APPEAL U/S 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT 1974, AGAINST THE ORDER COMMUNICATED TO THE APPELLANT VIDE LETTER DATED 06-10-2022 WHEREBY APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT FOR COUNTING HIS PREVIOUS SERVICE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAY PROTECTION AND PENSION HAS BEEN REGRETTEED.

PRAYER:-

On acceptance of this appeal, the impugned order communicated to the appellant vide letter dated 06-10-2022 may kindly be set aside and respondents may kindly be directed to count previous contract service of the appellant for the purpose of pay protection and pension with all back benefits.

Respectfully Submitted:-

1. That the appellant being qualified was appointed as Lecturer Maths (BPS-17) after due process of law and upon recommendations of Selection Committee in erstwhile FATA for the project period or till the creation of regular posts/arrival of KP Public Service Commission vide Order dated 28-08-2003 and was posted to Govt. Degree College Ghaljo Orakzai Agency. **(Copy of Order dated 28-08-2003 is enclosed as Annexure A).**
2. That in the meanwhile the posts of Male Lecturers were advertised by respondent department and appellant being perfectly fit and eligible and coming up to the criteria also applied for the same through proper channel and finally after due process of law and upon the recommendations of

Departmental Selection Committee was appointed as Lecture Male (BPS-17) Maths vide Notification dated 07-09-2005 and was posted to Govt. Degree College Thana Malakand Agency and after appointment was relived from service by the Principal Govt. Degree College Ghaljo Orakzai Agency on 12-09-2005 vide letter of even date. **(Copy of Notification dated 07-09-2005 & Letter dated 12-09-2005 is enclosed as Annexure B).**

3. That the services of the appellant were duly extended by the respondents sane any break vide Notifications dated 18-05-2006, Notification dated 21-10-2006, Notification dated 21-10-2006, Notification dated 06-06-2007 & Notification dated 21-10-2008. **(Copies of Notifications dated 18-05-2006, Notification dated 21-10-2006, Notification dated 06-06-2007 & Notification dated 21-10-2008 are enclosed as Annexure C).**

4. That there after the posts of Lecturers were advertised by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission Peshawar on regular basis and the and appellant being perfectly fit and eligible and coming up to the criteria also applied for the same through proper channel and finally after due process of law and upon the recommendations of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission was appointed as Lecture of Maths. (BPS-17) vide Notification dated 14-03-2009 and was posted to Govt. Degree College Kohi Sher Haider Bara Khyber Agency and after appointment was relived from service by the Principal Govt. Degree College Thana Malakand Agency on 16-03-2009 vide letter of even date. Since appointment appellant performed his duties with honesty and full devotion and to the entire satisfaction of his high ups. **(Copy of Notification dated 14-03-2009 & Letter dated 16-03-2009 is enclosed as Annexure D).**

5. That the appellant time and again approached respondents that he may be extended the benefits of previous service for the purpose of Pay Protection and Pension however department was not ready to count the Previous service of the appellant of about five years and seven months for the purpose of pay protection and pension in violation of the law, rules and numerous Judgments rendered by this as well as of the Apex Court where after the appellant approached the honorable Peshawar High Court, Peshawar by filing Writ Petition No 1617-P/2020 which was finally disposed of with directions to the respondents to treat it as departmental appeal and decide the

same within two months in accordance with law vide Order and Judgment dated 24-11-2021, however representation of the appellant was regretted by the respondents copy of which was communicated to the appellant vide Letter dated 06-10-2022. **(Copy of Writ Petition, Order/Judgment dated 24-11-2021 & Letter dated 06-10-2022 is enclosed as Annexure E & F).**

6. That the impugned order communicated to the appellant vide Letter dated 06-10-2022 and not counting the previous service of the appellant w.e.f 28-08-2003 to 16-03-2009 for the purpose of pay protection and pension etc. is against the law, facts and principles of justice on grounds inter-alia as follows:-

GROUND:-

- A.** That the impugned order communicated to the appellant vide letter dated 06-10-2022 is illegal and void ab-initio.
- B.** That mandatory provisions of law are badly violated by the department who are not ready to treat the appellant according to law and rules being his fundamental right as per Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution and law of the land.
- C.** That Pension Rules 1963 as well as the Civil Service Regulations are very much clear on the point which gives protection to such previous service for the purpose of pay protection and pension.
- D.** That a number of Judgments rendered by this honorable Tribunal, by the Peshawar High Court as well as the Apex Court of the Country have also given protection to such service to be counted for the purpose of pay protection and pension. Similarly writ petition No 1188-P/2014 titled as Baghi Shah VS Govt. of KPK, Judgment dated 01-03-2018 passed in Writ Petition No 3221-P/2013 and others besides Rule 2.1 of the Pension Rules is also support the case of the appellant. **(Copies of Judgments are enclosed as Annexure G).**
- E.** That the service rendered by the appellant was uninterrupted and even the provincial Govt. has recently issued 'Notification for giving protection of previous service to its employees for pay protection.

- F. That the appellant has been deprived of his due rights without any omission or commission on his part in violation of the principles of natural justice.
- G. That the appellant has been discriminated as such service of other employees has been counted while appellant is not extended such benefits and is treated differently.
- H. That the appellant has long service career of about seventeen years with unblemished service record.
- I. That the appellant seeks the permission of this honorable tribunal for further/additional grounds at the time of arguments.

It is therefore prayed that appeal of the appellant may kindly be accepted as prayed for in the heading of the appeal.

iii. *Any other relief, which is not specifically asked for, may also be granted in favor of the petitioner against the respondents."*

2. In essence, grievance of petitioners is that under the law, they are entitled to get the benefits of their pre-regularization service *as Junior Clerk (BPS-07)* towards their pay and pension; which has illegally been denied to them by the BoG in its meeting held on 25.6.2021.

3. Pursuant to notice, the respondents filed their comments wherein they resisted the issuance of the desired writ by raising certain legal and factual objections. Their main contention was that, the issue under consideration had earlier been decided by this Court in WP 1487-P/2016 and; there was a break in service of the petitioners and; hence, instant petitions need summarily dismissal.

4. Heard; record perused.

5. Record reveals that initially, both the petitioners were appointed as Junior Clerks in BPS-07 on 04.6.2011 & 12.9.2012 respectively by the Chairman, Board of

Intermediate & Secondary Education, Peshawar, on temporary basis, for a period of six months. whereafter, their services were extended from time to time till 18.3.2014 and 01.01.2014. Subsequently, their services were regularized w.e.f. 10.11.2016, on 02.8.2018, in light of the judgment dated 06.02.2018 of this Court rendered in WP 3604-P/2017 read with Govt of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Elementary & Secondary Education Department Letter No.SO(B/T) E&SE/5-14/2016/BISE, Peshawar, dated 24.11.2016 and the judgment of august Apex Court dated 06.7.2018. After regularization, the petitioners once again approached this Court for counting their pre-regularization service for pay protection and pensionary benefits cum seniority in WP 6703-P/2019, which was decided, on 15.12.2020, in the following manner;

"The claim of the petitioners regarding counting their previous service for the purpose of pay and pension has not been decided by the respondents-Board; as such, we left this issue for the respondents/Board to decide it at their own level, but no later than a period of 03 months with intimation to the petitioners. Thereafter, if petitioners still find themselves aggrieved of the denial of protection of pay and pension, may approach the proper forum, available to them under the law."

In view of the *ibid* findings the matter was placed before the BoG for consideration, which was taken up in its meeting No.51 dated 25.6.2021 at agenda Item No.14; however, the BoG did not agree with the pay and pensionary benefits of the petitioners due to the alleged break in their service from time to time.

6. Undeniably, the service of petitioners have been regularized by the respondents after rendering long and satisfactory service as Junior Clerks on Contract basis with an artificial breaks. The petitioners while relying on the Rule 2.3 of K P Civil Servants Pension Rules, 1963 solicited for counting the period of their contract service towards their pay and pensionary benefits. Learned counsel representing the respondents could not controvert the *ibid* contention of the petitioners, rather, candidly admitted at the bar the adaptation of *ibid* rule by the respondent No 2. The *ibid* rule provides that temporary and officiating service of an employee shall be counted towards his pay and pension. In this respect, wisdom can also be derived from *Muhammad Farooq's* reported in 2012 CLJ 343 wherein it was held that, "Government Servant continuously remaining in service without break would, after his regularization have the right that the period of his service before regularization be counted

towards his pay and pensionary benefits". Besides, the Courts being the custodian of law, have to safeguard the inalienable rights of the citizens as enshrined in the Constitution and; whenever any such infringement of rights is brought to the notice of the Court that is to be struck down. In the instant case, since respondents have illegally denied the petitioners benefits of their pre regularization service towards their pay and pension, therefore, the impugned order is liable to be struck down; being illegal. Wisdom can also be drawn from 2021 SCMR 116 "Syed Muddasar Shah Termizi and others Vs. Peshawar High Court, Peshawar through Registrar and others"

7. In view thereof, both the writ petitions are, allowed as prayed for, but only to the extent of their pay and pension.

IKRAMULLAH KHAN, J. - Petitioners have

filed instant Constitutional petition for issuance of an appropriate writ with the following prayer:-

"On acceptance of this writ petition the non-counting of previous service of the petitioners towards pay protection and pensionary benefits by the respondents may be declared as illegal, unconstitutional, arbitrary and exploitation of the past good service of the petitioners. The respondents may further please be directed to give full pay protection with pensionary benefits of the past service rendered by the petitioners to meet the ends of justice and principles of equity. Any other remedy which this august court deems fit and not specifically prayed for that may also be awarded in favour of petitioners."

2. In essence, petitioners were appointed in the year 1990 and onwards by the Political Agent, Bajaur

Agency as Principal, Teachers, Ministerial Staff and Class-IV employees, in the Bajaur Public School and College with the condition that they would be allowed pay scales and other allowances admissible to a Civil Servant in Bajaur Agency. Later on, the Bajaur Public School and College was taken into supervision and control by the Federal Government and services of all the employees appointed by the Political Agent, Bajaur Agency on contract basis were made regularized vide Notification issued by the Governor's Secretariat, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar on March 28, 2013.

In para-4 of the Notification, it has been held that all the eligible incumbent teaching and non-teaching staff will be adjusted against the regular sanctioned posts on merit cum seniority in service in the respective scales and categories. As the petitioners were eligible to be regularized, as such, they were adjusted on regular newly created posts with immediate effect vide order dated 20.5.2013, however, the previous services rendered by the petitioners were not counted towards their pay and pension by the respondents, hence, the instant writ petition.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners contended that though the services of petitioners were regularized since 2013 but the respondents have denied

the benefit of protection of pay and pensionary benefits to the petitioners on the sole ground that the previous services rendered by them were on contract basis, as such, it could not be counted towards the length of their service, which act of respondents is against law.

4. On the other hand, learned counsel for respondents contended that the services of petitioners were not either on contract or adhoc basis, but they were appointed by the Political Agent, therefore, the period of services rendered by the petitioners in the concerned School could not be counted towards their pay and pension, etc.

5. We have heard learned counsel for the parties in light of law and available record.

6. The first appointment orders of the petitioners reveal that though they were appointed by the Political Agent, Bajaur Agency but on the condition that the petitioners will receive all the benefits and allowances admissible under the rules to a Civil Servant. The Notification issued by the worthy Governor, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa itself reveals rather admitted therein that petitioners were on contract basis and their services were regularized. Rule 2.1 of Chapter-II (Service Qualifying for Pension) of Civil

Servants Act, 1973, prescribes conditions of qualifications for pension, which read as:-

Rule 2.1. Conditions of Qualifications.-The service of a Government Servant does not qualify for pension unless it conforms to the following three conditions:-

First:- The Service must be under Government.

Second:- The Service must not be non-pensionable.

Third:- The service must be paid by Government from the Provincial Consolidated Fund.

Note- (1) For the previous service of displaced Government Servants which qualifies for pension see Chapter-VII.

Note- (2) Service rendered after retirement on superannuation pension / retiring pension shall not count for pension or gratuity.

7. The abovementioned rule admittedly shall be applied to the case of petitioners as they were appointed on the conditions applicable to the Civil Servants. This court in Writ Petition No.1188-P/2014 titled "Baghi Shah Versus The Govt. of KPK through Secretary Finance, Peshawar and two others, decided on 9.9.2014 has held that:-

"The Courts, being the custodian, are to safeguard the inalienable rights of the citizens as enshrined in

the constitution. Whenever any such infringement of rights is brought to the notice of the court that is to be struck down. Here in the instant case, since respondents have not denied discrimination as averred in the petition, so their act of depriving the petitioner of his pensionary benefits is not condonable and is liable to be struck down."

8. Similarly, this court while resolving the identical proposition of law in case titled "**Muhammad Arif Versus The Secretary to Government of KPK, Transport Department, Peshawar and other**" decided on 24.11.2014 has held : "that the period served by a Government Servant on contract basis shall be counted towards his pensionary benefits, after regulation, in accordance with Rule 2.3 of the West Pakistan Civil Services Pension Rules, 1963."

9. Likewise, in case titled "**Muhammad Farooq Versus Engineer In Chief, ENC Branch, General Headquarters (GHQ), Rawalpindi** reported as (2012 CLJ 343), the Honourable Lahore High Court has held as follows:-

"Government Servant continuously remaining in service without break would after his regularization have

the right that the period of his service before regularization be counted towards his pay, pension and promotion."

10. This Court has decided a number of Writ Petitions through its consolidated judgment dated 22.6.2017 delivered in WP No.3394-P/2016 has held: "that the person selected for appointment on contract basis and thereafter his regularization, the period served as a contract employee shall be counted towards his pension, pay and promotion, etc."

11. The facts as well as the legal proposition involved in this case is similar to the one already decided by this court in the above mentioned cases; therefore, this court could not take a different view, therefore, this writ petition is disposed of in the term that the services rendered by the petitioners as contract employees shall be considered towards their pay and pension.



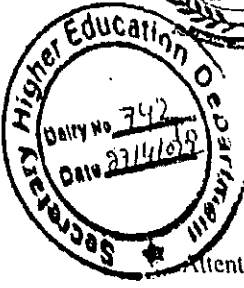

Dear Sir,

In pursuance to the Finance Division's Office Memorandum No.4(2)R-2/2014-237 dated 7th April, 2015, the Competent Authority (Provincial Cabinet) is pleased to allow the pay protection to gazette contract employees on their regularization / Appointment on regular basis subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) That the contract appointment has been made in BPS on standard terms and conditions circulated by this Provincial Government as amended from time to time.
- (ii) That the contract employee has applied through proper channel and has been properly relieved by the appointing authority. This condition shall not apply in case of authority on the same post.
- (iii) The regularization / regular appointment has been made with the approval of competent authority.
- (iv) That there is no break / interruption between contract service and regular service.

Contributory Provident Fund. For the said fund 10% contribution will be made by the Provincial Government and 10% by the Civil Servant concerned in the prescribed manner. Provided further that, in the event of death of the civil servant, whether before or after retirement, his family shall be entitled to receive the said amount, if it has not already been received by the concerned deceased civil servant. They will have all rights / privileges contained in NWFP Civil Servants Act, 1973 with all amendments made therein including NWFP Civil Servants (Amendment) Act, 2005 and Rules made there under.
