SETTING ASIDE ORDER DATED 05-01-2023 RENDERED BY THE
HONOURABLE SERVICE TRIBUNAL, KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA
PESHAWAR IN APPEAL NO.4998 OF 2021 TITLED SAJAD ALI VS. GOVT
OF KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA ETC. ON THE BASIS OF FRAUD,
MISREPRESENTATION, MIS-JOINDER AND NON-JOINDER &
CONCEALMENT OF FACTS.

Respectfully Sheweth,

It is humbly submitted before this honorable Service Tribunal;

1. That the respondent No. 1 (appellant in service appeal) brought in a Service Appeal before this Honorable Tribunal. Copy of the Service Appeal is **Annex-A.**
2. That the respondents in the said service appeal were put on notice and they filed their comments in the subject case.
Copy of the comments is Annex-B
3. That in respect of Seniority of civil servants graded BPS-17 & above, the competent authority to issue such directions is either the Chief Secretary or the Chief Minister, and the Administrative Secretary is not vested with any authority to grant any relief.
4. That during the pendency of the Service Appeal, a letter dated 20-07-2022 was issued by the Secretary of High Education, whereby, directions were given for correcting the seniority of the Appellant, and the same was provided by the Appellant before this Honourable Tribunal, based on which the Appellant submitted that the desired relief has been otherwise granted.
5. That in view of the invalid letter dated 20-07-2022 issued by an incompetent authority i.e., Secretary of Higher Education, the Honourable Tribunal was defrauded.
6. That by virtue of order dated 05-01-2023, the appeal was rendered "fruit-less" by the worthy Tribunal, hence, subsequently the appeal should have been "dismissed", instead of being "disposed off", since the same was rendered as baseless by the worthy Tribunal.
(Copy of the Order dated 05-01-2023 has been **Annexed-C**)
7. That a fresh seniority list was issued by falsely basing it on the order dated 05-01-2023, by completely disregarding the fact that the Service Tribunal in the said order had given no such directions, however, since the appeal rendered

“fruitless” but was not “dismissed” and instead “disposed off” by the Service Tribunal, a fresh seniority list was wrongfully issued, however, with no directions by the worthy Tribunal in context, hence, making the fresh seniority list as void and baseless.

(Copy of the Seniority list is Annex-D)

8. That having narrated the facts as they transpired, and having had prima facie established the factum of fraud and misrepresentation employed in obtaining the impugned order dated 05-01-2023 passed by this very Service Tribunal, on grounds, inter alia, as follows:

GROUND:

- A. **Because** for the promotion of civil servants graded BPS-17 & above, the competent authority to issue such directions is either the Chief Secretary or the Chief Minister, however, it was the Secretary of Higher Education who issued the said directions, making the letter dated 20-07-2022 invalid before the supreme law of the land. *The order is therefore obtained through fraud.*
- B. **Because** by virtue of order dated 05-01-2023, the appeal was rendered “*fruitless*” by the worthy Tribunal, hence, subsequently the appeal should have been “*dismissed*”, instead of being “*disposed off*”.
- C. **Because** since the appeal was rendered as baseless by the worthy Tribunal, then the same should have been “dismissed”, and not “disposed off”.
- D. **Because** a fresh seniority list was issued by falsely basing it on the order dated 05-01-2023, by completely disregarding the fact that the Service Tribunal in the said order had given no such directions to correct the seniority of the Appellant.
- E. **Because** since the appeal was rendered “fruitless” but was not “dismissed” and instead “disposed off” by the Service Tribunal, a fresh seniority list was wrongfully issued, however, with no directions by the worthy Tribunal in context, hence, making the fresh seniority list as void and baseless.
- F. **Because** if the appeal was dismissed by the worthy Tribunal, and subsequently then, a fresh seniority list was issued, then merely the seniority list would have been challenged, however, regardless of the fact that the worthy Tribunal rendered the appeal as fruitless, it was still not dismissed, giving an opportunity for the authorities to misinterpret and misuse the order dated 05-01-2023 rendered by the Service Tribunal to their own wrongful benefit.

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G. Because there is no legal bar in way of recalling and setting aside the impugned Order, rather it would be just and expedient and would meet the ends of justice, saving the applicants from grave hardship.

Any other ground which may also be raised at the time of arguing this petition with prior permission of this Honourable Court.

PRAYER

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this application/petition, the order dated 05-01-2023, mentioned supra, may most graciously be recalled and set aside, with costs.



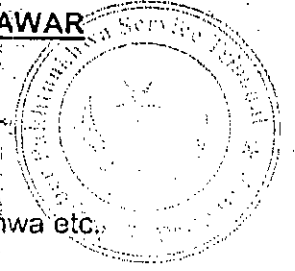



PRAYER IN APPEAL:

- (a) Directing the Respondent's No. 1 to 4 to allow ante dated promotion to the appellant as Assistant Professor (BPS-18) with retrospective effect from 03-04-2012 when the post of Assistant Professor fell / lying vacant in the respondent department against the 60% quota reserved for promotion in view of the rules available at the time of sanction availability / creation of the post with all the benefits of continuous service.
- (b) Further directing the respondent department to place the appellant at his proper place of seniority at serial No. 16 of the seniority list of Assistant Professors (BPS-18) of Government Colleges of Management Sciences / Commerce, above directly appointed Assistant Professors, i.e respondents No. 5 to 27.
- (c) Any other remedy deemed appropriate may also be granted in addition to the relief claimed above.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH


1. Being qualified and eligible, the appellant was selected and appointed as Instructor / Lecturer (Maths) vide notification dated 15-05-2007 in the Provincial Government industries, Commerce, Min: Dev Labour and Technical Education Department (In commerce colleges presently attached with the Higher Education Department). The appellant was promoted as Assistant Professor (BPS-18) on 10-08-2018. He has been serving the department continuously till date. (Copy Annexed "A")
2. That while serving as Lecturer (BPS-17) a post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18) fell vacant on retirement of Mr. Anwar Ul haq, Assistant Professor (BPS-18) on 03-04-2012. Thus the appellant was entitled to be promoted on the said post as Assistant Professor (B-18) on the basis of seniority cum fitness. (Copy Annexed "B")
3. The said post of Assistant Professor (B-18) was lying vacant and the respondent department was required to promote the Senior Instructor/ Lecturer (B-17) on the basis 60% of the available posts in view of the Technical Education Recruitment Rules issued vide notification No. SOIII(IND)TE/4-13/2010 dated 03-12-2010. (Copy annexed hereto marked "C").
4. The respondent department however, willfully delayed the case of promotion of Instructors (B-17) to the post of Assistant Professor (B-18), thus depriving experienced instructors / lecturers of their benefit due.
5. The appellant filed his departmental appeal dated 19-01-2021, requesting the worthy authority to grant him promotion against the 60% of the quota for promotion to the post of B-18 with retrospective effect since the date it was lying vacant in the department, on analogy of his seniors (Mr. Nadeem Anjum Ansari etc.) allowed vide the HED notification No. SO(CE&MS)HED/695(1-33) dated. 11/5/2020. His departmental appeal was not decided till the expiry of the statutory period of 90 days. (Copies annexed hereto marked "D" & "E")

Feeling aggrieved and finding no other remedy, the appellant has been constrained to approach the Hon'ble Service Tribunal for the redress of his grievance, respectfully maintaining that he be considered for promotion to the post of Assistant Professor (B-18) in view of the rules prevailing at the time of sanction of the available vacancies, inter-alia, for the following.

Grounds

- (a) That the impugned omission of the authority to promote the appellant with effect from the date of creation of vacancy in the next higher scale without considering the material facts on record and is illegal and void ab-initio and is liable to be set right by this Hon'ble Tribunal.
- (b) That the august Supreme Court of Pakistan in case law reported as 1985 SCMR 1158 has categorically held that the promotees shall be considered for promotion with effect from the dated when vacancies in their quota became available in next higher scale.

Moreso, the august Supreme Court has strictly emphasized that the quota should be implemented in the manner so prescribe and no deviation is permissible under the law. 2000 SCMR 1555, 1998 SCMR 88.

The worthy Service Tribunal has already settled the matter in question while deciding the Service Appeal No. 524/2011 titled "Nadeem Anjum Ansari Vs Govt" and 21 other identical appeals vide judgment and order dated 04-04-2012, while holding as under;

7. The Tribunal observes that the appellant was serving as Instructor (BPS-17). Certain posts of Assistant Professor were lying vacant in the department. Being eligible and fit for promotion, his working papers were prepared on the basis of 80% quota, for promotion against the post under the Service Rules notified in the year, 1994. The promotion process has been delayed by the department for the reasons best known to them. In the meantime, the department notified fresh Service Rules on 3-12-2010 wherein quota for promotion has been decreased from 80% to 60% and resultantly the promotion case of the appellant was returned to re-format it on the basis of newly circulated Service Rules. Under the law, rules circulars or regulations made or enacted cannot be given retrospective effect. The appellant alongwith others should have been considered for promotion against the posts already available for them under the prevailing Service Rules. The Tribunal agrees with the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for the appellant.
8. In view of the above, the appeal is accepted and the respondents are directed to consider the appellant alongwith others for promotion from the date, when clear vacancies were available for them; subject to seniority / fitness etc. under the rules in vogue at that time. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record.

ANNOUNCED

The Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa challenged the judgment of this Hon'ble Tribunal before the august Supreme Court of Pakistan thorough CA No. 91-P to 112-P / 2013, which were dismissed vide judgment dated 09-02-2015, wherein the judgment of this Tribunal dated 04-04-2012 was maintained. (Copies annexed hereto marked "F" & "G").

- (d) That Mr. Anwar Ul Haq Assistant Professor (BPS-18) retired from service from the department on 03-04-2012, Mr. Umer Ali Khan, Assistant Professor (BPS-18) was selected as Associate Professor (BPS-19) through PSC on 04-02-2013, 10 Assistant Professors (BPS-18) were promoted to the post of Associate Professors on 24-10-2013 and Muhammad Yousaf, Assistant Professor (BPS-18) retired from service on 11-11-2013.

Thus a total of 13 vacancies were lying vacant with the respondent department w.e.f. 03-04-2012 to 11-11-2013 but no appropriate action was taken by the respondent department to consider the appellant for promotion to next higher scale.

- (e) That apart from the 13 posts mentioned in para "c" above 26 posts of Assistant Professors (BPS-18) were created by the respondent department on 07-02-2014. Thus a total of 39 sanctioned posts of Assistant Professors (B-18) from promotion quota were lying vacant with the respondent department till 07-02-2014.

That 23 Assistant Professors (B-18) were directly appointed on 13-03-2014, while still leaving behind 39 posts for promotion for the lecturers serving the department in BPS-17.


- (f) The denial of promotion to the appellant in view of the vacant post on 03-04-2012 is arbitrary, discriminatory, malafide and such is without lawful authority.
- (g) The appellant being qualified and eligible lawfully deserves to be considered for promotion to the post of Assistant Professor (B-18) on the 60% quota reserved for the promotion of Lecturers / Instructors with effect from 03-04-2012.
- (h) Above all remains the fact that equity and justice demands integration retrospectively w.e.f. the actual date of availability of post of B-18. The Respondent department had to comply accordingly. Any design harmful to the Appellant's service interest cannot be imposed arbitrarily.
- (i) The appellant's case merits acceptance and is lawfully entitled to be promoted as Assistant Professor (B-18) with effect from the date of creation of the post i.e. 03-04-2012 and is consequently entitled to be rightfully placed at serial No. 16 of the seniority list of Assistant Professors (BPS-18), above all the directly appointed Assistant Professors (B-18) respondents 5 to 27. (Copy of seniority list annexed hereto marked "H").
- (j) The Respondent was required by law to act in accordance with the well established principles of equity and justice. Their omission and reluctance to do so justify interference by the Hon'ble Service Tribunal.
- (k) Appellant seeks permission to take several other grounds at the time of arguments.

In view of the above, this appeal may be accepted while directing the Respondents No. 1 to 4 to allow the appellant ante date promotion to the post of Assistant Professor (B-18) against the 60% quota reserved for promotion retrospectively w.e.f 03-04-2012 and is entitled to be placed at serial No. 16 of the seniority list of Assistant Professors BPS-18 above all directly appointed Assistant Professors / respondent No. 5 to 27 with all the benefits of service due.



- a) They shall, for all intents in purpose, be Civil Servants except for purpose of pension or gratuity. In lieu of pension and gratuity, they shall be entitled to receive such amount contributed by them towards Contributory Provident Fund (C.P.F) along with the contributions made by Government to their accounts in the said fund, in the prescribed manner.
- b) They shall be governed by the NWFP Civil Servants Act 1973, all the laws applicable to the Civil Servants and Rules made thereunder.

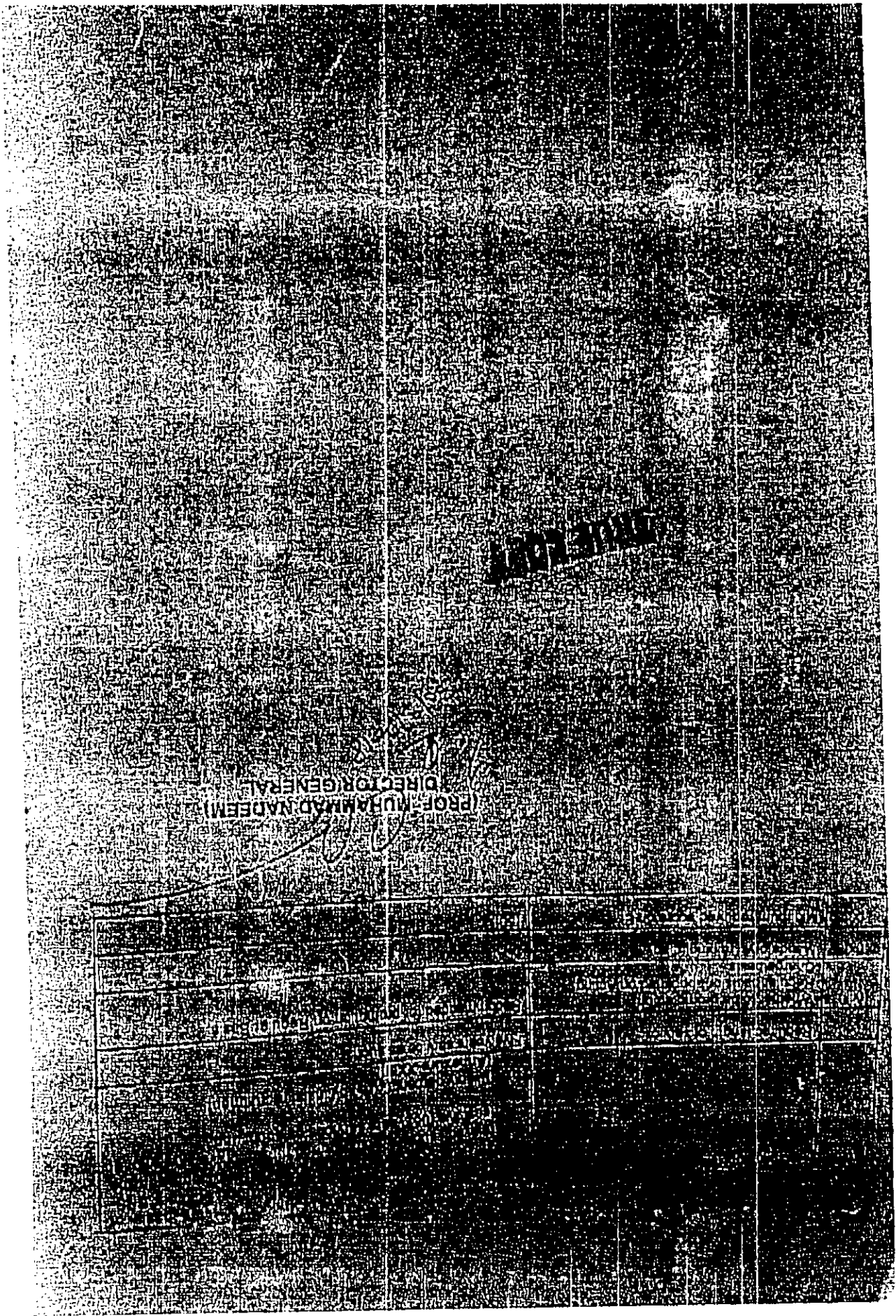

With reverence it is stated that I am currently serving as Assistant Professors at GCMS Peshawar and have the then close seniority with the recently antedated promoted Assistant Professors (Mr Nadeem Anjum Ansari and others) and want to bring your kind focus to the following facts:

5. After a long struggle since 2011, our senior Assistant Professors have been awarded retrospective seniority vide the seniority list issued on dated. 31-12-2020; They are also promoted with Antedated promotion vide the Department's Notification No. 50(CE&MS)HED/1-2/695(1-33) dated. 11-05-2020 according to the judgment of Civil Appeal No. 91-P to 112-P of 2013 dated. 26/09/2015 issued by the Honorable Supreme court of Pakistan after. It is found that they were promoted when they had exactly five years service.
6. Due to this court case our promotion has been kept in abeyance for a long time (from 2012 to 2018) despite of the fact that the substantial seats of promotional quota had been lying vacant since 2012 and I was fulfilling all the eligibility requirements like qualifying service of five (5) years.
7. During these years, the department had been making initial recruitments of Assistant Professors (BPS-18) and Associate Professors (BPS-19) by Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission but the promotional quota seats have not been filled which appears to be unjust to already suffering employees.
8. The call of justice would be that the sufferer would have also been considered along with the aforementioned promotees to compensate career and financial loss as I was having close seniority with them in 2011.

Keeping in view the historical facts, I humbly request to your kind esteem to adjust my seniority retrospectively and process my promotion case according to the vacant post of Assistant Professor at the time I had completed qualifying service.

Looking at your gracious professional stature and discerning eyes I appeal to compensate me with the same degree of fruition as my seniors have been bestowed upon. Your affectionate considerations will highly be appreciated and acknowledged please.



JUDGMENT

SYED MANZOOR ALI SHAH, MEMBER. This appeal has been filed by Nadeem Anjum Ansari, the appellant under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal's Act, 1974. It has been prayed that on acceptance of the appeal, the respondents may be directed to consider the appellant for promotion to the post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18) against the 60% quota reserved for promotion in view of the rules availing at the time of sanctioned availability/creation of the post with retrospective effect with all the benefits of service.

2. Brief facts of the case are that the appellant was selected and appointed as Junior Instructor (BPS-14) in Technical Education and Manpower Training Peshawar

Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar on 11.12.1989. He was promoted to the post of Instructor (BPS-17) on 26.5.2006. He is serving continuously in the said capacity till date. Having put in more than 22 years of service, he is entitled to be promoted as Assistant Professor (BPS-18) on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness. The Provincial Government had accorded sanction to the creation of different posts including Assistant Professors (BPS-18) in different Government Colleges of Commerce and Management Sciences vide different notifications dated 26.7.2007, to 19.2.2010, copies of which are available on record. The posts of Assistant Professors (BPS-18) were lying vacant since their sanction of creation and the respondent department was required to promote the Instructors (BPS-17) on the 80% of the available posts in view of the Technical Education Recruitment Rules Issued vide notification No.SO(TE)/7-55/89, dated 1.9.1994. Working paper for the promotion of the eligible regular/acting charge officers was prepared and a proper advice to this effect was given to the Directorate General Technical Education and Manpower Training vide notification dated 21.10.2009. The respondent department delayed the case of promotion of Instructors (BPS-17) to the post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18) and amended the rules vide notification dated 3.12.2010. The 80% quota from promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Lecturers/Instructors (BPS-17) (Commerce/Management Sciences) was reduced to 60% of the available vacancies and 20% quota for direct recruitment through Public Service Commission was enhanced to 40%. Feeling aggrieved the appellant filed departmental appeal on 29.12.2010, which has not been decided within the statutory period of ninety days, hence this appeal.

3. The appeal was admitted to regular hearing on 3.5.2012 and notices were issued to the respondents. The respondents have filed their joint written reply and contested the appeal. The appellant also filed rejoinder in rebuttal.

4. Arguments heard and record perused.

5. The learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant was appointed as Junior Instructor in BPS-14 on 11.12.1989. He was then promoted as Instructor (BPS-17) on 26.5.2006. The Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Education Department, notified Service Rules on 1.9.1994 for different posts including Assistant Professor (BPS-18). The post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18) to be filled in eighty percent by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Instructors who hold a Bachelors Degree in Technical subjects in the relevant field with five years' service as such; and twenty percent by initial recruitment in the specified subject. Certain posts of Assistant Professor (BPS-18)

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were lying vacant in the department. Working papers of eligible Instructors including the appellant were prepared but the department delayed the process of promotion on mala fide intentions for a period of more than two years. He further argued that the department Industries, Commerce and Technical Education Department vide notification dated 3.12.2010, amended the Service Rules and decreased the promotion quota from eighty percent to sixty percent and increased the direct recruitment quota from twenty percent to forty percent and the appellant has been deprived of his legal right to be considered for promotion against the post of Assistant Professor. He stated that the posts were lying vacant in the department before the amendment in the Service Rules, therefore it could not affect the promotion of the appellant as it is well established principles of law that rules, regulation etc. framed or enacted cannot be given retrospective effect. He requested that the appeal may be accepted as prayed.

6. The learned AAG, on the other hand, argued that length of service is not the sole criteria to qualify a person for promotion, other conditions such as the availability of posts, seniority-cum-fitness are also taken into consideration. Promotion are always made with immediate effect. As per the fresh Recruitment & Promotion Rules notified on 3.12.2010, the promotion quota was reduced from 80% to 60%. There are 162 posts of Assistant Professor in the Commerce side, out of which 97 posts fall to the share of promotion quota and 65 posts fall to the share of initial recruitment. All the posts falling to promotion quota have already been filled in as per fresh recruitment and promotion rules. He requested that the appeal may be dismissed.

7. The Tribunal observes that the appellant was serving as Instructor (BPS-17). Certain posts of Assistant Professor were lying vacant in the department. Being eligible and fit for promotion, his working papers were prepared on the basis of 80% quota, for promotion against the post under the Service Rules notified in the year, 1994. The promotion process has been delayed by the department for the reasons best known to them. In the meantime, the department notified fresh Service Rules on 3.12.2010 wherein quota for promotion has been decreased from 80% to 60% and resultantly the promotion case of the appellant was returned to re-format it on the basis of newly circulated Service Rules. Under the law, rules, circulars or regulations made or enacted cannot be given retrospective effect. The appellant alongwith others should have been considered for promotion against the posts already available for them under the prevailing Service Rules. The Tribunal agrees with the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for the appellant.

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5. In view of the above, the appeal is accepted and the respondents are directed to consider the appellant alongwith others for promotion from the date, when their vacancies were available for them, subject to seniority/fitness etc. under the rules in vogue at that time. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record.

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ORDER

EJAZ AFZAL KHAN, J.- These appeals with the leave of the Court have arisen out of the judgment dated 1.1.2012 of the learned Service Tribunal whereby it allowed the appeals filed by the respondents by holding as under:-

"8. In view of the above, the appeal is accepted and the respondents are directed to consider the appellant alongwith others for promotion from the date, when clear vacancies were available for them, subject to seniority/fitness etc. under the rules in vogue at that time. Parties are left to bear their own costs."


2. Points raised and noted at the time of grant of leave read as under:


"2. The learned Advocate General KPK submits inter alia that :

i) the working paper relied upon by the respondents were only for promotion on officiating and not regular basis;

ii) the respondents were promoted to BPS-17 on different dates in the year 2006 and by the year 2009 they were not even qualified for promotion to BPS-18 on regular basis, as according to the Rules of 1994 they had to gain five years experience in BPS-17 before they could be considered for promotion to the next higher grade and;

iii) the Petitioner Department is empowered to change the promotion and recruitment rules at any time and the respondents are not invested with any right that their terms and conditions of service be regulated by particular rules".

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
3. Learned Addl. A.G. appearing on behalf of the appellants contended that where it is the prerogative of the Government to enact and amend rules to update and uplift the service structure, no person can claim any vested right on the strength of a rule so long as he has not acquired a vested right. The learned Addl. A. G. to support his contention placed reliance on the case of "Dr. Alyas Qadeer Tahir. Vs. Secretary Ministry of Education (Now M/o CADD), Islamabad and others" (2014 SCMR 997).

4. Learned ASC appearing on behalf of the respondents contended that where the vacancies occurred before the amendment of the rules and the officials working in scale-17 acquired a right for being considered for promotion to the next higher scale, subsequent amendment cannot take away such right. The learned ASC to support his contention placed reliance on the cases of "Water and Power Development Authority Lahore through Chairman and others. Vs. Haji Abdul Aziz and others" (2012 SCMR 965) and Muhammad Amjad and others. Vs. Dr. Israr Ahmed and others (2010 PLC (C.S.) 760).

5. We have gone through the entire record carefully and considered the submissions of the learned Addl. A.G for the appellants and the learned ASC for the respondents.

6. Before we appreciate the contentions of the learned Additional Advocate General for the appellant, it is worthwhile to refer to the rule subsisting during the period when




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vacancies in the next higher scale occurred. The rule reads as under :-

7. The above quoted rule was amended by notification No. SOIII(IND)TE/4-13/20/Teaching Cadre dated 3.12.2010. The rule thus amended reads as under :-

"a) Sixty percent by promotion, on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness, from amongst the Lectures (BPS-17) (Commerce/Management Sciences), having Master's Degree in the relevant subjects with five years service as such;"

8. It is too settled to be cavilled at that it is the prerogative of the Government to enact and amend rules to update and uplift the service structure. Nobody, therefore, can claim any right much less vested thereunder. But it is not the case where vacancies occur in the next higher scale during the subsistence of the rules and yet they are not filled. Those who are eligible for promotion may not have acquired a vested right for promotion but they will certainly acquire a vested right for being considered therefor. If the department does not

fill the vacancies soon after their occurrence under the

erstwhile dispensation from amongst the eligible persons, it is the fault of the department, therefore, they cannot be punished therefor. They are to be considered for promotion to the next higher scale under the erstwhile rules against the vacancies occurring during their subsistence. Subsequent amendment in the rules cannot take away such right. The cases of "Water and Power Development Authority Lahore through Chairman and others. Vs. Haji Abdul Aziz and others" and Muhammad Amjad and others. Vs. Dr. Israr Ahmed and others (supra) may well be referred to in this behalf. The case of "Dr. Alyas Qadeer Tahir. Vs. Secretary Ministry of Education (Now M/o CADD), Islamabad and others" (supra) being distinguishable has no relevance to the case in hand. The view taken by the Service Tribunal being in conformity with the dicta of this Court is not open to any interference.

For the reasons discussed above, these appeals being without merit are dismissed.

JOINT PARA-WISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENT NO. 1 To 4.

Respectfully Sheweth: -

Preliminary Objections: -

1. That the Appellant does not fall within the definition of an aggrieved person and has no locus standi to file the appeal in hand.
2. That the Appellant has got no cause of action to file the instant case.
3. That the Appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant appeal.
4. That filing of this appeal is futile exercise and wastage of precious time of this Honorable Service Tribunal, liable to be dismissed forthwith.
5. That the instant appeal is barred by law and not maintainable.
6. That the appeal in hand is barred by limitation.
7. That the appeal is bad for mis-joinder and non joinder of necessary and proper parties.
8. That this Hon'ble tribunal has no jurisdiction to adjudicate upon the matter.

On Facts: -

1. Para-1 pertains to record.
2. Para -2 is incorrect. Length of service and availability of post is not the sole criteria to qualify a person for promotion, other conditions such as the seniority-cum-fitness, and prescribed promotion criteria of the Provincial Government as per established service rules of the department and ACRs are also taken into consideration. Promotion is also made with immediate effect. According to Recruitment & Promotion Rules notified on 03-12-2010, the promotion quota was reduced from 80% to 60%. There were 162 posts of Assistant Professor (BPS-18) in the Commerce side, out of which 97 posts falls to the share of promotion quota and 65 posts falls to the share of initial recruitment.

All the posts fallen to promotion quota were already been filled at that time, however, the appellant was not eligible at that time due to short length of the required service as the appellant was appointed on 18-05-2007 as Lecturer (BPS-17), however, according to Service Rules 2010, 05 years service was required for promotion to the post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18). It is further added that the Provincial Selection Board in its meeting held on 28-02-2011 promoted only eight 08 Lecturers to the post of Assistant Professors (BPS-18) as mentioned at serial No.3,4,6,7,8,9,11 and 12 of the seniority list as stood on 31-12-2009 (Seniority list attached as Annexure-A) against the eight 08 vacant posts, while the appellant was at serial No.49 of the seniority list of 2009. (Minutes of the meeting dated 28-02-2011 are enclosed as annexure-B) In the year 2016, as per judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan dated 9-12-2015, the promotion case of 33 No's lecturer (BPS-17) were processed in the year 2016 and they were promoted to the post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18) as per their seniority position. The appellant was junior from all these 33 Lecturers (BPS-17) promoted to the post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18). (Minutes of the meeting are enclosed as annexure-C).

3. Para-3 is incorrect. The Provincial Selection Board (PSB) in its meeting held on 28-02-2011 recommended eight (08) Lecturers BS-17 for promotion as Assistant Professor BS-18 according to the amended Service Rules notified on 03-12-2010 (Service Rules attached as Annexure-D) wherein promotion quota was decreased from eighty percent (80%) to Sixty (60%). Certain officers filed an appeal in the Service Tribunal for consideration of their promotion under old Service Rules notified on 01-09-1994, wherein 80% quota was given to promotion and the same was accepted by the Service Tribunal. The Provincial Government filed CPLA in the Supreme Court of Pakistan against the Judgment of Service Tribunal. The Court dismissed the civil appeal of the Government. Accordingly, on the direction of court the promotion case of the senior most Lecturers was processed and the PSB in its meeting held on 09-12-2016 recommended the promotion of 33 Lecturers (BPS-17) to the post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18). It is further stated that the appellant was even not considered in the PSB meeting held on 09-12-2016 as the appellant was junior from the promoted officers. The appellant was promoted to the post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18) on 03-05-2018 on regular basis (Minutes of the meeting dated 03-05-2018 are enclosed as annexure-E) and accordingly he was given seniority from the date of his regular promotion as per rules (i.e.) seniority is determined from the date of regular appointment/promotion.
4. It is incorrect in view of reply given in the preceding paras.
5. It is incorrect in view of reply given in the preceding paras.

REPLY ON GROUNDS:-

- a) It is incorrect. Length of service and availability of post is not the sole criteria to qualify a person for promotion, other conditions such as the seniority-cum-fitness, and prescribed promotion criteria of the Provincial government as per established service rules of the department and ACRs are also taken into consideration.

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According to Promotion Policy 2009, Promotion is always notified with immediate effect. Further, as per seniority list, the appellant was not considered for promotion as he was very much junior from the Lecturers promoted in 2011 and 2016.

- b) As explained in preceding paras.
- c) In reply, it is submitted that the Provincial Selection Board (PSB) in its meeting held on 28-02-2011 recommended eight (08) Lecturers (BPS-17) for promotion as Assistant Professor (BPS-18) according to the amended Service Rules notified on 03-12-2010 wherein promotion quota was decreased from eighty percent (80%) to Sixty (60%). Certain officers filed an appeal in the Service Tribunal for consideration of their promotion under old Service Rules notified on 01-09-1994, wherein 80% quota goes to promotion and the same was accepted by the Service Tribunal. The Provincial Government filed CPLA in the Supreme Court of Pakistan against the Judgment of Service Tribunal. The Court dismissed the civil appeal of the Government. Accordingly, the promotion case of the senior most Lecturers was processed and the PSB in its meeting held on 09-12-2016 recommended the promotion of 33 Lecturers (BPS-17) to the post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18). It is further stated that the appellant was even not considered in the PSB meeting held on 09-12-2016 as the appellant was junior from the promoted officers.
- d) As explained in para-C above.
- e) It is incorrect with further clarification that as per Service Rules, 20% quota is reserved for initial recruitment while 80% quota is reserved for promotion quota. All the vacant posts become vacant due to creation/promotion/retirement does not mean that all the posts are reserved for promotion. 20% quota is reserved for initial quota and 80% quota reserved for promotion quota and out of promotion quota, 33 posts reserved for promotion quota were placed before the Provincial Selection Board and accordingly, the PSB in its meeting dated 09-12-2016 recommended the promotion of 33 Lecturers BS-17 to the Post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18).
- f) It is incorrect in view of the reply given in the preceding paras.
- g) It is incorrect. The appellant claim promotion with effect from 03-04-2012 is baseless because the appellant was appointed as Lecturer (BPS-17) on 18-05-2007 and according to Service Rules, for promotion to the post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18) five Years service in (BPS-17) is mandatory.
- h) It is incorrect. According to Recruitment & Promotion Rules notified on 03-12-2010, the promotion quota was reduced from 80% to 60%. There were 162 posts of Assistant Professor (BPS-18) in the Commerce side, out of which 97 posts falls to the share of promotion quota and 65 posts falls to the share of initial recruitment.

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All the posts fallen to promotion quota were already been filled at that time, the appellant was even not eligible at that time because the appellant was appointed as Lecturer on 18-05-2007 and for promotion to Assistant Professor (BPS-18), 05 years' service is mandatory.

- i) Incorrect. As explained in Paras ibid.
- j) Incorrect. The Appellant is treated in accordance with laws and regulations.
- k) The Respondents also seek the permission of this Hon'ble Tribunal to advance additional arguments and raise additional grounds at the time of arguments.

Prayer: -

In view of the above submissions, it is humbly prayed that the Service Appeal in hand may be dismissed with costs, being devoid of merit and time barred.





SUBJECT: PROMOTION OF INSTRUCTOR/LECTURER BS-17 TO THE POST OF ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (COMMERCE) BS-18

Secretary Higher Education apprised the Board that due to promotion/creation/appointment in upper scale of officers and death, thirty three (33) posts of Assistant Professor (Commerce) BS-18 falling to the share of promotion quota are lying vacant. He further apprised the Board that the Board in its meeting held on 25.02.2011 recommended eight (08) Lecturers BS-17 for promotion as Assistant Professor BS-18 according to the amended Service Rules notified on 03.12.2010 wherein promotion quota was decreased from eighty percent (80%) to sixty percent (60%). Certain officers filed an appeal in Service Tribunal for consideration of their promotion under old Service rules notified on 01.09.1994, wherein 80% quota goes to promotion and the same was accepted by the Tribunal. The Provincial Govt filed CPLA in Supreme Court of Pakistan against the judgment of Service Tribunal. The court dismissed the civil appeal of the Govt. Resultantly the department forwarded the working paper proposing therein promotion w.e.f. 28.02.2011, the date on which the previous meeting of PSB was held. The Board considered the working paper and observed that according to promotion policy 2009, promotion is always notified with immediate effect and their promotion with retrospective effect will open a Pandora's Box which will create problem for Govt in future. Hence the Board recommended the promotion with immediate effect.

2. According to old service rules the post is required to be filled as under:-

- i. Eighty percent by promotion, on the basis of seniority cum fitness from amongst the Instructors/Lecturers, Government Commerce Training institutes, Government College of Commerce with five year service in BS-17, provided that if no candidate having the requisite qualification and experience is available for promotion then by initial recruitment to be adjusted in future vacancies.
- ii. Twenty percent by initial recruitment.
