PARAWISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS.

Respectfully shewith:

Preliminarily objection:-

1. That the service appeal is time barred.
2. That the service appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
3. The instant appeal is bad due to mis-joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.
4. That the appellant is estopped due to his own conduct.
5. That the appellant has concealed material facts from this Honorable Tribunal.
6. That the appellant has got no cause of action and locus standi to prefer the instant appeal.
7. The appellant has not come to this Tribunal with clean hands.

ON FACTS

1. Pertains to record, hence need no comments.
2. Pertains to record, hence need no comments.
3. Incorrect. That the appellant while posted to JIS Police Lines had absented himself from lawful duty without prior permission or leave vide DD No.34 w.c.f. 21-04-2017 for 19 days, DD No.41 w.c.f. 11-05-2014 for 02 months and 13 days, DD No.10 w.c.f. 07-07-2017 for 01 month and 10 days and DDNo.50 w.c.f. 18-08-2017 up till the date of dismissal. The appellant was issued Charge Sheets coupled with Statements of allegations and SDPOs City and Barikot Circles were deputed as Enquiry Officers. The Enquiry Officers conducted proper departmental enquiries against the appellant and recorded statements of all concerned. The Enquiry Officers provided ample opportunity to the appellant to defend the charges leveled against him. After conducting proper departmental enquiries, the Enquiry

Officers submitted their Enquiries reports and found that allegations leveled against the appellant were proved during enquiry and recommended for awarding major punishment (**Enquiry report annexed as "A"**). Consequently, the appellant was issued Final Show Cause Notice but he did not bother to submit his reply. The appellant was also called in Orderly Room to be heard in person but he did not appear to produce any plausible defense for the charges leveled against him, hence awarded major punishment of dismissal from service vide OB No.169 dated 17/10/2017. (**Enquiry report annexed as "B"**)

4. That the appellant was dismissed from service on account of willful absence from official duty without prior permission or approved leave after completing all legal formalities. The appellant was a habitual absentee and had also earlier been dismissed from service due to willful absence without any permission vide OB No.42 dated 11-03-2015 (**Order annexed as "C"**) but was later on reinstated. On completion another enquiry of absence, he was warned to be careful in future and in case of any future misconduct he shall be dismissed from service after proper departmental proceedings.
5. That departmental appeal of the appellant was thoroughly examined by the respondent No.2, wherein he was called and heard in person but he failed to produce any cogent reason in his defense, hence his appeal was rejected as per rules. (**annexed as "D"**)
6. Pertain to record, hence needs no comments.
7. That each and every case has its own facts and circumstances, the case of instant appellant is different from that of others, hence the plea taken by the appellant is not plausible under the law.
8. Pertain to record, appeal of the appellant is liable to be dismissed on the following grounds.

GROUND

ORDER

This order will dispose of the departmental enquiry conducted against Constable Maaz No.2264. He while posted to RE Police Lines has absented himself from lawful duty without permission or leave vide DD No.31 w.e.f. 21-04-2017 for 19 days, DD No.41 w.e.f. 05-05-2017 for 02 months and 13 days, DD No.10 w.e.f. 07-07-2017 for 03 months and 10 days and DD No.10 w.e.f. 15-08-2017 up till now.

He was issued Charge Sheets coupled with Statements of Allegations vide this office No.102/EB, dated 01-06-2017 No.109/EB, dated 20-06-2017 and No.156/EB, dated 07-08-2017 and SDPOs City and Barikot Circles were deputed as Enquiry Officers. The Enquiry Officers conducted proper departmental enquiries against the delinquent Constable and recorded statements of all concerned. The Enquiry Officers provided ample opportunity to the delinquent Constable to defend the charges leveled against him. After conducting proper departmental enquiries, the Enquiry Officers submitted their Enquiries reports and found that allegations leveled against the above named delinquent Constable have been proved during enquiry and recommended for awarding major punishment. Consequently he was issued Final Show Cause Notice vide this office No.13885/BB, dated 18-09-2017 but he did not bothered to submit his reply. He was called in Ordinary Room to be heard in person but he did not appeared to produced any plausible defense for the charges leveled against him.

Having perused his service record, it has been found that delinquent Constable Maaz No.2264 has got a habit of willful absence and has 64 bad entries during his short service. He had also earlier been dismissed from service due to willful absence vide OB No.42 dated 11-03-2015 but was later on reinstated. On completion another enquiry of absence he was warned to be careful in future and in case of any future misconduct he shall be dismissed from service after proper departmental proceedings. Foregoing in view, the undersigned is of considered opinion that there are no chances that Constable Maaz No.2264 will become an efficient Police Official. His further retention in service is bound to affect the discipline of the entire force. Therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the undersigned under Rules 2 (iii) of Police Disciplinary Rules-1975, I, Muhammad Ijaz, I, PS-I District Police Officer, Swat as a competent authority am constrained to take Ex-Parte action and award him major punishment of Dismissal from service from the date of his first absence i.e. 21-04-2017.

ORDER.

This order will dispose off the departmental enquiry against Maaz Khan No. 2264 who while posted to Police Station Kanju has absented himself from duty without prior permission or leave vide DD No.27 w.e.f. 20-11 -2014 to 28-12-2014.

He was issued Charge Sheet alongwith statement of Allegations and SDPO/Kabal, Circle was deputed as Enquiry Officer. The Enquiry Officer conducted proper departmental enquiry against the delinquent officer and recorded the statements of all concerned officers. He has provided ample opportunity to the delinquent officer to defend the absence rendered by him. After conducting proper departmental enquiry, the Enquiry Officer submitted his findings wherein he recommended the delinquent Officer for Major punishment and was called in Orderly Room but he has not provide any plausible defense.


Having perused his service record, it was patently evident that the delinquent officer Constable Maaz Khan No. 2264 is addicted to a chronic absentee and is not interested to continue his service. Forgoing in view the undersigned is of considered opinion that there are no chance that Constable Maaz Khan No. 2264 become an efficient Police officer. His further retention in service is bound to affect the discipline of the entire force. Therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the undersigned under Rules 2 (iii) of Police Disciplinary Rules-1975, I, Muhammad Saleem Marwat, P.S.P., District Police Officer, Swat, as a competent authority, am constrained to award him the punishment of Removal from service from the date of absence i.e. 20-11-2014.

ORDER

This order will dispose of appeal of Ex-Constable Maaz Khan No.2264 of Swat District for reinstatement in service, who has been dismissed from service by the then District Police Officer, Swat OB No.169 dated 17/10/2017, received from CPO, Peshawar vide Memo: No.S/175/22, dated 16-02-2022.

Brief facts of the case are that Ex-Constable Maaz Khan No.2264 of Swat District while posted to JIS Police Lines absented from lawful duty for 05 months and 23 days with effect from 21/4/2017 to 11/05/2017, 11/5/2017 to 04/07/2017, 07/07/2017 to 17/08/2017 and 18/08/2017 to 17/10/2017 without prior permission or approved leave. Consequently he was issued Charge Sheet coupled with statement of allegations and SDPO City Circle was appointed as Enquiry Officer. The Enquiry conducted proper departmental enquiry against the delinquent constable and recorded the statements of all concerned. The Enquiry Officer after conducting proper departmental enquiry submitted his finding report holding the delinquent Constable guilty of willful absence and recommended him for major punishment. The delinquent Constable had also been earlier removed from service due to willful absence but he did not give up his indiscipline attitude. Being found guilty of the charges the then District Police Officer, Swat "Dismissed" him from service vide his office OB No.169 dated 17/10/2017 under Rule 2 (iii) of Police Disciplinary Rules 1975.

He was called in Orderly Room on 20/05/2022 and heard him in person, but he did not produced any cogent reason to defend his willful absence, therefore, his appeal is hereby rejected.


