawar, and Governing Body shall ordinarily hald its meetings at the Hadquarters; provided that Government may direct the Governing Body to hold its meeting elsewhere.
- (2) The Governing Body shall regulate its own procedure for convening meetings, circulations and service of notices of meetings, and keeping records of such meetings:

Provided that it shall hold at least two meetings in a year, one in the month of April and other in October.

- The decision in the mosting of the Governing body shall be taken by majority of the members present and voting and in case of equality of votes, the president or the Vice President as the case may be, presiding over the meeting, shall have the casting vote.
- Six members shall constitute quorum for a mooting of the Governing Body.
- 3. The meetings of the Governing Body shall be presided over by the President and his absence the Vice President shall preside over the meetings.
- 4. The minutes of the meeting shall be recorded and circulated by the Secretary; provided that in the absence of Secretary, the President or as the case may be, the Vice President, presiding over the meeting, may authorize any member to record and circulate the minutes of the meeting.

11. There shall be a whole time Secretary of the Governing Body, who shal be the Chief Excutive Officer of the Faculty.

(1) The faculty shall have the right to confer grant or issue degrees, Diplemas, Licences, Certificates or other documents stating or implying that the holder, grantee or recoipient is qualified to practice Western Medical Science, or toperform duties of the respective

(2). for the ultimate purposes of confering, granting or issuing of Licences and certificates on or to certain persons so as to enable them to perform duty as Medical Technicians, Health Assistants, Sanitary Inspectors, Medical and Health Auxiliaries, Dispensers, Dressers, Para Medical Workers in leprosy, Radiographers or Laboratory—Assistants or any other category that may be approved by Government, the faculty shall perform all or any of the following functions:—

to prescribe courses of study and curriculum;

(wy) to prescribe standards, eligibility and procedure for holding examinations;

- (vii) to fix, demand and receive fee and other chapes from the students and candidates;
- (viii) to institute awards, scholarships and prizes;
- (xi) to hold, control and administer the property and funds of the faculty.
- (x) to propare, process and pass the annual budget; to make provision for buildings, premises, furniture, apparatus, books and other means required to earry out the purposes of the
- to sauction such expenditure as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of the Faculty;
- (Xiii) to confer grant or issue, licences, diplomas, and certificates on or to the powers who have qualified in the prescribed courses and examinations so as to enable them to perform duties and functions as Medical technicians, health assistants, sanitary inspectors, dispensers, Medical and Health auxiliaries, presers, Para Medical Workers, in leprosy, adiographers, Laboratory Assistants, or any by Government and to prescribe forms of granted to such persons;
- (Xiv) to appoint sub-committee from amongst its members for any specific purposes; and
- (xv) to do all oter acts necessary for carrying our the purposes of the Faculty.
- 13. The Faculty shall be competant to acquire, hold and dispose off property, both movable and immovable.

 14. The Faculty shall have a fund to which shall be credited its income from fees, donations, trusts, bequests, endownents, contributions, grants andother sources. The fund shall be maintained in accordance with the orders passed by the Government from time to time.
- 15. (1) The Faculty shall maintain proper accounts and other relevant records and prepare annual statement of accounts, in accordance with and Auditor- General of Pokistan.
 - (2) The annual statement of accounts of the Faculty shall be submitted to Government within six months of closing of the Financial year.




