2. That appellant was deputed to Training Centre Abbotabad and after qualifying the training from the said Centre, he was posted at Police Line Timergera.

That being active he was selected for DCT now CTD and was deputed to Peshawar for service. He also participated in the operation.

That appellant was allowed 05 days casual leave with effect from 07-08-2009 but he could not report back for duty as by then Swat Valley was in clutches of the miscreants and it was well in knowledge of every one that they were ruling the area and the government machinery was totally collapsed. Employees were kidnapping, beheading and killing either through guns or bomb blasts. In such a situation employees of almost all of every department let their services, especially of the police department which was in target of the miscreants.

5. That on account of absence, appellant was removed from service on 14-01-2010 by R. No. 1 with effect from the date of absence ' from duty i.e. 07-08-2009. (Copy as Annex "A")

6. That thereafter appellant submitted appeal before R. No. 02 on 02-02-2010 for reinstatement in service after receipt of the impugned order but no heed was paid to the same (Copy as Annex "B")

- 7. That subsequent appeal was filed before R. No. 02 for reinstatement in service which was rejected on 25-05-2018 but no copy was endorsed to appellant. (Copies as Annex "C" & "D")
- 8. That on 29-08-2018, appellant submitted application for the supply of the documents mentioned therein and in pursuance of the same copy of order dated 25-05-2018 was delivered to him on 14-09-2018. (Copy as Annex "E")
- 9. That not only appellant was dismissed from service on the score of absence but numerous others were also dismissed as such and they were reinstated into their services vide order dated 30-11-2010, 15-03-2017 and 09-08-2017 (Copies as Annex "F")

10. That apart from the aforesaid fact, the subject matter came up for consideration before the hon'ble Tribunal and after thorough probe, their appeal's were accepted vide judgments dated02-05-2016 and 07-12-2017, etc. (Copies as Annex "G")

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Hence this appeal, inter alia, on the following grounds:

### <u>GROUNDS:</u>

a. That appellant was enlisted in service in the year 2007 and served the department till the date of removal from service.

b. That at the time, the Swat Valley was in clutches of the miscreants and it is will in knowledge of every one that they were ruling the area and the government machinery was totally collapsed. Employees were kidnapping, beheading and killing either through guns or bomb blasts. In such a situation employees of almost all of every department let their services, especially of the police department.

- c. That appellant was removed from service on the score of absence but such absence was not willful but was due to the deteriorated situation of the area.
- d. That absence does not constitute any misconduct when the same is not willful and as stated earlier, hundreds and thousands similarly and equally placed employees have been reinstated into their services not only by the department but also by the hon'ble Tribunal / courts which judgments were upheld by the apex court.
- e. That no executive order could be effected respectively.
- f. That codal formalities enumerated in the Rules were never observed, being mandatory. The impugned order not per the mandate of Law and based on malafide.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of appeal, order dated 14-01-2010 and 25-05-2018 of the respondents be set aside and appellant be reinstated in service with all consequential / back benefits, with such other relief as may be deemed proper and just in circumstances of the case.

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This islan order, passed on regular Departmental Enquiry conducted against Constable Hameedur Rehman NO. 315 DCT, SB: for his welful obsence w.e.f. 07.08.2009: Facts are that the Constable concerned while posted to Police Station, DC1, SB: was due back from 5 days Casual Leave with effect trom 07.08.2009, but he badly failed to report back for duty. As such a report against him was entered in the Daily Dairy vide item No.14 dated 07.08.2009 Police Station DET. SB. Owing to which he was served with charge sheet and Statement of allegations, vide this office Endst: No. 3754-55/DCT /SB dated 09:10:2009 and enquiry Committee Consisting of DSP Zafar Hayat Khan and Inspector Khan Akbar Khan was constitution for initiating proceedings against the delinquent Constable under the NWFP removal from Service (Special Power) Ordinance, 2000.

The Charge Sheet was delivered to the father of the Constable at his home by Constable Alamgir No. 313 of DCT. SB: At the time of delivery of the Charge Sheet, Mr. Abdullah son of Firdus Khan Resident of Dheri. Taimergara told the Constable that his son Constable Hameed Ur Rehman has gone to Saudi: Arabia for labouring. These facts were also verified from him by the Engulty: Committee on CELL No. 0346/8981469. On the recommendation of the Enquiry Committee, Final Show Cause Notice which was issued to the Constable vide Endst: No. 4347/SRC/DCT/SB: dated 07.12.2009. 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

MAZ MUHAMMAD KHAN, CHAIRMAN: - This judgment shall also disposed of other connected appeals No. 697/2016 Muhammad Said, No. 958/2016 Fazal Yaseen, No. 959/2016 Afzal Khan, and No. 961/2016 Umar Ali as in all the appeals common questions of law and facts are involved.

# <u>Facts</u>'

3. The appellant Shaukat Ali, Umar Ali and Alzal Khan were removed from service on 28.08.2016, the appellant Fazal Yascen was removed from

service on 02.02.2009 and the appellant Muhammad Saeed was removed from service on 21.09.2009. The appellants then filed departmental appeals belatedly, which were rejected then the appellant also approached this Tribunal belatedly not within the stipulated time.

## ARGUMENTS

4. The learned counsel for the appellants argued that the very orders of removal from service are void because all these orders have been given retrospective effect. That in view of judgment reported as 1985-SCMR-1178 nolimitation shall run against void order.

5. On the other hand the learned Addl. Advocate General argued that the departmental appeals are hopelessly time barred. That the revision within the meaning of Rule 11 -A of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules, 1975 could not enlarge the period of limitation. That all the codal formalities were lutfilled by the department.

#### CONCLUSION

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6. Regardless of other merits of the case it is an admitted position that allthese orders have been given retrospective effect and in view of so many judgments delivered by this Tribunal on the basis of judgment reported in 1985. SCMR-1178 the retrospective order is a void order and no limitation shall run against void order.

7. Since no limitation runs against a void order, any successive appeals of revision would not curtail the rights of the appellants qua the limitation or in other

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respect. Presuming that all other elements of due processes have been complied with, the void order cannot be sustained on this score alone.

Correct to the extent that the petitioner was allowed 05 days casual leave but he badly failed to report back for duty. A report against his absence was entered in the daily diary vide No. 14 dated 07.08.2009. Proper charge sheet was issued and enquiry committee was constituted to carry proper enquiry against him. The charge sheet was delivered to the father of the petitioner at his home by constable Alamgir No. 313. At the time of delivery of charge sheet, Mr. Abdullah, father of the present petitioner told the constable that his son Hameed Ur Rehman has gone to Saudi Arabia for laboring. This fact was also verified from him by the enquiry committee. Final show cause notice was also issued to him. Which was also received by his cousin Saleem Ur Rehman but neither he submitted replies nor bother to appear before enquiry committee nor reported back for duty. Moreover, the petitioner voluntarily accepted that he left his service due to the fear of miscreants.

> Keeping inview of his confession such person is not fit for police job because this department needs bold and courageous persons to fight against

the criminals and miscreants but the petitioner prove himself a coward man who escape from Pakistan due to the fear of miscreants therefore, his service appeal may please be dismissed.

- 5. Incorrect, appellant was not only removed from service on allegation of absentee but it was also proved that he left for Saudi Arabia for labouring. Moreover, he also accepted in Para 4 that he left Police department due to the fear of miscreants which shows that the appellant was a cowardman which is not fit for police job.
- 6. Incorrect and rebutted. The petitioner never submitted any appeal against his removal order in time.
- 7. The appeal was filed because the same was badly time barred case for about 08 years.
- 8. Pertains to record hence no comments.
- 9. Incorrect, appellant proceeded abroad and willfully absented himself from lawful duties. Moreover, the case of the petitioner is different from other persons mentioned by him.
- 10. Incorrect, these cases were thoroughly different from the case of petitioner.

#### **GROUNDS:-**

- a. Incorrect: Petitioner was removed from service due to his wilfull absence and he proceeded to Saudi Arabia for laboring due to the fear of miscreants.

The enquiry committee also recorded the statement of his cousin Saleem Ur Rehman who verified that Hameed Ur Rehman proceeded Saudi Arabia for laboring. (Copy of statement is enclosed).
- d. Reply to this Para has already been explained in the previous Paras.
- e. Incorrect: Appellant was removed from service after conducting proper departmental enquiry. All the formalities were adopted. The competent authority passed his removal order.
- f. Incorrect: All codal formalities were adopted and strictly followed. Copies of charge sheet, final show cause notice, enquiry report and copies of statement are enclosed as Annexure "A", "B", "C".

Prayer:

It is therefore, prayed that the appeal of appellant may be dismissed being meritless and badly time barred, hit by doctrine of laches.

- 2) By reasons of the Statement of Allegations, you appear to be guilty of misconduct/negligence under section 3 of the NWFP, Removal from Service (Special Powers) Ordinance 2000 and have rendered yourself liable to all or any of the penalty specified in section 3 of the Ordinance.
- 3) You are therefore, required to submit your written defence within (07) seven days of the receipt of this charge sheet to the Enquiry Committee as the case may be.
- 4) Your written defence, if any should reach the Enquiry Committee within the specified period failing which it shall be presumed that you have no defence to put up and in that case ex-part action shall follow against you.
- 5) Intimate whether you desire to be heard in person.
- 6) Statement of Allegations is enclosed.

## **DISCIPLINARY ACTION.**

Owing to his absence his pay has also been stopped vide this office letter No. 3237/Acctt: dated 02.09.2009.

It has also come to the notice that the defaulter Constable has proceeded Dubai in connection with his livelihood.

- 2. For the purpose of scrutinizing the conduct of the said accused with the reference of the above allegations, an Enquiry Committee consisting of the following officers is constituted under section 3 of the Ordinance:-

4. The accused and a well conversant departmental representative shall join the proceedings on the date, time and place fixed by the Enquiry Committee.
