Learned counsel for the appellant present. Mr. Asad Ali Khan learned Assistant Advocate General for the respondents present.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant alongwith others applied for the post Qari Teacher (BPS-12) and after passing through required test they were qualified but respondents reluctant to issue appointment orders of the appellant as Qari Teacher. On 13.06.2014 appellant preferred appeal which was accepted and he was appointed vide order dated 14.02.2015. He further argued that as appellant had qualified and passed NTS test and in accordance with merit list of qualified candidates/appointees vide order dated 13.06.2014, therefore, appellant will also be appointed from 13.06.2014 but when seniority list was issued appellant was placed junior to appointees of 13.06.2014 which is injustice, therefore, appellant filed departmental appeal which was not decided within statutory period of ninety days. Hence, instant service appeal 21.02.2022 under Section 4 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal 1974. Points raised need consideration. Instant appeal is admitted for regular hearing subject to all legal objections. Appellant is directed to deposit security fee within 10 days. Written reply on behalf of respondents submitted through office, which is found place on file. Cost of Rs. 5000/- paid receipt of which is also placed on file. To come up for arguments on 22.11.2023 before D.B at Camp Court, D.I.Khan. P.P given to learned counsel for the appellant.
