Preliminary Objections:

(1-5) All objections raised by the respondents are incorrect and baseless. Rather the respondents are estopped to raise any objection due to their own conduct.

GROUNDS:

A) Incorrect. The action of the department is not lawful and they order dated 14.1.2013 and 14.11.2013 are against the law, facts, material

- B) Incorrect. While para B of the appeal is correct.
- C) Incorrect. The appellant never remained absent from her duty which is evident from the attendance register and report which are attached as Annexure-A with the appeal.

- F) Incorrect. The whole action of the department is arbitrary and not sustainable in the eyes of law.

- H) Incorrect. Hence denied.

- C) Incorrect. The appellant never remained absent from her duty which is evident from the attendance register and report which are attached as Annexure-A with the appeal.
- D) Not replied according to para D of the appeal.

- E) Incorrect. While para E of the appeal is correct.
- F) Not replied according to para F of the appeal moreover para F of the appeal is correct.

- I) Legal.
