REPLY BY RESPONDENTS NO. 1, 2, 3& 4.

Respectfully Sheweth:-

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:-

- 1. That the appeal is badly barred by law & limitation.
- 2. That the appeal is bad for mis-joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.
- 3. That the appellant has not come to Hon'able Tribunal with clean hands.
- 4. That the appellant has no cause of action and locus standi to file the instant appeal.
- 5. That the appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant appeal.
- 6. That the appellant has concealed the material facts from Honorable Tribunal.
- 7. That the appeal is not maintainable being devoid of any merit.

REPLY ON FACTS:-

- 1) Incorrect. The appellant was appointed as constable in the year 2011 in the respondent department.
- 2) Incorrect. The appellant has not a clean service record and contains 02 bad entries, on different occasions in his service.
- 3) Para needs to be proved.
- 4) Para needs to be proved.
- 5) Para pertains to record.
- 6) Incorrect. In fact the appellant was posted at PS tehkal, Peshawar absented from his lawful duty w.e.from 27.03.2016 to 18.07.2017(total 01 year, 03 months and 21 days) without taking any Leave/Permission. In this regard, he was issued Charge Sheet with Statement of Allegations. SDPO Town was appointed as Enquiry Officer. The enquiry officer finalized the enquiry and submitted finding report, wherein the allegations, of wilful absence were proved against him. Upon receipt of the findings report, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to him. After observing all codal formalities, he was awarded major punishment of dismissal from service.(copy of charge sheet, statement of allegations, enquiry report and FSCN are annexure as B,,C,D,E)
- 7) Incorrect. The appellant was issued charge sheet with summary of allegations, proper enquiry was conducted and final show cause notice was issued before passing the punishment order. He was provided full opportunity of defense but he foiled to defend

- himself. After fulfilling all codal formalities appellant was found guilty, hence awarded major punishment of dismissal from service under the rules.
- 8) Incorrect. The appellant preferred time barred departmental appeal on 31.12.2018 after inordinate delay of about 01 year, 05 months and 13 days, meaning thereby that he was not interested and his departmental appeal was filed/rejected on the grounds of facts and limitation.
- 9) Incorrect. Appellant preferred revision petition before the appellate authority, which after due consideration was also filed/rejected being time barred.
- 10) That appeal of the appellant being devoid of merits and limitation may be dismissed on the following grounds.

REPLY ON GROUNDS:

- A) Incorrect. The punishment orders are in accordance with law/rules and liable to be upheld.
- B) Incorrect. The competent authority before imposing the major punishment had completed all codal formalities and an ample opportunity of self defense was provided, but appellant being not interested in his official duty remained continuously absented from lawful duty for long period without any leave. The respondents department has not been violated any provision of Constitution of Pakistan 1973.
- C) Incorrect. Proper departmental enquiry was conducted against the appellant. The enquiry officer called time and again but he did not turn up. The allegations were proved against him; thereafter a final show cause notice was issued before passing the punishment order, after fulfilling of all codal formalities he was awarded appropriate punishment in accordance with facts and rules.
- D) Incorrect. The appellant was provided the opportunities of defense, but he willfully avoided. The charges of deliberately absence were proved against him. Therefore, the punishment order was passed by competent authority in pursuance of his long absence period which is not tolerable in the disciplined force.
- E) Incorrect. Being a member of a disciplined force the appellant was well aware about the proceedings and its consequences. However he deliberately absented from his lawful duty without any leave /permission. The punishment order passed by the competent authority is in accordance with law/rules.
- F) Incorrect. The appellant availed the opportunities of defense, but he could not prove his innocence with plausible grounds.
- G) Respondents also seek permission of this Honorable Tribunal to raise additional grounds at the time of arguments.

Prayers:-

Keeping in view the above stated facts & reasons it is, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant being devoid of merits and limitation, may kindly be dismissed with costs please.


