





APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT 1974 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 1.7.2016 WHEREBY THE CONFIRMATION ORDER OF THE APPELLANT TO THE RANK OF SUB INSPECTOR HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN AND AGAINST NO ACTION TAKEN ON THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN THE STATUTORY PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this appeal the impugned order dated 1-07-2016 may very kindly be set aside and the appellant and the confirmation order of the appellant dated 25.1.2016 may kindly be restored with all back benefits. That the respondents may further please be directed to consider the appellant for officiating promotion to the Rank of Inspector w.e.f. 2.3.2017 with all back benefits. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

ON FACTS:

1. That the appellant joined the respondent Department as Constable at Malakand Region and on satisfactory

performance was promoted to the Ranks of Head Constable and Assistant Sub Inspector.

2. That where after the appellant was promoted to the Rank of Officiating Sub Inspector and was confirmed in the Rank of Sub Inspector on the proper recommendation of Departmental Promotion Committee vide order dated 25.1.2016. That accordingly the name of the appellant was brought into list "E". Copy of the order is attached as annexure..... **A.**
3. That all of a sudden the confirmation order of the appellant in the Rank of Sub Inspector has been withdrawn without any solid reason vide impugned order dated 1.7.2016. That it is pertinent to mention that according to the circular dated 11.9.2004 the period spent in training institutes including traffic training school be counted towards confirmation as Sub Inspector but inspite of that the respondents withdrawn the order of confirmation of the appellant. Copies of the impugned order and circular are attached as annexure **B and C.**
4. That all the S.I's of Malakand Region including the appellant were not selected for upper college course during the year 2003 to 2009 due to law and order situation in Malakand Region. That later on in the year 2009 the respondent no.1 issued standing order whereby upper college course was declared mandatory for confirmation, and further promotion. That colleagues of the appellant feeling aggrieved filed writ petition No.231-M/2013 before the Peshawar High Court Dar Ul Qaza Bench swat and vide judgment dated 28.3.2014 the same was disposed of with the direction to decide the Departmental appeal of the petitioners within a period of 30 days. Copies of the application and judgment are attached as annexure **D and E.**
5. That all those S.I's who filed above mentioned writ petition were promoted to the Rank of Inspector (BPS-16) on officiating basis without the condition of upper college Course vide Notification dated 2.3.2017 while the appellant was ignored on the reason that unless and until his withdrawal order regarding confirmation in the Rank of Sub Inspector is not being set aside he will serve the Department in the present rank. Copies of the proforma and Notification are attached as annexure **F and G.**

6. That appellant having no other remedy filed Departmental appeal but of no avail. Hence the present appeal on the following grounds amongst the others. Copy of the Departmental appeal is attached as annexure H.

GROUND:

- A- That impugned order dated 1-7-2016 issued by the respondents is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondent Department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- C- That, the treatment meted out to the appellant clearly based on discrimination and malafide and as such the respondents violated the principle of natural justice.
- D- That the case of the appellant is clear violation of the Law & Rules of "Locus Poenitentiae " meaning thereby that once an order has been issued can not be reverted/ withdrawn unilaterally".
- E- That neither notice nor chance of personal hearing has been given by the respondents to appellant before issuing the impugned orders dated 1.7.2016 against the appellant.
- F- That appellant is fully entitled for his ante dated seniority and officiating promotion to the Rank of Inspector in light of the prevailing Rules.
- G- That all those S.I's who filed writ petition were promoted to the Rank of Inspector (BPS-16) on officiating basis without the condition of upper college Course vide Notification dated 2.3.2017 while the appellant was ignored on the reason that unless and until his withdrawal order regarding confirmation in the Rank of Sub Inspector is not being set aside he will serve the Department in the present rank.
- H- That the respondents acted in arbitrary and malafide manner while issuing the impugned order dated 1.7.2016 against the appellant.

- I- That it is pertinent to mention that according to the circular dated 11.9.2004 the period spent in training institutes including traffic training school be counted towards confirmation as Sub Inspector but inspite of that the respondents withdrawn the order of confirmation of the appellant.
- J- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may very graciously be accepted as prayed for, please.

The contents of the DPC held on 23/2/2000 is re-produced below for strict compliance:-

1. The DIG of Police, Peshawar Range Peshawar has reported that DPC were constituted to examine the confirmation cases of Offg: SIs due for confirmation in their ranks.
2. During the proceeding the SSP Peshawar pointed out that those Offg: SIs who have remained posted to Special Branch and Crimes Branch for a period of One year can be considered for confirmation in their ranks.
3. In this connection Police Rules Para-10(2) is reproduced below:-

POLICE RULES 13.10(2)

"No ASI shall be confirmed in a substantive vacancy in the rank of SI unless he has been tested for at least a year as an Offg: SI independent charge of a Police Station in a District other than that in which his Home is situated".

4. According to Para-10 of the minutes of the meeting held in Police Club on 14-8-1977 that those who remained posted at PTC/Hangu for 3 years and also in Special Branch/Crime Branch there should be no bar in their confirmation in the rank of SI. In case, they have not remained posted as SHO the period they have spent in PTC/Hangu should be counted towards the period of the SI.
5. Previously CID was a component of Special Branch therefore, the SIs posted in CID may also be considered for confirmation in their ranks.
6. This case relates to the period of posting of CID for counting or otherwise for confirmation as SI. Confusion was arised that whether period of CID is also countable towards the confirmation of SI like the period of Special Branch.

8. Accordingly the DIG of Police, Peshawar Range, Peshawar was informed vide this Office Endst:No:17041/E-II dated 22-9-1999.

9. Now the DIG of Police, Peshawar Range, Peshawar has submitted the following:-

1. Clarification was sought on the Minutes of the Police Conference held in Police Club, Peshawar on 14-8-1977 under the Chairmanship of the then Police Chief.
2. The only issue is that whether period spent on posting in the CID is to be counted equivalent to the posting of SHO of a Police Station or not.
3. This decision needs to be taken at the level of IGP as there seems to be no necessity forwarding it to the Home Deptt;

10. He has further requested that the decision in the matter may be taken so that the confirmation cases are not delayed.

This DPC thoroughly examined the case and unanimously recommended to be considered the period of posting of SIs who remained posted in CID for a period of 3 years for confirmation as SI like Special Branch, Crimes Branch and Training Institutions.

You are requested to keep in mind the requirements under PR 13.10(2) and period of Special Branch, Investigation Unit, CID & Training Institutes, which recommending the cases for list-F.

Respected Sir,

With due respect it is stated that I was joined your good self Department as Constable at Malakand Region. During service I was promoted to the Ranks of Head Constable and Assistant Sub Inspector and where after I was promoted to the Rank of Officiating Sub Inspector and was confirmed in the Rank of Sub Inspector on the proper recommendation of Departmental Promotion Committee vide order dated 25.1.2016. That accordingly my name was brought into list 'E'. Later on my confirmation order in the Rank of Sub Inspector has been withdrawn without any solid reason vide impugned order dated 1.7.2016. That it is pertinent to mention that according to the circular dated 11.9.2004 the period spent in training institutes including traffic training school be counted towards confirmation as Sub Inspector but inspite of that the concerned authority withdrawn the order of my confirmation. All the S.Is of Malakand Region including me were not selected for upper college course during the year 2003 to 2009 due to law and order situation in Malakand Region. Later on in the year 2009 the concerned authority issued standing order whereby upper college course was declared mandatory for confirmation and further promotion. That my colleagues feeling aggrieved filed writ petition No.231-M/2013 before the Peshawar High Court Dar Ul Qaza Bench swat and vide judgment dated 28.3.2014 the same was disposed of with the direction to decide the Departmental appeal of the petitioners within a period of 30 days and all those S.Is who filed above mentioned writ petition were promoted to the Rank of Inspector (BPS-16) on officiating basis without the condition of upper college Course vide Notification dated 2.3.2017 but I was ignored on the reason that unless and until my withdrawal order regarding confirmation in the Rank of Sub Inspector is not being set aside.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this Departmental appeal the impugned order dated 01.07.2016 may very kindly be set aside and my confirmation order dated 25.01.2016 to rank of Sub Inspector may be restored. Any other remedy which your good self deems fit that may also be awarded in my favor.
