**APPEAL AGAINST VIOLATE THE SENIORITY FROM THE SERIAL NO. 10, OF THE APPELLANT AS SDFO (BS-17) K P, BY ADDING THE THEN NAMES OF SYED TARIQ ALI SHAH (DFO), AND NOW MR. SHABIR AHMAD (SDFO) AT S.NO. 1 AND MR. ALAMGIR KHAN (SDFO) AT S.NO.2, IN SENIORITY LIST DATED 28.02.2023 AND 31.05.2023, AND PROMOTION OF THE APPELLANT AS A DIVISIONAL FOREST OFFICER (BS-18), AND SAID OFFICERS HAD BEEN FAILED IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE EXAM 2007.**

Respectfully Sheweth;

### FACTS

1. That the then CCF-I has passed an order No.268, dated 27.06.2022, in the capacity of Competent Authority after having considered the above recommendations of the Enquiry Officer in the subject case, exercising his powers under rules- 14 (3) of KP Govt; Servants (E&D) Rules 2011, Muhammad Ali Forest Ranger is hereby exonerated from all the charges leveled against him as per charge sheets/ statement of allegations.  
(Order Dated 27.06.2022, is Annexed as Annexure A)
2. That the appellant had been submitted an appeal to the appellate Authority on dated 31.03.2023 against the seniority.  
(Departmental Appeal dated 31.03.2023, is Annexed as Annexure B)
3. That the Competent Authority (Chief Secretary Khyber Pakhtunkhwa) is pleased to promote Muhammad Ali, Range Forest Officer (BS-16) to the post of Sub Divisional Forest Officer (BS-17) on regular basis in the forest Department, through Notification, No. SO (Estt) FE&WD/1-3/2022, dated 20<sup>th</sup> January 2023.  
(Order Dated 20.02.08.2023, is annexed as Annexure C)
4. That the appellant had been filed an appeal for Seniority and the Appellate Authority has passed an order No. SO(ESTT)/ FE&WD/1-39/2022/KC, Dated 20<sup>th</sup> February 2023, to state that the Seniority of the appellant as a SDFO (BS-17) may be pleased at his due place in the seniority list of SDFO (BS-17) in the light of Para-V (d) of promotion Policy.
5. That the Syed Tariq Ali Shah, (DFO) Mr. Shabir Shmad the then Forest Ranger, and Mr. Alamgir khan the then Forest Ranger, were inducted in

the Deptt; as contract employees and the appellant the then inducted as RFO (BS-16) through PSC Exam in 2007 in the department, all the *above said officers were failed* in said PSC Exam and the appellant had passed the said required exam. While Range Forest Officers (RFO) and SDFOs can only inducted through Public Service commission Exam in the department, therefore name of the said candidate not include in the Seniority list for 22.04.2009.

(Final Seniority list of RFOs 22.04.2009, is Annexed as Annexure D)

6. That in another hand the Syed Tariq Ali Shah, (DFO) had been filed an Appeal in the Honorable High Court/ Dar-ul-Qaza Swat, and get Seniority as Forest Rangers (BS-16) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
7. That in the Final Seniority list of Forest Rangers (BS-16) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, forest department as it stood on 31.08.2014, the both officers were listed i.e. Mr. Shabir Ahmad at S.No. 11, and Mr. Alamgir Khan at S.No. 12, and did not raised any objection against the seniority therefore the Chief Conservator of Forests Central Southern Forest Region has Certified that the Seniority is final, notified, un-disputed and attested, thereafter the both officers has no any cause of action in this regards.

(Final Seniority list of RFOs 31.08.2014, is Annexed as Annexure E)

8. That the Mr. Shabir Ahmad at S. No. 1 and Mr. Alamgir Khan at S. No. 2, and appellant name listed at S. No. 58, in the tentative seniority list of Sub Divisional Forest Officers (BS-17) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, forest department as it stood on 28.02.2023, but same officers were junior from appellant in accordance to the final seniority list of forest rangers (BS-16) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, forest department as it stood on 31.08.2014.

(Tentative Seniority list of SDFs 31.02.2023, and is 31.05.2023, Annexed as Annexure F)

## GROUNDS

- A. That the Post of RFO (BS-16) and SDFO (BS-17) had been inducted in the Forest deptt; through PSC.

- B. That the Appellant had been passed the B.Sc in Forestry in the year 2001, and the department been get undertaking that all the qualified candidates not to be demand the Post of RFO (BS-16) on the bases of contract employee or Qualifications and the appellant had been working as RFO in working plan since 2005 to 2007.
- C. That in another hand the Syed Tariq Ali Shah, (DFO) has get Seniority as Forest Rangers (BS-16) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, forest department on the bases of Canceled the Facts and Mis-represent the case, and the Deptt; had not been defiance the case, and Law Deptt; also failed put up the law point against said appellant accordingly.
- D. That the Mr. Shabir Ahmad at S. No. 1 and Mr. Alamgir Khan at S. No.2 and *said officers were basically contract employees in the Forest department.*
- E. That the then said an officer has to regularized their position in the department had been appeared in the PSC in the year 2007, but they were *failed.*
- F. That the said seniority lists had been affected *my seniority which is based on regular induction in 2007 through PSC and may be count from 2007,* and it is reflected at serial No. 40, in the final seniority list of the RFOs dated 22.04.2009.
- G. That the then said an officer had filed Petition in the Honorable Peshawar High Court/ Dar-ul-Qaza Swat, W.P.No.675-M/2020, and letter dated 15.12.2021, issued by the law department.
- H. That they Mis representative and concealed the facts get regularization and seniority through judgment dated 02.11.2021, and the Honorable Peshawar High Court restored Seniority from w.e.f 24.09.2009, from wrong forum against the Law and Facts.
- I. That the Law Department had over looked the case in accordance to the Facts and Law.

- J. That they were instituted time bought petition without coadunation of delay and get seniority through judgment dated 02,11.2021, from wrong forum.
- K. That the Mr. Shabir Ahmad at S. No. 1 and Mr. Alamgir Khan at S. No. 2, and appellants name listed at S. No. 13, insert of S. No. 10 in the tentative seniority list of Sub Divisional Forest Officers (BS-17) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, forest department as it stood on dated 31.05.2023, and the Syed Tariq Ali Shah (DFO) the then Forest Ranger, has not qualified the PSC Exam 2007.

### PRAYER

It is in the light of above Facts, and read with Para-V (d) of promotion Policy, that the appellant was inducted by PSC in 2007. other hand the Name of the Mr. Shabir Ahmad the then Forest Ranger, Mr. Alamgir Khan the then Forest Ranger, and Syed Tariq Ali Shah (DFO) the then Forest Ranger, has not qualified the PSC Exam 2007. They were counteract employees in the department, and they were not follow the proper way of induction through PSC in the Deptt; therefore requested please pass an order to directed to the Forest Deptt; the Seniority of the appellant as a SDFO (BS-17) may be placed at S. No. 10, in the Seniority list of SDFOs (BS-17) dated 31.05.2023, and also requested to the Provincial Selection Board (PSB) to be considered promotion of the appellant in accordance to Law and Facts. And the appellant could be gave relief in true sense.

Any other remedy which this August Tribunal deems fit and appropriate that, may also be awarded in the favor of appellant.

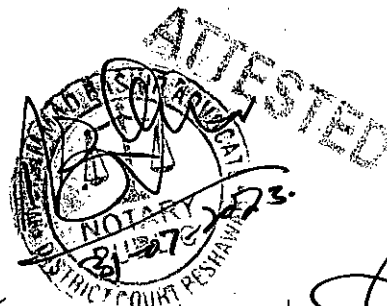


1. That the First Regular Entry in Gov; Service of the appellant in 18.12.1986, as Forest Guard (BS-2) and thereafter forest deptt; re-nominated for B. Sc in Forestry /Training Course 1998-2000, for the Cadre of RFO and then PSC had been re-recommended for the Cadre of RFO/FR (BS-16) in 2007, and CCF NWFP being a Competent Authority had passed an order No. 103, dated 15.11.2007, submitted Arrival Report on dated 27.11.2007.  
 (Appointment order dated 18.12.1986, and CCF order No. 103, Arrival report 27.11.2007 are annexed as Annexure A)
2. That the appellant had been submitted an application to the Chairman Public Service Commission Peshawar, under RTI Act for Full result, recommendation for Seniority in accordance to Merit and Zone 1 to 5 of the RFO/FR (BS-16) for the year 2007, dated 21.08.2023.  
 (Application dated 21.08.2023, is Annexed as Annexure B)
3. That the appellant had been submitted an application to the Respondent No. 4, under RTI Act for Enquiry Report and Full result, recommendation for Seniority in accordance to Merit and Zone 1 to 5 of the RFO/FR (BS-16) dated 21.08.2023, respondents reply for the Petition No.2972/2012, decided on 20.11.2014 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Petition No. 2994/2017, decided on 3.10.2019, copy of the CPLA against Impugned Judgment Dated 20.11.2014.

4. That the Department has by adding the then names of Contract Employee Private Respondent No.5, in the regular Seniority list in the RFOs and SDFOs under regularized Act, and now once again the same deptt; **has violated right of regular seniority of the appellant, the Department has by adding the name of the Private Respondent No.6, at S. No. 1 and Private Respondent No.7, at S.No.2, and appellant name listed at S. No. 13, instead of S. No. 10, in the tentative seniority list of Sub Divisional Forest Officers (BS-17) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, forest department as it stood on 28.02.2023 and 31.05.2023.**

**(Tentative Seniority list of SDFOs 28.02.2023 and 31.05.2023, are annexed as Annexure D)**

5. That the appellant had been submitted an appeal to the Respondent No.4, on dated 31.03.2023 against the seniority has not been responded.

**(Departmental Appeal dated 31.03.2023, is Annexed as Annexure E)**

6. That the then Private Respondent No.5, Private Respondent No.6, and Private Respondent No.7, were inducted in the Deptt; as contract employees and the appellant the then inducted as RFO (BS-16) through PSC Exam in 2007 in the department, all the *above said officers were failed* in said PSC Exam and the appellant had passed the said required exam. While Range Forest Officers (BS-16) and SDFOs (BS-17) can only inducted through Public Service commission Exam in the department, or through Promotion therefore name of the said responded were not listed in the Seniority list for 22.04.2009, and **secondly** the Private Respondent No., Private Respondent No.8, at S. No. 37, in said List, Private Respondent No.9, S. No. 39, and appellant S. No. 40, were not listed in accordance to the PSC recommendations or as per age under the rules.

9. That the Respondent No.2, is pleased to directed to Respondent No.4, to reinstate w.e.f 06.06.2018, with the reference of the Honorable Tribunal Court Judgment dated 19.03.2018, order No. SO (Estt) FE&WD/1-43/2021, dated 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

12. That the Respondent No.2, is pleased to promote Muhammad Ali, Range Forest Officer (BS-16) to the post of Sub Divisional Forest Officer (BS-17) on regular basis in the Forest Department, through Notification, No. SO (Estt) FE&WD/1-3/2022, dated 20<sup>th</sup> January 2023.  
**(Order Dated 20.01.2023, is annexed as Annexure K)**
13. That the appellant had been submitted an appeal for Seniority and the Respondent No.2, has passed an order No. SO(ESTT)/ FE&WD/1-39/2022/KC, Dated 20<sup>th</sup> February 2023, to state that the Seniority of the appellant as a SDFO (BS-17) may be pleased at his due place in the seniority list of SDFO (BS-17) in the light of Para-V (d) of promotion Policy.  
**(Order Dated 20.02.2023, is annexed as Annexure L)**
14. That in the Final Seniority list of Forest Rangers (BS-16) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, forest department as it stood on 31.08.2014, the appellant had been listed at Serial No. 10, and the both officers were listed i.e.



Private Respondent No.6, at S. No. 11, and Private Respondent No.7, at S. No. 12, and did not raised any objection against the seniority.

**(Final Seniority list of RFOs 31.08.2014, is Annexed as Annexure M)**

15. That in another hand the Private Respondent No.5, had been filed **Writ Petition No. 2972/2012**, in the Honorable High Court Peshawar. And the Judgment order passed on dated 20.11.2014.
16. That the Forest Department had not been defended or raised any logical Grounds objection against Civil Appeal being respondents in the Apex Court of the Pakistan i.e. that the Cadre of RFO (BP-16) should be inducted in the Department only through PSC Exam, as a president code appellant name.
17. That the Law Department had also been failed to re-examine the Judgment dated 02.11.2021, in Write Petition No.675-M/2020, passed by the Honorable High Court Mingora Bench/ Dar-ul-Qaza Swat.

## GROUND S

- A. That the First Regular Entry in Gov; Service of the appellant in 18.12.1986, as Forest Guard (BS-2) and thereafter Respondents has nominated for B.Sc in Forestry /Training Course 1998-2000, for the Cadre of RFO and then qualifying PSC, Exam and PSC had been recommended for the Cadre of RFO/FR (BS-16) in 2007, and CCF NWFP being a Competent Authority had passed an order to change the cadre, No. 103, dated 15.11.2007, same like Forest Guard, Forester and Deputy Ranger Trainings and respondents had promote to regular position, in the Department and appellant date of Birth 25.05.1966 and submitted Arrival Report on 27.11.2007, which was un justice and the then the Respondent No. 4 responsible and in accordance recommendation of PSC as like final seniority list 22.04.2009, as Private Respondent No. 8, date of Birth 3.11.1980, and 9, date of Birth 10.04.1975, the appellant have senior in age same recommendations \*right of Seniority was violate by the respondent No.4, under rules 17 (1) and (4) KP Civil Servants (A, P, & T) Rules 1989, and in the, RFOs Bach 2007 at serial No. 36 up to 40.
- B. That the Respondents has by adding the then names of Private Respondent No. 5, Joiner from appellant and Contract Employee and the Respondents had been failed to contest /defend protect the rights of the regular RFOs and SDFOs, this was the Gate which was to open and re-open, ultimately the respondents consider his seniority may be form 1.07.2005, in regular RFO cadre, and in regular SDFO cadre from 24.09.2009, against the NWFP Regularized Act but in accordance

Judgment dated 20.11.2014, in Petition No. 2972/2012, and Judgment 03.10.2019, in Petition No. 2994/2017, \* **Private Respondent No. 5**, did not made the appellant and others as Ex-Parte in both the Judgments and passed by the Honorable Peshawar High Court, against the **Seniority of the Govt; Servants** thereafter the counteract employees and Joiner from appellant had been used as President to violate the rights of the appellant.

C. That the Judgment dated 20.11.2014, in Petition No. 2972/2012, and Judgment 03.10.2019, in Petition No. 2994/2017, both the Judgments based on either NWFP Regularized Act No. IX- of 2005 and \***Section No.4**, of the NWFP Regularized of Service Act No. XVI- of 2009, did not permit the Seniority, against the **Regular Govt; Servants**, but the respondents has been \*violated right of placement of in Regular Seniority **of the appellant and others**, the Respondent No.4 has by adding the name of the Private Respondent No. 6, at S. No. 1 and Private Respondent No. 7, at S.No.2, and appellant name listed at S. No. 13, in the tentative seniority list of Sub Divisional Forest Officers (BS-17) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, forest department as it stood on 28.02.2023 and 31.05.2023.

D. That the Respondents had not follow up the Enquiry Report has 2<sup>nd</sup> Part which lead to Malafide attention against the appellant *"The department shall conduct proceedings to enquire, dig out facts and to proceed against delinquents to recovers loss sustained to Govt; /department if any, as pointed out by the accused in his counter allegations. This will provide mental satisfaction to the accused for the hardship he faced in defending the seven year long proceedings and discriminatory treatment."*

**Who will pay the cost of irreparable losses of the appellant and his Family?**

E. That the tentative seniority list of Sub Divisional Forest Officers (BS-17) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, forest department as it stood on 28.02.2023 and 31.05.2023, and \*may also be violated the right of promotion as a DFO (BS-18) in accordance to the actual seniority.

F. That the Appellant had been passed the B. Sc in Forestry in the year 2001, and the department been get undertaking that all the qualified candidates not to be demand the Post of RFO (BS-16) as like on the bases of contract employee or Qualifications and the appellant had been

working as RFO in working plan since 2005 to 2007, on this ground being permanent employee of the forest Deptt; appellant have not the right to get seniority from 2005 till until the except qualifying PCS Exam for RFO cadre.

- G. That **Secondly** the Private Respondent No. 5, the then Forest Ranger BS-16 (counteract employee) and having a charge as a SDFO Komila / Dassu Kohistan, which was not possible before 20.11.2014, he was counteract employee, but due to political influence (at that time he was PA to Forest Minister it is on record), Private Respondent No. 5, the then Forest Ranger had been filed Writ Petition No. 2972/2012, with **\*fraudulently and Mis-represented on the wrong form Regularizations is not emergency case**, Private Respondent No. 5, liable to proceed against section 12(2) CPC to the Same Higher Court this ground had not be took by the Respondents of the forest Deptt; and Law department.
- H. That the Forest Department had been **advertised the RFO (BS-16) cadre posts in 1988, 1989, 1997, and 2007**, appellant and the Private Respondent No. 5, 6 and 7, before appeared in PSC Exam for the cadre of RFO (BS-16) in 2007, and the said Private Respondents No. 5, 6, and 7, were failed except appellant was passed, **It is factual logical Ground which was not raised by the respondent or other objection in the Civil Appeal being respondents in the Apex Court of the Pakistan**. And the respondents had been failed to protect the valuable rights of the ten (10) Regular RFOs for Promotion against the three (3) contract employees. \* This CPLA gave **Hugh loss to the Govt; Regular Servant and Appellant to violet the position in seniority list**.
- I. That the Law Department had also been failed to re-examine Judgment dated 02.11.2021, in Write Petition No.675-M/2020, passed by the Honorable High Court Mingora Bench/ Dar-ul-Qaza Swat, and grounds against **Private Respondent No. 6, and Private Respondent No. 7 were Joiner from appellant and now they were Senior from appellant and said Private Respondents are not make Ex. Parte to the appellant and others**.
- J. ***And another hand to Violate the rights of 10 regular SDFOs, said Judgments, Forest Deptt; and Law Deptt; make their self as Party because that Private Respondent No. 5, 6, and 7 should be regular from the date of Judgment”, According to constitution of Pakistan, all citizens are equal before law and entitle to equal protection of law, Fundamental rights, Articles 8 to 28).***

Whereas the Deptt; has vacant Posts in any cadre proceed in accordance to the Govt; GAZETTE Notification in this case of SDFOs 1<sup>st</sup> Respondents may proceed twenty percent by Promotion through DPC, before in each inducted through initial recruitment of the SDFOs. But the Respondents had been violated three times of the right of promotion of the regular RFOs, to the cadre of SDFOs, through DPC, but the Respondents to proceeded against the law and Justice through initial recruitment of the respective SDFOs, (i) Private Respondent No. 10, S. No. 3 up to Private Respondent No. 11, at S. No. 04, on dated 09.10.2015, (ii) Private Respondent No. 12, S. No. 5 up to Private Respondent No. 13, at S. No. 06, on dated 14.12.2017, (iii) Private Respondent No. 14, S. No 07 up to Private Respondent No. 18, at S. No. 11, on dated 12.06.2018, and \*thereafter twenty percent RFOs Promoted on dated 13.12.2018.

- K. That the to protect the right of Seniority of the appellant also file an application for stay order along with this appeal, All the three ingredients, Doctrine for the grant of temporary injunction, existence of Prima Facie Case, Balance of Convenience in the right of appellant, and Doctrine of Irreplaceable losses are available in the favor of appellant.


### PRAYER







- f) He will not be entitled to any TA/DA on his first appointment as Forest Ranger.


